**The Game:** The St. Cloud State University Husky football team will host the University of Nebraska-Omaha in the Hall of Fame Game on Saturday, Oct. 27. The kick-off is set for 1:00 p.m. at Husky Stadium (4,197) on the SCSU campus.

**The 2007 Records:** St. Cloud State is 4-4 overall and 1-4 in the NCC following a 27-13 win at Minnesota State University Mankato last Saturday. The 4th-ranked (Oct. 16 poll) University of Nebraska-Omaha Mavericks enter the weekend with a 7-0 record and a 5-0 NCC mark. The Mavericks are ranked first in the Northwest Regional poll.

**The Series:** The University of Nebraska-Omaha has won four straight games over the Huskies and lead the all-time series 16-11. The Mavericks have won eight of the last nine meetings with the lone Husky win a 47-19 victory in St. Cloud during the 2002 season.

**Hall of Fame:** Eight people will be inducted into the St. Cloud State Athletic Hall of Fame in a ceremony on Saturday morning and will be introduced at the football game. The eight inductees include Pamela Raetz Benoit (swimming), the late Jack Conley (basketball/baseball), Judi McDonald Larkin (tennis), Grant Nelson (wrestling), Karen Scott (tennis), Jim Stanek (head baseball coach/assistant football coach), and Bob Wolff (basketball). Former hockey player Jeff Passolt will receive the Distinguished Service Award.

**SCSU Head Coach:** SCSU head coach Randy Hedberg (Minot State 1977) is



in his ninth season with the Huskies in 2007. He has a current won/loss record of 47-48 at SCSU and is 92-71-2 overall in 16 plus years as a collegiate coach. He netted his 75th career coaching win against UND on October 2, 2004 and his 30th with the Huskies. The Huskies won the NCC title in 2002, which marks the second time in team history that SCSU has won the NCC title. In 2004 SCSU posted an 8-3 record, and hosted the University of North Dakota in the first round of the NCAA Division II playoffs. The Parshall, N.D.

native has been the head coach at Minot State (1982-89), assistant coach at Central Missouri State (1990-95), and an assistant coach at North Dakota (1996-98). Hedberg was an honorable mention All-America quarterback at Minot State. He was drafted by Tampa Bay of the NFL in 1977, and played with the Bucs through 1978. He also played with the Oakland Raiders (1979) and Green Bay Packers (1980).

**2007 Team Captains:** Seniors Philip Hedlof (Blomkest) and Derek Sedin (Santa Maria, CA), along with juniors Ryan Kees (Eagan) and Matt Plautz (Appleton, WI) will captain the 2007 Husky football team.

**Husky Hits/Player Notes.....**

**Husky Recap:** The Huskies ended a four-game losing streak with a solid 27-13 win at Minnesota State University Mankato. SCSU was turnover free in the game and forced three Maverick turnovers. Junior QB Jon Quesnel (Eagan) threw three touchdown passes in the game and sophomore linebacker David Kamin (Menomonee Falls, WI) had a career high nine tackles and a fumble recovery. Redshirt first-year WR Fred Williams (Milwaukee, WI) caught five passes for 50 yards and two touchdowns.

**Kamin is Player of the Week:** Sophomore linebacker David Kamin (Menomonee Falls, WI) had a career day, notching nine tackles and a fumble recovery. He was instrumental in forcing three quarterback sacks and was always around the ball on special teams. His performance netted him North Central Conference Player of the Week honors. He is the first Husky this season to gain the honor. Kamin has 22 tackles and two fumble recoveries this season.

**Horn is Special:** Sophomore wider receiver/special teams player Rocky Horn (Melrose) had a career highlight day. He made four returns on punts and kick-offs and ran off a 65-yard kick-off return, the longest return of the season for a Husky. Horn also caught his first collegiate touchdown pass, an eight-yard strike that put the Huskies up 17-0 in the second quarter.

**Quesnel Throws Three Strikes:** Quesnel threw three touchdown passes on Saturday, which equals his career high. He finished the day 12 of 21 passing for 109 yards and three touchdowns. He has thrown for 673 yards and seven touchdowns this season, and has completed 59 of 118 pass attempts.

**Husky Sacks:** SCSU upped its season total for quarterback sacks to 28 on Saturday. Juniors Ryan Kees (Eagan), Cale Pulczinski (Mukwonago, WI) and Derek Pawlitzke (Two Rivers, WI) all had QB sacks for the Huskies. Pulczinski leads the Huskies with six sacks this season and has 10.5 tackles for loss. Kees leads the team in tackles for loss with 11 and is second in QB sacks with four. Pawlitzke has 1.5 tackles for loss and sacks this season.

**Turnover Free:** The Huskies were turnover free in the game. That comes on the heels of committing 16 turnovers combined in the three previous games. It marked the second game this season that the Huskies did not commit a turnover. The previous game without a turnover was against UW-Whitewater.

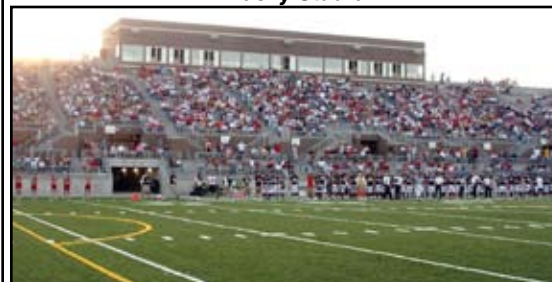
**In the NCC:** The Husky defense ranks second in the NCC in total defense giving up 371.4 yards per game. The Huskies also rank third in rushing defense allowing 132.6 yards on the ground.

**Husky Stadium**



2007 marks the fourth season of Husky Stadium. St. Cloud State is 12-6 at Husky Stadium since the 2004 season. The Huskies posted a 4-2 record at Husky Stadium in 2004, including a 0-1 mark in an NCAA playoff game in the new facility. In 2005, SCSU went 5-1 at Husky Stadium, followed by a 3-3 home mark in 2006. The Huskies averaged 3,772 fans in the 4,198 seat facility in 2004, 3,961 in 2005, and 3,936 in 2006. SCSU's first sell-out was on October 2, 2004 against the University of North Dakota. 2004 Record: 4-2; 2005 Record: 5-1; 2006 Record: 3-3.

### Final Year of the NCC

The 2007-08 school year will mark the final year of league competition in the North Central Conference for the St. Cloud State University athletics program. St. Cloud State University, Minnesota State University Mankato, Augustana College and the University of Minnesota Duluth will join the Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference in the fall of 2008. The University of Nebraska-Omaha will join the Mid-America Intercollegiate Athletics Association, while the University of South Dakota and the University of North Dakota have elected to seek NCAA Division I status. The St. Cloud State men's program joined the North Central Conference in 1981. The Huskies made their presence known in the league winning 13 tennis championships (1986, 90, 91, 93, 94, 97, 98, 99, 2002, 03, 04, 05, 06) four swimming and diving championships (1982,83, 84, 85), four basketball championships (1986,87,88, 2001), three golf championships, two football (1989 and 2002), and one title each in cross-country (1983), and baseball (1991). The SCSU women's program joined the NCC in 1984, and won five conference tennis titles (1985, 87, 88, 90, 91), three softball titles (1998, 2003, 2004), and one basketball championship (1989).

**UNO Notes:** - Nebraska-Omaha is the #4 ranked team in the nation and the #1 ranked team in the Northwest Region...the Mavericks are led by 14th year head coach Pat Behrns...under Behrns the Mavericks have won 102 games and six NCC titles, including a least a share of the last three...with seven wins this season Behrns has already secured his 12th straight winning season as head coach at UNO...the Mavericks shared the NCC title last season with North Dakota as each had 7-1 league records...with their 8-2 overall record the Mavericks earned a first round bye in the national playoffs...they met UND in Omaha in the second round where North Dakota escaped with the win 38-35...twice this season UNO has knocked off the #2 ranked team in the nation at the time...the first was in the second week of the season on Sept. 8, in Omaha, where UNO quarterback Zach Miller scored the go-ahead touchdown on a one yard run with 3:17 left in the game to earn the 25-21 victory over then #2 Northwest Missouri State...the next was just two weeks ago on Oct. 13 in Grand Forks, N.D. when they beat then #2 North Dakota by the score of 28-17...UNO running back Brian McNeill scored on a 39 yard touchdown run with 1:34 left to seal the victory at 28-17...junior QB Zach Miller is the reigning NCC offensive player of the week...Miller rushed 17 times for 124 yards and one touchdown and completed 17 of 27 pass attempts for 218 yards and three touchdowns in last weeks 42-17 win against Minnesota Duluth...in that game UNO used 361 yards on the ground...Nate Wurth ran for 179 yards and three touchdowns in the win.
