The Game: The 20th-ranked St. Cloud State football team travels to Duluth, Minn., for an NSIC North Division game against the #2-ranked University of Minnesota Duluth Bulldogs on Saturday, Oct. 30. Game time is 1:00 p.m. at Malosky Stadium (4,500) on the UMD campus.

For The Record:

St. Cloud State is 7-1 overall and 7-0 in overall NSIC competition. The Huskies are 3-0 in NSIC North Division play. **St. Cloud State** has won seven games in a row. The Huskies are coming off a 49-6 Homecoming win over the University of Minnesota, Crookston.

The University of Minnesota Duluth is 8-0 overall, 7-0 in the NSIC and 4-0 in the North Division. The Bulldogs are coming off a 27-7 win at Northern State University. UMD won the 2008 NCAA Division II Football National Championship. The Bulldogs have a 27-game NSIC win streak on the line.

In the Polls: The Huskies and Bulldogs are ranked in the top 20 in this week's Division II polls. St. Cloud State moved up three spots in the AFCA Division II Coaches poll to #20 this week. Minnesota Duluth remained at #2 for the eighth straight week. The Bulldogs are ranked #1 in the D2football.com poll. The Huskies are #16 in the D2football.com.

National Statistics Report: In this week's NCAA Division II Football Statistical report, three Huskies are listed in the top ten of their statistical category. Quarterback Phillip Klaphake (Princeton) is ranked fifth in passing efficiency with a 167.9 rating. Senior safety Tyler Niedfeldt (Plymouth, Wis.) is tied for third in interceptions and junior corner Joe Everson (Lakeville) is tied for tenth. Wide receiver Fred Williams (Milwaukee, Wis.) is tenth in receiving yards per game with 113.8.

Seven in a Row: St. Cloud State brings a seven game winning streak into Saturday's game. It is the longest win streak since the 2008 season, Scott Underwood's first at the helm, when the Huskies won five straight. The longest win streak in school history came during the North Central Conference (NCC) Championship season of 1989 when the Huskies rattled off nine straight wins and hosted the first and second round NCAA Playoff games.

Homecoming Win: Last Saturday marked the 83rd Husky Football Homecoming game and the Huskies came away with a 49-6 victory over the University of Minnesota, Crookston. With the win St. Cloud State is 52-30-1 overall in Homecoming games. The Huskies are 4-3 in Homecoming games played at Husky Stadium. The first Homecoming game was played in 1925. George Lynch was the head coach and the Huskies lost to Winona, 6-0. The longest winning streak for Homecoming games is seven years from 1971 to 1977. Rod Anfenson was the head coach in 1971 and Mike Simpson had the

winning mark from 1972 to 1977.

Niedfeldt Tabbed NSIC Defensive Player of the Week:

Senior free safety Tyler Niedfeldt (Plymouth, Wis.) intercepted a career high four passes and returned one for a touchdown in the Huskies win over UMC, and was named the NSIC Defensive Player of the Week for his effort. The four INT's for an individual in one game was one shy of the school record five held since the 1970 season by Bill Trewick. Niedfeldt is the third Husky in school history to collect three or more INT's in a game. Mitch Denne had a three interception game in 2004 against UMD. Niedfeldt collected 55 yards in interception returns including his 32-yard TD return. Niedfeldt has a team high six interceptions this season and the school record is nine held by Trewick. Niedfeldt has 11 career interceptions and two touchdowns. Niedfeldt leads the NSIC in interceptions this season and junior teammate Joe Everson (Lakeville) is second with five this season.



Mike Walker Debut is a Hit:

True freshman running back Mike Walker (Walworth, Wis.) made his collegiate debut a memorable one. Walker carried the ball ten times for 64 yards and one touchdown. He scored on a four-yard run early in the second quarter and had a long run of 19 yards.



Popanda Has Solid Outing:

Senior nose guard and captain Josh Popanda (Twin Lakes, Wis.) had another solid game with five tackles, one sack, three tackles for a loss and one fumble recovery. Popanda has two fumble recoveries this season, including one he returned 78 yards for a touchdown against Southwest Minnesota State on Oct. 16. The 78-yard return is the longest in school history. The old run of 70 yards was by Isaiah Harris on Oct. 28, 2000 at Northern Colorado. Popanda has 24 career tackles for a loss which currently ranks him 14th on the all-time chart.

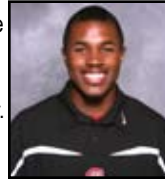
Klaphake Rushes for Career High:

Redshirt first-year quarterback Phillip Klaphake (Princeton) has taken to the ground and for the second week in a row rushed for over 130 yards. On Saturday he carried the ball ten times for 136 yards and three touchdowns. He also threw for 109 yards and one touchdown. A week ago Klaphake rushed for 134 yards and one touchdown against Southwest Minnesota State. Klaphake has started all eight games this season. He has thrown for 1,789 yards and 17 touchdowns. He has rushed for 544 yards and eight touchdowns. Seven times this season, he has thrown for over 200 yards in a game and three times has gone over 300. He threw back to back 300's to start his collegiate career. Twice he has thrown four TD passes in a game. If he keeps pace with his passing game for the remainder of the season he would become the seventh Husky QB to pass for 2,000 yards in a season. The last Husky to do it was Dan Kaczor in 2004. In his collegiate debut on Sept. 4 at Augustana College he threw for 319 yards and following week 302 to become the first Husky to throw back to back games of 300 yards since Keith Heckendorf during the 2003 season. He is the first Husky QB since Mike Hammerseng (302 yards Nov. 11, 2006 at Minnesota Duluth) to throw for over 300 yards in a game. His four touchdown passes in a game is one short of the single game school record for TD passes held by Heckendorf, Dan Kaczor and Mike Leivermann.



Williams Tops the Charts: Senior wide receiver

Fred Williams (Milwaukee, Wis.) caught a game high five passes for 72 yards and one touchdown to improve his career numbers as a receiver. He tops the charts in three receiving categories and is tied for a third. Williams is the all-time leading receiver in receptions with 221 and this season became the first Husky to reach 3,000 receiving yards and has 3,099 in his career. Besides his mark as the top receiver in yards, Williams set the career record for receptions against Northern State on Oct. 2. On Sept. 4, against Augustana College, he set the single game record for receiving yards with 236. Three times in his career, Williams has tied the single game record for touchdown receptions in a game, including twice this season. He has 34 career touchdown receptions and trails Ben Nelson's record of 43 career TD receptions. In addition, he has caught a pass in 39 straight games. He currently tops the NSIC rankings in receptions per game with 6.50 and receiving yards per game with 113.9.

Husky Stadium

2009 marked the sixth season of Husky Stadium. St. Cloud State is 22-11 at Husky Stadium since the 2004 season. The Huskies posted a 4-2 record at Husky Stadium in 2004, including a 0-1 mark in an NCAA playoff game in the new facility. The Huskies averaged 3,772 fans in the 4,198 seat facility in 2004, 3,961 in 2005, 3,936 in 2006, 2,742 in 2007, 4,004 in 2008, and 4,112 in 2009. SCSU's first sell-out was on October 2, 2004 against the University of North Dakota.

Huskies vs. Minnesota, Crookston Homecoming recap:

ST. CLOUD, Minn. –The No. 23 nationally ranked St. Cloud State football team caused seven University of Minnesota, Crookston turnovers in a one-sided 49-6 victory at Husky Stadium Saturday afternoon in the 83rd Homecoming game in school history.

Senior captain defensive back Tyler Niedfeldt (Plymouth) helped the Huskies (7-1, 7-0 NSIC, 3-0 NSIC North) defensively with a career-high four interceptions for 55 yards and a touchdown in the game.

Niedfeldt was one interception short of tying former Husky Bill Trewick who had five in a game against Bemidji State back in 1970.

The Golden Eagles (1-7, 0-7 NSIC) got on the board first with a turnover of their own, but failed to connect on the extra point and did not get things going the rest of the day offensively.

For St. Cloud State Freshman Phillip Klaphake (Princeton) broke his own career rushing high in back to back weeks, as he rushed for 136 yards on 10 carries after a 134 yard, 12 carry day last weekend.

Three of the rushes were for touchdowns and all of his stats were produced in the first half.

Klaphake was not the only person getting things done on the ground as the offense set a season high with 323 yards of rushing offense on 46 carries.

Freshman Damon Treat (Fairfield, Cali.) rushed five times for 77 yards and a score, while fellow freshman Mike Walker (Walworth, Wis.) made his career debut with 10 rushes for 64 yards and a score.

Senior Fred Williams (Milwaukee, Wis.) had another successful day catching the ball for SCSU, making five grabs for 73 yards and a score with the team throwing only 19 passes in the game

The Husky offense combined for 459 yards in the game, while the defense allowed just 51 yards on the ground and 97 through the air, as the Golden Eagles punted seven times in the game.

Senior captain Josh Popanda (Twin Lakes, Wis.) had himself another solid day at the nose guard position with five tackles, one sack, three tackles for a loss, and a fumble recovery.

Sophomore Marvin Matthews (Roseville) also had five tackles in the game to go with a break up and the Huskies' fifth interception of the day.

Series Record: The Huskies have a narrow edge over the Bulldogs in the all-time series which began during the 1933 season. St. Cloud State leads the series 22-19 but has lost five straight to the Bulldogs including a 31-7 loss in Duluth last season. The Bulldogs have won six of the last seven games.

About Minnesota Duluth: One of the top ranked teams in NCAA Division II, the Bulldogs are operating without the services of two-time All-American senior running back Isaac Odum who underwent knee surgery earlier this season. Odum owns 17 UMD single game, single season and career records. The Bulldogs lead the NSIC in scoring offense (46.8 points per game), rushing offense, scoring defense, pass defense, kickoff returns and total offense. UMD averages 489.4 yards in total offense this season while the Huskies have an equally impressive 439.8 yards per game average. The Bulldogs have outscored their opponents 46.8 to 10.6 and are allowing 270.5 yards in offense. At quarterback Chase Vogler has passed for 1,143 yards and ten touchdowns with an efficiency rating of 180.39. D.J. Winfield has caught 29 passes for 713 yards and six touchdowns. On the defensive side of the ball Kiel Fechtelkotter has a team high 48 tackles. The Bulldogs are 35-2 in their last 37 games, a run which started with a 23-13 win at St. Cloud State in the 2007 season finale.

Head Coach: University of Minnesota Duluth head coach Bob Nielson is in his eighth season with the Bulldogs and 18th as a collegiate head coach. He has compiled a 72-21 record with the Bulldogs and is 142-54-1 in all collegiate games he has coached. In 2008, he took a team that was 4-7 the previous season, and won the NCAA Division II National Championship with an undefeated season.

Last Week: The Bulldogs posted a 27-7 North Division win over Northern State in Aberdeen. Brad Foss rushed 23 times for 159 yards (both career highs) and one touchdown in the win. UMD ran up 594 yards of total offense to Northern's 220 yards. Northern State scored late in the game to avoid the shutout.

Scott Underwood (Augustana College, 1988) was introduced as Head Coach of Husky Football on March 25, 2008. He is the 12th head football coach in the history of Husky football and had been the Huskies defensive coordinator since 2001.

In 2008, his first season at the helm, Underwood guided the Huskies to a 7-4 overall record, fourth place in the NSIC with a 7-3 mark and second place in the NSIC North Division with a 5-1 record. The Huskies had a senior class of 25 players and the seven wins marked the most victories for the Huskies since winning eight games in 2005.

The 2009 season was almost identical to 2008. The Huskies were 7-4 overall, tied for third overall in the NSIC with a 7-3 record, and placed second in the NSIC North with a 5-1 mark. The Huskies played a non-conference game at the University of Maine and nearly defeated the Division I Black Bears, losing 34-27 in overtime.

The Husky defense, led by Underwood ranked among the best in the North Central Conference in the last seven seasons of the league. In 2002, SCSU led the NCC in rushing defense, giving up 77.1 yards per game. Ten defensive players have earned All-North Central Conference first team honors with Underwood, including Charlie Cosgrove, the 2005 Defensive Lineman of the Year. The Huskies were co-winners of the NCC title in 2002 and hosted a first round NCAA Division II playoff game in 2004, the year that Husky Stadium opener.

Success has followed Underwood at each of his coaching stops. Prior to joining the St. Cloud State staff in 2001, Underwood was the inside linebackers coach at the University of North Dakota for four seasons, and coached two NCAA playoff teams. From 1993 to 1996, he served as the defensive coordinator at the University of Sioux Falls. The University of Sioux Falls advanced to the playoffs during three of those seasons and won the NAIA Division II National Championship in 1996.

Underwood began his coaching career at his alma mater, Augustana College, where he spent five seasons as the defensive secondary coach, following a four-year career at defensive back for the Vikings from 1984 to 1988. In 1988, Underwood coached in an NCAA playoff game. In 1989, with Underwood as an assistant coach, the Vikings advanced to the NCAA playoffs, losing to St. Cloud State at Selke Field.

A native of Marion, Iowa, Underwood has a bachelor's degree in social sciences from Augustana College and a master's degree in health, physical education, and recreation from the University of South Dakota.
