**Season Opener:** The St. Cloud State University women's basketball team will officially open the 2008-09 season against the University of Wisconsin Oshkosh in a non-conference game in Halenbeck Hall on Nov. 15 at 6:00 p.m.

**SCSU Team Captains:** Senior guards Anna Cashman (Faribault) and Katie Tacheny (Woodbury), along with junior guard Megan Foley (St. Cloud) will captain the 2008-09 Huskies.

**For the Record:** St. Cloud State posted an 11-17 overall record in 2007-08 and finished the final season of the North Central Conference with a 3-9 league record and a fifth place finish. The University of Wisconsin-Oshkosh posted a 10-16 overall record in 2007-08. UW-Oshkosh is an NCAA Division III school and member of the Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (WIAC). The Titans recorded a 5-11 record in conference play, good for sixth place.

**Series Record:** This is the first meeting between the Huskies and the Titans

**A New League:** In 2008-09, the Huskies athletic program joins the Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference (NSIC), a 14-school league representing schools from Minnesota, North Dakota, South Dakota, Nebraska and Iowa. With the expanded conference, the Huskies will play a 20-game league schedule and follow the regular season with the NSIC Tournament. It also means that SCSU will not play every team twice in 2008-09. The Huskies will play Bemidji State, Concordia-St. Paul, Minnesota, Crookston, Minnesota Duluth, Minnesota State University, Southwest Minnesota State University and Winona State University twice.

Head Coach Lori Fish

Lori Fish is a familiar name to the St. Cloud area. Fish grew up in St. Cloud and attended St. Cloud Tech High School. Following her graduation from Tech, she went on to play basketball at South Dakota State and competed against the Huskies in the North Central Conference.



Following the completion of an outstanding collegiate playing career where she gained First Team All-Conference honors as a junior and senior, Fish entered the coaching ranks. She started as a high school coach in Foley, Minn., for two seasons before returning to South Dakota State as a graduate assistant coach. She spent one year at NCAA Division I Eastern Illinois University and returned to SDSU as an assistant. In 1999, Lori Ulferts hired Fish as an assistant to the Husky program and she served as the recruiting and strength and conditioning coordinator under Ulferts for five seasons. In 2004, Fish became a head coach at rival Minnesota State University, Mankato. She quickly distinguished herself as a rising young coach and in 2007-08, her final season with the Mavericks, led her team to a 23-9 record and the championship game of the NCAA Division II North Central Region Tournament.

In four seasons as a collegiate head coach, Fish has compiled a 62-53 overall won/loss record.

Assistant Coaches



St. Cloud State assistant coach **Carol Thelen** is in her third season with the Huskies. An SCSU alumnus and Albany, Minn., native, Thelen had been the head girls basketball coach at DeLaSalle High School in Minneapolis since 1999.



**Darby Noreen** is in her rookie season with the Huskies. An Albany, Minn., native, Noreen was a standout athlete at Albany High School and the College of St. Benedict. She has been an assistant coach at both Albany and St. Ben's.



**Katie Jensen** will serve as a student assistant coach in 2008-09. Jensen played for the Huskies from 2005 to 2007. She is a graduate of English Valleys (IA) High School.

## Game Notes

**About St. Cloud State:** A new coach and a new league will help to define St. Cloud State women's basketball in 2008-09. Head coach Lori Fish takes over the reins from Dr. Lori Ulferts and the SCSU athletics program is embarking on its first year in the Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference (NSIC). St. Cloud State returns four starters and a total of six players with starting experience. The returning starters include senior guards Katie Tacheny (Woodbury) and Krystal Scott (Rosemount), sophomore guard Talisha Barlow (Little Canada), and sophomore post Rachel Booth (Minneapolis). The fifth starter was Kayla Rengel (St. Cloud) who completed her eligibility. She was the team's scoring and rebounding leader in 2007-08, and scored over 1,000 points in her career. Joining the returning class will be five first year players. The top returning scorer for SCSU is Booth. She averaged 12.5 points and 5.3 rebounds a year ago.

**About UW-Oshkosh:** The UW-Oshkosh women's basketball team will look to take its game to another level after many young players gained valuable experience last season. Four of last year's starting five players return for the 2008-09 campaign as Head Coach Terri Schumacher leads a squad that features no seniors, one junior, eight sophomores and six freshmen. Eight Titans with starting experience are back, including six letter winners from last year's team.

**Head Coach Terri Schumacher:** UW-Oshkosh head coach **Terri Schumacher** enters her fourth season at the helm for the Titans. The former UW-Oshkosh standout was a NCAA Division III All-American as part of the Titans' 1984-85 WIAC championship team. She has compiled a 37-40 coaching record, which includes the Titans earning a share of the WIAC title in 2005-06.

**NSIC Preseason Poll:** The 2008-09 NSIC Women's Basketball Coaches Preseason Poll was released last week and the Huskies were picked to finish eighth in the league. Conference newcomer Minnesota State University, Mankato was tabbed the preseason favorite followed by another newcomer Augustana College. Concordia-St. Paul, the defending NSIC champion was picked third.

**Not a Stranger to the NSIC:** St. Cloud State is no stranger to the NSIC as the university was a charter member of the Northern Sun Conference, the predecessor to the current league. The SCSU men's athletics department was a charter member of the Northern Intercollegiate Conference (NIC) in 1932. The Northern Sun Conference (NSC) for women's sports was formally announced in 1979-80 and SCSU was a charter member of that organization. Later the two combined to become the Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference for men's and women's athletics. SCSU women's teams captured four NSC basketball and tennis championships, and one volleyball championship from 1979 to 1984.

### Player Notes

**#3 Katie Tacheny Notes:** Guard and co-captain Katie Tacheny (Woodbury) started all 28 games in 2007-08...scored a career high 18 points against USD on 2/16 and equaled her career high of eight rebounds against UNO on 2/14.... averaged 11.5 points and 4.1 rebounds...notched a career high six steals versus Glenville College on 12/8/07...had eight games where she was perfect from the free throw line...led the NCC in steals.

**#10 Krystal Scott Notes:** Guard Krystal Scott (Rosemount) started the last nine games and played in all 28 of the 2007-08 season...tallied her career high seven assists on 11/21/07 against MSU Moorhead...averaged 6.0 points and 3.1 rebounds per game.

**#11 Talisha Barlow Notes:** First year guard Talisha Barlow (Little Canada) played in all 28 games in 2007-08 and started in 23 including the last 19 games of the season...she started her collegiate career with back to back ten and 20 point games, and went on to record double figures in scoring in 15 games...scored career high 24 points against Lake Superior State on 12/22/07, making ten of 13 field goal attempts..tallied her first collegiate double-double vs UNO with 21 points/ten rebounds on 2/14/08... ten rebounds was also a career high...had season/career highs of six assists and five steals...named NCC Player of the Week on 12/10/07...averaged 11.0 points and 5.0 rebounds per game.

**#21 Anna Cashman Notes:** Guard Anna Cashman (Faribault) led the 2007-08 team with 46 three-point field goals...scored a career high 23 points vs. UW-Stout on 11/17/07, hitting eight of 12 field goals...pulled career high five rebounds twice during the season...twice during the season she made five three-point baskets in a game...played in 27 games and made two starts...named to the UMD The Edge Thanksgiving Classic All-Tournament Team...averaged 7.5 points...tallied career highs in points (23), rebounds (5), assists (4), and steals (2).

**#23 Danielle Ellison Notes:** Forward Danielle Ellison (St. Paul) started 16 games in 2007-08 and played in all 28...averages 5.3 points and 2.7 rebounds... scored her career high 18 points against Chico State on 12/28/07...equaled her career highs in rebounds (8), assists (4) and steals (3).

**#32 Rachel Booth Notes:** Center Rachel Booth (Minneapolis) started the first 27 games of her rookie season...suffered a knee injury in the first 30 seconds of second to the last game of the season and did not play in the final game..averaged 12.5 points and 5.3 rebounds for the Huskies...scored in double figures in 20 games...named to the All-Tournament team at Sonoma State...recorded her first collegiate double-double in an 18 point, 17 rebound effort against Sonoma State on 12/29/07...is one of two rookies to rank in the top ten in league scoring...ranked tenth in NCC scoring and fourth in blocks...career highs of 22 points, 17 rebounds, and six blocks.

**#34 Megan Foley:** A guard, Foley played in 13 games in 2007-08 and scored her career high eight points against Lake Superior State on 12/22/07...averaged 1.5 points per game.
