New Year's Week: The St. Cloud State women's basketball team will close 2008 with their final non-conference game of the schedule on Tuesday, Dec. 30 at 4:00 p.m. against Minot State University. The Huskies will open the new year in the NSIC by hosting Concordia University, St. Paul on Saturday, Jan. 3 at 2:00 p.m. Both games will be played in Halenbeck Hall (6,927).

For the Record: St. Cloud State is 9-1 overall and 3-1 in the NSIC. Minot State brings an 8-6 overall record into Tuesday's game. Concordia, St. Paul enters the week with a 10-3 overall record and 3-1 NSIC mark. The Golden Bears will play a non-conference game at South Dakota on Monday night.

Series Records: The St. Cloud State women have tipped off against Minot State once in the history of

the program. The game was played in 1979 and the result was a 75-50 SCSU win. The Huskies will be playing Concordia, St. Paul for the 14th time overall and first time in league play. St. Cloud State has a 9-5 advantage in the series that began in 1977. Last season the Golden Bears defeated the Huskies 83-66 in non-conference action.

SCSU Team Captains: Senior guards Anna Cashman (Faribault) and Katie Tacheny (Woodbury), along with junior guard Megan Foley (St. Cloud) captain the 2008-09 Huskies.

Five Game Home Stretch: These two games mark the final games of a five game home stretch for the Huskies. St. Cloud State will hit the road for an NSIC series on Jan. 9 and 10 at Minnesota Duluth and Bemidji State.

Head Coach Lori Fish

Lori Fish is a familiar name to the St. Cloud area. Fish grew up in St. Cloud and attended St. Cloud Tech High School. Following her graduation from Tech, she went on to play basketball at South Dakota State and competed against the Huskies in the North Central Conference.



Following the completion of an outstanding collegiate playing career where she gained First Team All-Conference honors as a junior and senior, Fish entered the coaching ranks. She started as a high school coach in Foley, Minn., for two seasons before returning to South Dakota State as a graduate assistant coach. She spent one year at NCAA Division I Eastern Illinois University and returned to SDSU as an assistant. In 1999, Lori Ulferts hired Fish as an assistant to the Husky program and she served as the recruiting and strength and conditioning coordinator under Ulferts for five seasons. In 2004, Fish became a head coach at rival Minnesota State University, Mankato. She quickly distinguished herself as a rising young coach and in 2007-08, her final season with the Mavericks, led her team to a 23-9 record and the championship game of the NCAA Division II North Central Region Tournament.

In four seasons as a collegiate head coach, Fish has compiled a 62-53 overall won/loss record.

Assistant Coaches



St. Cloud State assistant coach **Carol Thelen** is in her third season with the Huskies. An SCSU alumnus and Albany, Minn., native, Thelen had been the head girls basketball coach at DeLaSalle High School in Minneapolis since 1999.



Darby Noreen is in her rookie season with the Huskies. An Albany, Minn., native, Noreen was a standout athlete at Albany High School and the College of St. Benedict. She has been an assistant coach at both Albany and St. Ben's.



Katie Jensen will serve as a student assistant coach in 2008-09. Jensen played for the Huskies from 2005 to 2007. She is a graduate of English Valleys (IA) High School.

Game Notes

About St. Cloud State: St. Cloud State brings a 9-1 overall record into New Year's week following a 107-58 win over Dakota State on Dec. 22. The Huskies continue to shoot well this season as St. Cloud State is shooting 50 percent from the floor and 41.5 percent from three-point range. St. Cloud State has an impressive +23.8 scoring margin over their opponents and are averaging 83.2 points per game. Twice this season the Huskies have scored over 100 points in a game, marking the first time since the 2005-06 season that SCSU has gone over 100 twice in a season. The school record for points scored in a game is 123 scored against Morningside College during the 1998-99 season. The Huskies have scored 90 or more points three times this season. Three players are averaging double figures in scoring led by sophomore guard Talisha Barlow (Little Canada) with 16.7 points. Senior guard Katie Tacheny (Woodbury) is next with 15.6 points and sophomore post Rachel Booth (Minneapolis) is third averaging 11.8 points per game.

In the NSIC: St. Cloud State is tied for third in the league standings with Concordia, St. Paul as both teams are 3-1 in league play with their only loss coming to league leader MSU Moorhead. The only teams above the Huskies are MSU Moorhead at 4-0 and Minnesota State University, Mankato at 3-0. St. Cloud State leads the NSIC in scoring offense with 77.5 points per game and field goal percentage at .462. The Huskies are also tops in the league in rebounding defense with 31.5 per game. St. Cloud State is second in the league in turnover margin and steals, and third in three-point field goal percentage.

NSIC Preseason Poll: The 2008-09 NSIC Women's Basketball Coaches Preseason Poll was released on Oct. 22 and the Huskies were picked to finish eighth in the league. Conference newcomer Minnesota State University, Mankato was tabbed the preseason favorite followed by another newcomer Augustana College. Concordia-St. Paul, the defending NSIC champion was picked third.

Player Notes

#3 Katie Tacheny Notes: Guard and senior captain Katie Tacheny (Woodbury) leads the Huskies in assists and steals with 33 each. Tacheny has scored in double figures in eight of the Huskies nine games. She scored a career high 22 points at Upper Iowa on Dec. 6. She made ten free throws at Upper Iowa, marking the fourth time in her career that she has made ten or more free throws in a game. She has started 55 straight games for the Huskies.



#10 Krystal Scott Notes: Senior guard Krystal Scott (Rosemount) scored a career high 16 points against Dakota State last Monday, her fifth double figure scoring game of the season...Scott has played in a team high 95 games...has started 19 straight games including the final nine of the 2007-08 season.



#11 Talisha Barlow Notes: Sophomore guard Talisha Barlow (Little Canada) collected her second collegiate double-double against Dakota State on 12/22 with a 15 point, 10 rebound game...scored a career high 25 points in the Huskies loss to 13th-ranked MSU Moorhead on 12/12/08...has scored in double figures nine times this season... has played in every game, 38 straight, of her collegiate career and made 33 starts...had a career high seven steals in the season opener against UW-Oshkosh on Nov. 15...tallied her first collegiate double-double vs UNO with 21 points/ten rebounds on 2/14/08...averaging a team leading 16.7 points per game.



#21 Anna Cashman Notes: Senior guard and captain Anna Cashman (Faribault) dished out a career high eight assists against Dakota State on 12/22/08...tallied a career high seven rebounds against Minnesota, Crookston on 12/13/08...scored a season high 17 points in win over Nebraska-Omaha...led the 2007-08 team with 46 three-point field goals...scored a career high 23 points vs. UW-Stout on 11/17/07, hitting eight of 12 field goals...twice during the 2007-08 season she made five three-point baskets in a game.



#23 Danielle Ellison Notes: Senior forward Danielle Ellison (St. Paul) scored a season high 12 points against Minnesota, Crookston on 12/13/08...also had a season high seven rebounds against MSU Moorhead...started the 37th game of her career last Monday...has played in 66 career games as a Husky...scored her career high 18 points against Chico State on 12/28/07.



#32 Rachel Booth Notes: Sophomore center Rachel Booth (Minneapolis) has scored in double figures in seven games this season.. tallied a season high 19 points in the Huskies 73-55 win over Northwest Missouri State... has played in 37 of the 37 games of her collegiate career...missed the final game of her rookie season due to an injury...starter in 35 collegiate games...has scored in double figures in 27 games during her collegiate career...recorded her first collegiate double-double in an 18 point, 17 rebound effort against Sonoma State on 12/29/07.

#34 Megan Foley: Junior guard and team captain, Foley (St. Cloud) scored her first points of the season against Northwest Missouri State...twice has notched two blocked shots in a game this season... equaled her career high of seven rebounds, all on the defensive boards against Dakota State on Nov. 21...played in 13 games in 2007-08 and scored her career high eight points against Lake Superior State on 12/22/07.



#2 Becca Friestleben Notes: First year guard Becca Friestleben (Victoria) scored her career high 12 points against Dakota State on 12/22 with four of six shooting from three-point range...her three rebounds, five assists and two steals in that same game were all career highs...has played in eight games this season... holds Holy Family Catholic High School all-time scoring record (boys and girls) with 2,515 career points...led State in three-point baskets made three years in a row.



#13 Marlayna Graff Notes: Sophomore post Marlayna Graff (Harris) is a transfer who sat out the second half of the Huskies 2007-08 season...has played in nine games this season (missed game on 12/22 with the flu)...equaled her season and career high seven points against Upper Iowa on Dec. 6...had a season and career high three steals against Henderson State on Nov. 21... named a NJCAA Division III Preseason Second Team All-American in the fall of 2007 prior to her transfer to St. Cloud State.



#35 Amy Frye Notes: First year forward Amy Frye (Hudson, WI) has played in five games this season... tallied season high four rebounds against Dakota State on 12/22...had two points, two assists and two steals, all season highs against Dakota State on Nov. 22...scored 262 points, pulled down 128 rebounds, had 37 steals, and 24 blocked shots during her senior campaign at Hudson (WI) High School.



#43 Christina Steele Notes: First year post Christina Steele (Apple Valley) scored eight points in her collegiate debut on Nov. 15...has played in six games this season...scored a career high 11 points against Dakota State on 12/22...three-time First Team All-Lake Conference in high school...holds record for most points in a season with 504...team rebounding leader for three straight years.



#45 Aaryn Booker Notes: First year forward Aaryn Booker (Minneapolis)...scored her collegiate high 16 points against Dakota State on Nov. 22...twice this season has seven rebounds and six rebounds in two games...top scoring rookie for the Huskies, averaging 6.7 points and 4.2 boards per game...Booker and Rachel Booth played high school ball at DeLaSalle High School...all-time scoring and rebounding leader at DeLaSalle with 1,226 career points and 787 career rebounds.

Opponent Notes and Probable Starters

About Minot State: The Beavers are members of the NAIA and Dakota Athletic Conference (DAC). Last season the Beavers posted a 21-11 overall record, finished third in the DAC with a 10-4 mark, and made a trip to the national tournament advancing to the Elite 8. Three starters return from that successful team including senior LaShay Bagsby, an NAIA All-Tournament team selection and all-conference performer. Head coach Sheila Green Gerding is in her 14th year with the Beavers.



About Concordia, St. Paul: The Golden Bears have won six of their last seven games (does not include game on 12/29), and like the Huskies have one loss in NSIC play to MSU Moorhead. CU averages 74.8 points per game. The Golden Bears are shooting 41.3 percent from the field and 37.0 percent from three point range. CU is led in scoring by junior guard Jamie Jones who averages 13.9 points per game. She also leads the team in assists with 61. Head coach Paul Fessler is in his ninth season with the Golden Bears and 13th overall. In eight seasons at CU he has compiled a 178-66 record. Last season, the Golden Bears posted a 28-3 overall record, won the NSIC with a 16-2 mark, won the NSIC tournament, and were ranked #14 in the final USA Today/ESPN Division II coaches poll. CU lost to Minnesota State University, Mankato in the North Central Region Tournament.
