The Game: The St. Cloud State University Husky football team will open its final season of play in the North Central Conference on Saturday, Sept. 22 at the University of South Dakota in Vermillion. The kick-off is scheduled for 2:00 p.m. at the DakotaDome (10,000).

The 2007 Records: St. Cloud State is 3-0 overall following non-conference wins over Northern State (17-7), the University of Mary (16-13), and Wisconsin-Whitewater (26-16). The University of South Dakota is 2-1 overall and opened NCC play with a 36-22 win at the University of Minnesota Duluth last Saturday.

The Series: St. Cloud State leads the all-time series against the Coyotes 15-10. SCSU is 4-4 against USD in the Randy Hedberg era, including 1-1 at Vermillion. The Huskies have played USD in three NCC openers over the last eight years and are 2-1 in those games.

SCSU Head Coach: SCSU head coach Randy Hedberg (Minot State 1977) is in his ninth season with the Huskies in 2007. He has a current won/loss record of 46-44 at SCSU and is 91-67-2 overall in 16 plus years as a collegiate coach. He netted his 75th career coaching win against UND on October 2, 2004 and his 30th with the Huskies. The Huskies won the NCC title in 2002, which marks the second time in team history that SCSU has won the NCC title. In 2004 SCSU posted an 8-3 record, and hosted the University of North Dakota in the first round of the NCAA Division II playoffs. The Parshall, N.D. native has been the head coach at Minot State (1982-89), assistant coach at Central Missouri State (1990-95), and an assistant coach at North Dakota (1996-98). Hedberg was an honorable mention All-America quarterback at Minot State. He was drafted by Tampa Bay of the NFL in 1977, and played with the Bucs through 1978. He also played with the Oakland Raiders (1979) and Green Bay Packers (1980).



2007 Team Captains: Seniors Philip Hedlof (Blomkest) and Derek Sedin (Santa Maria, CA), along with juniors Ryan Kees (Eagan) and Matt Plautz (Appleton, WI) will captain the 2007 Husky football team.

SCSU All-Time Record: The 2007 season marks the 85th in the history of SCSU football. Since 1920, SCSU has compiled a 384-328-22 overall record and has won a total of 18 conference titles, two in the North Central Conference (1989, 2002), 14 Northern Intercollegiate Conference crowns and two Minnesota State College Conference titles.

Husky Hits.....

Husky Recap: The Huskies improved to 3-0 on the season with a 26-16 win over the highly regarded and nationally ranked University of Wisconsin-Whitewater team...SCSU forced four UWW turnovers and blocked a field goal attempt in the win...senior QB Mike Hammerseng (Minnetonka) completed 23 of 36 passes for 240 yards and two touchdowns...on the receiving end of those TD passes was senior WR Derek Sedin (Santa Maria, CA) who caught a game high 13 passes...senior LB Aaron LaPointe (Elk River) had a solid all-around performance with five tackles, an interception and a fumble recovery.

3-0 Start: The Huskies are off to a 3-0 start for the fourth time since the 2002 season, when SCSU was crowned co-champion in the NCC...in the three most recent 3-0 starts, SCSU went to 5-0 and won the NCC title in 2002, went to 7-0 and advanced to the NCAA playoffs in 2004, and went to 5-0 and 8-3 overall in 2005.

NCC Openers: St. Cloud State is 5-3 in NCC openers under current head coach Randy Hedberg and...the Huskies are 15-9 all-time in NCC opening games dating back to the 1983 season.

A Career Night: Senior WR Derek Sedin (Santa Maria, CA) caught a school record tying 13 passes in the win over UWW... his 13 catches for 158 yards and two TDs were all single game career highs for Sedin...he is the first Husky to gain over 150 yards receiving since Ben Nelson went 150 during the 2002 season...Mike McKinney and Brent Otto also had single game performances of 13 catches in their careers...both of Sedin's TD catches came in the third quarter and put the Huskies ahead 26-3...Sedin leads the Huskies this week with 21 catches for 288 yards and three touchdowns.

Husky Picks: The SCSU defense has recorded an interception in each of the three games this season...senior LB Aaron LaPoint kept the streak alive with his pick against UW-Whitewater...junior DB Matt Jensen (Mequon, WI) had two pick-offs against Mary, and junior LB Matt McLagan (Minneapolis) had an interception in the season opener...Jensen is the NCC co-leader in INTs this week.

Sack Attack: The Husky defense is at 35 and counting for consecutive games with a quarterback sack...SCSU recorded two QB sacks against Wisconsin-Whitewater, extending SCSU's consecutive games with a quarterback sack to 35, dating back to Sept. 2, 2004... Ryan Kees, Aaron LaPointe, and Cale Pulczinski, all had a hand in last week's QB sacks...the SCSU defense found the opposing quarterback 36 times in 2006...the SCSU record for most sacks in a season is 40, established in 1991, and in 2005, the Huskies recorded 39 QB sacks...the Huskies have notched 11 QB sacks in the first three games of the 2007 season...Pulczinski leads the NCC in QB sacks this week.

Cristan Picks Up Second Honor: Last last week, junior P/PK Brian Cristan (Mahtomedi) was named the Don Hansen Football Gazette Special Teams Player of the Week...Cristan, the NCC Special Teams Player of the Week, called into placekicking duties, hit three of three field goals, including a game winner with under one minute to play.

Hedlof on Tackles: Senior DB Philip Hedlof (Blomkest) led all players with 11 tackles in the UWW game...that is one tackle short of his career high 12 registered against UNO in 2005...he also had a game high three pass break-ups.

Husky Stadium



2007 will mark the fourth season of Husky Stadium. St. Cloud State is 12-6 at Husky Stadium since the 2004 season. The Huskies posted a 4-2 record at Husky Stadium in 2004, including a 0-1 mark in an NCAA playoff game in the new facility. In 2005, SCSU went 5-1 at Husky Stadium, followed by a 3-3 home mark in 2006. The Huskies averaged 3,772 fans in the 4,198 seat facility in 2004, 3,961 in 2005, and 3,936 in 2006. SCSU's first sell-out was on October 2, 2004 against the University of North Dakota. 2004 Record: 4-2; 2005 Record: 5-1; 2006 Record: 3-3.

SCSU in the NCAA Stats: The Huskies have four players ranked in the top ten in NCAA DII statistics this week...punter/placekicker Brian Cristan is fourth in field goals per game with 1.7...Cale Pulczynski ranks seventh in forced fumbles and eighth in pass sacks...Philip Hedlof ranks ninth in passes defended.

Final Year of the NCC

The 2007-08 school year will mark the final year of league competition in the North Central Conference for the St. Cloud State University athletics program. St. Cloud State University, Minnesota State University Mankato, Augustana College and the University of Minnesota Duluth will join the Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference in the fall of 2008. The University of Nebraska-Omaha will join the Mid-America Intercollegiate Athletics Association, while the University of South Dakota and the University of North Dakota have elected to seek NCAA Division I status. The St. Cloud State men's program joined the North Central Conference in 1981. The Huskies made their presence known in the league winning 13 tennis championships (1986, 90, 91, 93, 94, 97, 98, 99, 2002, 03, 04, 05, 06) four swimming and diving championships (1982,83, 84, 85), four basketball championships (1986,87,88, 2001), three golf championships, two football (1989 and 2002), and one title each in cross-country (1983), and baseball (1991). The SCSU women's program joined the NCC in 1984, and won five conference tennis titles (1985, 87, 88, 90, 91), three softball titles (1998, 2003, 2004), and one basketball championship (1989).

Coyote Notes: South Dakota head coach Ed Meierkort is in his fourth season with the Coyotes...he has compiled a 27-3 record in three seasons at USD and is 82-63 in 14 seasons as a collegiate head coach...the Coyotes posted a 9-4 overall record last season and finished third in the NCC with a 6-2 record...USD advanced to the NCAA Division II playoffs and won its first round game against Northwood 31-28 in overtime and fell to Grand Valley State 35-17 in the second round...like the Huskies, this is the last season of NCC action for USD...however, the USD athletics program will move into NCAA Division I...the Coyotes return 17 starters from a year ago...sophomore quarterback Noah Shepard leads the Coyotes offense in 2007...he has completed 69 of 114 passes for 1,009 yards and 11 touchdowns this season...his main targets have been Brooks Little with 22 catches for 255 yards and three touchdowns and Dan Skelly with 15 catches for 348 yards and four touchdowns...on the ground, the Coyotes rush is led by Amos Allen with 58 carries for 525 yards and five touchdowns...the Coyote offense is averaging 589 yards per game and 43.3 points...the 589 yards in total offense leads NCAA DII...QB Noah Shepard also leads NCAA DII in total offense with 384.7 yards per game...Blake Hojer is the defensive leader with a team high 24 tackles.
