Spring 2006 Golf News May 9, 2006

SCSU Men Off to NCAA DII Championship: The St. Cloud State University men's golf team will compete in the 2006 NCAA Division II Men's Golf Championship, May 16-19 at The Resort at Glade Springs, Daniels, West Virginia.

Participating Teams: A total of 105 participants representing 20 teams and five individual players will compete for the Championship. South Carolina-Aiken, representing the Southeast Region is the returning and defending national champion.

Second National Appearance: The 2006 NCAA Championship marks the second ever tournament appearance for the Huskies. SCSU's first appearance was in 2004 and the Huskies placed 16th in the field.

Husky Line-Up: Competing for SCSU at the NCAA Championships will be Senior Chris Little (Maple Grove), sophomore Corey Grace (Ogilvie), senior John Cliplef (Poway, CA), first year Jake Zilkoski (St. Cloud) and sophomore Grant Hanson (Alexandria).

Northwest Region Champions: For the second time in school history, the SCSU men's golf team won the NCAA Division II Northwest Region Championship. The Huskies distanced themselves from second place finisher Minnesota State Mankato by 26 strokes to win the eight-team region. The tournament was played May 1-3 in Phoenix, Arizona.

Corey Grace is Co-Medalist: SCSU sophomore Corey Grace (Ogilvie) went from seventh place to champion in the final round of the Northwest Region. He birdied four holes on the final nine to card a two-under 69 and finished the tournament with a three-day total of 215 (73-73-69).

Other Finishes: SCSU senior Chris Little (Maple Grove), the co-leader after the second day, dropped to third place after shooting a two over par 73 on Wednesday. He finished the tournament at 216 (70-73-73), one stroke behind the leaders. Little is the only Husky who played on the 2004 championship team and placed 47th at the NCAA tournament.

First year golf Jake Zilkoski (St. Cloud) finished the tournament tied for 11th. He shot a 77 in the final round and finished with a three-day total of 224 (76-71-77). Senior John Cliplef (Poway, CA) placed 16th with a 54-hole total of 227 (79-68-80) and sophomore Grant Hanson (Alexandria) shot a final round 77 to finish in 25th place at 231 (78-76-77).

Third Straight Region Appearance: This spring marked the third straight Super Regional appearance for the Huskies. In the spring of 2004, the Huskies won the Northwest Regional in Bellingham, Washington and advanced to the 2004 NCAA Division II Men's Golf Championship for the first time ever. The 2004 region title was the first ever for the SCSU program and former Husky Brett Swedberg took medalist honors to lead the Huskies. Current Husky Chris Little placed ninth at the Regional and went on to a 47th place finish at the NCAA Championships and as a team, the Huskies placed 16th. In 2005, the Huskies placed fourth in the Region and Little was the co-medalist.

Women's Spring Season Finale: The SCSU women's team finished the spring season with a sixth place finish at the MWCGA Tournament held April 22-23 at Pebble Creek Golf Club in Becker. St. Cloud State was led by Brooke Brezek who finished tied for 21st with a 169 (89-85). Teammates Sarah Warner placed 42nd with a 187 (95-92), Kristin Edberg placed 48th with a 195 (95-100) and Nicole Adams finished 49th with a 196 (97-99).

2005 Fall Finish: The St. Cloud State men's golf team made up 11 strokes on the final day of the North Central Conference championships to win the team title for the second straight year and senior Chris Little (Maple Grove) was the individual runner-up following a one-hole playoff, after shooting a one-over par 73 in the final round (71-78-73). The team title is the second straight and third all-time for the men's program (SCSU won team titles in 2004 and 1994).

The St. Cloud State women's golf team placed sixth at the 2005 NCC Championships with a team score of 1063. Senior Becca Rotert (Sioux Falls, SD) and sophomore Brooke Brezek (Fergus Falls) tied for 22nd in the three-day tournament with scores of 266. Rotert shot an 88 in the final round (88-90-88) and Brezek a 92 (93-81-92).
