2007 SCSU FOOTBALL NEWS

Release Date: March 27, 2007

Spring Drills: The 2007 edition of Husky Football will begin spring practice on Friday, March 30 and conclude on Saturday, April 28 with a Spring Game at Husky Stadium.

2006 Season Record: The St. Cloud State University football team finished the 2006 season with a 3-8 overall record. The Huskies finished ninth in the North Central Conference with a 1-7 league record. The Huskies posted a 3-3 record at Husky Stadium.

The 2007 Huskies: St. Cloud State returns 42 letterwinners including 17 starters in 2007. Ten starters return on offense, five on defense and two on special teams.

2007 Schedule: St. Cloud State is scheduled to play ten games in 2007, including five home games. The Huskies will open the season at home against Northern State University, a member of the Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference on August 30. SCSU's other home games include Central Washington on September 29, Augustana College on October 13, Nebraska-Omaha on October 27, and Minnesota Duluth on November 10. The Huskies have an open date on the schedule, September 15.

All-Time Record: The 2006 season marked the 84th in the history of SCSU football. Since 1920, SCSU has compiled a 384-328-22 overall record and has won a total of 18 conference titles, two in the North Central Conference (1989, 2002), 14 Northern Intercollegiate Conference crowns and two Minnesota State College Conference titles.

At Husky Stadium: 2006 marked the third season in Husky Stadium for the SCSU football team. St. Cloud State is 12-6 at Husky Stadium since the 2004 season. The Huskies

posted a 4-2 record at Husky Stadium in 2004, including a 0-1 mark in an NCAA playoff game in the new facility. In 2005, SCSU went 5-1 at Husky Stadium, followed by a 3-3 home mark in 2006. The Huskies averaged 3,772 fans in the 4,198 seat facility in 2004, 3,961 in 2005, and 3,936 in 2006. SCSU's first sell-out was on October 2, 2004 against the University of North Dakota. 2004 Record: 4-2; 2005 Record: 5-1; 2006 Record: 3-3.





SCSU Head Coach Randy Hedberg:

SCSU head coach Randy Hedberg (Minot State 1977) completed his eighth season with the Huskies in 2006. **He has a current eight year record of 43-44 at SCSU and is 88-67-2 overall in 16 years as a collegiate coach.** He netted his 75th career coaching win against UND on October 2, 2004 and his 30th with the Huskies. The Huskies won the NCC title in 2002, which marks the second time in team history that SCSU has won the NCC title. In 2004 SCSU posted an 8-3 record, and hosted the University of North Dakota in the first round of the NCAA Division II playoffs. The Parshall, N.D. native has been the head coach at Minot State (1982-89), assistant coach at Central Missouri State (1990-95), and an assistant coach at North Dakota (1996-98). Hedberg was an honorable mention All-America quarterback at Minot State. He was drafted by Tampa Bay of the NFL in 1977, and played with the Bucs through 1978. He also played with the Oakland Raiders (1979) and Green Bay Packers (1980).

The defensive secondary suffered the biggest losses due to graduation. Gone are safeties Tate Wheeler, Mitch Denne, and Justin Biebighauser. Wheeler led the Huskies in tackles last season with 72. Denne picked off a team high five passes, and Biebighauser had 30 tackles. Juniors Matt Jensen (Mequon, WI), Bryce Kieffer (Dennison), and David Cullom (Moorhead) have three years of experience with the Huskies and all earned playing time in 2006. Red-shirts Zach Sturm (Springfield) and Tyler Niedfeldt (Plymouth, WI) have the ability to step forward and contribute to the team. Sophomore Brian Kampa (Sartell) will figure into the mix depending on his come back from an injury. The SCSU coaching staff feels really good about the players returning at the corners. Senior Philip Hedlof (Blomkest) and junior Tyler Krueger (Milwaukee, WI) bring excellent experience to the corners. Hedlof notched 64 tackles in 2006 and had two interceptions and Krueger had 41 tackles. Red-shirts Mark Snow (St. Paul), Larry Thomas, Jr. (St. Paul), and Matt Jensen will also be factors at the corners.

Junior All-North Central Conference placekicker Jon Gutierrez (Beloit, WI) and sophomore punter Brian Cristan (Mahtomedi) anchor the kicking game for the Huskies. Gutierrez led the Huskies in scoring and Cristan averaged 35.3 yards per punt last season. Red-shirt Justin Delgado (Burlington, WI) will get a look at placekicking.

2007 Husky Football Outlook

The 2007 edition of Husky football returns a wealth of experience with 17 returning starters, including 2006 All-North Central Conference placekicker Jon Gutierrez (Beloit, WI). In addition, the Huskies will have a new look offense as offensive coordinator Paul Rudolph left to become the head coach at Minot State University. Steve Crutchley and the newly hired Doug Patterson will share the offensive coordinator duties this season. Ninth-year head coach Randy Hedberg says there will be a different look on the offensive side of the ball in 2007. "We are going to do a little more out of the shotgun," said Hedberg.

On offense, the Huskies have starters returning at every position with the exception of tight end. SCSU graduated two seniors from that position in Anders Johnson and Aaron Frana. Johnson ended his career on an 11-game pass receiving streak. He led the 2006 Huskies with 44 catches and ranked second in receiving yards with 451. Sophomores Cody Anderson-Norbloom (Minneapolis) and Houston Niesche (Carver), along with junior transfer Matt Hoffman (St. Paul) will work the tight end position. Niesche is an on the line player while Anderson-Norbloom is a wide receiver/tight end player with good movement.

The offensive line returns a strong group of players in 2007. According to Hedberg, this group, with its added experience, should be even better than a year ago. The coaching staff looks to return senior Matt Plautz (Appleton, WI) back to the guard position. He played tackle much of last season, but was slowed by an injury late in the year. Junior Adam Koss (Stoughton, WI) is coming back from surgery and it is hoped that he will return to his tackle spot, allowing Plautz to return to the guard position. "We feel really good about our offensive line," said Hedberg. "We are very strong internally from guard to guard." Other returnees on the line include junior Ryan Knoll (St. Paul), senior Craig Reesor (Jacksonville, FL), sophomore Matt Bennek (White Bear Lake) and junior Jeff Dirkes (Albany). Several young players will figure into the offensive line in 2007 including red-shirts Scott Ferguson (Bowmanville, Ontario) at tackle and Tyler Illikainen (Plymouth) at guard, and Justin Ourada (Manitowoc, WI) at center.

Everyone is back at the wide receiver position, led by junior Zach Stover (Eagan) and senior Derek Sedin (Santa Maria, CA). Stover made 38 catches for a team high 789 yards and four touchdowns, while Sedin pulled in 31 passes for 483 yards and four touchdowns. According to Hedberg, Stover and Sedin closed out the year on a high note in 2006, and the receiving corps developed as the season went along. Sophomore Tyler McKee (New Brighton) could have a big year for the Huskies. Junior Tony Parker (Little Falls) sat out last season with an injury. A big, tall receiver, he is expected to see playing time in 2007. Junior Cody Rysewyk (Green Bay, WI) is expected to keep developing and add to the depth at the receiver position.

Juniors Kenny Patrick (Milwaukee, WI) and Michael Graham (Oakdale) are the returning starters at running back. Graham rushed for 474 yards on 89 carries and tallied four touchdowns. Patrick carried the ball 98 times for 341 yards and a team high six touchdowns. "Kenny made good progress during the winter," Hedberg said. "It will be a little different for all our backs running out of the gun versus the I-formation, so we will have to see how they adjust to the change."

Red-shirt Jake Machacek (Eagan) will get his chance for playing time this season and Hedberg thinks he can have a good career at SCSU.

The Huskies return two starters at quarterback in senior Mike Hammerseng (Minnetonka) and junior Jon Quesnel (Eagan). Both players split signal calling duties early last season until Hammerseng suffered an injury and Quesnel became the starter. Quesnel was hurt early in the final game of the season and Hammerseng took over to finish the game. Quesnel completed 147 of 264 pass attempts for 1,775 yards and ten touchdowns. He set a new SCSU record for most passing yards in a game with 377 yards against Augustana College on October 14. Hammerseng appeared in seven games, completed 43 of 77 pass attempts for 711 yards and two touchdowns. Red-shirts Nick Sharp (Des Moines, IA) and Jake Kranz (Hastings) have really progressed and have a chance to push the returning players in spring ball. "There will be a lot of decision making in our offense next season and we will be looking to see who can pick that up the fastest," said Hedberg.

The Husky defense will have some holes to fill as six positions are open due to graduation. Juniors Ryan Kees (Eagan) and Cale Pulczynski (Mukwonago, WI) will anchor the defensive line and according to Hedberg are two of the better defensive ends in the North Central Conference. Kees is coming off a very good season with the exception of missing the final two games with an injury. He collected a team high 10.5 tackles for loss and seven quarterback sacks in 2006. Pulczynski has a chance to move into the STUD position left open by the graduation of Barrett Flatt. Pulczynski notched 24 tackles, including 8.5 tackles for loss and four quarterback sacks. Juniors Richard Magembe (St. Paul) and Ahmed Ibrahim (Fairmont) will back up the defensive ends. Magembe replaced the injured Kees in 2006. Ibrahim, a transfer, sat out last fall and will be Huskies long snapper in 2007. Junior Tom Conboy (Rosemount) and senior Treg Swanson (Pierz) also return in 2007. Red-shirts Jason Terres (Cold Spring), Joe Winandy (Mazomanie, WI), Josh Popanda (Twin Lakes, WI), and Chuck Merritt (Aurora, IL) will battle for playing time in 2007. "I am looking forward to seeing some of these guys play. They have good talent and just need some playing time, which they should experience in spring ball," said Hedberg.

Among the returning linebackers are seniors Aaron LaPointe (Elk River) and Chris Streit (Sauk Rapids), junior Matt McLagan (Minneapolis), sophomore David Kamin (Menomonee Falls, WI) and red-shirt Jim Siegle (Long Prairie). McLagan has been moved from the outside to the inside. He runs well and can add a lot to the inside. LaPointe really progressed as the season went on last year and will bring experience to the position. He is the top returning defender in terms of tackles, as he recorded 67 during the 2006 season. Kamin has moved from the outside to the inside. Streit is a very active player and Siegle was one of the better scout players last fall. On the outside will be junior Darius Dotch (St. Paul) and red-shirt Aaron Uthoff (Wickenburg, AZ)
