NSIC North Contest: St. Cloud State University Husky football will host Minnesota State University Moorhead in a Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference (NSIC) game on Saturday, Nov. 1 at 1:00 p.m. in Husky Stadium (4,198).

For the Record: St. Cloud State enters the game with a 6-3 overall record and a 6-2 NSIC record. MSU Moorhead brings a 2-7 overall record and 2-6 NSIC record into the game. SCSU is 4-1 in North Division games and MSUM is 2-3.

Series Record: The Husky/Dragon rivalry dates back to the first season that SCSU kept records for football in 1920. Since that first game and only game of the 1920 season for the Huskies, a 27-17 loss, the two teams have played 52 times. St. Cloud State leads the series 27-23-2 and the last game was played during the 1990 season in the Metrodome Classic, a 42-20 Husky win. Prior to the Metrodome game, the Dragons had won three straight in the series.

New Year in the NSIC: The Husky football game at Augustana on Aug. 28 marked the first official contest for St. Cloud State in its new conference, the Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference (NSIC). The acceptance to the NSIC is a homecoming of sorts for St. Cloud State University athletics. The SCSU men's athletics department was a charter member of the Northern Intercollegiate Conference (NIC) in 1932. The Northern Sun Conference (NSC) for women's sports was formally announced in 1979-80 and SCSU was a charter member of that organization. Later the two combined to become the Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference for men's and women's athletics. SCSU women's teams captured four NSC basketball and tennis championships, and one volleyball championship from 1979 to 1984. From 1932 to 1980, the SCSU men's program captured a total of 66 conference titles in the NIC in the sports of wrestling, track and field, golf, cross country, baseball, football, and basketball.

HUSKY COACHING STAFF

SCSU Head Coach Scott Underwood: Scott Underwood (Augustana College, 1988) was introduced as Head Coach of Husky Football on March 25, 2008.

Underwood had served as the acting head coach of the Huskies since December and had been the defensive coordinator/recruiting coordinator/defensive backs coach since 2001.

Underwood is the 12th head football coach in the history of the program and replaces Randy Hedberg, who coached the Huskies from 1999 to 2007, and is currently a member of the Southern Illinois University football coaching staff.

The Husky defense, led by Underwood has ranked among the best in the North Central Conference for the last seven seasons. In 2002, SCSU led the NCC in rushing defense, giving up 77.1 yards per game. Ten defensive players have earned All-North Central Conference first team honors with Underwood, including Charlie Cosgrove, the 2005 Defensive Lineman of the Year. The Huskies were co-winners of the NCC title in 2002 and hosted a first round NCAA Division II playoff game in 2004, the year that Husky Stadium opener.

Success has followed Underwood at each of his coaching stops. Prior to joining the St. Cloud State staff in 2001, Underwood was the inside linebackers coach at the University of North Dakota for four seasons, and coached two NCAA playoff teams. From 1993 to 1996, he served as the defensive coordinator at the University of Sioux Falls. The University of Sioux Falls advanced to the playoffs during three of those seasons and won the NAIA Division II National Championship in 1996.

Underwood began his coaching career at his alma mater, Augustana College, where he spent five seasons as the defensive secondary coach, following a four-year career at defensive back for the Vikings from 1984 to 1988. In 1988, Underwood coached in an NCAA playoff game. In 1989, with Underwood as an assistant coach, the Vikings advanced to the NCAA playoffs, losing to St. Cloud State at Selke Field.

A native of Marion, Iowa, Underwood has a bachelor's degree in social sciences from Augustana College and a master's degree in health, physical education, and recreation from the University of South Dakota.

Last Saturday: Senior linebacker Darius Dotch (St. Paul) returned an interception for a touchdown with three minutes left in the game to give the Huskies a 14-7 NSIC North Division win Saturday afternoon at the Bismarck Community Bowl. With the University of Mary threatening to tie the game, Dotch and the Husky defense came up big as defensive end Ryan Kees (Eagan) provided the pressure on the play and Dotch returned the pick 28 yards for the touchdown. The Huskies led 7-0 at halftime and the University of Mary scored on the opening drive of the second half to tie the game at 7-7. Offensively, freshman Brandon Geiss (Shorewood, IL) rushed for 124 yards on 26 carries. It was the second 100-yard rushing game of his young career. The Huskies finished the game with 193 yards of total offense and 31:56 of possession time. Sophomore wide receiver Fred Williams (Milwaukee, WI) caught three passes for 12 yards including a touchdown.

Team Notes: The Huskies improved to 6-3 on the season and have assured themselves of a winning record for the first time in three seasons after Saturday's 14-7 win. St. Cloud State recorded two interceptions against UMary, a feat they have accomplished four times this season. SCSU has nine interceptions over the last five games. The Husky defense came up big in a game played in a stiff wind as SCSU collected eight tackles for loss, two quarterback sacks, two interceptions and three pass break-ups.

By the Numbers: The Huskies are averaging 28.9 points per game this season and allowing 18.6. St. Cloud State is giving up 288.4 yards per game to its opponents. MSU Moorhead has allowed an average of 29.6 points per game this season and 354.2 yards of total offense. The Dragons opponents have outscored MSUM 113-42 in the second quarter this season. The Dragons have outscored their opponents 58-44 in the fourth quarter.

In the NSIC: The Huskies lead the NSIC in pass defense allowing 147.4 yards passing per game. In addition, the Huskies lead the league in kickoff returns with a 26.3 yards per return average. Fred Williams is the individual league leader in kickoff returns with 13 for 364 yards, and average of 28.0 yards per return.

The Last Time: The Huskies have had three plays this year that can be found on The Last Time list. Fred Williams returned a kickoff 85 yards for TD on Oct. 11. The last player to return a kickoff for a TD was Matt Birkel on a 93 yard return, Oct. 5, 2002 against Augustana College. David Kamin returned an interception for a 41-yard TD on Oct. 18 against UMD, as did Darius Dotch on a 28-yard return on Oct. 25. Prior to this year, the last interception return for a TD was on Sept. 9, 2006 when Philip Hedlof returned a pick 61-yards for a touchdown at Missouri Western.

Kamin Leads Team in Tackles: Senior linebacker **David Kamin (Menomonee Falls, WI)** recovered a fumble against UMary and led the team in tackles with eight. He also had a pass break up. This season Kamin has recovered two fumbles and had two interceptions, one of which he returned for a touchdown against UMD. He currently leads the team in tackles with 58 including a team high 40 solo stops and 18 assists. Kamin notched a career high 11 tackles against UMC on 10/11/08.



McLagan Posts a Solid Line: Senior linebacker **Matt McLagan (Minneapolis)** had an outstanding day for the Huskies on Saturday. McLagan tallied his second quarterback sack of the day with :47 seconds left in the game to stop a UMary drive and give the Huskies the ball to end the game. McLagan recorded seven tackles, three tackles for loss, two quarterback sacks and one pass break-up. The seven tackles equaled his season high.



Dotch Scores Winning Touchdown: Senior linebacker **Darius Dotch (St. Paul)** scored the winning touchdown against U-Mary with a 28-yard interception return with three minutes left in the fourth quarter. The interception was the first for Dotch in his collegiate career. Dotch has 39 tackles this season, five tackles for loss, an interception and a fumble recovery.



Krueger Gets First Pick of Season: Senior cornerback **Tyler Krueger (Milwaukee, WI)** also recorded an interception, his first of the season and fourth of his collegiate career at Mary. He finished the game with seven tackles.



Ryan Kees Nets a Season High: Senior defensive end Ryan Kees (Eagan) was the man applying the pressure when Dotch returned an interception for a TD. Kees finished the game with two tackles for loss and a total of six tackles. Kees, a 2008 National Football Foundation & Hall of Fame Draddy Trophy Semifinalist is fourth on the SCSU all-time tackles for loss chart with 34.5 and is sixth all-time on the quarterback sack chart with 16.



Geiss Gets Second 100-Yard Game: Freshman running back **Brandon Geiss (Shorewood, IL)** rushed for a game and career high 124 yards on 26 carries, in the second 100-yard game of his young career. On Sept. 20, Geiss rushed for 123 yards and two touchdowns at Northern State. He has 146 carries for 643 yards and seven touchdowns this season.



Chart Climbers: Five Huskies are climbing the career charts this season. Wide receivers Fred Williams and Nate Johnson have reached the top 20 in receiving yards. Running back Michael Graham is in the top 15 in rushing yards and defensive ends Cale Pulczynski and Ryan Kees are in the top ten for tackles for loss and quarterback sacks. Here is where they rank.

2007 marked the fourth season of Husky Stadium. St. Cloud State is 14-10 at Husky Stadium since the 2004 season. The Huskies posted a 4-2 record at Husky Stadium in 2004, including a 0-1 mark in an NCAA playoff game in the new facility. The Huskies averaged 3,772 fans in the 4,198 seat facility in 2004, 3,961 in 2005, 3,936 in 2006 and 2,742 in 2007. The Coaches: St. Cloud State head coach **Scott Underwood (Augustana College)** is in his first season at the helm of the Huskies. Underwood had served as the Huskies defensive coordinator since the 2001 season and was named head coach in March of 2008. Underwood's coaching history includes stops at the University of North Dakota, University of Sioux Falls, and his alma mater Augustana College. His first win as a head coach was a 31-17 victory over Wayne State on a rainy Sept. 13 at Husky Stadium.



Minnesota State University Moorhead head coach **Damon Tomeo (Pomona, 1999)** is in his third season as the head coach of the Dragons. In his first two seasons, he has compiled a 10-12 overall record. Last season, MSU Moorhead posted a 4-7 overall record, with five of those losses coming by five or fewer points. Before becoming the head

coach, Tomeo was the defensive coordinator for the Dragons for one season. A California native, he has also coached at California Lutheran University and Pomona Pitzer College, and was the assistant director of football and recruiting operations for the University of Arizona.

Last Season: St. Cloud State competed in the North Central Conference for the last time. The Huskies posted a 4-7 overall record and finished eighth in the league with a 1-7 mark. MSU Moorhead compiled a 4-7 overall record and finished tied for sixth in the NSIC with a 3-6 league mark.

SCSU All-Time Record: The 2008 season marks the 86th in the history of SCSU football. Since 1920, SCSU has compiled a 388-335-22 overall record and has won a total of 18 conference titles, two in the North Central Conference (1989, 2002), 14 Northern Intercollegiate Conference crowns and two Minnesota State College Conference titles.
