**On the Road Again:** The St. Cloud State women's basketball team will play its third of four straight road games on Saturday, Feb. 21 when the Huskies travel to the University of Minnesota, Crookston for Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference (NSIC) game. The tip-off is scheduled for 2:00 p.m. at Lysaker Gymnasium (3,000) on the UMC campus.

**For the Record:** St. Cloud State is in fifth place in the NSIC standings with an 11-6 league mark and 18-6 overall record. The University of Minnesota, Crookston is 9-15 overall and 5-12 in the NSIC, and in 11th in the standings.

**Series Records:** The rivalry between the Huskies and the **Golden Eagles** is relatively new as the first game was played in 1995. Since then the team's have played 13 times with the Huskies leading 12-1.

**SCSU Team Captains:** Senior guards Anna Cashman (Faribault) and Katie Tacheny (Woodbury), along with junior guard Megan Foley (St. Cloud) captain the 2008-09 Huskies.

**Tacheny Leads NSIC in Scoring:** St. Cloud State senior guard Katie Tacheny (Woodbury) leads the NSIC in overall and league scoring this week. She is averaging 17.5 points per game in league games and 17.0 points in overall games.

Head Coach Lori Fish

Lori Fish is a familiar name to the St. Cloud area. Fish grew up in St. Cloud and attended St. Cloud Tech High School. Following her graduation from Tech, she went on to play basketball at South Dakota State and competed against the Huskies in the North Central Conference.



Following the completion of an outstanding collegiate playing career where she gained First Team All-Conference honors as a junior and senior, Fish entered the coaching ranks. She started as a high school coach in Foley, Minn., for two seasons before returning to South Dakota State as a graduate assistant coach. She spent one year at NCAA Division I Eastern Illinois University and returned to SDSU as an assistant. In 1999, Lori Ulferts hired Fish as an assistant to the Husky program and she served as the recruiting and strength and conditioning coordinator under Ulferts for five seasons. In 2004, Fish became a head coach at rival Minnesota State University, Mankato. She quickly distinguished herself as a rising young coach and in 2007-08, her final season with the Mavericks, led her team to a 23-9 record and the championship game of the NCAA Division II North Central Region Tournament.

In four seasons as a collegiate head coach, Fish has compiled a 62-53 overall won/loss record.

St. Cloud State assistant coach **Carol Thelen** is in her third season with the Huskies. An SCSU alumnus and Albany, Minn., native, Thelen had been the head girls basketball coach at DeLaSalle High School in Minneapolis since 1999.



**Darby Noreen** is in her rookie season with the Huskies. An Albany, Minn., native, Noreen was a standout athlete at Albany High School and the College of St. Benedict. She has been an assistant coach at both Albany and St. Ben's.



**Katie Jensen** will serve as a student assistant coach in 2008-09. Jensen played for the Huskies from 2005 to 2007. She is a graduate of English Valleys (IA) High School.

## Game Notes

**About St. Cloud State:** The Huskies lost back to back games for the second time this season, falling at Southwest Minnesota State and Minnesota State University over the weekend. With three games remaining in the regular season schedule, the Huskies will be on the road for two before finishing with a home tilt against Winona State on Feb. 28. St. Cloud State is 6-3 on the road this season, including 5-3 in the NSIC. The Huskies finished the non-conference portion of the schedule with a 7-0 record. Three Husky starters average double figures in scoring led by senior guard Katie Tacheny (Woodbury) with 17.0 points sophomore guard Talisha Barlow (Little Canada) with 15.6 points and sophomore post Rachel Booth (Minneapolis) with 12.2 points. St. Cloud State has a +13.8 scoring margin over their opponents and are averaging 76.6 points per game and giving up 62.9 points. Twice this season the Huskies have scored over 100 points in a game, marking the first time since the 2005-06 season that SCSU has gone over 100 twice in a season. The school record for points scored in a game is 123 scored against Morningside College during the 1998-99 season. The Huskies have scored 90 or more points three times this season.

**Hitting the Boards:** The Huskies out rebounded their opponents 43-38 and 38-34 over the weekend marking the first time this season SCSU has had the upper hand in rebounding during a series. The Huskies have out rebounded their opponents in three straight games.

**In the NSIC:** The Huskies rank second in the NSIC in scoring offense (73.2), and are ranked third in field goal percentage (.432) and three-point field goal percentage (.383). St. Cloud State is fourth in scoring margin (+7.0).

**30+ Points:** Tacheny scored a career high 31 points Jan. 16 against Southwest Minnesota State. The last Husky to score 30 or more points was three-time NCAA Division II Player of the Year Erika Quigley. Quigley scored 35 points in the final game of her collegiate career on Feb. 28, 2007.

**NSIC Preseason Poll:** The 2008-09 NSIC Women's Basketball Coaches Preseason Poll was released on Oct. 22 and the Huskies were picked to finish eighth in the league. Conference newcomer Minnesota State University, Mankato was tabbed the preseason favorite followed by another newcomer Augustana College. Concordia-St. Paul, the defending NSIC champion was picked third.

**Fish Gets 75th Career Win:** St. Cloud State head coach Lori Fish collected her 75th career win on Jan. 10 at Bemidji State. Fish has a 78-55 career record in four plus seasons as a collegiate head coach.

**Fifth in the Region:** The third NCAA Division II Women's Basketball Region poll was released on Feb. 11 and St. Cloud State University was ranked fifth in the Central Region. The next poll is due Feb. 18.

**#3 Katie Tacheny Notes:** Guard and senior captain Katie Tacheny (Woodbury) led the Huskies in scoring at Southwest Minnesota State (16) and Minnesota State (18) over the weekend ...scored a career high 31 points against Southwest Minnesota State on Jan. 16.....had a season high nine assists against SMSU...tallied her first collegiate double double of 29 points and ten steals against Minot State on Dec. 30...ten steals tied the SCSU single game record set in 1982...has scored in double figures in 22 games this season...ten free throws made against Mary on Jan. 23 marked the sixth time in her career that she has made ten or more free throws in a game....has started 69 straight games for the Huskies.



**#10 Krystal Scott Notes:** Senior guard Krystal Scott (Rosemount) set a career high with five steals against Southwest Minnesota State on Friday... has scored in double figures eight times this season...scored a career high 16 points against Dakota State on Dec. 22...Scott has played in a team high 109 games as a Husky...has started 33 straight games including the final nine of the 2007-08 season.



**#11 Talisha Barlow Notes:** Sophomore guard Talisha Barlow (Little Canada) averaged 16.5 points and 5.5 rebounds last weekend...has two double doubles this season and three in her collegiate career...third vs Augustana with ten points and ten rebounds...collected her second collegiate double-double against Dakota State on 12/22 with 15 points, 10 rebounds... scored a career high 25 points in the Huskies loss to 13th-ranked MSU Moorhead on 12/12/08...has scored in double figures 22 times this season...has played in every game, 52 straight, of her collegiate career and made 47 starts...had a career high seven steals in the season opener against UW-Oshkosh on Nov. 15...tallied first collegiate double-double vs UNO with 21 points/ten rebounds on 2/14/08.



**#21 Anna Cashman Notes:** Senior guard and captain Anna Cashman (Faribault) scored 11 and 13 points over the weekend...has scored in double figures five times this season...dished out a career high eight assists against Dakota State on 12/22/08...tallied a career high seven rebounds against Minnesota, Crookston on 12/13/08...scored a season high 17 points in win over Nebraska-Omaha...led the 2007-08 team with 46 three-point field goals...scored a career high 23 points vs. UW-Stout on 11/17/07, hitting eight of 12 field goals...twice during the 2007-08 season she made five three-point baskets in a game.



**#23 Danielle Ellison Notes:** Senior forward Danielle Ellison (St. Paul) scored a season high 12 points against Minnesota, Crookston on 12/13/08 and UMD on 1/9/09...also had a season high seven rebounds against MSU Moorhead...has started in 50 career games and played in 80 career games as a Husky....scored her career high 18 points against Chico State on 12/28/07.



**#32 Rachel Booth Notes:** Sophomore center Rachel Booth (Minneapolis) tallied her second double double of the season and third of career last Friday with ten points and 11 rebounds....had back to back season high three blocks vs. Augustana and UMD...collected first double double of season and second of collegiate career with 18 points and 12 rebounds against Wayne State on Jan. 30... equaled her career high with 22 points at BSU on Jan. 10...has scored in double figures in 17 games this season... has missed two games during her collegiate career (final game of her rookie season and this year missed the game against CSP with an injury)...starter in 49 of 50 collegiate games...has scored in double figures in 36 games during her collegiate career...recorded her first collegiate double-double in an 18 point, 17 rebound effort against Sonoma State on 12/29/07.

**#2 Becca Friestleben Notes:** First year guard Becca Friestleben (Victoria) averaged 16 minutes of playing time last weekend...has two 12-point games this season Dec. 22 vs. Dakota State and Feb. 7 vs. Bemidji State....against Dakota State on 12/22 was four of six shooting from three-point range...her five assists and two steals in that same game were all career highs...has played in 19 games this season... holds Holy Family Catholic High School all-time scoring record (boys and girls) with 2,515 career points...led State in three-point baskets made three years in a row.
