Thanksgiving Classic: The St. Cloud State University women's basketball team will continue to play on the road as the Huskies participate in the annual UNO Thanksgiving Classic on Friday and Saturday, Nov. 28-29 in Omaha, Nebraska.

The Schedule: The Huskies will play Northwest Missouri State at 3:00 p.m. on Friday and will take on the host school, University of Nebraska-Omaha at 3:00 p.m. Saturday.

For the Record: St. Cloud State is 3-0 following two wins at the Minnesota State University, Mankato Pepsi Tip-Off last weekend. The Huskies posted wins over Henderson State (Ark.), 78-54 and Dakota State, 103-62. St. Cloud State posted an 11-17 overall record in 2007-08 and finished the final season of the North Central Conference with a 3-9 league record and a fifth place finish.

Series Records: The Huskies are 1-1 all-time against Northwest Missouri State. The last meeting between the two teams was in 1994-95, a 68-53 season opening win for the Bearcats. St. Cloud State and Nebraska-Omaha are former members of the North Central Conference and the Huskies lead the series 29-20. The teams split last season winning on their home courts.

SCSU Team Captains: Senior guards Anna Cashman (Faribault) and Katie Tacheny (Woodbury), along with junior guard Megan Foley (St. Cloud) will captain the 2008-09 Huskies.

Middle of a Road Stretch: The Huskies are in the middle of a six-game road stretch. After opening the season at home, SCSU plays six road games, including the Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference (NSIC) season opener on Dec. 5 in Winona. The Huskies return home for NSIC action on Dec. 12 and 13 against MSU Moorhead and Minnesota, Crookston.

Head Coach Lori Fish

Lori Fish is a familiar name to the St. Cloud area. Fish grew up in St. Cloud and attended St. Cloud Tech High School. Following her graduation from Tech, she went on to play basketball at South Dakota State and competed against the Huskies in the North Central Conference.



Following the completion of an outstanding collegiate playing career where she gained First Team All-Conference honors as a junior and senior, Fish entered the coaching ranks. She started as a high school coach in Foley, Minn., for two seasons before returning to South Dakota State as a graduate assistant coach. She spent one year at NCAA Division I Eastern Illinois University and returned to SDSU as an assistant. In 1999, Lori Ulferts hired Fish as an assistant to the Husky program and she served as the recruiting and strength and conditioning coordinator under Ulferts for five seasons. In 2004, Fish became a head coach at rival Minnesota State University, Mankato. She quickly distinguished herself as a rising young coach and in 2007-08, her final season with the Mavericks, led her team to a 23-9 record and the championship game of the NCAA Division II North Central Region Tournament.

In four seasons as a collegiate head coach, Fish has compiled a 62-53 overall won/loss record.

Assistant Coaches



St. Cloud State assistant coach **Carol Thelen** is in her third season with the Huskies. An SCSU alumnus and Albany, Minn., native, Thelen had been the head girls basketball coach at DeLaSalle High School in Minneapolis since 1999.



Darby Noreen is in her rookie season with the Huskies. An Albany, Minn., native, Noreen was a standout athlete at Albany High School and the College of St. Benedict. She has been an assistant coach at both Albany and St. Ben's.



Katie Jensen will serve as a student assistant coach in 2008-09. Jensen played for the Huskies from 2005 to 2007. She is a graduate of English Valleys (IA) High School.

Game Notes

About St. Cloud State: The Huskies are off to a 3-0 start for the first time since the 2006-07 season. As a team, St. Cloud State is shooting 55.7 percent from the field and averaging 91.7 points through three games. Last Saturday in the win over Dakota State, the Huskies shot an amazing 71.9 percent (23 of 32 field goal attempts) in the first half and finished the game with a single game school record .677 field goal percentage. In that game five players shot 70 percent or better from the field, including four who missed only one field goal attempt.

NSIC Preseason Poll: The 2008-09 NSIC Women's Basketball Coaches Preseason Poll was released on Oct. 22 and the Huskies were picked to finish eighth in the league. Conference newcomer Minnesota State University, Mankato was tabbed the preseason favorite followed by another newcomer Augustana College. Concordia-St. Paul, the defending NSIC champion was picked third.

About Northwest Missouri State: The Bearcats are members of the Mid-America Intercollegiate Athletics Conference (MIAA) and last year posted an 18-14 overall record that included a fourth place tie in the conference with a 9-9 mark. Northwest Missouri returns one starter from a year ago and bring a 2-1 record into the week. The Bearcats will play Missouri-St. Louis on Nov. 25 before meeting up with the Huskies on Friday. Northwest Missouri State opened the season with a 69-60 win over the University of South Dakota. The Bearcats are led by senior guard Meghan Brue who is averaging 18.0 points and 7.7 rebounds. She scored 30 points in an 80-71 loss to Evangel on Nov. 21. Head coach Gene Steinmeyer is in his tenth season with the Bearcats and 23rd overall. He has a 131-127 record at Northwest Missouri. The Bearcats are averaging 75.7 points and 40.3 rebounds per game thus far in the season.

About Nebraska-Omaha: Like the Huskies, the University of Nebraska-Omaha is a former member of the North Central Conference. The Mavericks are embarking on their first season as a member of the Mid-America Intercollegiate Athletics Conference (MIAA). The Mavericks return seven seniors from a team that went 17-12 last year and tied with the Huskies in NCC play with a 3-9 record. Head coach Patty Patton Shearer is in her fifth season with the Mavericks and ninth season overall as a collegiate head coach. She has a 67-49 record at UNO over the last four seasons and last year her team started the year with a 14-1 record. The Mavericks return four starters from a year ago and are 1-1 this season following a loss to Nebraska-Kearney and a win over Dana College. UNO is led in scoring by junior forward Ashley Nelson who is averaging 12.5 points per game. Junior guard Alyssa Green, an All-NCC pick last season leads the team in rebounding with 8.5 boards a game. The Mavericks average 79.0 points per game and are out rebounding their opponents 47.5 to 39.0.

#3 Katie Tacheny Notes: Guard and senior captain Katie Tacheny (Woodbury) has started 48 straight games for the Huskies... scored a career high 20 points against Dakota State on Nov. 22... made seven of ten field goal attempts and had a season high five assists and five steals...is averaging 15.7 points per game and leads the team with 13 steals.



#10 Krystal Scott Notes: Senior guard Krystal Scott (Rosemount) has played in a team high 88 games...has started 12 straight games including the final nine of the 2007-08 season...equaled her career high with 14 points against Dakota State on Nov. 22...made of seven of eight field goal attempts in the game.



#11 Talisha Barlow Notes: Sophomore guard Talisha Barlow (Little Canada) has played in every game, 31 straight, of her collegiate career and made 26 starts...leads the team in scoring with 19.7 points per game...shot 61.9 percent from the field and averaged 18.5 points in two wins at the Minnesota State University, Mankato Pepsi Tip-Off over the weekend...led all players with 23 points, dished out four assists and shot 50 percent from the field against Henderson State...23 points were one shy of her career high 24. ...scored 14 points on six of seven shooting, and had five assists (one shy of her career high), in 16 minutes of playing time against Dakota State...for the weekend, Barlow averaged 18.5 points, shot 61.9 percent from the field, 60 percent (3 of 5) from three point range and .727 from the free throw line...had a career high seven steals in in the season opener against UW-Oshkosh on Nov. 15...scored career high 24 points against Lake Superior State on 12/22/07, making ten of 13 field goal attempts...tallied her first collegiate double-double vs UNO with 21 points/ten rebounds on 2/14/08.



#21 Anna Cashman Notes: Senior guard and captain Anna Cashman (Faribault) missed the season opener with an injury, but player in both games over the weekend...led the 2007-08 team with 46 three-point field goals...scored a career high 23 points vs. UW-Stout on 11/17/07, hitting eight of 12 field goals...twice during the 2007-08 season she made five three-point baskets in a game.



#23 Danielle Ellison Notes: Senior forward Danielle Ellison (St. Paul) started the 30th game of her career last Saturday...has played in 59 career games as a Husky...scored a season high 11 points against Henderson State on Nov. 21...scored her career high 18 points against Chico State on 12/28/07.



#32 Rachel Booth Notes: Sophomore center Rachel Booth (Minneapolis) has played in 30 of the 31 games of her collegiate career... missed the final game of her rookie season due to an injury...starter in 30 collegiate games...scored 12 points against Dakota State on Nov. 22...averages 11.0 points and 4.0 rebounds per game this season, and is shooting 60.9 percent from the field...has scored in double figures in 22 games of her collegiate career...recorded her first collegiate double-double in an 18 point, 17 rebound effort against Sonoma State on 12/29/07.

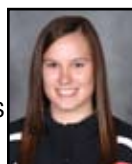


Player Notes

#34 Megan Foley: Junior guard and team captain, Foley (St. Cloud) twice has notched two blocked shots in a game this season...equaled her career high of seven rebounds, all on the defensive boards against Dakota State on Nov. 21...leads the team with four blocked shots this season. played 19 minutes in the 2008-09 season opener and dished out three assists...also blocked a game high two shots...played in 13 games in 2007-08 and scored her career high eight points against Lake Superior State on 12/22/07.



#2 Becca Friestleben Notes: First year guard Becca Friestleben (Victoria) has played in all three game this season... holds Holy Family Catholic High School all-time scoring record (boys and girls) with 2,515 career points...led State in three-point baskets made three years in a row.



#13 Marlayna Graff Notes: Sophomore post Marlayna Graff (Harris) is a transfer who sat out the second half of the Huskies 2007-08 season...has played in all three games this season... scored a season and career high seven points against Dakota State on Nov. 22...had a season and career high three steals against Henderson State on Nov. 21...is eight of ten in field goals made this season...named a NJCAA Division III Preseason Second Team All-American in the fall of 2007 prior to her transfer to St. Cloud State.



#35 Amy Frye Notes: First year forward Amy Frye (Hudson, WI) has played in all three games this season... had two points, two assists and two steals, all team highs against Dakota State on Nov. 22...scored 262 points, pulled down 128 rebounds, had 37 steals, and 24 blocked shots during her senior campaign at Hudson (WI) High School.



#43 Christina Steele Notes: First year post Christina Steele (Apple Valley) scored eight points in her collegiate debut on Nov. 15...has played in all three games this season...three-time First Team All-Lake Conference in high school...holds record for most points in a season with 504...team rebounding leader for three straight years.



#45 Aaryn Booker Notes: First year forward Aaryn Booker (Minneapolis)...scored her collegiate high 16 points against Dakota State on Nov. 22...made seven of eight field goal attempts.. twice this season has seven rebounds...top scoring rooker for the Huskies, averaging 9.0 points and leads the team in rebounding with 6.7 boards per game...Booker and Rachel Booth player high school ball at DeLaSalle High School....all-time scoring and rebounding leader at DeLaSalle with 1,226 career points and 787 career rebounds.

A New League: In 2008-09, the Huskies athletic program joins the Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference (NSIC), a 14-school league representing schools from Minnesota, North Dakota, South Dakota, Nebraska and Iowa. With the expanded conference, the Huskies will play a 20-game league schedule and follow the regular season with the NSIC Tournament. It also means that SCSU will not play every team twice in 2008-09. The Huskies will play Bemidji State, Concordia-St. Paul, Minnesota, Crookston, Minnesota Duluth, Minnesota State University, Southwest Minnesota State University and Winona State University twice.

Not a Stranger to the NSIC: St. Cloud State is no stranger to the NSIC as the university was a charter member of the Northern Sun Conference, the predecessor to the current league. The SCSU men's athletics department was a charter member of the Northern Intercollegiate Conference (NIC) in 1932. The Northern Sun Conference (NSC) for women's sports was formally announced in 1979-80 and SCSU was a charter member of that organization. Later the two combined to become the Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference for men's and women's athletics. SCSU women's teams captured four NSC basketball and tennis championships, and one volleyball championship from 1979 to 1984.
