Last Week: The Huskies posted their second straight road victory in a 66-13 win at Minnesota, Crookston.

In the Polls: St. Cloud State moved up to #11 in the AFCA Division II poll and #8 in the D2football.com poll. The Huskies have held a national ranking all season. Like the Huskies, Minnesota Duluth has been in the national rankings all season, starting the year at #1. This week the Bulldogs are ranked #6 in both the AFCA and D2Football.com polls.

Super Region #3: The first NCAA Super Region rankings came out on Monday. The Bulldogs are ranked #3 in the region and SCSU is ranked #5. Colorado State-Pueblo is the #1 team in the region.

The Minnesota Duluth Series: This closely contested rivalry began in 1933. Saturday's game marks the 44th meeting between the two teams with St. Cloud State holding a 22-21 advantage. Minnesota Duluth has won seven straight against the Huskies including two games last season, a 40-17 regular season win and a 20-17 overtime win in the second round of the NCAA football playoffs, both in Duluth. The last time Duluth played at St. Cloud was in 2008, a 38-21 Bulldog victory. The last Husky win was in 2004 a 28-0 victory at Duluth.

NSIC Contest: Saturday's game will count towards the Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference (NSIC) North Division standings as well as the league's overall standings. The Bulldogs are 4-0 in the North while the Huskies sport a 3-0 record.

Home Win Streak Reaches 13: St. Cloud State has won 13 straight games at Husky Stadium dating back to Oct. 29, 2009. The Huskies won the last four home games of the 2009 season and won all six in 2010. St. Cloud State is 31-12 all-time in games played in Husky Stadium since it opened for the 2004 season. The Huskies are 18-2 at home since the start of the 2008 season. St. Cloud State is 1-1 in NCAA playoff games at Husky stadium losing to the University of North Dakota in the 2004 first round, 20-17 in two overtimes and winning 42-28 Nov. 20, 2010 against Hillsdale College.

First 2-0 Start with Underwood: For the first time since the 2007 the Huskies started a season 2-0. It is the first 2-0 start for a Scott

Underwood coached team. The Huskies were 1-1 in 2010 and 0-2 in 2009 and 2008.

Underwood Gains 30th Career Win: With the Huskies win at SMSU on Oct. 22, St. Cloud State head coach Scott Underwood recorded his 30th career win with the Huskies. He reached the milestone the fastest of all SCSU coaches reaching it in his fourth season. Underwood is also closing in on 30 NSIC wins. Heading into Saturday's contest with UMD, Underwood has a 29-8 record in NSIC league games.

Klaphake Has Record Return, Reaches 4,000 Career Passing Yards: Sophomore quarterback Phillip Klaphake (Princeton) returned to the starting line-up last Saturday after missing two games to injury. His return was impressive as he threw for a career high 342 yards, completing 14 of 21 passes and connecting on an 82-yard TD strike, and he only played in the first half. He went over the 4,000 career passing mark against UMC and has 4,207 career passing yards making him the eighth SCSU quarterback to reach 4,000 yards. For the season, Klaphake has completed 92 of 135 passes for 1,289 yards and seven touchdowns.

Folz Has Career Rushing Day: Senior running back Andy Folz (Spring Grove) rushed for a career high 101 yard on 13 carries and scored a touchdown on a 14-yard run at UMC. He joins Dante Steward, Michael Walker and Brandon Geiss as 100-yard rushers this season.

Steward Flirts With 100: For the second straight week senior running back Dante Steward (Milwaukee, Wis.) flirted with the 100 yard rushing mark. He had 13 carries for 75 yards that followed his game at SMSU where he rushed for 98 yards on 20 carries. Steward leads the Huskies in rushing with 594 yards on 99 carries. This season he has gone over the 100-yard rushing mark twice as he gained 134 yards at Mary and 141 yards against Minnesota State. He has five 100-yard rushing games in his career with the Huskies.

Over 1,500 Yards for Steward: Steward's performance against MSU Mankato put him over the 1,500 yard career rushing mark. Steward has 1,692 career rushing yards and became the 15th Husky to reach the 1,500 yard plateau.

Walker for Three: Sophomore running back Michael Walker (Walworth, Wis.) scored a career high three touchdowns on runs of 20, one and one-yard in the win at UMC. He finished the game with ten carries for 52 yards.

Without Fred: Since All-American wide receiver Fred Williams finished his career last season the Huskies have used a stable of receivers in 2011. Six players have 12 or more catches this season.

Peterson for 82: Sophomore receiver/return man Chad Peterson (Winona) had a career long 82-yard touchdown reception and finished the UMC game with two catches for 91 yards.

Reception Leaders Sophomore Damon Treat (Fairfield, Calif.) leads the team with 21 receptions and three touchdowns. Sophomore Eli Shoemaker (Graham, Wash.) leads the team with 296 receiving yards and has 17 catches and one touchdown.

FG Streak Ended: Junior place kicker Tyler Aldridge (Woodbury) started the season eight of eight in field goals made until a fourth quarter miss against Northern State on Oct. 1 ended the streak. He booted a career long 46-yard field goal against Concordia University on Sept. 10. His previous long field goal attempt was a 42-yard connection on Oct. 30, 2010 at Minnesota Duluth.

Allery Nears 1,000 Receiving Yards: Junior wide receiver Tyler Allery (Lakeville) is 50 yards away from the 1,000 career mark. He caught two passes for 61 yards last week and has caught 16 passes for 244 yards this season. For his career, Allery has 63 catches for 950 yards and seven touchdowns. He would become the 15th player in school history to reach the 1,000 yard mark.

Geiss on the Run, Nears 2,000: Junior running-back Brandon Geiss (Shorewood, Ill) is closing

in on the 2,000 career yard rushing mark. In 25 career games, he has 391 carries for 1,926 yards. Geiss would become the eighth player in school history to record 2,000 yards. He missed the last two games due to an injury.

Williams Leads in Tackles at UMC: Junior defensive back Wade Williams (Waupun, Wis.) led the Huskies with a team high seven tackles against UMC. The seven tackles equaled his career high. The St. Cloud State defense recovered two fumbles, intercepted one pass and held the league's leading rusher Richard Haley to 74 yards on 23 carries.

Matthews and Martin Lead D: Senior linebacker Mark Martin (Milwaukee, Wis.) and junior defensive back Marvin Matthews (Roseville) lead the Huskies in tackles this week. Both collected four tackles against UMC. This season Martin has 43 tackles including four tackles for loss, two quarterback sacks and two forced fumbles. Matthews 43 total tackles including a team high 35 solo stops and three interceptions.

Bestgen Gets First Pick, Leads in Sacks: Sophomore MIKE linebacker Todd Bestgen (Rochester) collected his first collegiate interception at UMC last week. He leads the Husky defense in quarterback sacks with three for a loss of 25 yards this season.

Pick Six: The St. Cloud State defense picked off six passes in their 41-13 win over Concordia University, St. Paul on Sept. 10. Senior DB Tony Kubes (New Prague) and junior DB Marvin Matthews (Roseville) each had two interceptions. Kubes now has six career picks and Matthews five. Senior Joe Everson (Lakeville) collected his ninth career pick and sophomore Miky Woods (Brooklyn Park) grabbed his first collegiate INT.



Husky Stadium

2010 marked the seventh season of Husky Stadium. St. Cloud State is 28-11 at Husky Stadium since the 2004 season. The Huskies posted a 4-2 record at Husky Stadium in 2004, including a 0-1 mark in an NCAA playoff game in the new facility. The Huskies averaged 3,772 fans in the 4,198 seat facility in 2004, 3,961 in 2005, 3,936 in 2006, 2,742 in 2007, 4,004 in 2008, 4,112 in 2009, and 3,608 in 2010 (includes an NCAA playoff game). SCSU's first sell-out was on October 2, 2004 against the University of North Dakota.

Minnesota Duluth: The University of Minnesota Duluth Bulldogs enter the week with a 7-1 overall record and a 6-1 mark in the NSIC.

Last Season: The Bulldogs posted an unprecedented 15-0 record on the way to their second NCAA Division II National title in three years. UMD won the National title in 2008. In addition, the Bulldogs won their third straight NSIC title in 2010.

Last Week: In front of a record 6,044 fans, the Bulldogs defeated Northern State 37-6 in UMD's Homecoming game last Saturday. The Bulldogs led 16-6 at halftime and ran off 21 unanswered points in the second half for the win. Running back Zach Hulce came off the bench and gained 85 yards on eight carries and scored two touchdowns. Brian Lucas added 91 yards on 19 attempts and scored a touchdown. The UMD defense held Northern State to 166 yards of total offense.

Leaders: Brian Lucas and Austin Sikorski have been leading the Bulldogs ground attack this season. Lucas has 103 carries for 594 yards and four touchdowns. Sikorski has 583 yards on 108 carries and has scored seven touchdowns. Chase Vogler quarterbacks the Bulldogs. He has complete 104 passes for 1,121 yards and eight touchdowns. He has rushed for 335 yards and three touchdowns. Zach Zweifel is the leading receiver for the Bulldogs. He has 32 catches for 399 yards and one touchdown. Defensively, Colby Ring leads the team with 64 tackles. Derrick Zappa has a team high nine tackles for loss and four quarterback sacks.

Head Coach Bob Nielson: Bob Nielson is in his ninth season as head coach of the Bulldogs. He has won two NCAA Division II National titles, four NSIC titles including three straight. In eight seasons at the helm of the Bulldogs he has posted a 79-21 record and has an 18-year career coaching mark of 149-54-1.

By Comparison: St. Cloud State boasts the top scoring offense in the NSIC (overall games) with 34.5 points per game while UMD is first in scoring defense allowing 15.6 points a game. The Huskies are second in scoring defense with 15.8 points allowed.

Minnesota Duluth leads the league in rushing offense with 251.8 yards per game. The Huskies are fourth at 235.5 yards. The Bulldogs are second in rushing defense allowing 91.9 yards per game and the Huskies are third allowing 119.0 yards.

St. Cloud State leads the league in total offense with 449.5 yards per game and Minnesota Duluth is the leader in total defense allowing 272.2 yards per game.

Record Book Gets an Update: The Huskies broke or tied five single game records against Minnesota, Crookston on Oct. 22. SCSU gained a school record 770 yards of total offense including a single game record of 420 yards passing. The old record for total offense was 686 yards gained against Nebraska Omaha in 2002. The old mark for most yards gained passing was 379 set against UMC during the 2003 season. The Huskies also set a single game record for most first downs with 37 surpassing the old mark of 33 set against Nebraska Omaha in 2003. St. Cloud State tied records for most first downs rushing with 22 and most PAT's with nine.

Minnesota, Crookston Recap: Crookston, Minn. – The 14th-ranked St. Cloud State University football team gained a school record 770 yards of total offense in a 66-13 Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference (NSIC) win over Minnesota, Crookston at Ed Widseth Field in Crookston Saturday afternoon.

St. Cloud State scored on every possession and tallied nine touchdowns, one TD shy of the single game school record. The Huskies gained a single game record 420 yards passing and rushed for 350 yards.

Sophomore quarterback Phillip Klaphake (Princeton) completed 14 of 21 passes for a career high 342 yards. His big play of the day was an 82-yard touchdown strike to sophomore receiver Chad Peterson (Winona). Junior quarterback Brad Meade (Chippewa Falls) threw for 78 yards including an eight-yard TD strike to senior tight end Nick Angellotti (Wauconda, Ill.)

Senior running back Andy Folz (Spring Grove) had a career high 101 yards rushing and one touchdown. Sophomore Michael Walker (Walworth, Wis.) scored three touchdowns on runs of 20, one and one-yard and finished the day with ten carries for 52 yards. Senior Dante Steward (Milwaukee, Wis.) rushed for 75 yards and two touchdowns on runs of one and three-yards.

The St. Cloud State defense recovered two fumbles, intercepted one pass and held the league's leading rusher Richard Haley to 74 yards on 23 carries. Junior defensive back Wade Williams (Waupun, Wis.) had a team high seven tackles for the Huskies.

Scott Underwood (Augustana College, 1988) was introduced as Head Coach of Husky Football on March 25, 2008. He is the 12th head football coach in the history of Husky football and had been the Huskies defensive coordinator since 2001.

In his three seasons at the helm, he has compiled a 24-11 overall record. He has guided the Huskies to a 22-7 record in Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference (NSIC) games.

In 2008, his first season at the helm, Underwood guided the Huskies to a 7-4 overall record, fourth place in the NSIC with a 7-3 mark and second place in the NSIC North Division with a

5-1 record. The Huskies had a senior class of 25 players and the seven wins marked the most victories for the Huskies since winning eight games in 2005.

The 2009 season was almost identical to 2008. The Huskies were 7-4 overall, tied for third overall in the NSIC with a 7-3 record, and placed second in the NSIC North with a 5-1 mark. The Huskies played a non-conference game at the University of Maine and nearly defeated the Division I Black Bears, losing 34-27 in overtime.

2010 was an historic season for Husky football. St. Cloud State played a school record 13 games and tied the school record for wins with 10-3 mark. For the third time in school history, the team advanced to the NCAA Division II Playoffs. The Huskies won the first game on their home turf, 42-28 over Hillsdale College. In the second round, St. Cloud State traveled to NSIC rival Minnesota Duluth. The Bulldogs won that game, 20-17 in overtime and went on to win the national championship.

The Husky defense, led by Underwood ranked among the best in the North Central Conference in the last seven seasons of the league. In 2002, SCSU led the NCC in rushing defense, giving up 77.1 yards per game. Ten defensive players have earned All-North Central Conference first team honors with Underwood, including Charlie Cosgrove, the 2005 Defensive Lineman of the Year. The Huskies were co-winners of the NCC title in 2002 and hosted a first round NCAA Division II playoff game in 2004, the year that Husky Stadium opener.

Success has followed Underwood at each of his coaching stops. Prior to joining the St. Cloud State staff in 2001, Underwood was the inside linebackers coach at the University of North Dakota for four seasons, and coached two NCAA playoff teams. From 1993 to 1996, he served as the defensive coordinator at the University of Sioux Falls. The University of Sioux Falls advanced to the playoffs during three of those seasons and won the NAIA Division II National Championship in 1996.

Underwood began his coaching career at his alma mater, Augustana College, where he spent five seasons as the defensive secondary coach, following a four-year career at defensive back for the Vikings from 1984 to 1988. In 1988, Underwood coached in an NCAA playoff game. In 1989, with Underwood as an assistant coach, the Vikings advanced to the NCAA playoffs, losing to St. Cloud State at Selke Field.

A native of Marion, Iowa, Underwood has a bachelor's degree in social sciences from Augustana College and a master's degree in health, physical education, and recreation from the University of South Dakota.
