Women Prepare for MWCGA: St. Cloud State University will be the host school for the 2006 Minnesota Women's Collegiate Golf Association (MWCGA) Tournament, Saturday and Sunday, April 22 and 23. The tournament will be played at Pebble Creek Golf Course in Becker.

Tee Times: Tee times will begin at 12 noon on Saturday. Sunday's start will be a 9:00 a.m. shotgun.

Participating Teams: Ten teams will compete at the MWCGA. Joining the Huskies will be College of St. Benedict, Gustavus Adolphus, St. Thomas, Minnesota-Crookston, Augsburg College, St. Olaf College, Carleton College, Winona State (2nd team) and University of Minnesota (2nd team).

Last Week: The SCSU men tied for the team title at the Northwest Region Spring Head to Head played on Monday and Tuesday. It marked the second time in three years that the Huskies have won this tournament. The Huskies carded a 300 in the final round of the tournament for a two-day total of 900 (292-308-300). Senior Chris Little shot a one over par 72 Tuesday to claim co-medalist honors. He finished the tournament with a 54-hole score of 219 (73-74-72) at six over par. He was tied for third heading into the final day and made up eight strokes on the final 18 holes. St. Cloud State senior John Ciplef shot a final round 75 (74-77-75=226) to tie for 12th place. Sophomore Cory Grace shot a 77 Tuesday (74-75-77=226) and tied for 12th. First year Jake Zilkoski finished tied for 22nd after shooting a final round 76 (71-82-76=229). Sophomore Tommy Smith finished in 64th place carding an 83 on the final day (86-91-83=260).

The SCSU women's golf team placed ninth at the Southwest Minnesota State Mustang Golf Invitational. The Huskies fired a final round 374 for a two day total of 754. SCSU was led by Brooke Bezek who tied for 40th with a 176 (89-87). Kristin Edberg shot a 90 today for a 179 (89-90). Sarah Warner placed 60th with a 188 (94-94) and Nicole Adams placed 64th with a 201 (108-103).

Region Ranking: The SCSU men are currently ranked fifth in the Northwest Region.

Head Coach: SCSU head men's and women's golf coach Judi Larkin (St. Cloud State) is in her sixth season with the Huskies. Larkin was named the NCC Men's Golf Coach of the Year in 2004 and 2005.

2005 Fall Finish: The St. Cloud State men's golf team made up 11 strokes on the final day of the North Central Conference championships to win the team title for the second straight year and senior Chris Little (Maple Grove) was the individual runner-up following a one-hole playoff, after shooting a one-over par 73 in the final round (71-78-73). The team title is the second straight and third all-time for the men's program (SCSU won team titles in 2004 and 1994).

The St. Cloud State women's golf team placed sixth at the 2005 NCC Championships with a team score of 1063. Senior Becca Rotert (Sioux Falls, SD) and sophomore Brooke Bezek (Fergus Falls) tied for 22nd in the three-day tournament with scores of 266. Rotert shot an 88 in the final round (88-90-88) and Bezek a 92 (93-81-92).
