The Game: The St. Cloud State University Husky football team will travel to Mankato, Minn. for a North Central Conference tilt against Minnesota State University, Mankato on Saturday, Oct. 27 at 1:00 p.m. at Blakeslee Stadium (7,000) on the MSU campus.

The 2007 Records: St. Cloud State is 3-4 overall and 0-4 in the NCC following a 44-18 Homecoming loss to Augustana College last Saturday. Minnesota State enters the game with a 4-3 overall record and 2-2 NCC mark following a 35-14 win at Minnesota Duluth.

The Series: St. Cloud State leads the all-time series 37-30-4. The Huskies have won four straight over the Mavericks including a 16-3 SCSU Homecoming win last season. SCSU head coach Randy Hedberg is 5-3 against the Mavericks and 2-1 in games played in Mankato.

SCSU Head Coach: SCSU head coach Randy Hedberg (Minot State 1977) is in his ninth season with the Huskies in 2007. He has a current won/loss record of 46-48 at SCSU and is 91-71-2 overall in 16 plus years as a collegiate coach. He netted his 75th career coaching win against UND on October 2, 2004 and his 30th with the Huskies. The Huskies won the NCC title in 2002, which marks the second time in team history that SCSU has won the NCC title. In 2004 SCSU posted an 8-3 record, and hosted the University of North Dakota in the first round of the NCAA Division II playoffs. The Parshall, N.D. native has been the head coach at Minot State (1982-89), assistant coach at Central Missouri State (1990-95), and an assistant coach at North Dakota (1996-98). Hedberg was an honorable mention All-America quarterback at Minot State. He was drafted by Tampa Bay of the NFL in 1977, and played with the Bucs through 1978. He also played with the Oakland Raiders (1979) and Green Bay Packers (1980).



2007 Team Captains: Seniors Philip Hedlof (Blomkest) and Derek Sedin (Santa Maria, CA), along with juniors Ryan Kees (Eagan) and Matt Plautz (Appleton, WI) will captain the 2007 Husky football team.

SCSU All-Time Record: The 2007 season marks the 85th in the history of SCSU football. Since 1920, SCSU has compiled a 384-328-22 overall record and has won a total of 18 conference titles, two in the North Central Conference (1989, 2002), 14 Northern Intercollegiate Conference crowns and two Minnesota State College Conference titles.

Husky Hits/Player Notes.....

Husky Recap: The Huskies dropped their fourth straight NCC game against Augustana College last Saturday, 44-18. SCSU committed seven turnovers in the game, but held the Vikings to 284 yards of total offense.

Williams Sets Personal Marks: Redshirt first-year WR Fred Williams (Milwaukee, WI) caught five passes for a season and career high 142 yards and two touchdowns Saturday against Augustana...he scored on 70 and 35-yard pass plays, with the 70-yard effort the longest scoring play of the season for the Huskies.

Dotch Nets Career High in Tackles: Junior DB Darius Dotch (St. Paul) tallied a season and career high ten tackles against Augustana...he recorded seven solo tackles, three assisted and his third quarterback sack of the year.

McLagan Nets Individual Career High: Junior linebacker Matt McLagan (Minneapolis) netted a career high nine tackles against Augie...he notched four solo, and five assisted, including half a quarterback sack in the game.

Defense Gets Picks: The SCSU defense intercepted four Augie passes...junior DE Ryan Kees (Eagan), senior DB Philip Hedlof (Blomkest), junior DB's Bryce Kieffer (Dennison), and Matt Jensen (Mequon, WI), all had picks...Kees returned his first collegiate pick 33 yards...Hedlof recorded his first pick of the season and fifth of his career...Kieffer notched his first collegiate pick...Jensen has a team high three INT's this season and seven in his career.

Four QB Sacks: The Husky defense recorded four QB sacks in the game and have a total of 25 on the season...junior DE Cale Pulczynski (Mukwonago, WI) led the team with 1.5 in the game and is the season leader with five QB sacks...and he leads the Huskies with 5.0 QB sacks this season...junior DB Darius Dotch (St. Paul) notched his second sack of the season...junior DL Justin Vasquez (Walnut, CA) has had sacks in back to back games, and senior LB Chris Streit (Sauk Rapids) has tallied two and one-half sacks this season.

Graham Gets the Ball: After rushing the ball just seven times over the first five games of the season, junior RB Michael Graham (Oakdale) has rushed 42 times for 242 yards and one touchdown in the last two games...he had 12 carries for 70 yards against Augie last Saturday, and two weeks ago rushed for a career high 172 yards on 30 carries against Western Washington...for the season, he has 49 carries for 259 yards and one touchdown.

Other Notes: The Huskies threw for a season high 298 yards against Augustana and ran a season high 75 offensive plays in the game...four times this season the Husky defense has held their opponent to under 300 yards of offense, including 284 against Augustana.

Husky Stadium



2007 marks the fourth season of Husky Stadium. St. Cloud State is 12-6 at Husky Stadium since the 2004 season. The Huskies posted a 4-2 record at Husky Stadium in 2004, including a 0-1 mark in an NCAA playoff game in the new facility. In 2005, SCSU went 5-1 at Husky Stadium, followed by a 3-3 home mark in 2006. The Huskies averaged 3,772 fans in the 4,198 seat facility in 2004, 3,961 in 2005, and 3,936 in 2006. SCSU's first sell-out was on October 2, 2004 against the University of North Dakota. 2004 Record: 4-2; 2005 Record: 5-1; 2006 Record: 3-3.

Final Year of the NCC

The 2007-08 school year will mark the final year of league competition in the North Central Conference for the St. Cloud State University athletics program. St. Cloud State University, Minnesota State University Mankato, Augustana College and the University of Minnesota Duluth will join the Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference in the fall of 2008. The University of Nebraska-Omaha will join the Mid-America Intercollegiate Athletics Association, while the University of South Dakota and the University of North Dakota have elected to seek NCAA Division I status. The St. Cloud State men's program joined the North Central Conference in 1981. The Huskies made their presence known in the league winning 13 tennis championships (1986, 90, 91, 93, 94, 97, 98, 99, 2002, 03, 04, 05, 06) four swimming and diving championships (1982,83, 84, 85), four basketball championships (1986,87,88, 2001), three golf championships, two football (1989 and 2002), and one title each in cross-country (1983), and baseball (1991). The SCSU women's program joined the NCC in 1984, and won five conference tennis titles (1985, 87, 88, 90, 91), three softball titles (1998, 2003, 2004), and one basketball championship (1989).

MSU Notes: - The Mavericks are led by third year head coach Jeff Jamrog...in his first two seasons he led MSU to an 8-14 record including a 6-5 record his first season in 2005 which followed a winless 0-11 2004 season...the six-game jump in victories was the fifth best all time in Division II...Jamrog is a 1987 graduate of the University of Nebraska where he was a starting outside linebacker... after trailing 14-7 to Minnesota Duluth last Saturday, Minnesota State scored 28 unanswered points, including 21 in the second half, to earn the 35-14 win...in the game Maverick quarterback Ben King passed for 341 yards, which gave him 9,455 career passing yards breaking the school record of 9,433...King is also the school record holder for career pass attempts (1,409) and pass completions...another school record in the win came from defensive end Grant Smith as he recorded 4.5 sacks for a loss of 35 yards besting the old record of three sacks in a single game...along with his performance the Maverick defense as a unit sacked the UMD quarterback seven times, which tied a school record...Smith earned NCC Defensive Player of the Week honors for his effort at UMD...last season the Huskies and Mavericks combined for eight turnovers and just six third down conversions in the game...MSU struck first with a field goal near the end of the first quarter to go up 3-0...that would be all for Minnesota State as the Husky defense kept them off the board and limited their offense to just 233 total yards...meanwhile the Husky offense was able to put 16 points of its own on the board to earn the 16-3 victory and retain the traveling training kit.
