NSIC CHAMPIONS!!: Last Saturday, St. Cloud State tied for the NSIC overall and North Division Championship with a 47-14 home win over MSU Moorhead. The win capped an undefeated regular season on the Huskies home turf. The Huskies share the overall title with Minnesota Duluth and Minnesota State University, Mankato. UMD and SCSU share the NSIC North Division title. The title is the first NSIC Championship for the Huskies and the first conference title since St. Cloud State tied for the North Central Conference (NCC) title in 2002. The Huskies won the 1989 NCC title and prior to that won 16 Northern Intercollegiate Conference (NIC) Championships from 1926 to 1970.

Super Region #3 Pairings: Colorado State University, Pueblo and the University of Nebraska-Kearney are the #1 and #2 seeds, respectively in the Super Region #3 and received a first round bye. The Huskies at #3 play #6 Wayne State with the winner advancing to play #2 Nebraska-Kearney. Minnesota Duluth is the #4 seed and will host #5 Saginaw Valley with the winner headed to CSU-Pueblo.

In the Polls: St. Cloud State is ranked #14 in the AFCA Division II poll and #12 in the D2football.com poll this week. The Huskies have held a national ranking all season. Wayne State received votes in the AFCA poll.

Wayne State Series: This is the first football game to be played between these two teams.

Huskies NCAA Playoff History: St. Cloud State is 2-3 all-time in NCAA playoff games and have made four post season appearances. Of note, SCSU has hosted a first round game in each of their four NCAA appearances and are 2-1 in those games. The Huskies first appearance in the NCAA tournament was in 1989. That year, SCSU posted a 10-2 overall record and won its first ever North Central Conference (NCC) title. The Huskies under then head coach Noel Martin, hosted Augustana College in the first round at Selke Field. The Huskies won that game, 27-20, and hosted Mississippi College in the quarterfinal the following week. Mississippi College jumped out to a 17-0 lead, went on to win the game 55-24 and were the eventual national champions in 1989. The Huskies earned the #4 seed in the 2004 NCAA Division II Northwest Region and hosted the University of North Dakota in the first round. UND won the game 20-17 in double overtime on a 32-yard Jeff Glas field goal at Husky Stadium. In 2010 the Huskies faced Hillsdale College and Husky stadium in a first round playoff game and posted a 42-28 win. St. Cloud State went on the road for the second round at #1 ranked Minnesota Duluth. The Bulldogs kicked a field goal to win the game, 20-17 in overtime. UMD went on to win the national championship.

Home Win Streak Reaches 15: St. Cloud State has won 15 straight games at Husky Stadium dating back to Oct. 29, 2009. The Huskies won the last four home games of the 2009 season and won all six in 2010. St. Cloud State is 33-12 all-time in games played in Husky Stadium since it opened for the 2004 season. The Huskies are 19-2 at home since the start of the 2008 season. St. Cloud State is 1-1 in NCAA playoff games at Husky stadium losing to the University of North Dakota in the 2004 first round, 20-17 in two overtimes and winning 42-28 Nov. 20, 2010 against Hillsdale College.

First 2-0 Start with Underwood: For the first time since the 2007 the Huskies started a season 2-0. It is the first 2-0 start for a Scott Underwood coached team. The Huskies were 1-1 in 2010 and 0-2 in 2009 and 2008.

Underwood is 30/30 in Career Wins: With the Huskies win against UMD on Oct. 29, SCSU head coach Scott Underwood recorded his 30th win in the NSIC. On Oct. 22, Underwood recorded his 30th overall career win with the Huskies. He reached the milestone the fastest of all SCSU coaches reaching it in his fourth season. Underwood is 33-13 overall and 31-9 in NSIC games.

Fourth in Scoring Defense: This week the Huskies ranked #4 in NCAA Division II in scoring defense. The Huskies are holding their opponents to 15.09 points per game. They lead the NSIC in scoring defense. Sophomore Chad Peterson (Winona) ranks 28th in NCAA DII in punt returns with 11.11 yards per return. He also leads the NSIC in that category. Sophomore QB Phillip Klaphake (Princeton) ranks 29th in passing efficiency with a rating of 144.46.

Klaphake Reaches 4,000 Career Passing Yards/1,000 Career Rushing Yards:

Sophomore quarterback Phillip Klaphake (Princeton) is the first Husky quarterback to pass for over 4,000 yards and rush for over 1,000 yards in a career. He went over the 4,000 yard passing mark on Oct. 22 against Minnesota, Crookston and surpassed the 1,000 yard career rushing mark on Nov. 5 at Bemidji State. Against UMC, he threw for a career high 342 yards, completing 14 of 21 passes and connecting on an 82-yard TD strike, and he only played in the first half. He currently has 4,669 career passing yard making him the eighth SCSU quarterback to reach 4,000 yards. He rushed for a season high 83 yards against Bemidji State to go over the 1,000 yard rushing mark. In 22 games, Klaphake has rushed for 1,144 yards.

Allery Gets 1,000 Receiving Yards: Junior wide receiver Tyler Allery (Lakeville) went over the 1,000 yard career reception mark when he caught two passes for 17 yards against Bemidji State on Nov. 5. Allery has 71 catches for 1,041 career yards and is the 15th player in school history to reach 1,000 yards. He ranks second in the team in receptions with 22 and receiving yards with 335 this season.

Geiss Nears 2,000: Junior runningback Brandon Geiss (Shorewood, Ill), who has missed four games this season due to injury is closing in on 2,000 yard career rushing mark. In 26 career games, he has 395 carries for 1,943 yards. Geiss would become the eighth player in school history to record 2,000 yards.

Steward Tops the Ground Game: Senior running back Dante Steward (Milwaukee, Wis.) has flirted with the 100 yard rushing mark in two of the last three games that he has played this season. He ran for 98 yards on Oct. 15 and 90 yards on Oct. 29, but has been sidelined with an injury. Steward leads the Huskies in rushing with 684 yards on 106 carries. This season he has gone over the 100-yard rushing mark twice as he gained 134 yards at Mary and 141 yards against Minnesota State.

He has five 100-yard rushing games in his career with the Huskies. Steward's performance against MSU Mankato on Oct. 8 put him over the 1,500 yard career rushing mark. Steward has 1,782 career rushing yards and became the 15th Husky to reach the 1,500 yard plateau. He currently ranks 11th on the all-time rushing chart.

Walker is a Scoring Machine: Sophomore running back Michael Walker (Walworth, Wis.) rushed for three touchdowns in the Huskies regular season finale last week. He has rushed for eight touchdowns over the last four games including another three-touchdown game on Oct. 22. Walker has 126 carries for 666 yards and 13 touchdowns this season.

Martin is a Defensive Boost: Senior linebacker Mark Martin (Milwaukee, Wis.) leads the Huskies with 69 tackles this season. He surpassed the 100 career tackle milestone earlier this season and had a career high 14 tackles at Bemidji State on Nov. 5.

Matthews Leads in Solo Stops: Junior corner back Marvin Matthews (Roseville) leads the Huskies in solo stops with 44 and is second in tackles with 63. had a season high ten tackles against the Beavers. He has 4.5 tackles for loss and is one of two Huskies with three interceptions this season. He is the team leader in pass break ups with six. Matthews has 170 career tackles and six career picks.

Kubes Over 200 Career Tackles: Senior defensive back Tony Kubes (New Prague) has 225 career tackles including 48 this season. He ranks in the top 20 in career tackles and is tied for ninth on the all-time tackles for loss chart with 26.0.



Husky Stadium

2010 marked the seventh season of Husky Stadium. St. Cloud State is 28-11 at Husky Stadium since the 2004 season. The Huskies posted a 4-2 record at Husky Stadium in 2004, including a 0-1 mark in an NCAA playoff game in the new facility. The Huskies averaged 3,772 fans in the 4,198 seat facility in 2004, 3,961 in 2005, 3,936 in 2006, 2,742 in 2007, 4,004 in 2008, 4,112 in 2009, and 3,608 in 2010 (includes an NCAA playoff game). SCSU's first sell-out was on October 2, 2004 against the University of North Dakota.

Wayne State University Warriors: Wayne State University is located in Detroit, Michigan. The Warriors compete in the Great Lakes Intercollegiate Conference (GLIAC). The Warriors finished the regular season with an 8-3 overall record. Wayne State posted a 7-3 GLIAC record to finish second in the South Division standings. Hillsdale College, the Huskies first round NCAA opponent in 2010 won the GLIAC with an 8-2 record and did not receive a bid to the NCAA tournament.

The Season: Wayne State rattled off six straight wins to start the 2011 season and have lost three of their last five games including a 43-42 overtime loss to Findlay in the final game of the regular season last Saturday. The Warriors have played two overtime games this season and are 1-1 in those games. Their three losses have been by a combined 12 points.

WSU Leaders: Senior Josh Renel and sophomore running back Toney Davis lead the Warriors ground attack. Renel has 1,051 yards rushing and 11 touchdowns this season. He also averages 16.1 yards per game in punt returns and 21.7 yards in kick returns. Toney has scored 13 touchdowns and rushed for 869 yards. Junior quarterback Mickey Mohner has completed 140 of 248 passes for 2,245 yards and 21 touchdowns. He has thrown six interceptions this season. His top target senior

Troy Burrell has caught nearly half of Mohner's passes. Burrell has 65 catches for 1,285 yards and 12 touchdowns. On the defensive side of the ball is senior Jeremy Jones who has a team high six interceptions and leads the team in tackles with 64. Sophomore Ed Viverette is the team leader with 9.5 tackles for loss and Nores Fradi has a team high six quarterback sacks in 2011.

Head Coach: Paul Winters is in his eighth season as head coach of the Warriors. His first team posted a 1-9 record in 2004. Since then his teams have posted five winning seasons including four straight. In 2010 the Warriors posted a school record in wins with nine and won the South Division in the GLIAC. Winters brings a 44-42 record into Saturday's NCAA playoff game.

Husky Notes Continued:

Godfredsen Breaks into Top 20 in TFL: Senior defensive end Joel Godfredsen (Armstrong, Iowa) has 20 tackles for loss which ranks him 20th on the all-time chart. Godfredsen has 6.0 tackles for loss this season and 22 tackles.

Aldridge Boots a Career Long: Junior place kicker Tyler Aldridge (Woodbury) booted a career long 46-yard field goal against Concordia University on Sept. 10. His previous long field goal attempt was a 42-yard connection on Oct. 30, 2010 at Minnesota Duluth. He started the season eight of eight in field goals made until a fourth quarter miss against Northern State on Oct. 1 ended the streak. Aldridge is 11 of 14 in field goal attempts this season and 43 of 45 in PAT's.

Pick Six: The St. Cloud State defense picked off six passes in their 41-13 win over Concordia University, St. Paul on Sept. 10. Senior DB Tony Kubus (New Prague) and junior DB Marvin Matthews (Roseville) each had two interceptions. Kubus now has six career picks and Matthews five. Senior Joe Everson (Lakeville) collected his ninth career pick and sophomore Miky Woods (Brooklyn Park) grabbed his first collegiate INT.

Record Book Gets an Update: The Huskies broke or tied five single game records against Minnesota, Crookston on Oct. 22. SCSU gained a school record 770 yards of total offense including a single game record of 420 yards passing. The old record for total offense was 686 yards gained against Nebraska Omaha in 2002. The old mark for most yards gained passing was 379 set against UMC during the 2003 season. The Huskies also set a single game record for most first downs with 37 surpassing the old mark of 33 set against Nebraska Omaha in 2003. St. Cloud State tied records for most first downs rushing with 22 and most PAT's with nine.

NSIC Coach of the Year Scott Underwood: Husky head coach Scott Underwood was named the NSIC Coach of the Year on Nov. 14. In his fourth season as head coach of the Huskies Underwood has four winning seasons, a Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference (NSIC) title and back-to-back NCAA playoff appearances to his credit. Underwood recorded his 30th career win with the Huskies on Oct. 15, reaching the milestone the fastest of all SCSU coaches. In addition he recorded his 30th NSIC win in a victory over Minnesota Duluth on Oct. 29. Underwood has a 33-13 career record with the Huskies, is 31-9 in NSIC games and 20-4 in NSIC North Division games.

Huskies Land 22 Players on All-Conference Team: Led by two three-time All-Conference selections, St. Cloud State landed 22 players on the 2011 NSIC All-Conference team including eight first team picks. Seniors Matt Theis and Tony Kubes were named All-Conference for the third time in their careers. Theis, a right tackle is a first team selection in 2011 and 2009 and was a second team player in 2010. A defensive back, Tony Kubes is a 2011 and 2010 first team pick and a 2009 second team selection.

Scott Underwood (Augustana College, 1988) was introduced as Head Coach of Husky Football on March 25, 2008. He is the 12th head football coach in the history of Husky football and had been the Huskies defensive coordinator since 2001.

In his three seasons at the helm, he has compiled a 24-11 overall record. He has guided the Huskies to a 22-7 record in Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference (NSIC) games.

In 2008, his first season at the helm, Underwood guided the Huskies to a 7-4 overall record, fourth place in the NSIC with a 7-3 mark and second place in the NSIC North Division with a

5-1 record. The Huskies had a senior class of 25 players and the seven wins marked the most victories for the Huskies since winning eight games in 2005.

The 2009 season was almost identical to 2008. The Huskies were 7-4 overall, tied for third overall in the NSIC with a 7-3 record, and placed second in the NSIC North with a 5-1 mark. The Huskies played a non-conference game at the University of Maine and nearly defeated the Division I Black Bears, losing 34-27 in overtime.

2010 was an historic season for Husky football. St. Cloud State played a school record 13 games and tied the school record for wins with 10-3 mark. For the third time in school history, the team advanced to the NCAA Division II Playoffs. The Huskies won the first game on their home turf, 42-28 over Hillsdale College. In the second round, St. Cloud State traveled to NSIC rival Minnesota Duluth. The Bulldogs won that game, 20-17 in overtime and went on to win the national championship.

The Husky defense, led by Underwood ranked among the best in the North Central Conference in the last seven seasons of the league. In 2002, SCSU led the NCC in rushing defense, giving up 77.1 yards per game. Ten defensive players have earned All-North Central Conference first team honors with Underwood, including Charlie Cosgrove, the 2005 Defensive Lineman of the Year. The Huskies were co-winners of the NCC title in 2002 and hosted a first round NCAA Division II playoff game in 2004, the year that Husky Stadium opener.

Success has followed Underwood at each of his coaching stops. Prior to joining the St. Cloud State staff in 2001, Underwood was the inside linebackers coach at the University of North Dakota for four seasons, and coached two NCAA playoff teams. From 1993 to 1996, he served as the defensive coordinator at the University of Sioux Falls. The University of Sioux Falls advanced to the playoffs during three of those seasons and won the NAIA Division II National Championship in 1996.

Underwood began his coaching career at his alma mater, Augustana College, where he spent five seasons as the defensive secondary coach, following a four-year career at defensive back for the Vikings from 1984 to 1988. In 1988, Underwood coached in an NCAA playoff game. In 1989, with Underwood as an assistant coach, the Vikings advanced to the NCAA playoffs, losing to St. Cloud State at Selke Field.

A native of Marion, Iowa, Underwood has a bachelor's degree in social sciences from Augustana College and a master's degree in health, physical education, and recreation from the University of South Dakota.
