Spring 2007 Golf News

SCSU Women to Compete at Minnesota State Invite: The St. Cloud State University women's golf team will compete in the Minnesota State Invite, April 21-22, at the Pebble Creek Golf Club in Becker. NCAA Division II and III teams from around the state will be competing.

SCSU Men to Duel With St. John's: The men's squad will compete with crosstown rival St. John's in a duel meet at Rich Spring Golf Club in Cold Spring on Monday, April 22.

Men Place Third at Northwest Region Spring Tournament: The men's golf team finished third in the Northwest Region Spring Head to Head Tournament played Monday and Tuesday at The Pinery Country Club in Parker, Colorado. The Huskies were tied for third after the first 36 holes. SCSU posted a 303 in the final round for a total score of 904 (306-295-303). Sophomore Jake Zilkoski (St. Cloud) shot an even par 72 in the final round to place 14th. Zilkoski improved his standing by ten positions. After 36 holes, he was tied for 24th. His 54-hole total of 78-74-72=224 put him in a 14th place tie. First year Travis Ross (Crookston) improved his standing from 20th to 17th with a final round 74 to finish 77-74-74=225. Junior Danny Anderson (Willmar) finished tied for 21st with a three round total 76-74-77=227. Junior Bobby Gaulke (McCook, NE) tied for 27th with a 74-73-83=231. Junior Theo Frentzos (Elk River) shot a final round 80 to tie for 42nd place at 80-76-80=236.

Men Are Two-for-Three: St. Cloud State men's golf team opened the spring season with back to back team titles after winning the Upper Iowa Spring Classic and the University of South Dakota Invite. The Huskies then placed third at the Northwest Region Spring Head to Head tournament last week.

Women Place Seventh in last Event: The Huskies shot a two-day total 360-367-727 to place seventh at the Upper Iowa Spring Classic on April 7. First year golfer Nicole Peters (Cottage Grove) led the Huskies with a 28th place finish, shooting an 87-94-181. First year players Shannon Moran (Bloomington) and Megan Hagemeyer (Woodbury) tied for 29th with a 193. Moran shot 90-93 and Hagemeyer 89-94. First year Lee Zutz (Red Lake Falls) placed 33rd with a 95-89-184, and junior Brooke Bezek (Fergus Falls) placed 36th with a 94-91-185.

Head Coach: SCSU head men's and women's golf coach Judi Larkin (St. Cloud State) is in her seventh season with the Huskies. Larkin was named the NCC Men's Golf Coach of the Year in 2004 and 2005. Larkin was named the 2006 Golf Coaches Association of America (GCAA) Northwest Region Coach of the Year, after guiding the men's team to its second NCAA Division II Northwest Region Championship in the spring of 2006. In the spring of 2006 SCSU advanced to the NCAA Division II National Championships for the second time in three seasons (last in 2004) and placed 17th as a team. Senior Chris Little (Maple Grove) earned All-American honors with a seventh place individual finish. That came on the heels of the Huskies second NCAA DII Northwest Region Championship. Larkin also led the team to the 2005 North Central Conference Championship, the second straight conference title and third overall for the Huskies program.
