The Game: The St. Cloud State University Husky football team hits the road for a North Central Conference game at Western Washington University on Saturday, Oct. 6. The kick-off is scheduled for 3:00 p.m. (CT) at Bellingham Civic Stadium (4,400) in Bellingham, Washington.

The 2007 Records: St. Cloud State is 3-2 overall and 0-2 in the NCC following a 29-0 conference loss to Central Washington last Saturday. Western Washington is 1-3 overall and 0-3 in the NCC following a 22-14 loss at Minnesota Duluth last week.

The Series: St. Cloud State leads the series 3-1. Two of the Huskies' three wins have been in Bellingham. Last year, Western Washington defeated the Huskies 24-17 in St. Cloud.

SCSU Head Coach: SCSU head coach Randy Hedberg (Minot State 1977) is in his ninth season with the Huskies in 2007. He has a current won/loss record of 46-46 at SCSU and is 91-69-2 overall in 16 plus years as a collegiate coach. He netted his 75th career coaching win against UND on October 2, 2004 and his 30th with the Huskies. The Huskies won the NCC title in 2002, which marks the second time in team history that SCSU has won the NCC title. In 2004 SCSU posted an 8-3 record, and hosted the University of North Dakota in the first round of the NCAA Division II playoffs. The Parshall, N.D. native has been the head coach at Minot State (1982-89), assistant coach at Central Missouri State (1990-95), and an assistant coach at North Dakota (1996-98). Hedberg was an honorable mention All-America quarterback at Minot State. He was drafted by Tampa Bay of the NFL in 1977, and played with the Bucs through 1978. He also played with the Oakland Raiders (1979) and Green Bay Packers (1980).



2007 Team Captains: Seniors Philip Hedlof (Blomkest) and Derek Sedin (Santa Maria, CA), along with juniors Ryan Kees (Eagan) and Matt Plautz (Appleton, WI) will captain the 2007 Husky football team.

SCSU All-Time Record: The 2007 season marks the 85th in the history of SCSU football. Since 1920, SCSU has compiled a 384-328-22 overall record and has won a total of 18 conference titles, two in the North Central Conference (1989, 2002), 14 Northern Intercollegiate Conference crowns and two Minnesota State College Conference titles.

Husky Hits/Player Notes.....

Husky Recap: The Huskies dropped to 3-2 overall and 0-2 in the NCC following last Saturday's 29-0 loss to Central Washington. The Wildcats scored on the opening drive of the game, a five-yard run by Johnny Lopez and tacked on two scoring drives in the second quarter, one in the third, and two more in the fourth. SCSU accumulated 301 yards in total offense while CWU tallied 439 yards.

Career Highs for Williams: Redshirt first-year wide receiver Fred Williams (Milwaukee, WI) caught seven passes for 113 yards with a long of 39, all career highs, last Saturday. Williams has 16 catches this season for 210 yards, which ranks third on the team.

Machacek Carries: Redshirt first-year running back Jake Machacek (Eagan) had a season and career high 13 carries against the Wildcats and finished the game with 37 yards rushing. He is averaging 4.0 yards per carry this season and 35.8 per game.

Kranz Gets Start: Redshirt first year quarterback Jake Kranz (Hasting) made his first collegiate start on Saturday. He displayed a strong arm, connecting on 15 of 34 pass attempts for 195 yards with a long of 39. He was also the top rusher for the Huskies, gaining 40 yards. A hit late in the fourth quarter knocked him out of the game and he could be out of the line-up indefinitely.

Kieffer Makes the Stops: Redshirt first-year free safety Bryce Kieffer (Dennison) notched a game and career high 11 tackles against CWU. He leads the team in total tackles with 33, including 19 solo hits.

LaPointe Marks Season High: Senior linebacker Aaron LaPointe (Elk River) had a season high eight tackles on Saturday and has 23 on the season. He has also notched a TFL, QB sack, an interception and a fumble recovery.

Kees is Consistent: Junior defensive end Ryan Kees (Eagan) has recorded at least one tackle for a loss in every game this season. Kees has tallied 28 tackles, including a team high eight tackles for loss.

Sack Streak Ends: The SCSU consecutive games streak with a quarterback sack has ended at 36 straight games. SCSU did not record a QB sack against Central Washington. The streak dates back to Sept. 2, 2004... the SCSU defense found the opposing quarterback 36 times in 2006...the SCSU record for most sacks in a season is 40, established in 1991, and in 2005, the Huskies recorded 39 QB sacks. The Huskies have notched 14 QB sacks in 2007.

Husky Stadium



2007 marks the fourth season of Husky Stadium. St. Cloud State is 12-6 at Husky Stadium since the 2004 season. The Huskies posted a 4-2 record at Husky Stadium in 2004, including a 0-1 mark in an NCAA playoff game in the new facility. In 2005, SCSU went 5-1 at Husky Stadium, followed by a 3-3 home mark in 2006. The Huskies averaged 3,772 fans in the 4,198 seat facility in 2004, 3,961 in 2005, and 3,936 in 2006. SCSU's first sell-out was on October 2, 2004 against the University of North Dakota. 2004 Record: 4-2; 2005 Record: 5-1; 2006 Record: 3-3.

Final Year of the NCC

The 2007-08 school year will mark the final year of league competition in the North Central Conference for the St. Cloud State University athletics program. St. Cloud State University, Minnesota State University Mankato, Augustana College and the University of Minnesota Duluth will join the Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference in the fall of 2008. The University of Nebraska-Omaha will join the Mid-America Intercollegiate Athletics Association, while the University of South Dakota and the University of North Dakota have elected to seek NCAA Division I status. The St. Cloud State men's program joined the North Central Conference in 1981. The Huskies made their presence known in the league winning 13 tennis championships (1986, 90, 91, 93, 94, 97, 98, 99, 2002, 03, 04, 05, 06) four swimming and diving championships (1982,83, 84, 85), four basketball championships (1986,87,88, 2001), three golf championships, two football (1989 and 2002), and one title each in cross-country (1983), and baseball (1991). The SCSU women's program joined the NCC in 1984, and won five conference tennis titles (1985, 87, 88, 90, 91), three softball titles (1998, 2003, 2004), and one basketball championship (1989).

Vikings Notes: Western Washington head coach Robin Ross is in his second season at the helm of the Vikings. Ross led his new team to a 5-6 record last season and tied for fifth place in their first season in the NCC. The Vikings return an experienced defense in 2007 as nine starters return and ten of the 15 seniors on this year's squad are defensive players. WWU is coming off a 22-14 loss at Minnesota Duluth last Saturday and after a season opening victory over UC-Davis, have lost three straight games. Senior outside linebacker Shane Simmons leads the NCC in total tackles and was named the league's co-defensive player of the week on Monday. Simmons notched 18 tackles, 10 solo and eight assisted, along with one quarterback sack in the Vikings 22-14 loss to Minnesota Duluth. He has recorded 51 total tackles in 2007. The Vikings are averaging 363.0 yards per game in total offense but are allowing 511.0 yards of offense this season. WWU averages 130.2 yards on the ground and 232.8 yards in the air. Running back Craig Garner has 420 yards rushing this season and five touchdowns. Quarterback Adam Perry has completed 75 of 133 pass attempts for 926 yards and five touchdowns. The Vikings top receiver is Travis McKee who has 18 catches for 178 yards and two touchdowns. Rick Copsey and Casey Dell each have 15 catches this season.
