#### Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference (NSIC)

**Debut Season:** The St. Cloud State University football team completed its inaugural season in the NSIC with a 7-4 overall record. The Huskies finished 7-3 overall in the NSIC, good for a fourth place tie. In addition, St. Cloud State placed second in the NSIC North Division with a 5-1 record.

**SCSU All-Time Record:** The 2008 season marked the 86th in the history of SCSU football. Since 1920, SCSU has compiled a 395-339-22 overall record and has won a total of 18 conference titles, two in the North Central Conference (1989, 2002), 14 Northern Intercollegiate Conference crowns and two Minnesota State College Conference titles.

**Final Saturday:** After a five-year hiatus, Minnesota State University, Mankato obtained the Traveling Training Kit with a 16-7 Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference (NSIC) football win over St. Cloud State University in the 2008 season finale. St. Cloud State first year running back Brandon Geiss (Shorewood, IL) rushed for 24 yards and the Huskies only touchdown of the day. Junior quarterback Mitch Watkins (Jerseyville, IL) rushed for a team high 26 yards and completed 11 of 22 passes for 126 yards. Sophomore wide receiver Fred Williams (Milwaukee, WI) caught a game high four passes for 55 yards. The Huskies were the victims of three turnovers, all interceptions including two in the Huskies final two possessions. Defensively, senior linebacker Matt McLagan (Minneapolis) notched a game high 12 tackles that included one quarterback sack and two tackles for loss. The Huskies finished the game with 180 yards of total offense.

## HUSKY COACHING STAFF

**SCSU Head Coach Scott Underwood:** Scott Underwood (Augustana College, 1988) completed his first season as head coach of the Huskies with a 7-4 overall record, a 7-4 mark in the NSIC and a 5-1 record in the NSIC North Division.

Underwood was introduced as the new Husky head coach on March 25, 2008, having served as the acting head coach of the Huskies since December. He had been the defensive coordinator/recruiting coordinator/defensive backs coach since 2001.

Underwood is the 12th head football coach in the history of the program and replaced Randy Hedberg, who coached the Huskies from 1999 to 2007..

The Husky defense, led by Underwood has ranked among the best in the North Central Conference for the last seven seasons. In 2002, SCSU led the NCC in rushing defense, giving up 77.1 yards per game. Ten defensive players have earned All-North Central Conference first team honors with Underwood, including Charlie Cosgrove, the 2005 Defensive Lineman of the Year. The Huskies were co-winners of the NCC title in 2002 and hosted a first round NCAA Division II playoff game in 2004, the year that Husky Stadium opener.

Success has followed Underwood at each of his coaching stops. Prior to joining the St. Cloud State staff in 2001, Underwood was the inside linebackers coach at the University of North Dakota for four seasons, and coached two NCAA playoff teams. From 1993 to 1996, he served as the defensive coordinator at the University of Sioux Falls. The University of Sioux Falls advanced to the playoffs during three of those seasons and won the NAIA Division II National Championship in 1996.

Underwood began his coaching career at his alma mater, Augustana College, where he spent five seasons as the defensive secondary coach, following a four-year career at defensive back for the Vikings from 1984 to 1988. In 1988, Underwood coached in an NCAA playoff game. In 1989, with Underwood as an assistant coach, the Vikings advanced to the NCAA playoffs, losing to St. Cloud State at Selke Field.

A native of Marion, Iowa, Underwood has a bachelor's degree in social sciences from Augustana College and a master's degree in health, physical education, and recreation from the University of South Dakota.

**100-Yards or More:** Freshman running back **Brandon Geiss (Shorewood, IL)** rushed for over 100 yards in three games during the 2008 season and senior running back **Michael Graham (Oakdale)** ran for over 100 yards in two games. The last time a Husky rushed for over 100 yards in multiple games was in 2005 when Matt Birkel, the Huskies all-time rushing leader, tallied 100 yards or better in nine games. Geiss rushed for a career high 131 yards against MSU Moorhead on Nov. 1. Geiss was the Huskies leading rusher in 2008 with 178 carries for 798 yards and ten touchdowns.

**Graham Goes Over 1,000 in Career:** **Michael Graham** finished his collegiate career with 1,469 rushing yards and ranks 14th on the SCSU career chart. He carried the ball 275 times and scored 13 touchdowns. He rushed for a career high 172 yards against Western Washington on Oct. 4, 2008. Graham rushed for over 100 yards four times in his career.

**Johnson Career Tops 1,000 Receiving Yards:** Senior wide receiver **Nate Johnson (Austin)** finished his career ranked 14th on the SCSU all-time receiving chart with 1,109 yards. He caught 77 passes and scored five touchdowns in 38 games.

**Cristan a Top Ten Punter:** Senior punter **Brian Cristan (Dellwood)** climbed the career punting chart to seventh in punting average with a mark of 36.7 yards per punt. He ranks sixth in punting yards with 6,863 and punt attempts with 187. He also ranks among the career leaders in PATs. He is eight in PATs made with 49, fifth in PAT attempts with 54 and fifth in PAT kick percent at 90.7.

**Matt Jensen Hits the Career Charts:** Senior free safety **Matt Jensen (Mequon, WI)** broke into the top 15 on two career charts in 2008. He ranks tenth all-time in pass break-ups/passes defended with 22. He is tied for 11th on the all-time interception chart with ten during his career. He collected a personal best four interceptions during the 2007 season.

**McLagan Nets a Career High:** Senior linebacker **Matt McLagan (Minneapolis)** continues to be successful on the field. Two weeks ago he stopped a Mary drive late in the game to secure the Husky win. Last week against the Dragons he collected a season and career high 12 tackles. McLagan has 58 tackles this season, including a team high 43 solo stops.

**Tyler Krueger Breaks In:** Senior cornerback **Tyler Krueger (Milwaukee, WI)** broke into the top ten chart in pass break ups/defended in 2008. He finished his career with 25 pass break ups which ranks him seventh on the all-time chart.

**Williams a Chart Climber:** Sophomore wide receiver **Fred Williams (Milwaukee, WI)** has begun his ascent on the career charts for receiving and returns. Williams currently ranks 11th on the all-time receiving yards chart with 1,307 yards. After the 2008 season he ranks ninth on the kickoff returns chart with a return average of 22.4 yards per kick.

### Ryan Kees: Draddy Trophy Finalist AFCA Division II All-American Valero Cactus Bowl Participant



Senior defensive end Ryan Kees (Eagan) rounded out his collegiate career with two national honors that recognized both academic and athletic achievement. He also was named to the West roster of the Cactus Bowl (an All-Star game featuring Division II senior football players).

Kees was named a 2008 Draddy Trophy Finalist, an award that recognizes academic success, football performance, and community leadership with an \$18,000 scholarship. Kees is the third Husky football player in the last five years to win this award. A mechanical engineering major, Kees joins Ryan Koch (2005) and Keith Heckendorf (2003) as Draddy Trophy Finalists.



Kees was also named to the 2008 AFCA Division II Coaches' All-America Team and the Football Gazette All-Super Region Three Third Team. He is the first Husky since the 2005 season to earn an All-American honor. Kees was a two-year captain of the Huskies and a three-year starter. He finished his career with 131 tackles, 35.0 tackles for loss, 15 quarterback sacks, four fumble recoveries and one interception. He ranks fourth on the SCSU career chart for tackles for loss with 35.0 and is sixth all-time on the quarterback sack chart with 15.0.

Kees is a first team All-NSIC selection and was awarded the St. Cloud State Gridiron Pride Award in 2008. He was named a Consensus Draft Services Division II Second Team Preseason All-American in 2008. He is a two-time All-North Central Conference team pick earning first team honors in 2007 and was named St. Cloud State's Dan Neubauer Defensive Player of the Year that same year. He has also been named a Daktronics, Inc., All-North Central Region Second Team Player and a Don Hanson Football Gazette First Team All-Region Player.

His academic achievements include 2008 NSIC Fall All-Academic Team, 2007 and 2007 ESPN The Magazine Academic All-District Five First Team, two-time Academic All-North Central Conference selection and two-time NCC Commissioner's Academic Honor Roll.

### Cale Pulczynski: 2008 NSIC Defensive Player of the Year

Senior defensive end Cale Pulczynski (Mukwonago, WI) finished his collegiate career on top as he was named the 2008 NSIC Defensive Player of the Year. He led the Huskies with 12 tackles for loss and eight quarterback sacks. He notched 36 tackles, blocked two kicks, forced a fumble and was credited with five QB hurries. Pulczynski set an SCSU single game record for quarterback sacks with 4.5 sacks at Northern State on Sept. 20 and was named the NSIC Defensive Player of the Week. A three-year starter for the Huskies, Pulczynski finished his career ranked third on the SCSU career quarterback sack chart with 21.0 sacks and fifth all-time on the tackles for loss chart with 34.5.





### Husky Stadium

2008 marked the fourth season of Husky Stadium. St. Cloud State is 15-11 at Husky Stadium since the 2004 season. The Huskies posted a 4-2 record at Husky Stadium in 2004, including a 0-1 mark in an NCAA playoff game in the new facility. The Huskies averaged 3,772 fans in the 4,198 seat facility in 2004, 3,961 in 2005, 3,936 in 2006, 2,742 in 2007, and 4003 in 2008 SCSU's first sell-out was on October 2, 2004 against the University of North Dakota. 2004 Record: 4-2; 2005 Record: 5-1; 2006 Record: 3-3; 2007 Record: 2-4; 2008 Record: 4-1.

**Joining the Ranks:** The St. Cloud State Huskies broke into the NCAA Division II Super Regional Three ranking on Oct. 27 at the number nine spot. The Huskies were ranked for one week during the season.

**The Last Time:** The Huskies have had three plays this year that can be found on The Last Time list. Fred Williams returned a kickoff 85 yards for TD on Oct. 11. The last player to return a kickoff for a TD was Matt Birkel on a 93 yard return, Oct. 5, 2002 against Augustana College. David Kamin returned an interception for a 41-yard TD on Oct. 18 against UMD, as did Darius Dotch on a 28-yard return on Oct. 25. Prior to this year, the last interception return for a TD was on Sept. 9, 2006 when Philip Hedlof returned a pick 61-yards for a touchdown at Missouri Western.

**2008 Senior Class:** It was one of the largest senior classes in the history of the program and definitely the largest since head coach Scott Underwood arrived on campus in 2001. The 2008 senior class was made up of 25 players, 16 on defense, eight on offense and one special teams player. In a truly amazing accomplishment, 20 of the 25 seniors played in their fifth year, having redshirted their first fall on campus in 2004. This group experienced the opening of the Husky Stadium and witnessed the Huskies first NCAA Playoff game since the 1989 season, a double overtime loss to the University of North Dakota in 2004. **NSIC Features Divisonal Play in Football**

With the expansion of the Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference to a 14-team league on July 1, 2008, the NSIC Football schedule will be broken into two seven-team divisions (North and South).
