NSIC Play: St. Cloud State University Husky football hits the road for a Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference (NSIC) game at the University of Minnesota, Crookston, Saturday, Oct. 11. The kick-off is scheduled for 1:00 p.m. at Ed Widseth Field on the UMC campus.

For the Record: St. Cloud State enters the game with a 4-2 overall record and are 4-1 in Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference games. Minnesota, Crookston is 2-4 overall and 1-4 in the NSIC. This is a Northern Division game where the Huskies are 2-0 and UMD 1-2.

Series Record: This game marks the fifth meeting between these two teams. St. Cloud State holds a 4-0 record against the Golden Eagles. The teams last met in the 2006 season opener, a 71-0 victory for the Huskies at Husky Stadium.

New Year in the NSIC: The Husky football game at Augustana on Aug. 28 marked the first official contest for St. Cloud State in its new conference, the Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference (NSIC). The acceptance to the NSIC is a homecoming of sorts for St. Cloud State University athletics. The SCSU men's athletics department was a charter member of the Northern Intercollegiate Conference (NIC) in 1932. The Northern Sun Conference (NSC) for women's sports was formally announced in 1979-80 and SCSU was a charter member of that organization. Later the two combined to become the Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference for men's and women's athletics. SCSU women's teams captured four NSC basketball and tennis championships, and one volleyball championship from 1979 to 1984. From 1932 to 1980, the SCSU men's program captured a total of 66 conference titles in the NIC in the sports of wrestling, track and field, golf, cross country, baseball, football, and basketball.

HUSKY COACHING STAFF

SCSU Head Coach Scott Underwood: Scott Underwood (Augustana College, 1988) was introduced as Head Coach of Husky Football on March 25, 2008.

Underwood had served as the acting head coach of the Huskies since December and had been the defensive coordinator/recruiting coordinator/defensive backs coach since 2001.

Underwood is the 12th head football coach in the history of the program and replaces Randy Hedberg, who coached the Huskies from 1999 to 2007, and is currently a member of the Southern Illinois University football coaching staff.

The Husky defense, led by Underwood has ranked among the best in the North Central Conference for the last seven seasons. In 2002, SCSU led the NCC in rushing defense, giving up 77.1 yards per game. Ten defensive players have earned All-North Central Conference first team honors with Underwood, including Charlie Cosgrove, the 2005 Defensive Lineman of the Year. The Huskies were co-winners of the NCC title in 2002 and hosted a first round NCAA Division II playoff game in 2004, the year that Husky Stadium opener.

Success has followed Underwood at each of his coaching stops. Prior to joining the St. Cloud State staff in 2001, Underwood was the inside linebackers coach at the University of North Dakota for four seasons, and coached two NCAA playoff teams. From 1993 to 1996, he served as the defensive coordinator at the University of Sioux Falls. The University of Sioux Falls advanced to the playoffs during three of those seasons and won the NAIA Division II National Championship in 1996.

Underwood began his coaching career at his alma mater, Augustana College, where he spent five seasons as the defensive secondary coach, following a four-year career at defensive back for the Vikings from 1984 to 1988. In 1988, Underwood coached in an NCAA playoff game. In 1989, with Underwood as an assistant coach, the Vikings advanced to the NCAA playoffs, losing to St. Cloud State at Selke Field.

A native of Marion, Iowa, Underwood has a bachelor's degree in social sciences from Augustana College and a master's degree in health, physical education, and recreation from the University of South Dakota.

Last Saturday: Junior quarterback Mitch Watkins (Jerseyville, IL) threw for three touchdowns and senior running back Michael Graham (Oakdale) ran for two others to lead the Huskies to a 48-14 NSIC North Division win over Bemidji State. Senior punter/kicker Brian Cristan (Dellwood) was two of two in field goal attempts and connected on six of six PATs. Senior wide receiver Cody Rysewyk (Green Bay) caught a game high five passes for 36 yards and his first touchdown of the season. Graham finished the game with five carries for 66 yards and two touchdowns, including a 56-yard TD run. Defensively, senior safety Tyler Krueger (Milwaukee, WI) and junior linebacker David Kamin (Menomonee Falls, WI) each had nine tackles. Kamin also had a quarterback sack and 1.5 tackles for loss. Senior defensive end Ahmed Ibrahim (Fairmont) had a career high two quarterback sacks. Senior linebacker Matt McLagan (Minneapolis) and senior safety Matt Jensen (Mequon, WI) recorded interceptions for the Huskies.

Team Notes: The Huskies have won four-straight games, the longest winning streak since rattling off three straight to open the 2007 season. St. Cloud State opened the 2005 season with a 5-0 record, and the last time the Huskies won four straight conference games was during the 1994 season in the North Central Conference (NCC). For the second straight week, the Huskies collected over 400 yards of total offense as SCSU came away with 420 against Bemidji State and 457 against Upper Iowa.



By the Numbers: St. Cloud State is averaging 349.8 yards per game on offense and Bemidji State is at a 314.2 yards per game average. The Huskies breakdown is 153.0 rushing and 196.8 passing while BSU has gained 70.0 yards rushing and 244.2 passing. As for time of possession, St. Cloud State has had the ball 29:34 while Bemidji State has been on offense 31:11 per game. While the Huskies have held their opponent to ten third quarter points, Bemidji State has only scored seven third quarter points. Both teams are nearly equal in the turnover category as the Huskies have turned the ball over ten times and Bemidji State nine times. The Huskies held Bemidji State scoreless in the first and fourth quarters of Saturday's game. The Husky defense has held their opponents scoreless in eight quarters this season.

In the NSIC: Through five NSIC league games, the Huskies rank highly in several defensive team categories. The Huskies are second in scoring defense (16.8 ppg), second in pass defense (152.0 ypg), and second in total defense allowing 274.6 ypg. The Huskies lead the NSIC in kickoff returns with a 27.3 yard average.

Graham Enters Top 20 in Rushing: Senior running back **Michael Graham (Oakdale)** currently ranks 18th on the all-time rushing chart at SCSU with 1,256 career yards. Graham has carried the ball 248 times and scored ten touchdowns. This season, he has 50 carries for 260 yards and three touchdowns.



Jensen Reaches Top 10 in INTs: Senior safety **Matt Jensen (Mequon, WI)** recorded his second interception of the season and tenth of his career last Saturday. He currently ranks eighth on the career INT chart. The career record is 16 held by Mitchell Denne (2003-06).



Williams Closes in on 1,000 Receiving Yards: Sophomore wide receiver Fred Williams (**Milwaukee, WI**) needs just one yard receiving to gain 1,000 yards in his career. Williams enters the week with 999 career receiving yards which ranks him 17th on the all-time chart. He has made 76 catches and eight touchdowns in his career. This season he leads the team with 28 catches for 351 yards and three touchdowns.



Johnson Nears 1,000 Receiving Yards: Senior wide receiver **Nate Johnson (Austin)** is also closing in on 1,000 career receiving yards. Johnson has caught 69 passes for 978 yards and four touchdowns. He currently ranks 19th on the all-time career chart. This season Johnson has caught 19 passes for 341 yards and one touchdown.



2008 Records: Senior defensive end **Cale Pulczynski (Mukwonago, WI)** set a single game record for quarterback sacks with 4.5 against Northern State on Sept. 20. The old mark of 3.0 was held by Jeremy Sinz and current SCSU assistant football coach Charlie Cosgrove. Pulczynski leads the team in tackles for loss with 8.5 and quarterback sacks with 6.5.





Husky Stadium

2007 marked the fourth season of Husky Stadium. St. Cloud State is 14-10 at Husky Stadium since the 2004 season. The Huskies posted a 4-2 record at Husky Stadium in 2004, including a 0-1 mark in an NCAA playoff game in the new facility. The Huskies averaged 3,772 fans in the 4,198 seat facility in 2004, 3,961 in 2005, 3,936 in 2006 and 2,742 in 2007. The Coaches: St. Cloud State head coach **Scott Underwood (Augustana College)** is in his first season at the helm of the Huskies. Underwood had served as the Huskies defensive coordinator since the 2001 season and was named head coach in March of 2008. Underwood's coaching history includes stops at the University of North Dakota, University of Sioux Falls, and his alma mater Augustana College. His first win as a head coach was a 31-17 victory over Wayne State on a rainy Sept. 13 at Husky Stadium.



University of Minnesota, Crookston head coach **Shannon Stassen (Valley City, 1995)** is in his sixth season with the Golden Eagles. In five seasons with the program, he has accumulated an 8-56 overall record. Prior to becoming the head coach, Stassen was an assistant coach and defensive coordinator for UMC. He spent two seasons as an offensive

coach at North Dakota State before joining the Golden Eagles staff in 1998.

Last Season: St. Cloud State competed in the North Central Conference for the last time. The Huskies posted a 4-7 overall record and finished eighth in the league with a 1-7 mark. Minnesota, Crookston posted a 2-8 overall record and went 1-8 in the NSIC to finish tenth.

SCSU All-Time Record: The 2008 season marks the 86th in the history of SCSU football. Since 1920, SCSU has compiled a 388-335-22 overall record and has won a total of 18 conference titles, two in the North Central Conference (1989, 2002), 14 Northern Intercollegiate Conference crowns and two Minnesota State College Conference titles.

Last Meeting: The Huskies and Golden Eagles last met in the 2006 season opener, a 71-0 St. Cloud State home win. The Huskies set school records for most points in a game and most touchdowns scored with 11. Special teams and turnovers were keys to the game as SCSU returned two punt returns for touchdowns (a school record), recovered two fumbles and collected two interceptions. The Huskies tallied 411 yards of offense to UMC's 61.
