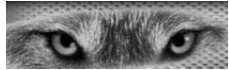

## 2003-04 SCSU W'S BASKETBALL TEAM NEWS

**UPCOMING GAMES:** The St. Cloud State University women's basketball team (17-10, 7-7 NCC) will open play in the 2004 Wells Fargo Finals tournament on March 2, with a 6 p.m. game at the University of South Dakota in Vermillion, S.D. Game time is slated for 6 p.m. Here is a look at the first round pairings:

- #2 South Dakota State (22-5, 11-3) hosts #7 Minnesota State (9-18, 3-11)
- #3 North Dakota (22-5, 10-4) hosts #6 Augustana (13-14, 5-9)
- #4 South Dakota (24-6, 9-5) hosts #5 St. Cloud State (17-10, 7-7)

North Dakota State will be the #1 seed and will host the Wells Fargo Final Four in Fargo, N.D. on March 6-7. The basketball games will be broadcast live on WJON AM 1240 with Jay Caldwell calling the play-by-play. **TEAM RECORD:** SCSU's record is 17-10, 7-7 in the NCC for the season. The Huskies will continue their season on March 2, against the South Dakota Coyotes.

**RECENT RESULTS:** The St. Cloud State women's basketball team (17-10, 7-7 NCC) lost a tough 86-54 game to #11 North Dakota State (22-5, 11-3 NCC) on Feb. 28 in Fargo, N.D. The game marked the final time in regular season play that the Huskies will play NDSU as a member of NCC and it also allowed NDSU to clinch the conference championship in its final year as a DII program. Next year, NDSU is slated to move to the NCAA Division I level. The Huskies hung tough in the early going as the lead changed five times in first half.

The Bison managed to get the upper hand in the later part of the opening half and pushed its lead at the break to 45-32. In the game, SCSU was led by Erika Quigley with 14 points and 11 rebounds, and Katie Huschle added 12 points. NDSU was paced by Michelle Fricke with 31 points and seven rebounds and Angie Froehlich with 20 points.

The St. Cloud State women's basketball team suffered a tough 86-54 loss to #7 North Dakota (21-5, 9-4 NCC) on Feb. 27 in Grand Forks, N.D. The game marked the final time in regular season play that the Huskies will play at UND's Hyslop Sports Arena as UND will move to a new facility in 2004-05. In the game, the UND squad led from start to finish, as it owned a 44-23 lead at the half. Shannon Francis led the Huskies with 12 points and four assists, while Erika Quigley had 10 points and six rebounds. Marissa Leighton led UND with 21 points, while Kristi Boese had 16 points and 11 rebounds. UND shot 50.8% from the floor in the game and the Huskies shot 33.8% in the game.

**SCSU COACHING STAFF:** Dr. Lori Ulferts (North Dakota, 1983), is in her 10th season with the Huskies and 19th season as a collegiate head coach. She has compiled a 139-133 record in 10 seasons at SCSU and has amassed a 291-231 record in 19 years as a head coach. Ulferts has coached at MN-Crookston (four seasons) and MN-State, Moorhead (five seasons). She is a two-time Northern Sun Conference Coach of the year. Assisting Ulferts in 2003-04 is Lori Fish (South Dakota State, 1991). Coach Fish is in her fifth season with the Huskies.

**JESSICA ABRAHAMS:** Co-captain and senior guard, from Detroit Lakes, will lead the Huskies into her last season of playoffs. Abrahams played consistent this past weekend in North Dakota as she accounted for 13 points and 6 rebounds on the weekend. In her final season, Abrahams is averaging 11.7 ppg. and 4.1 rpg.

**ERIKA QUIGLEY:** First-year post from Duluth led the Huskies this past weekend with 24 combined points and 17 rebounds. Quigley ranks third in the conference in the scoring category (18.6 ppg) and second in the rebound category (9.2 rpg).

**KATIE HUSCHLE:** Junior guard continues to bring a spark off the bench for the Huskies. For the season Huschle is averaging 9.5 points and 4.1 rebounds per game. This past weekend she accounted for 18 points and 11 rebounds.

**SASCHA HANSEN:** As a co-captain and sophomore point-guard, Hansen is averaging 9.5 points per game and 3.5 rebounds. She continues to be the floor general on the court as she has accounted for 86 assists on the season. This past weekend Hansen netted 16 points and 7 assists.

**SHANNON FRANCIS:** First-year guard, Francis is averaging 9.0 points per game and 3.0 rebounds. Francis scored 21 points this past weekend and grabbed 8 rebounds, along with dishing out 7 assists.

**KRISTA KETNER:** Junior post, Krista Ketner, has found her roll on the Husky team and has played it well. The 6-2 post from Nicollet is averaging 3.0 ppg and 3.2 rpg for the Huskies. She had 11 points and 10 rebounds on the weekend and earned her first start in the Husky line-up last Saturday night against the NDSU Bison.

**TEAM NOTES:** The Huskies have earned 9 Division II Nationally ranked votes according to the February 24th poll and are currently ranked #8 in the North Central Region. The Huskies dropped two heart-break losses this past weekend in NCC play to North Dakota and North Dakota State. Their NCC record of 7-7 leaves them with a 5th place finish in the NCC. They will meet up against #15 South Dakota (#4 in the NCC) this week as the NCC Wells Fargo Tournament begins on March 2. The Huskies will bring a sense of revenge into the game since the Coyotes defeated the Huskies recently this season in Halenbeck Hall. Freshman post Erika Quigley leads the Huskies in scoring with 365 points (18.3 ppg) and in blocks with 38 on the season...senior guard Jessica Abrahams leads the team with 43 treys and 47 steals. She ranks 3rd in the team's career records with 123 treys, while teammate Andrea Shogren ranks 4th with 96. As of February 21, the Huskies are first in the league in FT% with a .780 rate (423-542)...they have outscored their opponents 2036-1968 this year.

**OTHER NOTES:** The Huskies have used a well-rounded attack in 2003-04 to gain a solid 17-10 record, which includes wins over nationally ranked #6 South Dakota State, #12 South Dakota, Concordia-St. Paul, and Minnesota-Duluth... the Huskies will have two short days to prepare for the South Dakota Coyotes, whom they will meet up against in the first round of the NCC Wells Fargo Tournament. The Huskies beat the Coyotes in the Dakota Dome earlier this season, 66-61. USD will bring a 24-6, 9-5 NCC record into Tuesday night's game, along with a 22-22 tied series standing with the Huskies. Coach Chad Lavin is in his 9th season at USD, and he owns a 170-88 record there, along with a tie for the NCC championship last season. Senior forward and returning 2002-2003 Division II Player of the Year, Mandy Koupal, is averaging 24.2 ppg and 11.4 rpg for the USD squad...junior Jenni Flynn is averaging 9.1 ppg and 4.4 rpg, and sophomore guard Meghan Woster is averaging 8.8 ppg and 3.5 rpg. The Coyotes lost their senior point guard, Stacey Schooley a few weeks ago due to a career-ending knee injury.
