2004-05 SCSU Golf Team News

Release Date: October, 2004 - Fall Final



2004 NCC Champions: The St. Cloud State University men's golf team won the North Central Conference team championship with a three-day team total of 889 strokes. Senior Brett Swedberg (Alexandria) led from start to finish and won individual medalist honors with a one-under par 215 total (71-72-72). He shot an even par 72 in the final round. The team title is the second for an SCSU men's team as the Huskies won it in 1994. Swedberg is the second SCSU player to win the individual title following Chad Tucker who was the 1993 medalist.

The Huskies had top ten performances from three other golfers as junior Chris Little (Elk River) finished tied for third with a three-day stroke total of 223 (76-70-77). First year player Tommy Smith (St. Cloud) finished sixth at 226 (72-75-79) and sophomore Erik Anderson (Naperville, IL) was eighth at 228 (76-75-77). Sophomore Tanner Bown (Plymouth) rounded out the Husky scoring with a 14th place finish at 234 (80-78-76).

North Dakota finished second 24 strokes behind the Huskies with a score of 913. Minnesota State finished third at 918, followed by Augustana at 930 and South Dakota at 942.

Women's NCC Results: The SCSU women's team finished sixth with a three-day team total of 1099. Minnesota State University won the team title with a score of 965, followed by Nebraska-Omaha (966), North Dakota (1008), Augustana (1014), and South Dakota (1049).

Sophomore Quinn Scarborough (Alexandria) led the Huskies and finished tied for 14th with an 84-88-87-259 total. Sophomore Sammi Jones (Austin) finished 25th with a 277 (96-97-84), senior Kristina Carlin (St. Cloud) was 26th at 280 (97-93-90), senior Becca Rotert (Sioux Falls, SD) was 28th at 283 (93-92-98), and first year player Kristin Edberg (Belle Plain) was 29th at 322 (108-111-103).

All-NCC: SCSU placed two golfers on the 2004 All-North Central Conference Men's First Team and two others were named to the second team. Senior Brett Swedberg (Alexandria) and junior Chris Little (Elk River) were named to the First team. Swedberg was the 2004 NCC medalist with a six stroke victory. Little placed third at the 2004 championships and also earned 2003 All-Conference honors. Sophomore Erik Anderson (Naperville, IL) and first year golfer Tommy Smith (St. Cloud) were named to the second team. Anderson placed eighth at the league championships while Smith finished in sixth place.

NCC Coach of the Year: SCSU head men's and women's golf coach Judi Larkin was named the NCC Men's Golf Coach of the Year. Larkin (St. Cloud State) is in her fifth season as head coach of the Huskies. She is a former SCSU tennis player and resides in St. Cloud with her family.
