## Spring 2007 Golf News

### April 12, 2007

**SCSU Men to Compete in Northwest Region Qualifier:** The St. Cloud State University men's golf team will travel to Loveland, Colorado for the NCAA Division II Northwest Region Qualifier on Monday and Tuesday, April 16 and 17.

**What it Means:** The total team score of the Spring Qualifier combined with the total team score of the Fall Qualifier will determine the field for the Super Regional to be played May 7-9 in Denver.

**Women Prepare for Minnesota State Invite:** The SCSU women's squad will compete at the Minnesota State Invitational on April 21-22 at Pebble Creek Golf Club in Becker.

**Men Are Two-for-Two:** St. Cloud State men's golf team opened the spring season with back to back team titles after winning the Upper Iowa Spring Classic on Tuesday. The final team scores were: 1. SCSU-300-289-589; 2. South Dakota 296-293-589; 3. Upper Iowa 294-299-593. While SCSU and the University of South Dakota had the same team score of 589, the Huskies won the tiebreaker based on the low team score of the second day, a 289 for SCSU.

Individually, SCSU first year player Travis Ross (Crookston) and junior Theo Frentzos (Elk River) tied for second. Ross shot a 75-69 for a 144, while Frentzos recorded a 74-70. Sophomore Jake Zilkoski (St. Cloud) tallied a 74-76-150; junior Danny Anderson (Willmar) shot a 77-74-151, and junior Corey Grace (Ogilvie) an 81-79-160. The Huskies had two other golfers who did not figure into the team scoring. Junior Bobby Gaulke (McCook), playing as an individual tied for fourth with a 72-75-147 and senior Tanner Bown (Plymouth) shot a 77-73-150.

**Women Place Seventh:** The Huskies shot a two-day total 360-367-727 to place seventh.

First year golfer Nicole Peters (Cottage Grove) led the Huskies with a 28th place finish, shooting an 87-94-181. First year players Shannon Moran (Bloomington) and Megan Hagemeyer (Woodbury) tied for 29th with a 193. Moran shot 90-93 and Hagemeyer 89-94. First year Lee Zutz (Red Lake Falls) placed 33rd with a 95-89-184, and junior Brooke Bezek (Fergus Falls) placed 36th with a 94-91-185.



## **St. Cloud State University Golf Update Page 2**

**Head Coach:** SCSU head men's and women's golf coach Judi Larkin (St. Cloud State) is in her seventh season with the Huskies. Larkin was named the NCC Men's Golf Coach of the Year in 2004 and 2005. Larkin was named the 2006 Golf Coaches Association of America (GCAA) Northwest Region Coach of the Year, after guiding the men's team to its second NCAA Division II Northwest Region Championship in the spring of 2006. In the spring of 2006 SCSU advanced to the NCAA Division II National Championships for the second time in three seasons (last in 2004) and placed 17th as a team. Senior Chris Little (Maple Grove) earned All-American honors with a seventh place individual finish. That came on the heels of the Huskies second NCAA DII Northwest Region Championship. Larkin also led the team to the 2005 North Central Conference Championship, the second straight conference title and third overall for the Huskies program.
