## St. Cloud State University Huskies (7-4, 7-3 NSIC, 5-1 NSIC North)



- ✓ Huskies post second straight seven-win season
- ✓ St. Cloud State gains Traveling Training Kit in 2009

**2009 Final Record:** The St. Cloud State University football team posted a 7-4 overall record, finished tied for third in the Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference (NSIC) overall with a 7-3 record and finished second in the NSIC North Division with a 5-1 mark.

**Highlights:** Season highlights included a 26-21 upset of undefeated and nationally ranked Minnesota State University, Mankato in the final game of the season. The win brought home the vaunted "Traveling Training Kit". After starting the season with an 0-3 record, the Huskies went 7-1 over the last eight games, and finished the season on a three-game winning streak.

**HUSKY COACHING STAFF**

**SCSU Head Coach Scott Underwood:** Scott Underwood (Augustana College, 1988) was introduced as Head Coach of Husky Football on March 25, 2008. He is the 12th head football coach in the history of Husky football and had been the Huskies defensive coordinator since 2001.

In 2008, his first season at the helm, Underwood guided the Huskies to a 7-4 overall record, fourth place in the NSIC with a 7-3 mark and second place in the NSIC North Division with a 5-1 record. The Huskies had a senior class of 25 players and the seven wins marked the most victories for the Huskies since winning eight games in 2005.

The 2009 season was almost identical to 2008. The Huskies were 7-4 overall, tied for third overall in the NSIC with a 7-3 record, and placed second in the NSIC North with a 5-1 mark. The Huskies played a non-conference game at the University of Maine and nearly defeated the Division I Black Bears, losing 34-27 in overtime.

The Husky defense, led by Underwood ranked among the best in the North Central Conference in the last seven seasons of the league. In 2002, SCSU led the NCC in rushing defense, giving up 77.1 yards per game. Ten defensive players have earned All-North Central Conference first team honors with Underwood, including Charlie Cosgrove, the 2005 Defensive Lineman of the Year. The Huskies were co-winners of the NCC title in 2002 and hosted a first round NCAA Division II playoff game in 2004, the year that Husky Stadium opener.

Success has followed Underwood at each of his coaching stops. Prior to joining the St. Cloud State staff in 2001, Underwood was the inside linebackers coach at the University of North Dakota for four seasons, and coached two NCAA playoff teams. From 1993 to 1996, he served as the defensive coordinator at the University of Sioux Falls. The University of Sioux Falls advanced to the playoffs during three of those seasons and won the NAIA Division II National Championship in 1996.

Underwood began his coaching career at his alma mater, Augustana College, where he spent five seasons as the defensive secondary coach, following a four-year career at defensive back for the Vikings from 1984 to 1988. In 1988, Underwood coached in an NCAA playoff game. In 1989, with Underwood as an assistant coach, the Vikings advanced to the NCAA playoffs, losing to St. Cloud State at Selke Field.

A native of Marion, Iowa, Underwood has a bachelor's degree in social sciences from Augustana College and a master's degree in health, physical education, and recreation from the University of South Dakota.

**Williams Ties/Sets Records:** Junior wide receiver Fred Williams (Milwaukee, WI) tied the SCSU single game record for touchdown receptions in a game with four against MSUM on Oct. 31. He tied the record held by Ben Nelson who collected four touchdowns in three games during the 2002 season. Williams finished the day with seven catches for 126 yards. With those numbers, Williams went over the 2,000 yard receiving mark in his career. He has 2,188 receiving yards at SCSU and is the ninth Husky to go over the 2,000 yard mark. He has caught at least one pass in 31 straight games as a Husky. Earlier in the year, Williams set a school record for most receptions in a game with 15 against Maine on Sept. 3. That night he finished with 15 catches for 171 yards and one touchdown.

**Geiss for 1,000 Career Yards:** Sophomore running back **Brandon Geiss (Shorewood, Ill)** went over the 1,000 career yards rushing mark during the 2009 season. Geiss became the 21st Husky to gain 1,000 yards on Sept. 12 against Wayne State. That day he gained 79 rushing yards on 22 carries and scored one touchdown. Geiss missed the last three games of the season with a broken leg and finished the year with 142 carries for 697 yards and six touchdowns in eight games. He currently ranks 14th on the career rushing chart with 1,495 career yards.

**Machacek for 1,000 Yards:** Junior running back Jake Machacek (Eagan) was the second Husky this season to go over the 1,000 career yards rushing mark. Machacek gains 125 yards against MSU Moorhead on Oct. 31 to put him over 1,000. He is the 22nd Husky to reach 1,000 yards rushing and has 1,128 career rushing yards, which ranks him 21st on the all-time list.

**Back to Back 100's:** Jake Machacek recorded back to back 100-yard rushing games during the season. His first career 100-yard rushing game came on Oct. 24 against the University of Mary when he rushed for 100 yards on 14 carries and scored two touchdowns. His second straight 100-yard game on Oct. 31 at MSU Moorhead as he rushed for 125

yards and one touchdown on 14 carries. Machacek went over the 1,000 yard career rushing mark against MSUM.

**Three Picks for Touchdowns:** Three times during the 2009 season, a Husky defender returned an interception for a touchdown. Sophomore corner Joe Everson (Lakeville) returned an interception 55-yards for a touchdown against MSUM on Oct. 31 to mark his first collegiate score and second career interception. The first interception return for a touchdown was on Sept. 26 at Upper Iowa when sophomore zombie Tony Kubers (New Prague) returned a pick for a 54-yard touchdown in the first quarter. On Oct. 10, sophomore corner Matt Hansmann (Forest Lake) returned an interception 45-yards for a touchdown against Minnesota, Crookston on Homecoming Saturday.

**More on Interceptions:** Four Huskies recorded two or more interceptions during the season led by junior safety Tyler Niedfeldt (Plymouth) with four picks. Joe Everson finished the season with three interceptions and Matt Hansmann and senior MIKE linebacker Gyangelo Bradden (Minneapolis) had two interceptions each. Nine different players recorded a total of 16 interceptions during the season.

**Leading the NSIC:** The St. Cloud State defense led the NSIC (overall games stats) in pass defense in 2009. The Huskies allowed 170.2 yards passing per game in the league overall team stats. The Huskies also led the league in pass efficiency with a rating of 156.9.... Individually, junior wide receiver Fred Williams (Milwaukee, Wisc.) ranked second in receptions per game with 6.55 in overall games played....In league games, St. Cloud State led the conference in pass defense allowing 177.1 yards per game. The Huskies ranked in the top four in scoring defense, turnover margin, rushing offense, total defense, punt returns, pass efficiency, pass defense efficiency, fourth-down conversions, and third-down conversions.



**Husky Stadium**

2009 marked the sixth season of Husky Stadium. St. Cloud State is 22-11 at Husky Stadium since the 2004 season. The Huskies posted a 4-2 record at Husky Stadium in 2004, including a 0-1 mark in an NCAA play-off game in the new facility. The Huskies averaged 3,772 fans in the 4,198 seat facility in 2004, 3,961 in 2005, 3,936 in 2006, 2,742 in 2007, 4,004 in 2008, and 4,112 in 2009. SCSU's first sell-out was on October 2, 2004 against the University of North Dakota. 2004 Record: 4-2; 2005 Record: 5-1; 2006 Record: 3-3; 2007 Record: 2-4; 2008 Record: 4-1, 2009 Record: 4-1.

**SCSU All-Time Record:** The 2009 season marked the 87th in the history of SCSU football. Since 1920, SCSU has compiled a 390-349-23 overall record and has won a total of 18 conference titles, two in the North Central Conference (1989, 2002), 14 Northern Intercollegiate Conference crowns and two Minnesota State College Conference titles.



**Anderson-Norblom and Scott Ferguson Named to Preseason Team:** St. Cloud State senior tight end Cody Anderson-Norblom (Minneapolis) and junior offensive lineman Scott Ferguson (Bowmanville, Ontario) have been named to the D2Football.com 2009 All-NSIC Preseason Football Team. D2Football.com is a website that provides national coverage of NCAA Division II football.

**Traveling Training Kit:**

In honor of the St. Cloud State/Minnesota State rivalry, the winning team takes home the Traveling Training Kit. The Kit features the Husky logo in red on one side and the MSU Mavericks logo in purple on the other side. They began playing for the "Traveling Training Kit" in 1978. In 2004, Jeff Merron of ESPN.com compiled a Top Ten List featuring the "Most Bizarre College Football Rivalry Trophy." The "Traveling Training Kit" ranked second on the list. With a 26-21 win over the Mavericks on Nov. 7, the Huskies brought home the "Kit".

**Three for 100:** For the first time in recent history three players rushed for over 100 yards in the same game. The rare performance happened on Oct. 24 against the University of Mary. Senior quarterback Derek Stripling (Wabasso) rushed for 154 yards on 13 carries and scored two touchdowns. Junior running back Dante Steward (Milwaukee, WI) had 17 carries for 108 yards and junior RB Jake Machacek (Eagan) finished the game with 14 carries for 100 yards and two touchdowns. The last time the Huskies had more than one player rush for over 100 yards was on Oct. 8, 2005 when Drew Meyer (103 yards) and Matt Birkel (154 yards) went over the mark against Augustana College. Meyer and Birkel did it twice that season. Husky records show two players rushing for 100 yards in the same game four times. The other two were recorded on Sept. 9, 1995 when Tom Williams and Randy Martin went over 100 against Minnesota Duluth, and on Oct. 8, 1994 when Martin and Keith Williams gained 100 against Augustana.
