**Husky Pre-Holiday:** The St. Cloud State women's basketball team will play host to Dakota State University on Monday, Dec. 22 at 7:30 p.m. in a non-conference game. A high school prelim game featuring Princeton versus Sauk Rapids will be played at 5:30 p.m. Both games will be played in Halenbeck Hall (6,927).

**For the Record:** St. Cloud State is 8-1 overall and 3-1 in the NSIC. Dakota State enters the week with a 4-7 overall record. The Lady T's will play at Midland Lutheran Friday.

**Series Records:** The St. Cloud State women are 1-0 against Dakota State, having defeated the Lady T's 103-62 earlier this season on Nov. 22 at the Minnesota State Pepsi Tip-Off.

**SCSU Team Captains:** Senior guards Anna Cashman (Faribault) and Katie Tacheny (Woodbury), along with junior guard Megan Foley (St. Cloud) captain the 2008-09 Huskies.

**Five Game Home Stretch:** The Huskies are in the midst of a five-game home stretch that will take them through the new year. St. Cloud State hosted two Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference (NSIC) games last weekend. On Dec. 30, SCSU will host Minot State in a non-conference contest at 4:00 p.m. On Jan. 3, the Huskies return to NSIC action at home against Concordia University, St. Paul. That tip-off is scheduled for 2:00 p.m.

Head Coach Lori Fish

Lori Fish is a familiar name to the St. Cloud area. Fish grew up in St. Cloud and attended St. Cloud Tech High School. Following her graduation from Tech, she went on to play basketball at South Dakota State and competed against the Huskies in the North Central Conference.



Following the completion of an outstanding collegiate playing career where she gained First Team All-Conference honors as a junior and senior, Fish entered the coaching ranks. She started as a high school coach in Foley, Minn., for two seasons before returning to South Dakota State as a graduate assistant coach. She spent one year at NCAA Division I Eastern Illinois University and returned to SDSU as an assistant. In 1999, Lori Ulferts hired Fish as an assistant to the Husky program and she served as the recruiting and strength and conditioning coordinator under Ulferts for five seasons. In 2004, Fish became a head coach at rival Minnesota State University, Mankato. She quickly distinguished herself as a rising young coach and in 2007-08, her final season with the Mavericks, led her team to a 23-9 record and the championship game of the NCAA Division II North Central Region Tournament.

In four seasons as a collegiate head coach, Fish has compiled a 62-53 overall won/loss record.

St. Cloud State assistant coach **Carol Thelen** is in her third season with the Huskies. An SCSU alumnus and Albany, Minn., native, Thelen had been the head girls basketball coach at DeLaSalle High School in Minneapolis since 1999.



**Darby Noreen** is in her rookie season with the Huskies. An Albany, Minn., native, Noreen was a standout athlete at Albany High School and the College of St. Benedict. She has been an assistant coach at both Albany and St. Ben's.



**Katie Jensen** will serve as a student assistant coach in 2008-09. Jensen played for the Huskies from 2005 to 2007. She is a graduate of English Valleys (IA) High School.

## Game Notes

**About St. Cloud State:** St. Cloud State is off to an 8-1 start to the season, having suffered their first loss last Friday to 13th ranked Minnesota State Moorhead 67-65 in NSIC action. The Huskies are currently third in the NSIC standings with a 3-1 record and league play will resume on Jan. 3 when SCSU hosts Concordia University, St. Paul, also 3-1 in the league. St. Cloud State is averaging 80.6 points per game and boasts a 21.0 point scoring margin over their opponents. The Huskies have scored 90 or more points three times this season, including a season high 103 points against Dakota State. St. Cloud State has been a good shooting team in the early going of the schedule with a .487 field goal percentage, .391 three-point shooting percentage, and a .769 mark from the free throw line. The Huskies have also protected the ball well, turning the ball over 137 times as compared to their opponents 218 turnovers. Sophomore guard Talisha Barlow (Little Canada) leads the team in scoring with 16.9 points per game. She is followed by senior guard Katie Tacheny (Woodbury) with 16.0 points per contest. Sophomore center Rachel Booth (Minneapolis) leads the team in rebounding with 5.4 rebounds per game.

**In the NSIC:** The Huskies are 3-1 in the NSIC and are one of three teams with one league loss. Two teams, MSU Moorhead and Minnesota State University are undefeated overall and in league play. As a team, the Huskies lead the NSIC in scoring with 77.5 points per game and are the league leader in field goal percentage at .462. The Huskies are third in scoring margin at +9.5 and third in three-point field goal percentage at .440. Several Huskies are among the league leaders in individual stats categories this week. Senior guard Katie Tacheny (Woodbury) ranks third in league scoring with an 18.3 points per game average, is third in three-point field goal percentage at .636, third in steals, and second in assist/turnover ratio. Sophomore guard Talisha Barlow (Little Canada) is fourth in league scoring at 17.3 points. She is second in three-point field goal percentage with a mark of .778. Senior guard Krystal Scott (Rosemount) is seventh in assist/turnover ratio.

**NSIC Preseason Poll:** The 2008-09 NSIC Women's Basketball Coaches Preseason Poll was released on Oct. 22 and the Huskies were picked to finish eighth in the league. Conference newcomer Minnesota State University, Mankato was tabbed the preseason favorite followed by another newcomer Augustana College. Concordia-St. Paul, the defending NSIC champion was picked third.

## Player Notes

**#3 Katie Tacheny Notes:** Guard and senior captain Katie Tacheny (Woodbury) averaged 18.0 points and shot 57.9 percent from the field in the Huskies loss to MSU Moorhead and win over Minnesota, Crookston last weekend. Against Minnesota, Crookston she scored 17 points, had a season high seven assists, and zero turnovers in 29 minutes of play. Tacheny has scored in double figures in seven of the Huskies eight games. She scored a career high 22 points at Upper Iowa on Dec. 6. She made ten free throws at Upper Iowa, marking the fourth time in her career that she has made ten or more free throws in a game. She has started 54 straight games for the Huskies.



**#10 Krystal Scott Notes:** Senior guard Krystal Scott (Rosemount) scored 12 points against Minnesota, Crookston last Saturday, her fourth double figure scoring game of the season...Scott has played in a team high 94 games...has started 18 straight games including the final nine of the 2007-08 season...equaled her career high with 14 points against Dakota State on Nov. 22...made seven of eight field goal attempts in the game.



**#11 Talisha Barlow Notes:** Sophomore guard Talisha Barlow (Little Canada) scored a career high 25 points in the Huskies loss to 13th-ranked MSU Moorhead...has scored in double figures eight times this season...has played in every game, 37 straight, of her collegiate career and made 32 starts...had a career high seven steals in the season opener against UW-Oshkosh on Nov. 15...tallied her first collegiate double-double vs UNO with 21 points/ten rebounds on 2/14/08...averaging a team leading 16.9 points per game.



**#21 Anna Cashman Notes:** Senior guard and captain Anna Cashman (Faribault) tallied a career high seven rebounds against Minnesota, Crookston on 12/13/08...scored a season high 17 points in win over Nebraska-Omaha...led the 2007-08 team with 46 three-point field goals...scored a career high 23 points vs. UW-Stout on 11/17/07, hitting eight of 12 field goals...twice during the 2007-08 season she made five three-point baskets in a game.



**#23 Danielle Ellison Notes:** Senior forward Danielle Ellison (St. Paul) scored in double figures twice last weekend including a season 12 points against Minnesota, Crookston...also had a season high seven rebounds against MSU Moorhead...started the 36th game of her career last Saturday...has played in 65 career games as a Husky...scored her career high 18 points against Chico State on 12/28/07.



**#32 Rachel Booth Notes:** Sophomore center Rachel Booth (Minneapolis) has scored in double figures in six games this season...tallied a season high 19 points in the Huskies 73-55 win over Northwest Missouri State... has played in 36 of the 36 games of her collegiate career...missed the final game of her rookie season due to an injury...starter in 34 collegiate games...has scored in double figures in 26 games during her collegiate career...recorded her first collegiate double-double in an 18 point, 17 rebound effort against Sonoma State on 12/29/07.

**#2 Becca Friestleben Notes:** First year guard Becca Friestleben (Victoria) has played in seven games this season... scored her season high six points in season opener against UW-Oshkosh on Nov. 15...holds Holy Family Catholic High School all-time scoring record (boys and girls) with 2,515 career points...led State in three-point baskets made three years in a row.



**#13 Marlayna Graff Notes:** Sophomore post Marlayna Graff (Harris) is a transfer who sat out the second half of the Huskies 2007-08 season...has played in all nine games this season... equaled her season and career high seven points against Upper Iowa on Dec. 6...had a season and career high three steals against Henderson State on Nov. 21...named a NJCAA Division III Pre-season Second Team All-American in the fall of 2007 prior to her transfer to St. Cloud State.
