2010 Season Opener: The 2010 St. Cloud State football season gets underway on Saturday, Sept. 4 at 1:00 p.m. in a non-conference tilt against Augustana College in Sioux Falls, S.D. The Huskies and Vikings will play at Kirkeby-Over Stadium (6,898) on the Augustana College campus.

2009 Final Record:

St. Cloud State posted a 7-4 overall record, finished tied for third in the NSIC overall with a 7-3 record and finished second in the NSIC North Division with a 5-1 mark.

Augustana College posted an 8-4 overall record and lost to Missouri Western, 34-21, in the Mineral Water Bowl. The Vikings were 7-3 in NSIC play and tied for second in the South Division with a 4-2 record.

About the Huskies: St. Cloud State returns 41 letterwinners from a squad that posted a 7-4 record in 2009. Among those letterwinners are 17 starters, eight on offense, eight on defense and one kicker. Also among the returning group are three first team All-NSIC North Division players in tackles Scott Ferguson (Bowmanville, Ontario) and Matt Theis (Eden Valley) and wide receiver Fred Williams (Milwaukee, Wis.). The entire offensive line returns intact led by two-time All-Conference left tackle Ferguson and right tackle Theis. The strength of the defensive unit will be the defensive line with two returning seniors in Josh Popanda (Twin Lakes, Wis.) and Joe Winandy (Mazomanie, Wis.).

NSIC Players to Watch: Two Huskies, wide receiver **Fred Williams** and linebacker/defensive back **Tony Kubes** (New Prague) are players to watch in the NSIC in 2010.

Williams is a two-time First Team All-NSIC Northern Division selection and highlights the Husky offense in 2010. He has played in 31 career games for the Huskies and last year had his best season to date. He set a school record for most receptions in a game with 15 at the University of Maine. That day he collected 15 passes for 171 yards and one touchdown. He also tied the single game record for touchdown receptions with four against MSU Moorhead. Williams has 2,188 career receiving yards, is the eighth Husky to go over 2,000 yards and ranks fifth in career receiving yards. He ranks third all time in receptions with 169, fifth in receiving touchdowns with 22, fourth in kick returns (1,213) and eighth in all-purpose yards with 3,408, heading into 2010. In 2009 he collected 72 passes for 881 yards and 11 touchdowns. He has caught at least one pass in 31 straight games. Williams was voted the Team Offensive MVP in 2009. He will be a co-captain for the Huskies in 2010. **Kubes** was named Second Team All-NSIC North Division and Academic All-NSIC in 2009. He received St.

Cloud State's Defensive Player of the Year Award as a starter. In 2009 he played at the outside linebacker position and may see playing time at safety in 2010. Kubes led the Huskies in tackles with 76, solo stops with 49 and assisted tackles with 27. He ranked second on the team with 9.5 tackles for loss and recorded two quarterback sacks. Kubes tallied a career high 14 tackles and 2.5 TFL against Wayne State. He also returned punts and kick offs with 17 punt returns for 198 yards and eight kick returns for 142 yards. A two-year starter, Kubes has 92 career tackles.

Klaphake to Make the Calls: Redshirt first year quarterback Philip Klaphake (Princeton) will make the calls for the Huskies in 2010. Klaphake replaces the graduated Mitch Watkins and Derek Stripling as the Huskies signal caller in 2010. Klaphake was an All-State Honorable Mention and All-Conference quarterback at Princeton High School where he holds the school passing record.

Geiss Returns: After missing the last three games of the 2009 season with a leg injury, junior Brandon Geiss (Shorewood, Ill.) returns to the Husky line-up in 2010. Last year he played in the first eight games, rushing 142 times for 697 yards and six touchdowns.

Take Your Pick: Two of the returning Husky defensive backs accounted for seven of the 16 interceptions collected by SCSU in 2009. Senior free safety **Tyler Niedfeldt** (Plymouth, Wis.) and junior cornerback **Joe Everson** (Lakeville) collected four and three interceptions, respectively in 2009. Three INT's were returned for touchdowns in 2009 including Everson's 55-yard return against MSU Moorhead on Oct. 31.

Leading the NSIC: The St. Cloud State defense led the NSIC (overall games stats) in pass defense in 2009. The Huskies allowed 170.2 yards passing per game in the league overall team stats. The Huskies also led the league in pass efficiency with a rating of 156.9....Individually, junior wide receiver Fred Williams (Milwaukee, Wisc.) ranked second in receptions per game with 6.55 in overall games played....In league games, St. Cloud State led the conference in pass defense allowing 177.1 yards per game. The Huskies ranked in the top four in scoring defense, turnover margin, rushing offense, total defense, punt returns, pass efficiency, pass defense efficiency, fourth-down conversions, and third-down conversions.

SCSU All-Time Record: The 2010 season marks the 88th in the history of SCSU football. Since 1920, SCSU has compiled a 390-349-23 overall record and has won a total of 18 conference titles, two in the North Central Conference (1989, 2002), 14 Northern Intercollegiate Conference crowns and two Minnesota State College Conference titles.

Williams Ties/Sets Records: Last season wide receiver Fred Williams (Milwaukee, WI) tied the SCSU single game record for touchdown receptions in a game with four against MSUM on Oct. 31. He tied the record held by Ben Nelson who collected four touchdowns in three games during the 2002 season. Williams finished the day with seven catches for 126 yards. With those numbers, Williams went over the 2,000 yard receiving mark in his career. He has 2,188 receiving yards at SCSU and is the ninth Husky to go over the 2,000 yard mark. He has caught at least one pass in 31 straight games as a Husky. Earlier in the year, Williams set a school record for most receptions in a game with 15 against Maine on Sept. 3. That night he finished with 15 catches for 171 yards and one touchdown.

Geiss for 1,000 Career Yards: In 2009 running back Brandon Geiss (Shorewood, Ill) went over the 1,000 career yards rushing mark. Geiss became the 21st Husky to gain 1,000 yards on Sept. 12 against Wayne State. That day he gained 79 rushing yards on 22 carries and scored one touchdown. Geiss missed the last three

games of the season with a broken leg and finished the year with 142 carries for 697 yards and six touchdowns in eight games. He currently ranks 14th on the career rushing chart with 1,495 career yards.

Husky Stadium

2009 marked the sixth season of Husky Stadium. St. Cloud State is 22-11 at Husky Stadium since the 2004 season. The Huskies posted a 4-2 record at Husky Stadium in 2004, including a 0-1 mark in an NCAA play-off game in the new facility. The Huskies averaged 3,772 fans in the 4,198 seat facility in 2004, 3,961 in 2005, 3,936 in 2006, 2,742 in 2007, 4,004 in 2008, and 4,112 in 2009. SCSU's first sell-out was on October 2, 2004 against the University of North Dakota.

The Series vs. Augustana College: St. Cloud State leads the all-time series with the Augustana Vikings 20-13. The Huskies have opened against Augustana in each of the last two seasons and are 0-2 in those games. St. Cloud State is 1-4 against the Vikings over the last five games. The first game played between the two schools was during the 1950 season and resulted in a 6-0 Husky win.

About Augustana College: Saturday's season opener marks Augustana's second season in its new home, Kirkeby-Over Stadium located on the Vikings campus. The Vikings return a total of 17 starters from the 2009 squad. Seven starters return on offense, six on defense and four on special teams. The Vikings have won their last four season openers, including the last two against the Huskies. Like the Huskies, Augustana will have a new quarterback making the calls in 2010. Sophomore Josh Hanson will start the season opener. He appeared in five games last season and completed eight of 14 passes for 100 yards. Senior wide receiver Tyler Schulte returns in 2010. Last season he caught 44 passes for 641 yards and was named All-NSIC South Division first team for the second straight year. Senior linebacker Chris Janisch, another two-time All-NSIC pick, led the Vikings with 95 tackles last season.

Head Coach: Augustana head coach Mike Aldrich (St. Olaf) is in his first season leading the Vikings and is one of two new head coaches in the league, joining Tom Dosch of Northern State in 2010. Aldrich has been on the Vikings coaching staff since 2004, serving as the special teams coordinator and assistant defensive coordinator before spending the last four seasons as Augustana's defensive coordinator. He has coached with the Sioux Falls Storm, Louisville, California Luther, College of the Sequoias and his alma mater St. Olaf College.

Last Year: Augustana scored 14 second quarter points to lead 24-9 at the half and added a touchdown in each of the third and fourth quarters to post a 38-16 NSIC win over the Huskies on Aug. 27 at Husky Stadium. Augustana running back Joe Clark rushed 17 times for 75 yards and Tyler Schulte caught three passes, two for touchdowns, for a total of 43 yards. The Huskies scored on a 38 yard Tyler Aldridge

field goal, a Mitch Watkins nine yard run, and Tyler Allery touchdown pass reception. Allery finished the game with five catches for 53 yards. Augustana tallied 362 yards of offense to the Huskies 296.

Scott Underwood (Augustana College, 1988) was introduced as Head Coach of Husky Football on March 25, 2008. He is the 12th head football coach in the history of Husky football and had been the Huskies defensive coordinator since 2001.

In 2008, his first season at the helm, Underwood guided the Huskies to a 7-4 overall record, fourth place in the NSIC with a 7-3 mark and second place in the NSIC North Division with a 5-1 record. The Huskies had a senior class of 25 players and the seven wins marked the most victories for the Huskies since winning eight games in 2005.

The 2009 season was almost identical to 2008. The Huskies were 7-4 overall, tied for third overall in the NSIC with a 7-3 record, and placed second in the NSIC North with a 5-1 mark. The Huskies played a non-conference game at the University of Maine and nearly defeated the Division I Black Bears, losing 34-27 in overtime.

The Husky defense, led by Underwood ranked among the best in the North Central Conference in the last seven seasons of the league. In 2002, SCSU led the NCC in rushing defense, giving up 77.1 yards per game. Ten defensive players have earned All-North Central Conference first team honors with Underwood, including Charlie Cosgrove, the 2005 Defensive Lineman of the Year. The Huskies were co-winners of the NCC title in 2002 and hosted a first round NCAA Division II playoff game in 2004, the year that Husky Stadium opener.

Success has followed Underwood at each of his coaching stops. Prior to joining the St. Cloud State staff in 2001, Underwood was the inside linebackers coach at the University of North Dakota for four seasons, and coached two NCAA playoff teams. From 1993 to 1996, he served as the defensive coordinator at the University of Sioux Falls. The University of Sioux Falls advanced to the playoffs during three of those seasons and won the NAIA Division II National Championship in 1996.

Underwood began his coaching career at his alma mater, Augustana College, where he spent five seasons as the defensive secondary coach, following a four-year career at defensive back for the Vikings from 1984 to 1988. In 1988, Underwood coached in an NCAA playoff game. In 1989, with Underwood as an assistant coach, the Vikings advanced to the NCAA playoffs, losing to St. Cloud State at Selke Field.

A native of Marion, Iowa, Underwood has a bachelor's degree in social sciences from Augustana College and a master's degree in health, physical education, and recreation from the University of South Dakota.

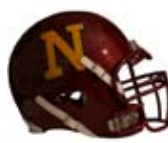
