2003 SCSU CROSS COUNTRY TEAM NEWS

LAST WEEK'S RESULTS: It was a weekend of personal record times for the St. Cloud State University women's and men's cross country teams. The Huskies participated in the Minnesota State Open on Saturday, October 25th. Despite the taxing and hilly course, the Huskies had a confidence-buidling day.

The 5K and 8K meet was scored by individual times. Husky senior, Travis Hoover, ran a great race and led the Huskies with a second place finish (26:45). The remaining four Husky runners finished the race together. Sophomore Keith Stenzel finished the race in 15th place (29:10), Anthony Dunkel finished in 16th place (31:23), Todd Hoffman finished in 17th place (32:33), and Daniel Scheff finished in 19th place (33:45). There were a total of 26 runners in the men's competition.

The SCSU women ran an exceptional race. Senior Amy Dombrovski had a career day and won the race with a 20:00 time. Jamie Petsch, another senior Husky, finished in third place with a 20:17 time. Junior Sarah Getty finished in 5th place (20:48), and sophomore Becky Anderson finished right behind Getty in 6th place with a time of 20:57. Sophomore Abby Clark ran a personal best of 21:32, finishing in 9th place, and Maggie Christensen came in with an 11th place finish and a time of 21:41. The other Husky women runners were; Kari Sakrismo with a 14th place finish (22:28), Molly Hansen with a 15th place finish (22:38), Jenny Uner with a 16th place finish (22:52), Jenny Lanin with a 17th place finish (23:19), and Sarah Rheingans with an 18th place finish (23:41). There were a total of 24 runners in the women's competition.

The Huskies will have two weeks to prepare for the NCAA Regional Meet. The men's team will bring their five runners and the women's team plans on bringing seven runners. Coach Seth Mischke foresees great Husky finishes in two weeks.

NCAA REGIONAL RACE: The St. Cloud State University Men's and Women's Cross Country teams will be competing in the NCAA Regional Meet in two weeks. The men will be running an 8K and the women will be running a 6K. The meet is scheduled to start at 10:00 a.m. for the women and 10:30 a.m. for the men. The race is taking place in Wayne, Neb., on Saturday, November 8th.
