2005 SCSU Spring Golf Team News

Release Date: April 6, 2005 - Spring Golf



2005 Spring Opener: The St. Cloud State University golf teams will continue the spring schedule on Monday and Tuesday, April 11-12 at the Minnesota State University, Mankato Invitational. The SCSU women's golf team is off until the Minnesota State Invitational on April 16-17 in Waseca.

Men Claim First: In the first competition of the spring season, the SCSU men claimed the team title at the University of South Dakota Invitational played last Sunday and Monday. The Huskies were in third place after day one but came back with a second day total of 294 to pass Winona State by one stroke. Junior Chris Little (Elk River) was second overall with a 70-70=140. Senior Brett Swedberg (Alexandria) carded a 71-72=143 for fourth place. Sophomore Tanner Bown (Plymouth) was 23rd with a 78-78=156, followed by first year Tommy Smith (St. Cloud) in 24th 83-74=157, and junior Eric Bjerke (Eagan) in 58th with an 84=95=179.

Women Finish Sixth: The SCSU women's team placed sixth at the USD Invitational. Senior Kristina Carlin tied for seventh with a two-day score of 82-83=165. Senior Becca Rotert (Sioux Falls, SD) tied for 22nd with 89-85=174. Sophomore Sammi Jones (Austin) placed 26th with 85-91=176, followed by sophomore Quinn Scarborough (Alexandria) who tied for 30th with a 92-88=180, and first year Kristin Edberg (Belle Plaine) who tied for 40th with 97-94=191.

Golfers to Watch: Senior Brett Swedberg (Alexandria) is coming off an outstanding fall season. Swedberg was the medalist in three of the five competitions during the fall season and placed second in the other two. He was the medalist in the 2004 North Central Conference Championships and was co-medalist in the Northwest Region Head to Head. Junior Chris Little (Elk River) was the co-medalist with Swedberg at the Northwest Region Head to Head and placed third at the NCC Championships. On the women's side, sophomore Quinn Scarborough (Alexandria) had the top finish for the Huskies at the NCC Championships, a 14th place tie.

All-NCC: SCSU placed two golfers on the 2004 All-North Central Conference Men's First Team and two others were named to the second team. Senior Brett Swedberg (Alexandria) and junior Chris Little (Elk River) were named to the First team. Sophomore Erik Anderson (Naperville, IL) and first year golfer Tommy Smith (St. Cloud) were named to the second team.

NCC Coach of the Year: SCSU head men's and women's golf coach Judi Larkin was named the NCC Men's Golf Coach of the Year. Larkin (St. Cloud State) is in her fifth season as head coach of the Huskies.
