HOMECOMING Game: The St. Cloud State University Husky football team will host Augustana College in the 79th Annual Homecoming game Saturday, October 13. The kick-off at Husky Stadium (4,198) is set for 1:00 p.m.

The 2007 Records: St. Cloud State is 3-3 overall and 0-3 in the NCC following an 18-15 conference loss at Western Washington last Saturday. Augustana College is 2-5 overall and 0-4 in the NCC and lost to Minnesota Duluth 35-7 last week.

The Series: St. Cloud State leads the all-time series 20-10. Randy Hedberg is 6-2 against Augustana College. Last year, the Vikings defeated the Huskies 27-23 with a game winning touchdown in the final minute of play.

HOMECOMING HISTORY: The Huskies are 53-24 in Homecoming games. Last year, the Huskies defeated Minnesota State University, Mankato 16-3 in front of over 4,000 fans. This will be the third time that SCSU has hosted Augustana at Homecoming. The Huskies are 1-1 against AC in Homecoming games played in St. Cloud, with the last matchup a 43-28 SCSU win in 1997. The other Homecoming game, played in 1983, resulted in a 28-6 Viking win.

SCSU Head Coach: SCSU head coach Randy Hedberg (Minot State 1977) is in his ninth season with the Huskies in 2007. He has a current won/loss record of 46-47 at SCSU and is 91-70-2 overall in 16 plus years as a collegiate coach. He netted his 75th career coaching win against UND on October 2, 2004 and his 30th with the Huskies. The Huskies won the NCC title in 2002, which marks the second time in team history that SCSU has won the NCC title. In 2004 SCSU posted an 8-3 record, and hosted the University of North Dakota in the first round of the NCAA Division II playoffs. The Parshall, N.D. native has been the head coach at Minot State (1982-89), assistant coach at Central Missouri State (1990-95), and an assistant coach at North Dakota (1996-98). Hedberg was an honorable mention All-America quarterback at Minot State. He was drafted by Tampa Bay of the NFL in 1977, and played with the Bucs through 1978. He also played with the Oakland Raiders (1979) and Green Bay Packers (1980).



2007 Team Captains: Seniors Philip Hedlof (Blomkest) and Derek Sedin (Santa Maria, CA), along with juniors Ryan Kees (Eagan) and Matt Plautz (Appleton, WI) will captain the 2007 Husky football team.

SCSU All-Time Record: The 2007 season marks the 85th in the history of SCSU football. Since 1920, SCSU has compiled a 384-328-22 overall record and has won a total of 18 conference titles, two in the North Central Conference (1989, 2002), 14 Northern Intercollegiate Conference crowns and two Minnesota State College Conference titles.

Husky Hits/Player Notes.....

Husky Recap: The Huskies dropped their third straight NCC game at Western Washington last Saturday, losing 18-15 when the Vikings Josh Lider kicked a 35-yard field goal with 21 seconds left in the game. The Huskies led 13-0 after the first quarter and 15-9 at the half.

End of a Scoring Drought: The Huskies scored on their opening drive of the first quarter, marking the first time since the third quarter of SCSU's game against UW-Whitewater (Sept. 15) that SCSU had scored. The Huskies had gone nine quarters without scoring and broke the drought with 13 first quarter points against Western Washington.

Seven Sacks Recorded: The SCSU defense recorded seven sacks in the loss to Western Washington. Darius Dotch, Chris Streit, Treg Swanson, Ryan Kees, Chuck Merrit, Justin Vasquez, and Derek Pawlitzke all had a hand in a sack. The seven sacks was just two shy of the school record nine sacks recorded at Western Washington during the 2005 season. Junior DE Cale Pulczynski and Ryan Kees, and redshirt first year DT Chuck Merritt lead the Huskies in sacks. Pulczynskis has 3.5 while Kees and Merritt have three each this season. SCSU has 21 sacks this season. The school record of 40 sacks in a season was established during the 1991 season.

Graham Rushes for a Career High: Junior RB Michael Graham (Oakdale) in his first start of the season, rushed for a career high 172 yards. Graham had 30 carries, also a career high, and scored the Huskies second touchdown of the game. Last season, Graham rushed for a high of 155 yards against the University of Mary. Graham is averaging 5.1 yards per carry and 31.5 yards per game.

Kees Gets the QB: Junior DE Ryan Kees (Eagan) recorded a career high two quarterback sacks against WWU. The sacks were the tenth and 11th of his career as a Husky. He currently leads the team in tackles for loss with ten and is second in QB sacks with three.

Rysewyk Gets First TD: Junior WR Cody Rysewyk (Green Bay, WI) caught his first touchdown pass of the season and second of his collegiate career last Saturday. Rysewyk and junior QB Jon Quesnel (Eagan) connected on a nine-yard pass play in the first quarter to put the Huskies ahead 6-0.

On the Season: The Huskies are averaging 300.7 yards in total offense this season and allowing 343.5 yards. Of that total offense, 197 yards has been in the air.

Husky Stadium



2007 marks the fourth season of Husky Stadium. St. Cloud State is 12-6 at Husky Stadium since the 2004 season. The Huskies posted a 4-2 record at Husky Stadium in 2004, including a 0-1 mark in an NCAA playoff game in the new facility. In 2005, SCSU went 5-1 at Husky Stadium, followed by a 3-3 home mark in 2006. The Huskies averaged 3,772 fans in the 4,198 seat facility in 2004, 3,961 in 2005, and 3,936 in 2006. SCSU's first sell-out was on October 2, 2004 against the University of North Dakota. 2004 Record: 4-2; 2005 Record: 5-1; 2006 Record: 3-3.

Final Year of the NCC

The 2007-08 school year will mark the final year of league competition in the North Central Conference for the St. Cloud State University athletics program. St. Cloud State University, Minnesota State University Mankato, Augustana College and the University of Minnesota Duluth will join the Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference in the fall of 2008. The University of Nebraska-Omaha will join the Mid-America Intercollegiate Athletics Association, while the University of South Dakota and the University of North Dakota have elected to seek NCAA Division I status. The St. Cloud State men's program joined the North Central Conference in 1981. The Huskies made their presence known in the league winning 13 tennis championships (1986, 90, 91, 93, 94, 97, 98, 99, 2002, 03, 04, 05, 06) four swimming and diving championships (1982,83, 84, 85), four basketball championships (1986,87,88, 2001), three golf championships, two football (1989 and 2002), and one title each in cross-country (1983), and baseball (1991). The SCSU women's program joined the NCC in 1984, and won five conference tennis titles (1985, 87, 88, 90, 91), three softball titles (1998, 2003, 2004), and one basketball championship (1989).

Vikings Notes: - Head Coach Brad Salem was named the program's 20th head coach prior to the 2005 season after serving one season as Offensive Coordinator. An Augustana Alum and former Viking quarterback and wide receiver, he coached the Vikings to an 11-11 record in his first two seasons. ...Augustana is playing in its third straight homecoming game this week and carries an 0-2 record in those games, dropping a 37-0 decision to North Dakota in Grand Forks, N.D. on September 29th, and a 34-7 decision last week at home to Minnesota Duluth....Viking defense has gone back-to-back weeks without forcing a turnover after creating 14 in the first five weeks...senior WR Tommy Ellingworth is the leading pass catcher in the NCC thus far this season and seventh nationally at 7.14 rec/game...he tallied an NCC season high with 190 yards receiving versus Minnesota State on 9/15/2007, a game which Augustana lost 26-16...in that same game he caught 13 passes which ties him for the NCC season high with the Huskies Derek Sedin who caught 13 passes against Wisconsin-Whitewater on the same day... Augie has the best pass defense in the NCC at 194.9 yards/game...last Saturday, the Vikings lost 34-7 at home to Minnesota Duluth...UMD scored first to go ahead 7-0 but Augie would tie it at 7-7 in the second quarter...from there it was all Bulldogs, scoring 27 unanswered points in the victory... the Vikings were out-gained 356-197 and UMD was a perfect 4-4 in the red zone...Tommy Ellingworth hauled in seven passes for 46 yards to add to his league leading total...Brandon McMichael finished with 12 total tackles
