NSIC Tournament First Round: The St. Cloud State women's basketball team will travel to Moorhead, Minn. for a first round Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference (NSIC)/ Sanford Health tournament game on Wednesday, Mar. 4. The Huskies will play MSU Moorhead at 6:00 p.m. in Alex Nemzek Fieldhouse on the MSUM campus.

For the Record: The Huskies are the sixth seed in the tournament sporting a 19-8 overall record and 12-8 NSIC mark. The Dragons are the third seed in the tournament with a 21-6 overall record and 14-6 league mark.

SCSU Team Captains: Senior guards Anna Cashman (Faribault) and Katie Tacheny (Woodbury), along with junior guard Megan Foley (St. Cloud) captain the 2008-09 Huskies.

NSIC/Sanford Health Tournament Bracket: Minnesota State University, Mankato (19-1) is the #1 seed in the tournament and will host #8 Concordia, St. Paul (11-9). #2 Winona State (15-5) will host #7 Wayne State (12-8). #3 MSUM (14-6) hosts #6 SCSU (12-8) and #4 Augustana (13-7) hosts #5 Minnesota Duluth (13-7). The winners will advance to the semifinals on Saturday, Mar. 7 at the site of the highest remaining seed. The Championship game is scheduled for 2:00 p.m. on Sunday, Mar. 8.

Series Records: The Huskies and Dragons will play each other for the second time this season. MSU Moorhead handed the Huskies their first loss of the season, 67-65 on Dec. 12 in St. Cloud. Wednesday will mark the 42nd meeting between these two teams with St. Cloud State holding a 25-16 advantage. This rivalry dates back to the 1972 season. SCSU has won four of the last six games, including a win in the 2005 NCAA Division II North Central Region Tournament held in Grand Forks, ND.

Head Coach Lori Fish

Lori Fish is a familiar name to the St. Cloud area. Fish grew up in St. Cloud and attended St. Cloud Tech High School. Following her graduation from Tech, she went on to play basketball at South Dakota State and competed against the Huskies in the North Central Conference.



Following the completion of an outstanding collegiate playing career where she gained First Team All-Conference honors as a junior and senior, Fish entered the coaching ranks. She started as a high school coach in Foley, Minn., for two seasons before returning to South Dakota State as a graduate assistant coach. She spent one year at NCAA Division I Eastern Illinois University and returned to SDSU as an assistant. In 1999, Lori Ulferts hired Fish as an assistant to the Husky program and she served as the recruiting and strength and conditioning coordinator under Ulferts for five seasons. In 2004, Fish became a head coach at rival Minnesota State University, Mankato. She quickly distinguished herself as a rising young coach and in 2007-08, her final season with the Mavericks, led her team to a 23-9 record and the championship game of the NCAA Division II North Central Region Tournament.

In four seasons as a collegiate head coach, Fish has compiled a 62-53 overall won/loss record.

St. Cloud State assistant coach **Carol Thelen** is in her third season with the Huskies. An SCSU alumnus and Albany, Minn., native, Thelen had been the head girls basketball coach at DeLaSalle High School in Minneapolis since 1999.



Darby Noreen is in her rookie season with the Huskies. An Albany, Minn., native, Noreen was a standout athlete at Albany High School and the College of St. Benedict. She has been an assistant coach at both Albany and St. Ben's.



Katie Jensen will serve as a student assistant coach in 2008-09. Jensen played for the Huskies from 2005 to 2007. She is a graduate of English Valleys (IA) High School.

Game Notes

First NSIC Postseason: The game at MSU Moorhead represents the first NSIC postseason action for the Huskies as St. Cloud State is one of four new teams to the league. Minnesota State University, Mankato won the regular season NSIC title. Concordia, St. Paul, the #8 seed in the tournament is the defending NSIC postseason tournament champion. The NSIC tournament champion earns automatic qualification to the 2009 NCAA Division II Central Region Tournament.

About St. Cloud State: After a 17-2 start to the season, the Huskies will try to overcome six losses over the last eight games in order to advance to the NSIC/Sanford Health Tournament semifinals. The Huskies have played well on the road this season with a 7-4 record when away from Halenbeck Hall.

19 Wins: The Huskies have won 19 games in 2008-09 and a 20-win season would be the first since 2005-06 and the tenth in the history of SCSU women's basketball that dates back to the 1968-69 season.

Climbing the Charts: Senior guard Katie Tacheny (Woodbury) scored her 900th career point against Winona State last Saturday and enters the week with 924 career points in three seasons with the

Huskies...senior guard Anna Cashman (Faribault) made her 99th career three-point field goal last Saturday and ranks seventh on the all-time chart...senior guard Krystal Scott (Rosemount) played in her 112th career game and ranks 17th on the all-time chart.

30+ Points: Tacheny scored a career high 31 points Jan. 16 against Southwest Minnesota State. The last Husky to score 30 or more points was three-time NCAA Division II Player of the Year Erika Quigley. Quigley scored 35 points in the final game of her collegiate career on Feb. 28, 2007.

NSIC Scoring Leader: Tacheny is the NSIC scoring leader once again this week as she averages 17.3 points per league game. She is also the league's overall scoring leader with 16.9 points per outing.

NSIC Preseason Poll: The 2008-09 NSIC Women's Basketball Coaches Preseason Poll was released on Oct. 22 and the Huskies were picked to finish eighth in the league. Conference newcomer Minnesota State University, Mankato was tabbed the preseason favorite followed by another newcomer Augustana College. Concordia-St. Paul, the defending NSIC champion was picked third.

Fish Gets 75th Career Win: St. Cloud State head coach Lori Fish collected her 75th career win on Jan. 10 at Bemidji State. Fish has a 78-55 career record in four plus seasons as a collegiate head coach.

Seventh in the Region: The fifth NCAA Division II Women's Basketball Region poll was released on Feb. 25 and St. Cloud State University was ranked seventh in the Central Region, down one spot from the previous poll. The next poll is due Mar. 4.

#3 Katie Tacheny Notes: Guard and senior captain Katie Tacheny (Woodbury) has scored 924 points in three years with the Huskies ...scored a career high 31 points against Southwest Minnesota State on Jan. 16... had a season high nine assists against SMSU...tallied her first collegiate double double of 29 points and ten steals against Minot State on Dec. 30...ten steals tied the SCSU single game record set in 1982...has scored in double figures in 24 games this season...13 free throws made against Winona State on Feb. 28 marked the seventh time in her career that she has made ten or more free throws in a game....has started 72 straight games for the Huskies.



#10 Krystal Scott Notes: Senior guard Krystal Scott (Rosemount) set a career high with five steals against Southwest Minnesota State on Feb. 13...has scored in double figures nine times this season...scored a career high 16 points against Dakota State on Dec. 22...Scott has played in a team high 112 games as a Husky (ranks 17th on the all-time list)...has started 36 straight games including the final nine of the 2007-08 season.



#11 Talisha Barlow Notes: Sophomore guard Talisha Barlow (Little Canada) is scored 723 points in her career as a Husky...has two double doubles this season and three in her collegiate career...third vs Augustana with ten points and ten rebounds...collected her second collegiate double-double against Dakota State on 12/22 with 15 points, 10 rebounds...scored a career high 25 points against MSU Moorhead on 12/12/08...has scored in double figures 24 times this season...has played in every game, 55 straight, of her collegiate career and made 50 starts...had a career high seven steals in the season opener against UW-Oshkosh on Nov. 15...tallied first collegiate double-double vs UNO with 21 points/ten rebounds on 2/14/08.



#21 Anna Cashman Notes: Senior guard and captain Anna Cashman (Faribault) has made 99 three-point baskets in her career and ranks seventh all-time in 3FG's made...equaled her career high of five three-point field goals made on Feb. 21 at UMC...has scored in double figures six times this season...dished out a career high eight assists against Dakota State on 12/22/08...tallied a career high seven rebounds against Minnesota, Crookston on 12/13/08...scored a season high 17 points in win over Nebraska-Omaha...led the 2007-08 team with 46 three-point field goals and has 46 this season to lead the team...scored a career high 23 points vs. UW-Stout on 11/17/07, hitting eight of 12 field goals...twice during the 2007-08 season she made five three-point baskets in a game.



#23 Danielle Ellison Notes: Senior forward Danielle Ellison (St. Paul) scored a season high 15 points against Concordia, St. Paul on Feb. 25... had a season high seven rebounds against MSU Moorhead on Dec. 12... has started in 53 career games and played in 83 career games as a Husky...scored her career high 18 points against Chico State on 12/28/07.



#32 Rachel Booth Notes: Sophomore center Rachel Booth (Minneapolis) notched her third double figure rebound night of the season at CSP on Feb. 25...tallied her second double double of the season and third of career on Feb. 13 (11 pts, 10 reb)...had back to back season high three blocks vs. Augustana and UMD...collected first double double of season and second of career (18 pts, 12 reb) against Wayne State on Jan. 30... equaled her career high with 22 points at BSU on Jan. 10...has scored in double figures in 19 games this season... has missed two games during her collegiate career (final game of her rookie season and this year missed the game against CSP with an injury)... starter in 51 of 52 collegiate games...has scored in double figures in 38 games during her collegiate career...recorded her first collegiate double-double in an 18 point, 17 rebound effort against Sonoma State on 12/29/07.

#13 Marlayna Graff Notes: Sophomore post Marlayna Graff (Harris) is a transfer who sat out the second half of the Huskies 2007-08 season...tallied career highs in points (8), steals (4) and blocked shots (2) on Feb. 6 against Minnesota Duluth...has started two games this season and played in 26 games (missed game on 12/22 with the flu)...named a NJCAA Division III Preseason Second Team All-American in the fall of 2007 prior to her transfer to St. Cloud State.

Opponent Notes and Probable Starters

About MSU Moorhead: The Dragons handed St. Cloud State their first loss of the season back on Dec. 12. In the game played at Halenbeck Hall, the 13th ranked Dragons posted a 67-65 win bringing an end to the Huskies seven game win streak. MSUM is lead in scoring by junior forward Alison Nash-Gerlach who averaged 14.5 points per game. Junior center Meghan Rettke leads the NSIC in rebounding with a 9.9 average in league games and 10.0 boards per game in overall games. Nash-Gerlach and Rettke each had a double double in the Dragons regular season finale, an 83-69 victory over Minnesota, Crookston last Saturday. Nash-Gerlach finished with 17 points, ten rebounds and Rettke tallied 21 points and 15 rebounds. MSU Moorhead owns an 8-9 record all-time in NSIC tournament games. Last year, the Dragons defeated Winona State in the quarterfinals and lost to eventual NSIC champion Concordia, St. Paul in the semifinals. The Dragons have won three NSIC titles since the 1979-80 season with the most recent in 2004-05. With a 21-6 overall record this season, MSUM became the sixth team in Dragons history and third under head coach Karla Nelson to reach 20 wins in a season. Nelson is in her ninth season at the helm of the Dragons and has a current 161-98 overall won/loss record.

Last Meeting: Minnesota State University Moorhead held off a late run by St. Cloud State University to post a 67-65 NSIC win on Dec. 12 at Halenbeck Hall. The 13th ranked Dragons improved to 9-0 overall and 3-0 in the NSIC, while the Huskies suffered their first loss of the season, dropping to 7-1 overall, 2-1 in league play. The Dragons featured four players who scored in double figures led by first year forward Angie Jetvig with 18 points. Junior guard Krista Opheim added 13 points and nine assists. Junior forward Alison Nash-Gerlach dropped in 12 points and junior center Meghan Rettke finished with 10 points and ten rebounds. The Huskies Talisha Barlow led all scorers with a game high and career high 25 points. Senior guard Katie Tacheny scored 19 points and was three of four from three-point range. Senior forward Danielle Ellison added ten points and a team high seven rebounds. In the final 30 seconds Opheim made one of two free throws to give MSUM a 66-63 lead. With 20 seconds on the clock, St. Cloud State called a time out to set up the offense. The Huskies had two three-point attempts by senior guard Anna Cashman miss the mark. St. Cloud State got the ball back with ten seconds left and Ellison laid one in and the score was 66-65 in favor of the Dragons. The Huskies fouled and Katie Walden made one of two free throw attempts with four seconds left. The Huskies had one last chance but were not able to score and lost their first game of the season.

The Northern Sun Conference (NSC) for women's sports was formally announced in 1979-80 and SCSU was a charter member of that organization. From 1979 to 1984, the Huskies won four women's basketball titles in 1979-80, 1981-82, 1982-83, and 1983-84.
