2004-05 SCSU W'S BASKETBALL TEAM NEWS

Release Date: November 8, 2003



THE GAMES: The Huskies open the 2004-05 season on Monday, November 15 at 6:00 pm in an away match against Bemidji State. They travel to Grand Valley State's tournament where they play Grand Valley State Friday, November 19 at 7:00 pm and Michigan Tech Saturday, November 20 at 1:00 pm.

THE SERIES: The Huskies hold the series lead against Bemidji State at 24-11; SCSU and Grand Valley State are tied at 1-1; Michigan Tech leads the Huskies 3-2.

2003-04 RESULTS: The St. Cloud State women's basketball team posted a 17-11 overall record and finished fifth in the North Central Conference with a 7-7 league record. In the NCAA Division II statistics, St. Cloud State ranked 6th in free throw percentage with 78.0% and ranked first in the NCC with 77.6% free throws. The Huskies ended their season with a loss to USD (73-44) in the first round of the Wells Fargo Tournament on March 2.

Two Huskies earned NCC honors for their performance during the 2003-04 season. Erika Quigley, the 6-2 post player, was selected by the North Central Conference coaches to the 2003-2004 All-NCC women's basketball team and was named the First-Year Player of the Year, just the third Husky to receive such an honor. Quigley was also named to the Daktronics, Inc. Division II All-North Central Region second team. Jessica Abrahams, a senior guard, was voted All-North Central Conference Honorable Mention by the NCC coaches.

THE COACHES:

Dr. Lori Ulferts (North Dakota, 1983) enters her eleventh season with the Huskies and 20th season as a collegiate head coach. She has compiled a 139-135 record in 10 seasons at SCSU and has amassed a 291-224 record in 19 years as a head coach. Under her guidance the Huskies reached the 2001 NCAA North Central Region Tournament Semi-Finals before falling to the University of North Dakota, 76-63. That season the Huskies posted a 21-9 record, the best for a Husky team since the 1989-90 team posted a 23-5 overall record and were Co-NCC Champions under long time coach Gladys Ziemer. Before coming to St. Cloud, Ulferts coached at MN-Crookston (four seasons) and MN-State, Moorhead (five seasons). She is a two-time Northern Sun Conference Coach of the Year.

Mike Jewett (Augustana College, 1994) begins his first year as Coach Ulferts' top assistant at SCSU. Previous to joining the SCSU staff, Jewett was the head women's basketball coach at Franklin College in Franklin, Indiana for 3 seasons (2001-2004). During his tenure, he compiled a 62-20 overall record. In 2004 he led his team to the second round of the NCAA Division III tournament, won the Heartland Collegiate Athletic Conference (HCAC), and was named the HCAC Coach of the Year. Jewett served as an assistant coach at Augustana College from 1997-2001. He also coached the girls basketball team at Brandon Valley High School in Brandon, South Dakota for three seasons (1994-1997).

Megan Taylor (Iowa State, 2002) will serve as the graduate assistant coach.

SASCHA HANSEN: As a co-captain and sophomore guard, Hansen averaged 8.9 points and 3.7 rebounds per game last season. She continues to lead the Huskies with strong play in the backcourt.

SHANNON FRANCIS: As a first-year guard, Francis stepped up to prove her ability in the post. She played in and started each of the 28 games last season, averaging 8.8 points and 3.1 rebounds per game.

KATIE HUSCHLE: Huschle proved to be a reliable go-to player for SCSU in 2003-04. She played in every game and averaged 8.3 points and 3.9 rebounds per game. She was the third leading scorer and second leading rebounder for SCSU last year.

APRIL CARLSON: The sophomore post player averaged 3.3 points and 3.2 rebounds per game. She proved to be effective as both a starter and bench player.

ERIKA QUIGLEY: First-year center Quigley jumped into the NCC with demanding force last season, leading the Huskies in both scoring and rebounding. She served as the main stronghold in the frontcourt, averaging 18.1 points and 8.9 rebounds per game.
