The Game: The St. Cloud State University Husky football team will travel to Grand Forks, ND for a North Central Conference match up against the University of North Dakota on Saturday, Nov. 3. The kick-off is scheduled for 1:00 p.m. at the Grand Forks Alerus Center (12, 283).

The 2007 Records: St. Cloud State is 4-5 overall and 1-5 in the NCC following a 13-3 home loss to the University of Nebraska-Omaha last Saturday. The 9th-ranked (Oct. 23 poll) University of North Dakota brings a 7-1 overall record and 5-1 NCC mark into the game. UND is coming off a 31-14 win at the University of Minnesota Duluth.

The Series: The University of North Dakota has won three straight in the series and four of the last five. UND leads the all-time series 25-4 and are 13-3 against the Huskies in Grand Forks. The Huskies last win in Grand Forks was a 21-17 victory during the 2004 season.

SCSU Head Coach: SCSU head coach Randy Hedberg (Minot State 1977) is in his ninth season with the Huskies in 2007. He has a current won/loss record of 47-49 at SCSU and is 92-72-2 overall in 16 plus years as a collegiate coach. He netted his 75th career coaching win against UND on October 2, 2004 and his 30th with the Huskies. The Huskies won the NCC title in 2002, which marks the second time in team history that SCSU has won the NCC title. In 2004 SCSU posted an 8-3 record, and hosted the University of North Dakota in the first round of the NCAA Division II playoffs. The Parshall, N.D. native has been the head coach at Minot State (1982-89), assistant coach at Central Missouri State (1990-95), and an assistant coach at North Dakota (1996-98). Hedberg was an honorable mention All-America quarterback at Minot State. He was drafted by Tampa Bay of the NFL in 1977, and played with the Bucs through 1978. He also played with the Oakland Raiders (1979) and Green Bay Packers (1980).



2007 Team Captains: Seniors Philip Hedlof (Blomkest) and Derek Sedin (Santa Maria, CA), along with juniors Ryan Kees (Eagan) and Matt Plautz (Appleton, WI) will captain the 2007 Husky football team.

SCSU All-Time Record: The 2007 season marks the 85th in the history of SCSU football. Since 1920, SCSU has compiled a 384-328-22 overall record and has won a total of 18 conference titles, two in the North Central Conference (1989, 2002), 14 Northern Intercollegiate Conference crowns and two Minnesota State College Conference titles.

Husky Hits/Player Notes.....

Husky Recap: The Huskies dropped a 13-3 decision to top ranked Nebraska-Omaha last Saturday in St. Cloud. The Mavericks scored all 13 points in the first half and used a solid running attack. UNO scored ten points in the final two and a half minutes of the first half as junior quarterback Zach Miller ran the ball in from five yards out a 2:34 and the Mavericks tacked on a Greg Zuerlein field goal, this one from 46 yards with :06 seconds remaining to take a 13-0 half-time lead. The Huskies scored a field goal late in the third quarter when junior Brian Cristan booted a 36-yard attempt.

It Doesn't Get Any Easier: The Huskies will play two top ten teams in back to back weeks as last Saturday SCSU played #4 UNO and will face #9 North Dakota this week. The Huskies have also played ranked teams in Central Washington, South Dakota and Minnesota State.

Defense Battles: The Husky defense held UNO to its lowest scoring output of the year, and are the only team this season to keep the undefeated Mavericks off the scoreboard in the second half of a game. However, the SCSU defense spent nearly 39 minutes on the field as UNO won the possession battle last Saturday.

Dotch Highlights Defense: Junior linebacker Darius Dotch (St. Paul) tallied eight tackles against UNO last Saturday, including a career high 3.5 tackles for loss. The eight tackles are the second most for Dotch in his career.

Streit Gets Career High: Senior linebacker Chris Streit (Sauk Rapids) notched a career high 13 tackles against UNO. He also recorded one tackle for loss.

LaPointe and Hedlof Hit Double Figures: Senior linebacker Aaron LaPointe (Elk River) and senior cornerback Philip Hedlof (Blomkest) each reached double figures in tackles against UNO. LaPointe had ten tackles, which equals his season and career high, including one tackle for loss. Hedlof tallied 11 tackles, the second time he has hit his season high.

Quarterback Sacks: The Husky defense has logged 30 quarterback sacks during the 2007 season, led by junior ends Cale Pulczynski (Mukwonago, WI) with six and Ryan Kees (Eagan) with four. The single season record for most sacks is 40 set during the 1991 season. The Huskies recorded 39 sacks during the 2005 season.

Tackles for Loss: The Huskies have recorded 72 tackles for loss this season. The school single season record of 90 tackles for loss was also set during the 2005 season.

Husky Stadium



2007 marks the fourth season of Husky Stadium. St. Cloud State is 12-6 at Husky Stadium since the 2004 season. The Huskies posted a 4-2 record at Husky Stadium in 2004, including a 0-1 mark in an NCAA playoff game in the new facility. In 2005, SCSU went 5-1 at Husky Stadium, followed by a 3-3 home mark in 2006. The Huskies averaged 3,772 fans in the 4,198 seat facility in 2004, 3,961 in 2005, and 3,936 in 2006. SCSU's first sell-out was on October 2, 2004 against the University of North Dakota. 2004 Record: 4-2; 2005 Record: 5-1; 2006 Record: 3-3.

Final Year of the NCC

The 2007-08 school year will mark the final year of league competition in the North Central Conference for the St. Cloud State University athletics program. St. Cloud State University, Minnesota State University Mankato, Augustana College and the University of Minnesota Duluth will join the Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference in the fall of 2008. The University of Nebraska-Omaha will join the Mid-America Intercollegiate Athletics Association, while the University of South Dakota and the University of North Dakota have elected to seek NCAA Division I status. The St. Cloud State men's program joined the North Central Conference in 1981. The Huskies made their presence known in the league winning 13 tennis championships (1986, 90, 91, 93, 94, 97, 98, 99, 2002, 03, 04, 05, 06) four swimming and diving championships (1982,83, 84, 85), four basketball championships (1986,87,88, 2001), three golf championships, two football (1989 and 2002), and one title each in cross-country (1983), and baseball (1991). The SCSU women's program joined the NCC in 1984, and won five conference tennis titles (1985, 87, 88, 90, 91), three softball titles (1998, 2003, 2004), and one basketball championship (1989).

UND Notes: - North Dakota is led by ninth year head coach Dale Lennon (North Dakota, 1985)...under Lennon North Dakota has won 87 games, five NCC titles and one NCAA title in 2001...UND sits as the ninth ranked team in the country and the third ranked team in the Northwest Region...UND's 5-1 league record puts them in a second place tie with Central Washington and South Dakota...last season UND finished as NCC co-champions with Nebraska-Omaha with a 7-1 league record...North Dakota was 10-1 overall in the regular season and earned home field advantage in the first round of the playoffs and beat Winona State 42-0...UND would go on to beat Nebraska-Omaha in the second round before falling in the regional championship to eventual national champion Grand Valley State 30-20...in the game against St. Cloud last season, North Dakota escaped with a 34-27 overtime win at Husky Stadium on Nov. 4...SCSU led 27-24 with under two minutes to go, but a UND field goal tied the game with 1:40 left to play...in the overtime North Dakota needed just two plays to score going up 34-27...with first and goal from the four SCSU was unable to get into the end zone...North Dakota is led by a high powered offense which ranks first in the NCC in both scoring at 36.8 points per game and total offense at 524.7 yards per game, and also first nationally at 540.6 yards per game...junior signal caller Danny Freund throws for 253.5 yards per game and is the league's most efficient passer at 165.3...running back Ryan Chappell leads the NCC in rushing with 176.3 yards per game and teammate Weston Dressler leads the conference in receiving yards per game with 120.7...all three also rank in the top four nationally in each category...last week North Dakota beat Minnesota Duluth 31-14 in Duluth...quarterback Danny Freund had a hand in three of the scores as he threw for one touchdown and ran for two more...North Dakota held the Bulldog offense to just 186 yards of offense and forced five three-and-outs while piling up 427 yards of their own.
