The NCC Finale: The St. Cloud State University Husky football team will host the University of Minnesota Duluth in the final North Central Conference game to be played by the Huskies on Saturday, Nov. 10. The kick-off is set for 1:00 p.m. at Husky Stadium (4,197) on the SCSU campus. The North Central Conference will no longer exist after the 2007-08 sports seasons and both SCSU and UMD will be joining the Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference beginning in the fall of 2008.

The 2007 Records: St. Cloud State is 4-6 overall and 1-6 in the NCC following a 59-14 conference loss at the University of North Dakota last Saturday. Minnesota Duluth is 3-6 overall and 2-5 in the NCC. The Bulldogs had a bye week last week and last played on Oct. 27, in a 31-14 home loss to UND.

The Series: St. Cloud State leads the all-time series with UMD 22-16, but the Bulldogs have won two of the last three meetings, including a 29-24 win in Duluth last season.

SCSU Head Coach: SCSU head coach Randy Hedberg (Minot State 1977) is in his ninth season with the Huskies in 2007. He has a current won/loss record of 47-50 at SCSU and is 92-73-2 overall in 16 plus years as a collegiate coach. He netted his 75th career coaching win against UND on October 2, 2004 and his 30th with the Huskies. The Huskies won the NCC title in 2002, which marks the second time in team history that SCSU has won the NCC title. In 2004 SCSU posted an 8-3 record, and hosted the University of North Dakota in the first round of the NCAA Division II playoffs. The Parshall, N.D.



native has been the head coach at Minot State (1982-89), assistant coach at Central Missouri State (1990-95), and an assistant coach at North Dakota (1996-98). Hedberg was an honorable mention All-America quarterback at Minot State. He was drafted by Tampa Bay of the NFL in 1977, and played with the Bucs through 1978. He also played with the Oakland Raiders (1979) and Green Bay Packers (1980).

2007 Team Captains: Seniors Philip Hedlof (Blomkest) and Derek Sedin (Santa Maria, CA), along with juniors Ryan Kees (Eagan) and Matt Plautz (Appleton, WI) will captain the 2007 Husky football team.

SCSU All-Time Record: The 2007 season marks the 85th in the history of SCSU football. Since 1920, SCSU has compiled a 384-328-22 overall record and has won a total of 18 conference titles, two in the North Central Conference (1989, 2002), 14 Northern Intercollegiate Conference crowns and two Minnesota State College Conference titles.

Husky Hits/Player Notes.....

Husky Recap: The Huskies dropped an NCC game at the University of North Dakota, 59-14 last Saturday. The University of North Dakota scored on all five first half possessions to take a 35-0 lead, and 359 yards of offense into the half-time break. The Huskies struggled with five, three and out possessions and gained 58 yards on offense in the first half. The second half opened with a lost SCSU fumble on the kick-off, followed by a UND fumble forced by the Huskies Cale Pulczinski and recovered by Treg Swanson. SCSU took over on the 32-yard line and five plays later junior running back Michael Graham (Oakdale) scored on a five-yard run and the Huskies trailed 35-7. As has been the case all season, the Husky defense held tough in the third quarter allowing a 51-yard field goal. SCSU would score its second touchdown of the day late in the fourth quarter on a one-yard run by junior Adam Luckey (Murrieta, CA).

Senior Day: St. Cloud State football fans will watch nine seniors play in their final game in a Husky uniform today. Senior captains defensive back Philip Hedlof, offensive lineman Matt Plautz, and wide receiver Derek Sedin will lead the Huskies onto the field in their final game. The senior class also includes quarterbacks Mike Hammerseng and Jon Quesnel, offensive lineman Craig Reesor, defensive lineman Treg Swanson, and linebackers Aaron LaPointe and Chris Streit.

Parent's Day: The Parent's of the 2007 Husky football players will also be recognized Saturday at half-time.

Coaches Connection: St. Cloud State head coach Randy Hedberg and Minnesota Duluth head coach Bubba Schweigert have coached with and against each other over the years. Both coached against each other in North Dakota when Hedberg was at Minot State and Schweigert was at Jamestown College. Prior to taking their current positions, they were assistant coaches at the University of North Dakota for three seasons.

Graham Hits 90: Junior running back Michael Graham (Oakdale) rushed for 91 yards and one touchdown on 12 carries against UND last Saturday. It was his second best performance of the season behind a 30 carry for 172 yard performance at Western Washington earlier this season. Among his carries was the Huskies longest rushing play of the season, a 53 yard scamper which set up his eventual touchdown run. Graham leads the Huskies in rushing with 98 carries for 473 yards.

Tackles for Loss on the Rise: The Husky defense tallied seven tackles for loss at North Dakota by five different players. Junior end Ryan Kees (Eagan) led the way with two tackles for loss and one quarterback sack. The Huskies have notched 79 tackles for loss this season, 11 short of the single season record of 90.

Husky Sacks: With five quarterback sacks against UND, the Huskies upped their season total to 35, just five short of the single season record of 40 set during the 1991 season. Junior end Cale Pulczinski (Mukwonago, WI) recorded his team leading seventh QB sack at UND.

2007 marks the fourth season of Husky Stadium. St. Cloud State is 12-6 at Husky Stadium since the 2004 season. The Huskies posted a 4-2 record at Husky Stadium in 2004, including a 0-1 mark in an NCAA playoff game in the new facility. In 2005, SCSU went 5-1 at Husky Stadium, followed by a 3-3 home mark in 2006. The Huskies averaged 3,772 fans in the 4,198 seat facility in 2004, 3,961 in 2005, and 3,936 in 2006. SCSU's first sell-out was on October 2, 2004 against the University of North Dakota. 2004 Record: 4-2; 2005 Record: 5-1; 2006 Record: 3-3.

Final Year of the NCC

The 2007-08 school year will mark the final year of league competition in the North Central Conference for the St. Cloud State University athletics program. St. Cloud State University, Minnesota State University Mankato, Augustana College and the University of Minnesota Duluth will join the Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference in the fall of 2008. The University of Nebraska-Omaha will join the Mid-America Intercollegiate Athletics Association, while the University of South Dakota and the University of North Dakota have elected to seek NCAA Division I status. The St. Cloud State men's program joined the North Central Conference in 1981. The Huskies made their presence known in the league winning 13 tennis championships (1986, 90, 91, 93, 94, 97, 98, 99, 2002, 03, 04, 05, 06) four swimming and diving championships (1982,83, 84, 85), four basketball championships (1986,87,88, 2001), three golf championships, two football (1989 and 2002), and one title each in cross-country (1983), and baseball (1991). The SCSU women's program joined the NCC in 1984, and won five conference tennis titles (1985, 87, 88, 90, 91), three softball titles (1998, 2003, 2004), and one basketball championship (1989).

UMD Notes: - Last season UMD finished 6-4 overall and 4-4 in the NCC for a fourth place finish...the Huskies and Bulldogs matched up in last season's finale as well with UMD scoring the winning touchdown with 1:19 left to play...SCSU led 7-3 after one quarter, but saw themselves down 23-7 heading into the fourth...the Huskies scored 17 straight points to take the lead 24-23 with under seven minutes to play but UMD engineered a 12 play, 75 yard drive over the next 5:04 and scored the winning touchdown on a one yard run...last week Minnesota Duluth had the week off following their home loss to North Dakota on October 27...in the UND game the visitors went up 10-0 in the first quarter and led 17-7 at the half as they cruised to the 31-14 victory...UMD was held to just 186 yards of total offense for the game, by far their lowest output of the season...a pair of UMD defenders have been honored as NCC defensive players of the week this season...junior free safety Tyler Yelk collected the honor on September 17 after a 14 tackle performance against South Dakota that included eight solo stops and an interception...senior linebacker Jon Ruffeldt won the same award two weeks earlier on September 4 after he recorded 10 tackles including two sacks in a season opening win over Bemidji State...junior quarterback Ted Schlafke leads a powerful offense that ranks 20th in the nation in passing yards at 270.1 yards/game...individually Schlafke sits at ninth in NCAA DII in total offense at 300.8 yards a game and his favorite target through the air is senior Brandon Anson who is 15th in the country with 6.5 receptions a game. The Bulldogs are led by **fourth year head coach Kyle "Bubba" Schweigert**...in his second season in Duluth in 2005 Schweigert led the Bulldogs to an 8-4 overall record that included a share of the NCC title and a berth in the NCAA playoffs...following the success of the 2005 season Schweigert was named regional coach of the year by d2football.com and the AFCA...the Jamestown College graduate has guided Minnesota Duluth to a 21-21 record through the current season.
