**Last Week:** The Huskies lost their second game of the season, 19-14 at Bemidji State. The loss ended a six game winning streak for the Huskies.

**In the Polls:** St. Cloud State dropped to #15 in the AFCA Division II poll and #13 in the D2football.com poll this week. The Huskies have held a national ranking all season. MSU Moorhead is not ranked this week.

**Super Region #3:** The third NCAA Super Region rankings came out on Monday. The Huskies dropped from #3 to #5.

**The MSUM Series:** This ranks among one of the two longest rivalries in Husky football as St. Cloud State and the Dragons have been playing each other since the 1920 season. The longest rivalry is with Winona State which began in 1919. The Huskies and Dragons have played 55 games with SCSU holding a 30-23-2 advantage in the series. St. Cloud State is 3-0 against MSUM since joining the NSIC. Prior to that the Dragons won three straight in 1979, 1980 and 1981.

**NSIC Contest:** Saturday's game will count towards the Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference (NSIC) North Division standings as well as the league's overall standings. The Huskies sport a 4-1 record and MSUM is 1-4 in the North.

**Home Win Streak Reaches 14:** St. Cloud State has won 14 straight games at Husky Stadium dating back to Oct. 29, 2009. The Huskies won the last four home games of the 2009 season and won all six in 2010. St. Cloud State is 32-12 all-time in games played in Husky Stadium since it opened for the 2004 season. The Huskies are 18-2 at home since the start of the 2008 season. St. Cloud State is 1-1 in NCAA playoff games at Husky stadium losing to the University of North Dakota in the 2004 first round, 20-17 in two overtimes and winning 42-28 Nov. 20, 2010 against Hillsdale College.

**First 2-0 Start with Underwood:** For the first time since the 2007 the Huskies started a season 2-0. It is the first 2-0 start for a Scott Underwood coached team. The Huskies were 1-1 in 2010 and 0-2 in 2009 and 2008.

**Underwood is 30/30 in Career Wins:**

With the Huskies win against UMD on Oct. 29, SCSU head coach Scott Underwood recorded his 30th win in the NSIC. On Oct. 22, Underwood recorded his 30th overall career win with the Huskies. He reached the milestone the fastest of all SCSU coaches reaching it in his fourth season. Underwood is 32-13 overall and 30-9 in NSIC games.

**Share of Title in Sight:** A Husky win on Saturday would give SCSU a share of the NSIC North Division title. A Husky win and a Minnesota State Mankato loss would give the Huskies a share of the overall NSIC title. The title would be the first NSIC crown for the Huskies and first conference title since SCSU shared the North Central Conference (NCC) title in 2002.

**Scoring on the Ground:** All five of the Huskies touchdowns against Minnesota Duluth were scored via the run. It marked the third most rushing TDs scored in a game by the Huskies this season. The most was seven against Minnesota, Crookston on Oct. 22 and six at Mary on Sept. 24. Running back Michael Walker scored two rushing touchdowns in the second quarter on runs of three and one-yard. Quarterback Phillip Klaphake scored the first TD of the game on a ten-yard run. A pair of long scoring runs were posted in the second half as running back Dante Steward ran one in from 48 yards out in the third quarter and wide receiver Damon Treak scored on a 25-yard run in the fourth quarter.

**Martin Boosts Husky D:** Senior linebacker Mark Martin (Milwaukee, Wis.) led the Huskies with a career high 14 tackles against Bemidji State last Saturday. He also forced and recovered a fumble that led to the Huskies first touchdown. It was the second fumble recovery of the season for Martin. Martin leads the Husky defense with 66 tackles. He has six tackles for loss, two quarterback sacks, one interception and two fumble recoveries. nine tackles against UMD on Saturday.

**Matthews Strong on D:** Junior corner back Marvin Matthews (Roseville) had a season high ten tackles against the Beavers. Matthews ranks second on the Husky defense in tackles with 60. He has 3.5 tackles for loss and is one of two Huskies with three interceptions this season. He is the team leader in pass break ups with six.

**Allery Gets 1,000 Receiving Yards:** Junior wide receiver Tyler Allery (Lakeville) caught two passes for 17 yards and surpassed the 1,000 yard career reception mark. Allery has 69 catches for 1,012 career yards and is the 15th player in school history to reach 1,000 yards. He ranks second in the team in receptions with 22 and receiving yards with 306 this season.

**Geiss Returns, Nears 2,000:** Junior runningback Brandon Geiss (Shorewood, Ill), after missing the three previous games scored the Huskies first touchdown, a four-yard run on SCSU's first possession of the game at Bemidji. He finished the game with four carries for 17 yards. Geiss is closing in on the 2,000 career yard rushing mark. In 26 career games, he has 395 carries for 1,943 yards. Geiss would become the eighth player in school history to record 2,000 yards.

**Walker Leads Team in Touchdowns:** Sophomore running back Michael Walker (Walworth, Wis.) has scored five touchdowns over the last three games, seven over the last five games and has at least one touchdown in seven of the Huskies ten games this season. He leads the team with ten rushing touchdowns and has a receiving TD. For the season, Walker has 110 carries for 593 yards.

**Without Fred:** Since All-American wide receiver Fred Williams finished his career last season the Huskies have used a stable of receivers in 2011. Six players have 14 or more catches this season.

**Treat Catches 4th TD of Season:** Sophomore wide receiver Damon Treat (Fairfield, Calif.) caught a 21-yard pass for a team leading fourth touchdown of the season against Bemidji State. Treat finished the game with five catches for 37 yards. He leads the team in receptions with 25 and has 275 receiving yards.

**Reception Leaders** Sophomore Damon Treat (Fairfield, Calif.) leads the team with 26 receptions and four touchdowns. Sophomore Eli Shoemaker (Graham, Wash.) leads the team with 379 receiving yards and has 21 catches and one touchdown. He made two receptions for 48 yards against the Beavers.

**FG Streak Ended:** Junior place kicker Tyler Aldridge (Woodbury) started the season eight of eight in field goals made until a fourth quarter miss against Northern State on Oct. 1 ended the streak. He booted a career long 46-yard field goal against Concordia University on Sept. 10. His previous long field goal attempt was a 42-yard connection on Oct. 30, 2010 at Minnesota Duluth.

**Pick Six:** The St. Cloud State defense picked off six passes in their 41-13 win over Concordia University, St. Paul on Sept. 10. Senior DB Tony Kubes (New Prague) and junior DB Marvin Matthews (Roseville) each had two interceptions. Kubes now has six career picks and Matthews five. Senior Joe Everson (Lakeville) collected his ninth career pick and sophomore Miky Woods (Brooklyn Park) grabbed his first collegiate INT.

**Top 10 in Scoring Defense:** This week the Huskies ranked #5 in NCAA Division II in scoring defense. The Huskies are holding their opponents to 15.20 points per game. They lead the NSIC in scoring defense.



Husky Stadium

2010 marked the seventh season of Husky Stadium. St. Cloud State is 28-11 at Husky Stadium since the 2004 season. The Huskies posted a 4-2 record at Husky Stadium in 2004, including a 0-1 mark in an NCAA playoff game in the new facility. The Huskies averaged 3,772 fans in the 4,198 seat facility in 2004, 3,961 in 2005, 3,936 in 2006, 2,742 in 2007, 4,004 in 2008, 4,112 in 2009, and 3,608 in 2010 (includes an NCAA playoff game). SCSU's first sell-out was on October 2, 2004 against the University of North Dakota.

**Minnesota State University Moorhead:** The Dragons enter the weekend with a 2-8 overall record and a 1-8 record in the NSIC.

**Last Season:** The Dragons posted a 2-9 overall record and finished 11th in the NSIC with a 2-8 record. MSUM finished sixth in the NSIC North with a mark of 1-5.

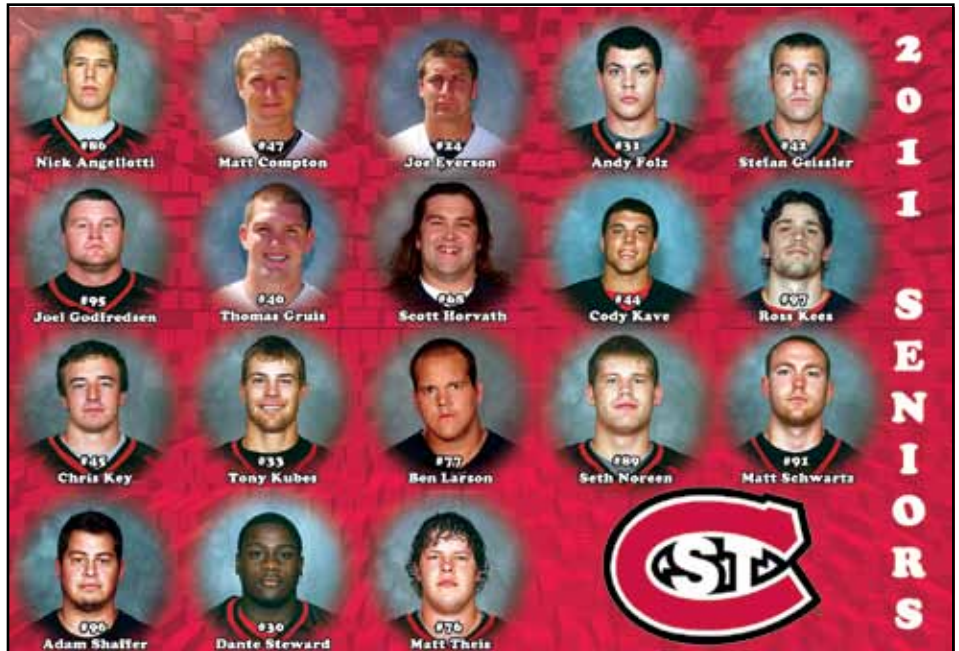
**Last Week:** After trailing Northern State University 21-14 at the half, the Dragons gave up 21 third quarter points and fell to the Wolves 42-21 in NSIC North Division play. MSUM had 332 yards of total offense in the game but gave up 464 yards to the Wolves. MSUM quarterback Kevin Koch completed 25 of 50 passes for 246 yards and two touchdowns.

**MSUM Leaders:** MSUM is led in rushing by E'Boni Lucious-West who has gained 501 yards on 111 carries and scored four touchdowns. Quarterback Kevin Koch has completed 182 of 328 passes for 2,012 yards and 17 touchdowns. Kendall Hendon leads the receiving corps with 61 catches for 827 yards and nine touchdowns. Defensively Jeff Schuette and Tyler Brody lead the Dragons. Schuette has 78 tackles and Brody 77 this season.

**Head Coach Steve Laqua:** MSUM head coach Steve Laqua is in his first season at the helm of the Dragons. He is the 17th head football coach in school history. Prior to joining the Dragons he was successful as head coach at Fargo Shanley High School. He has coached at the collegiate level as the running backs, tight end and punt team coach at North Dakota State from 2005 to 2007. In 2004 he was the offensive coordinator at the University of Minnesota, Crookston and he spent one season at St. Olaf College.

**2011 Senior Class Recognition:** Saturday's game marks the final regular season home game for the 18 members of the St. Cloud State senior class. These players have been instrumental in the continued success of Husky football, playing on four winning teams.

The 2011 senior class includes:

Tight end Nick Angellotti, punter Matt Compton, defensive back Joe Everson, running back Andy Folz, linebacker Stefan Geissler, defensive end Joel Godfredsen, linebacker Thomas Gruis (captain), offensive center Scott Horvath, linebacker Cody Kave, defensive end Ross Kees, linebacker Chris Key, defensive back Tony Kubes (captain), right guard Ben Larson, tight end Seth Noreen, defensive tackle Matt Schwartz, defensive end Adam Shaffer, running back Dante Steward and right tackle Matt Theis (captain).

**Record Book Gets an Update:** The Huskies broke or tied five single game records against Minnesota, Crookston on Oct. 22. SCSU gained a school record 770 yards of total offense including a single game record of 420 yards passing. The old record for total offense was 686 yards gained against Nebraska Omaha in 2002. The old mark for most yards gained passing was 379 set against UMC during the 2003 season. The Huskies also set a single game record for most first downs with 37 surpassing the old mark of 33 set against Nebraska Omaha in 2003. St. Cloud State tied records for most first downs rushing with 22 and most PAT's with nine.

**Bemidji State Recap: Bemidji, Minn.** – Bemidji State University upset #6 St. Cloud State 19-14 in NSIC action last Saturday.

The loss ended a six game winning streak for the Huskies this season and a seven game win streak against Bemidji State. The Huskies are 3-1 against BSU since joining the NSIC. The last Bemidji State win was during the 1977 season, a 28-7 victory when both teams were playing in the Northern Intercollegiate Conference (NIC).

The Huskies finished the game with 359 yards of total offense. Sophomore quarterback Phillip Klaphake (Princeton) rushed for 83 yards and completed 14 of 30 passes for 182 yards and one touchdown.

Junior running back Brandon Geiss (Shorewood, Ill.) rushed for the first touchdown of the game, a four-yard jaunt and finished the game with 17 yards rushing. Sophomore running back Michael Walker (Walworth, Wis.) rushed for 76 yards on 18 carries.

Sophomore wide receiver Damon Treat (Fairfield, Calif.) caught five passes for 37 yards and one touchdown.

Senior linebacker Mark Martin (Milwaukee, Wis.) led the Husky defense with 14 tackles. He also forced and recovered a fumble on Bemidji State's first drive of the game.

Bemidji State was led by quarterback Lance Rongstad who scored ran for a touchdown and passed for a second. Rongstad finished the game with 69 yards rushing and completed 15 of 23 passes for 126 yards.

The Beavers Brody Scheff led all players with 19 tackles and also forced and recovered a fumble.

**Scott Underwood** (Augustana College, 1988) was introduced as Head Coach of Husky Football on March 25, 2008. He is the 12th head football coach in the history of Husky football and had been the Huskies defensive coordinator since 2001.

In his three seasons at the helm, he has compiled a 24-11 overall record. He has guided the Huskies to a 22-7 record in Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference (NSIC) games.

In 2008, his first season at the helm, Underwood guided the Huskies to a 7-4 overall record, fourth place in the NSIC with a 7-3 mark and second place in the NSIC North Division with a

5-1 record. The Huskies had a senior class of 25 players and the seven wins marked the most victories for the Huskies since winning eight games in 2005.

The 2009 season was almost identical to 2008. The Huskies were 7-4 overall, tied for third overall in the NSIC with a 7-3 record, and placed second in the NSIC North with a 5-1 mark. The Huskies played a non-conference game at the University of Maine and nearly defeated the Division I Black Bears, losing 34-27 in overtime.

2010 was an historic season for Husky football. St. Cloud State played a school record 13 games and tied the school record for wins with 10-3 mark. For the third time in school history, the team advanced to the NCAA Division II Playoffs. The Huskies won the first game on their home turf, 42-28 over Hillsdale College. In the second round, St. Cloud State traveled to NSIC rival Minnesota Duluth. The Bulldogs won that game, 20-17 in overtime and went on to win the national championship.

The Husky defense, led by Underwood ranked among the best in the North Central Conference in the last seven seasons of the league. In 2002, SCSU led the NCC in rushing defense, giving up 77.1 yards per game. Ten defensive players have earned All-North Central Conference first team honors with Underwood, including Charlie Cosgrove, the 2005 Defensive Lineman of the Year. The Huskies were co-winners of the NCC title in 2002 and hosted a first round NCAA Division II playoff game in 2004, the year that Husky Stadium opener.

Success has followed Underwood at each of his coaching stops. Prior to joining the St. Cloud State staff in 2001, Underwood was the inside linebackers coach at the University of North Dakota for four seasons, and coached two NCAA playoff teams. From 1993 to 1996, he served as the defensive coordinator at the University of Sioux Falls. The University of Sioux Falls advanced to the playoffs during three of those seasons and won the NAIA Division II National Championship in 1996.

Underwood began his coaching career at his alma mater, Augustana College, where he spent five seasons as the defensive secondary coach, following a four-year career at defensive back for the Vikings from 1984 to 1988. In 1988, Underwood coached in an NCAA playoff game. In 1989, with Underwood as an assistant coach, the Vikings advanced to the NCAA playoffs, losing to St. Cloud State at Selke Field.

A native of Marion, Iowa, Underwood has a bachelor's degree in social sciences from Augustana College and a master's degree in health, physical education, and recreation from the University of South Dakota.
