**NSIC Contest:** The St. Cloud State University football team will play its final regular season game on the road as the Huskies travel to Minnesota State University, Mankato for a Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference game on Saturday, Nov. 8. The kick-off is scheduled for 1:00 p.m. at Blakeslee Stadium

(7,000) on the MSU campus. To the winner goes the Traveling Training Kit.

**For the Record:** St. Cloud State enters the game with a 7-3 overall record and a 7-2 NSIC record. The Huskies finished second in the North Division of the NSIC standings with a 5-1 record. Minnesota State University brings an 8-2 overall and 8-1 NSIC record into the game. The Mavericks tied for the South Division NSIC title with Wayne State, sporting a 5-1 record.

**Series Record:** The Husky/Mavericks rivalry is 72 games strong and the teams have been playing each other since the 1923 season. St. Cloud State holds a 38-30-4 advantage in the series. The Huskies have won five straight games in the series, including last year's 27-13 victory in Mankato. The last MSU win was in 2002, 41-40 in Mankato.

**Traveling Training Kit on the Line:** The winner of the St. Cloud State/Minnesota State match up on Saturday will gain possession of the Travel Training Kit. The kit features the Husky logo in red on one side the MSU logo in purple on the other side and is awarded annually to the winning team. The teams began playing for the "Traveling Training Kit" in 1978. In 2004, Jeff Merron of ESPN.com compiled a top ten list featuring the "Most Bizarre College Football Rivalry Trophy and the Traveling Training Kit ranked second on that list.

**HUSKY COACHING STAFF**

**SCSU Head Coach Scott Underwood:** Scott Underwood (Augustana College, 1988) was introduced as Head Coach of Husky Football on March 25, 2008.

Underwood had served as the acting head coach of the Huskies since December and had been the defensive coordinator/recruiting coordinator/defensive backs coach since 2001.

Underwood is the 12th head football coach in the history of the program and replaces Randy Hedberg, who coached the Huskies from 1999 to 2007, and is currently a member of the Southern Illinois University football coaching staff.

The Husky defense, led by Underwood has ranked among the best in the North Central Conference for the last seven seasons. In 2002, SCSU led the NCC in rushing defense, giving up 77.1 yards per game. Ten defensive players have earned All-North Central Conference first team honors with Underwood, including Charlie Cosgrove, the 2005 Defensive Lineman of the Year. The Huskies were co-winners of the NCC title in 2002 and hosted a first round NCAA Division II playoff game in 2004, the year that Husky Stadium opener.

Success has followed Underwood at each of his coaching stops. Prior to joining the St. Cloud State staff in 2001, Underwood was the inside linebackers coach at the University of North Dakota for four seasons, and coached two NCAA playoff teams. From 1993 to 1996, he served as the defensive coordinator at the University of Sioux Falls. The University of Sioux Falls advanced to the playoffs during three of those seasons and won the NAIA Division II National Championship in 1996.

Underwood began his coaching career at his alma mater, Augustana College, where he spent five seasons as the defensive secondary coach, following a four-year career at defensive back for the Vikings from 1984 to 1988. In 1988, Underwood coached in an NCAA playoff game. In 1989, with Underwood as an assistant coach, the Vikings advanced to the NCAA playoffs, losing to St. Cloud State at Selke Field.

A native of Marion, Iowa, Underwood has a bachelor's degree in social sciences from Augustana College and a master's degree in health, physical education, and recreation from the University of South Dakota.

**Last Saturday:** Running backs Brandon Geiss (Shorewood, IL), and Michael Graham (Oakdale) each scored two touchdowns and quarterback Mitch Watkins (Jerseyville, IL) ran for a touchdown and threw for one to lead the Huskies to a 42-7 NSIC North Division win over MSU Moorhead. The Huskies outscored the Dragons 28-0 in the second half, after holding a 14-7 lead at the intermission.

**Joining the Ranks:** The St. Cloud State Huskies broke into the NCAA Division II Super Regional Three ranking this week at the number nine spot. Other NSIC teams ranked include Minnesota Duluth in second, Minnesota State University in fifth and Wayne State in sixth. Grand Valley State (MI) is the top ranked team in the Super Regional. The top six teams in each of the four Super Regionals will advance to the NCAA Playoffs.

**Team Notes:** The Huskies improved to 7-3 on the season and have assured themselves of a winning record for the first time in three seasons. St. Cloud State recorded a season high three interceptions against MSU Moorhead and marked the fifth time this season that the Huskies have picked off two or more passes in a game. SCSU has 12 interceptions over the last six games. The Huskies have compiled over 400 yards of total offense in four games this season, including 412 against the Dragons.



**By the Numbers:** The Huskies are averaging 30.2 points per game this season and allowing 17.4. The Huskies average 361.3 yards of total offense per game and are allowing 284.5 yards per game. St. Cloud State has outscored its opponent 200 to 34 in the third quarter this season. On the other side, the Mavericks average 33.2 points per game and are allowing 16.5 points. Minnesota State averages 375.9 yards in total offense and has allowed 315.1.

**In the NSIC:** The Huskies continue to lead the NSIC in pass defense allowing 148.4 yards passing per game. In addition, the Huskies lead the league in kickoff returns with a 25.2 yards per return average. The Husky "D" also ranks second in total defense allowing 276.8 yard per game and third in scoring defense allowing 15.9 points per league game. Fred Williams is the individual league leader in kickoff returns with 14 for 375 yards and one touchdown, and averages 26.8 yards per return. Minnesota State leads the NSIC in punt returns with a 14.9 yard return average and is second in scoring defense (15.1 points) and second in kick-off returns (21.1 yards). Kelvin Rodgers of MSU leads the league in punt returns with 13 returns for 235 yards and two touchdowns.

**Geiss Gets Third 100-Yard Game:** Freshman running back **Brandon Geiss (Shorewood, IL)** rushed for a career high 131 yards on 19 carries and scored two touchdowns in St. Cloud State's 42-7 win over MSU Moorhead. Geiss scored on runs of 42 yards (1st quarter) and one yard (3rd quarter) to help the Huskies to the win. The game marked the third 100-yard game of Geiss' short career and his second straight 100-yard game. Geiss has 774 yards of rushing on 165 carries and nine touchdowns this season.



### Ryan Kees Named a Draddy Trophy

**Finalist:** Senior defensive end Ryan Kees (Eagan) was named a 2008 Draddy Trophy Finalist last week, an award that recognizes academic success, football performance, and community leadership with an \$18,000 scholarship. Kees is the third Husky football player in the last five years to win this award. A mechanical engineering major, Kees has tallied 31 tackles this season and currently ranks fourth on the career tackles for loss chart with 34.5 and is tied for sixth on the career quarterback sack chart with 15.



**McLagan Nets a Career High:** Senior linebacker **Matt McLagan (Minneapolis)** continues to be successful on the field. Two weeks ago he stopped a Mary drive late in the game to secure the Husky win. Last week against the Dragons he collected a season and career high 12 tackles. McLagan has 58 tackles this season, including a team high 43 solo stops.



**Three Picks:** The Huskies recorded three interceptions against MSU Moorhead as senior corners **Tyler Krueger (Milwaukee, WI)** and **Kenny Patrick (Milwaukee, WI)** and redshirt first-year **Mike Street (St. Cloud)** each had a pick. Krueger notched his second INT of the season and fifth of his career while Patrick and Street recorded the first of their careers. Krueger ranks third on the team in tackles with 54. The Husky defense has 14 interceptions this season, which is five more than last year's season total of nine.

**Kamin Leads Team in Tackles:** Senior linebacker **David Kamin (Menomonee Falls, WI)** leads the Huskies in tackles with 60. This season Kamin has recovered two fumbles and had two interceptions, one of which he returned for a touchdown against UMD. Kamin notched a career high 11 tackles against UMC on 10/11/08.



**Williams Leads Receivers:** Sophomore wide receiver **Fred Williams (Milwaukee, WI)** had a team high four catches against MSU Moorhead and scored his sixth touchdown of the season. He leads the team with 45 receptions for 604 yards. He currently ranks 12th on the Husky career reception yards chart with 1,252 yards.



**Huskies Finish Second in the NSIC North:** The Huskies finished second in the NSIC North Division standings and are currently tied for third in the overall standings.



### Husky Stadium

2007 marked the fourth season of Husky Stadium. St. Cloud State is 14-10 at Husky Stadium since the 2004 season. The Huskies posted a 4-2 record at Husky Stadium in 2004, including a 0-1 mark in an NCAA playoff game in the new facility. The Huskies averaged 3,772 fans in the 4,198 seat facility in 2004, 3,961 in 2005, 3,936 in 2006 and 2,742 in 2007. SCSU's first sell-out was on October 2, 2004 against the University of North Dakota. 2004 Record: 4-2; 2005 Record: 5-1; 2006 Record: 3-3; 2007 Record: 2-4

**The Coaches:** St. Cloud State head coach **Scott Underwood (Augustana College)** is in his first season at the helm of the Huskies. Underwood had served as the Huskies defensive coordinator since the 2001 season and was named head coach in March of 2008. Underwood's coaching history includes stops at the University of North Dakota, University of Sioux Falls, and his alma mater Augustana College. His first win as a head coach was a 31-17 victory over Wayne State on a rainy Sept. 13 at Husky Stadium.



Minnesota State University, Mankato head coach **Todd Hoffner (Valley City State)** is in his first season at the helm of the Mavericks football program. Prior to joining the MSU staff, Hoffner was the offensive coordinator at the University of South Dakota. Prior to USD, Hoffner was the head coach at the University of Wisconsin-EauClaire where he posted a 46-28 record over seven seasons. His other coaching stops include UW-Stevens Point as an assistant coach, North Dakota as a graduate assistant coach and Rogers (ND) High School as a head coach.

**Last Season:** St. Cloud State competed in the North Central Conference for the last time. The Huskies posted a 4-7 overall record and finished eighth in the league with a 1-7 mark. Minnesota State University, Mankato was also a member of the NCC last year. The Mavericks posted a 5-6 overall record and tied for fifth in the league standings with a 3-5 record.

**SCSU All-Time Record:** The 2008 season marks the 86th in the history of SCSU football. Since 1920, SCSU has compiled a 388-335-22 overall record and has won a total of 18 conference titles, two in the North Central Conference (1989, 2002), 14 Northern Intercollegiate Conference crowns and two Minnesota State College Conference titles.
