SCSU Men Earn Bid to NCAA West/Northwest Super

Regional: For the fourth straight year, the St. Cloud State University men's golf team has received a bid to the NCAA Division II West/Northwest Super Regional. The West/Northwest Super Regional will be held May 6-9 at the Fox Hollow Golf Course in Lakewood, Colorado, hosted by Regis University and the Colorado School of Mines.

There will be five super regional sites where two regions will meet and conduct individual tournaments. The Huskies will compete in a field of 16 teams, eight each from the West and Northwest Regions, along with ten individuals in the 54-hole tournament. The top team from each region (SCSU is in the Northwest Region) within the super region, along with ten additional teams will earn berths to the NCAA Division II Championships, May 22-25, hosted by Grand Valley State University in Allendale, Michigan.

Huskies in the Super Regional: This is the fourth straight year that SCSU has qualified for the NCAA tournament and fourth in the history of the program. The Huskies were crowned Northwest Region Champions in 2004 and 2006, advancing to the NCAA Division II National Championships. In 2005, SCSU placed fourth in the region tournament. The Huskies went on to a 16th place in the 2004 National Championship and 17th in 2006.

The Huskies also boast back-to-back-to-back individual medalists in the Northwest Regional as Brett Swedberg won the individual title in 2004, Chris Little won it in 2005, and current Husky Corey Grace was the co-medalist in 2006.

St. Cloud State's current roster features two players who competed in the 2006 regional and national championships. Junior Corey Grace (Ogilvie) and sophomore Jake Zilkoski (St. Cloud) competed in last year's championship tournaments. Grace went on to place 87th at the national championship. Zilkoski tied for 11th in the Northwest Region tournament and tied for 77th at the national championship.

Ranked Fourth in Region: The Huskies are ranked fourth in the NCAA Division II Northwest Region poll released on April 20.

Women Finish Spring Schedule With Fifth Place Finish at Minnesota State Invite: The St. Cloud State women's golf team placed fifth at the Minnesota State Invitational played Saturday and Sunday at Pebble Creek Golf Club in Becker. The Huskies posted a two-day score of 352-354=706. The Huskies were led by first year golfer Megan Hagemeyer (Woodbury). Hagemeyer shot an 83-84=167 to place 14th. Rookie Lee Zutz (Red Lake Falls) posted an 82-88=170 and placed 19th. Junior Brooke Bezek (Fergus Falls) placed 36th and shot a 91-93=184. First year Nicole Peters (Cottage Grove) placed 37th and carded a 96-89=185, and Shannon Moran (Bloomington) a 101-96=196 for 46th place. First year golf Kayla Nesvold (New Ulm) and junior Pam Roth (Maple Plain) competed as individuals in the tournament. Nesvold placed 41st with a score of 95-95-190 and Roth finished 42nd with a score of 92-99=191.

Head Coach: SCSU head men's and women's golf coach Judi Larkin (St. Cloud State) is in her seventh season with the Huskies. Larkin was named the NCC Men's Golf Coach of the Year in 2004 and 2005. Larkin was named the 2006 Golf Coaches Association of America (GCAA) Northwest Region Coach of the Year, after guiding the men's team to its second NCAA Division II Northwest Region Championship in the spring of 2006. In the spring of 2006 SCSU advanced to the NCAA Division II National Championships for the second time in three seasons (last in 2004) and placed 17th as a team. Senior Chris Little (Maple Grove) earned All-American honors with a seventh place individual finish. That came on the heels of the Huskies second NCAA DII Northwest Region Championship. Larkin also led the team to the 2005 North Central Conference Championship, the second straight conference title and third overall for the Huskies program.
