On the Road : The St. Cloud State women's basketball team begins a four-game road stretch with Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference (NSIC) games on Friday, Feb. 13 at Southwest Minnesota State and on Saturday, Feb. 14 at Minnesota State University Mankato. Both games begin at 6:00 p.m.

For the Record: St. Cloud State is in third place in the NSIC standings with an 11-4 league mark and 18-4 overall record. Southwest Minnesota State is 11-14 overall and 3-12 in the NSIC, and in 12th place. Nationally ranked Minnesota State University is the leader in the NSIC with a 14-1 league record and 21-1 overall mark.

Series Records: The rivalry between the Huskies and **Southwest Minnesota State** women's basketball programs dates back to the 1970 season. In 40 meetings, St.

Cloud State leads the series 27-13. That record includes a 76-55 Husky win on Jan. 16 in St. Cloud.

Minnesota State University is also a longtime rival as the teams first played each other in 1969. This will be the 94th meeting between the two schools with the Huskies holding a 56-37 advantage. The Mavericks handed the Huskies their second loss of the season, 67-60 on Jan. 17 in St. Cloud. Last year, the two teams played three times in the North Central Conference, split in regular season games and MSU won in the first round of the NCC tournament.

SCSU Team Captains: Senior guards Anna Cashman (Faribault) and Katie Tacheny (Woodbury), along with junior guard Megan Foley (St. Cloud) captain the 2008-09 Huskies.

Head Coach Lori Fish

Lori Fish is a familiar name to the St. Cloud area. Fish grew up in St. Cloud and attended St. Cloud Tech High School. Following her graduation from Tech, she went on to play basketball at South Dakota State and competed against the Huskies in the North Central Conference.



Following the completion of an outstanding collegiate playing career where she gained First Team All-Conference honors as a junior and senior, Fish entered the coaching ranks. She started as a high school coach in Foley, Minn., for two seasons before returning to South Dakota State as a graduate assistant coach. She spent one year at NCAA Division I Eastern Illinois University and returned to SDSU as an assistant. In 1999, Lori Ulferts hired Fish as an assistant to the Husky program and she served as the recruiting and strength and conditioning coordinator under Ulferts for five seasons. In 2004, Fish became a head coach at rival Minnesota State University, Mankato. She quickly distinguished herself as a rising young coach and in 2007-08, her final season with the Mavericks, led her team to a 23-9 record and the championship game of the NCAA Division II North Central Region Tournament.

In four seasons as a collegiate head coach, Fish has compiled a 62-53 overall won/loss record.

Assistant Coaches



St. Cloud State assistant coach **Carol Thelen** is in her third season with the Huskies. An SCSU alumnus and Albany, Minn., native, Thelen had been the head girls basketball coach at DeLaSalle High School in Minneapolis since 1999.



Darby Noreen is in her rookie season with the Huskies. An Albany, Minn., native, Noreen was a standout athlete at Albany High School and the College of St. Benedict. She has been an assistant coach at both Albany and St. Ben's.



Katie Jensen will serve as a student assistant coach in 2008-09. Jensen played for the Huskies from 2005 to 2007. She is a graduate of English Valleys (IA) High School.

Game Notes

About St. Cloud State: The Husky losses at Augustana (1/31) and against Minnesota Duluth (2/6) were the first back to back losses under new head coach Lori Fish and the first since losing four straight to finish out the 2007-08 season. St. Cloud State has four losses this season and have been held to 65 or fewer points in each loss, well below their 77.3 scoring average. The Huskies are on the road for four straight games before finishing the regular season with a home tilt against Winona State on Feb. 28. St. Cloud State is 6-1 on the road this season, including 5-1 in the NSIC, the only loss at Augustana. The Huskies finished the non-conference portion of the schedule with a 7-0 record. Three Husky starters average double figures in scoring and are shooting 50 percent or better from the field led by senior guard Katie Tacheny (Woodbury) with 17.0 points and a 50.7 shooting percentage, sophomore guard Talisha Barlow (Little Canada) with 15.5 points and a 52.3 shooting percentage, and sophomore post Rachel Booth (Minneapolis) with 12.5 points and a 51.4 percentage. Reserve first-year forward Aaryn Booker (Minneapolis) is also shooting better than 50 percent from the field with a mark of 51.8 percent. St. Cloud State has a +15.9 scoring margin over their opponents and are averaging 77.3 points per game and giving up 61.4 points. Twice this season

the Huskies have scored over 100 points in a game, marking the first time since the 2005-06 season that SCSU has gone over 100 twice in a season. The school record for points scored in a game is 123 scored against Morningside College during the 1998-99 season. The Huskies have scored 90 or more points three times this season.

In the NSIC: The Huskies rank second in the NSIC in scoring offense (73.8), scoring margin (+9.3), 3-point field goal percentage (.395), steals (10.53), and turnover margin (+5.00).

30+ Points: Tacheny scored a career high 31 points Jan. 16 against Southwest Minnesota State. The last Husky to score 30 or more points was three-time NCAA Division II Player of the Year Erika Quigley. Quigley scored 35 points in the final game of her collegiate career on Feb. 28, 2007.

Receiving Votes: St. Cloud State continues to receive votes in the USA Today ESPN Division II Top 25 Coaches Poll. In the Feb. 3 poll, the Huskies received 36 votes. NSIC member Minnesota State University, Mankato is ranked fifth and MSU Moorhead is 20th in the weekly poll. The Huskies have received votes in five straight polls. The next poll is out Feb. 10

NSIC Preseason Poll: The 2008-09 NSIC Women's Basketball Coaches Preseason Poll was released on Oct. 22 and the Huskies were picked to finish eighth in the league. Conference newcomer Minnesota State University, Mankato was tabbed the preseason favorite followed by another newcomer Augustana College. Concordia-St. Paul, the defending NSIC champion was picked third.

Fish Gets 75th Career Win: St. Cloud State head coach Lori Fish collected her 75th career win on Jan. 10 at Bemidji State. Fish has a 78-55 career record in four plus seasons as a collegiate head coach.

Fifth in the Region: The second NCAA Division II Women's Basketball Region poll was released on Feb. 4 and St. Cloud State University was ranked fifth in the Central Region. The next poll is due Feb. 11.

#3 Katie Tacheny Notes: Guard and senior captain Katie Tacheny (Woodbury) averaged 15.5 points and 4.0 assists over the weekend ...has scored 19 or more games in 11 games this season...scored a career high 31 points against Southwest Minnesota State on Jan. 16.....had a season high nine assists against SMSU...tallied her first collegiate double double of 29 points and ten steals against Minot State on Dec. 30...ten steals tied the SCSU single game record set in 1982...has scored in double figures in 20 games this season...ten free throws made against Mary on Jan. 23 marked the sixth time in her career that she has made ten or more free throws in a game....has started 67 straight games for the Huskies.



#10 Krystal Scott Notes: Senior guard Krystal Scott (Rosemount) matched her career high with four steals against Bemidji State last Saturday...has 506 career points...has scored in double figures eight times this season...scored a career high 16 points against Dakota State on Dec. 22... Scott has played in a team high 107 games as a Husky...has started 31 straight games including the final nine of the 2007-08 season.



#11 Talisha Barlow Notes: Sophomore guard Talisha Barlow (Little Canada) averaged 15.5 points and eight rebounds last weekend...had nine rebounds against BSU, marking her seventh game with seven or more rebounds...has two double doubles this season and three in her collegiate career...third vs Augustana with ten points and ten rebounds...collected her second collegiate double-double against Dakota State on 12/22 with 15 points, 10 rebounds...scored a career high 25 points in the Huskies loss to 13th-ranked MSU Moorhead on 12/12/08...has scored in double figures 20 times this season...has played in every game, 50 straight, of her collegiate career and made 45 starts...had a career high seven steals in the season opener against UW-Oshkosh on Nov. 15...tallied first collegiate double-double vs UNO with 21 points/ten rebounds on 2/14/08.



#21 Anna Cashman Notes: Senior guard and captain Anna Cashman (Faribault) matched her career high with seven rebounds against Wayne State on Jan. 30...has scored in double figures three times this season...dished out a career high eight assists against Dakota State on 12/22/08...tallied a career high seven rebounds against Minnesota, Crookston on 12/13/08...scored a season high 17 points in win over Nebraska-Omaha...led the 2007-08 team with 46 three-point field goals...scored a career high 23 points vs. UW-Stout on 11/17/07, hitting eight of 12 field goals...twice during the 2007-08 season she made five three-point baskets in a game.



#23 Danielle Ellison Notes: Senior forward Danielle Ellison (St. Paul) scored a season high 12 points against Minnesota, Crookston on 12/13/08 and UMD on 1/9/09...also had a season high seven rebounds against MSU Moorhead...has started in 48 career games and played in 78 career games as a Husky....scored her career high 18 points against Chico State on 12/28/07.



#32 Rachel Booth Notes: Sophomore center Rachel Booth (Minneapolis) averaged 12.5 points, 7.5 rebounds and 2.5 blocks last weekend...had back to back season high three blocks vs. Augustana and UMD...collected first double double of season and second of collegiate career with 18 points and 12 rebounds against Wayne State on Jan. 30... equaled her career high with 22 points at BSU on Jan. 10... has scored in double figures in 16 games this season... has missed two games during her collegiate career (final game of her rookie season and this year missed the game against CSP with an injury)...starter in 47 of 48 collegiate games...has scored in double figures in 35 games during her collegiate career...recorded her first collegiate double-double in an 18 point, 17 rebound effort against Sonoma State on 12/29/07.
