Spring 2006 Golf News

March 31, 2006



Spring Opener: The 2006 St. Cloud State men's and women's golf teams will open the spring season on April 2 and 3 at the University of South Dakota Invitational. The tournament will be played at The Bluffs Golf Course in Vermillion, SD. Play will begin both days at 10:00 a.m. On Sunday, the teams will have assigned tee time and Monday will be a shotgun start. The Bluffs, a par-72, will play 6,812 yards from the gold tees for the men, while the women will play at 5,998 yards from a combination of white and blue tees.

Sunday Tee Times: The SCSU will tee off beginning at 11:40 a.m. on Sunday. The women will step up to the tee at 1:30 p.m.

2005 Fall Finish: The St. Cloud State men's golf team made up 11 strokes on the final day of the North Central Conference championships to win the team title for the second straight year and senior Chris Little (Elk River) was the individual runner-up following a one-hole playoff, after shooting a one-over par 73 in the final round (71-78-73). The team title is the second straight and third all-time for the men's program (SCSU won team titles in 2004 and 1994).

The St. Cloud State women's golf team placed sixth at the 2005 NCC Championships with a team score of 1063. Senior Becca Rotert (Sioux Falls, SD) and sophomore Brooke Bezek (Fergus Falls) tied for 22nd in the three-day tournament with scores of 266. Rotert shot an 88 in the final round (88-90-88) and Bezek a 92 (93-81-92).

Region Ranking: The SCSU women are ranked tenth in the March 30 NCAA Division II North Region poll. North Dakota is ranked first, followed by Nebraska-Omaha, Minnesota State University, Southwest Minnesota State, South Dakota, Winona State, Augustana College, Truman, Upper Iowa and SCSU.

Head Coach: SCSU head men's and women's golf coach Judi Larkin (St. Cloud State) is in her sixth season with the Huskies. Larkin was named the NCC Men's Golf Coach of the Year in 2004 and 2005.
