## 2007 SCSU CROSS COUNTRY NEWS

**SCSU COMPETE'S AT MINNESOTA STATE OPEN:** The Huskies were in Mankato this past weekend at Land of Memories Park for the Minnesota State University Open on Saturday, Oct. 6. No team scores were kept in the event, which also included athletes from Gustavus Adolphus College in addition to MSU and SCSU. Minnesota State's women's team also had a number of track athletes enter the open event in honor of former teammate Caty Delwiche, who was stuck and killed by a vehicle while running near campus earlier in the week. Women's coach Jennifer Blue announced before the race that next year it would be renamed the Caty Delwiche Memorial Open in honor of the Mavericks former teammate.

**WINANS CONTINUES TO LEAD HUSKIES:** Emily Winans (Fergus Falls) recorded her first top 10 finish of 2007 at the MSU Open when she finished the four-kilometer race ninth with a time of 16:52. Fellow Husky Andrea Borden (Merrifield) was not far out of the top 10 with a 12th place finish in 17:19 for the day. Paula Marozas (Rochester) recorded an 18th place finish for the Huskies with her time of 17:54. Six runners total competed for SCSU in the women's event including Christa Halonen (Annandale), Libbie Sanders (Coon Rapids), and Sierra Poole (Winnebago). Halonen was next to cross the line at 26th with a time of 18:36, while Sanders and Poole rounded out the Huskies with a 29th place finish in 19:01 and a 35th place finish in 20:30 respectively.

Competing for Gustavus Adolphus, Laura Edlund was the race champion with her time of 15:25.

**ALLEN AND CHERIF LEAD HUSKIES:** As they did the week before, Dan Allen (St. Louis Park) and Hady Cherif (Minneapolis) crossed the finish line back-to-back to lead the Huskies. Again it was Allen just a place ahead as he finished 15th overall in a time of 21:23. Right behind in 16th place, Cherif finished in a time of 21:24. Lucas Pederson (Richfield) and Tim Moes (Becker) also ran for SCSU finishing 22nd and 31st respectively. Pederson crossed the line at the 22:36 mark while Moes crossed two minutes later at 24:36.

**NORTH CENTRAL CONFERENCE CHAMPIONSHIPS UP NEXT:** The Huskies will be off from competition this coming week in preparation for the NCC Championships on October 20. This years event will be held in Carlton, Minnesota, near Duluth with the men's eight-kilometer race set to start at 11:00 a.m. and the women's six-kilometer an hour later at 12:00 p.m. The defending women's champ is North Dakota, while Minnesota State is out to defend its title in the men's race.

**SCSU COACH SETH MISCHKE RETURNS FOR NINTH SEASON WITH THE HUSKIES:** Seth Mischke began his first season as head coach of the men's and women's track and field programs and cross country programs at St. Cloud State in 1999-2000. Prior to taking over the helm at SCSU, Mischke was a two-year assistant coach with former Husky head coach Tracy Dill.

Mischke is a 1997 graduate of the University of Minnesota. He was a member of the Golden Gophers men's team and participated in the decathlon. He placed third in the Big Ten meet in the decathlon as a senior. Mischke has completed his master's degree in physical education at St. Cloud State. He is a native of Worland, Wyoming and was a standout athlete at Worland High School - located in scenic north central Wyoming. Mischke resides with his wife Colleen and their two children in St. Cloud.
