## 2003-04 SCSU GOLF TEAM NEWS

Release Date: Final 2003-04



**NCAA MEN'S RESULTS:** St. Cloud State University junior Brett Swedberg (Alexandria) claimed All-America honors at the 2004 NCAA Division II men's golf championships with a sixth place finish at the Victoria Hills Golf Club in DeLand, Fla. on May 15. Swedberg finished the four-round tournament with a score of 296 (73-75-74-74), which placed him at +8. J.J. Jakovac of Chico State was the tournament winner with a score of 287 (-1). Of note, Swedberg becomes the first golf in SCSU history to place among the top 10 in NCAA Division II golf at a national tournament. This also marked the first time in school history that the Huskies placed among the NCAA's top 18 teams and it was SCSU's first-ever trip to the NCAA championships.

Swedberg was recognized after the tournament at the NCAA awards ceremony, which featured an appearance by Dick Vitale. As a team, the Huskies placed 16th out of 18 teams with a score of 1249 (+97). The tournament team title was claimed by South Carolina-Aiken, which posted a score of 1191. Chico State was second with a tally of 1200 and Barry was third at 1201. SCSU's Chris Little placed 47th at the tournament with a score of 309 (80-74-80-75) and Bob Gartland placed 95th with a score of 327 (78-87-78-84). Josh Hagstrom (81-84-86-81) and Pete Jameson (78-76-95-83) finished in a tie for 98th place with a tally of 332 apiece.

**NCAA WOMEN'S RESULTS:** The SCSU women's team was also making its first-ever trip to the NCAA championships on May 12-15 in Florida. At the Legacy Club at Alaqua Lakes in Longwood, Fla., the Huskies placed eighth with a score of 1305. Rollins College was the tournament champ with a score of 1196, while Ferris State and Florida Southern were tied for second with a score of 1264. Individually, Kristin Osheim placed 22nd with a score of 319 (86-81-74-78) and Sarah LeClair placed 28th with a score of 324 (78-82-83-81). Angela Kippley placed 34th at the meet with a score of 329 (80-81-87-81) and Kristina Carlin placed 42nd with a score of 334 (79-82-87-86). The group was completed by Becca Rotert with a 48th place score of 354 (85-86-94-89). Of note, Charlotte Campbell from Rollins College was the tournament medalist with a mark of 299.

**MEN WIN REGIONAL:** Led by Swedberg, who took medalist honors, the SCSU men's golf team captured first place at the 2004 NCAA Division II Northwest Regional tournament on May 5, in Bellingham, Wash. This marked the first time in school history this SCSU has won the regional tournament. Swedberg carded a three-day total of 215 on the links at Bellingham Golf and Country Club. His final total was 73, while he posted a 72 on day one and 70 on day (his score of 70 was the second best round in the tournament). The runner-up was Travis Morton of Colorado State-Pueblo with a 217 (74-74-69), while NDSU's Jon Miller was third at 218. As a team, SCSU posted a three-day total of 900 (302-292-306) and it was nine strokes above runner-ups Fort Lewis College (909) and Minnesota State, Mankato (909) and South Dakota (909). The remainder of the the field included Colorado-Colorado Springs (915), Nebraska-Kearney (915), North Dakota State (917) and Colorado State-Pueblo (931). In addition to Swedberg's scores, SCSU saw Bob Gartland place ninth with a 226

(77-73-76) and Chris Little also place ninth at 226 (75-73-78). SCSU's Pete Jameson placed 36th at 238 (83-76-79) and Josh Hagstrom placed 38th at 239 (78-77-74).

**WOMEN PLACE SECOND AT REGIONAL:** For the first time in history, St. Cloud State University has qualified for the NCAA Division II women's championships. The Huskies gained a trip to Florida next weekend thanks to their second place finish at the NCAA Division II North Region Tournament on May 4-5 in Mankato. Minnesota State University won the six-team regional with a score of 1,014, while the Huskies shot a three-round total of 1,043 (353-351-339). SCSU's senior Angela Kippley (St. Cloud/Tech) led the squad with an 8th place finish at 256 (83-90-83). Kristin Osheim placed 9th with a score of 258 (90-89-79), and her score of 79 on the final day marked the second lowest round score in tournament play. Sarah LeClair, a 2003 national qualifier for the Huskies as an individual, placed 11th at the regional with a score of 261 (88-86-87) and Kristina Carlin placed 15th with a tally of 268 (92-86-90). SCSU's team was completed by Becca Rotert, who had a 26th place score of 278 (94-94-90). The regional field was completed by Southwest Minnesota State (1046), Nebraska-Omaha (1050), South Dakota State (1078) and South Dakota (1085).

**A SEASON TO REMEMBER:** The St. Cloud State men's golf team enjoyed an impressive spring season with first place tournament finishes at the 2004 South Dakota Invitational, 2004 MSU, Mankato Invitational, 2004 Northwest Regional Head-to-Head Tournament, the 2004 St. John's University Invitational and the 2004 NCAA Division II Northwest Regional Tournament in Bellingham, Wash. Brett Swedberg gained medalist honors at the USD, MSU-Mankato, St. John's and NCAA Regional tournaments this spring. On the women's side, the Huskies placed 3rd at the USD Invitational, 4th at Mankato and second at the NCAA regional meet this spring. Angela Kippley won medalist honors at the MSU, Mankato open for the women on April 24-25.

**NCC RESULTS:** The St. Cloud State men's golf team placed third at the 2003 North Central Conference championships on Oct. 4-6, in Sioux Falls, S.D. Chris Little led the Huskies at the tournament with a second place score of 65-67-73=205. Robb Bierbaum of South Dakota won the medalist honors with a 68-69-66=203. SCSU's other top placer was Josh Hagstrom, who placed ninth with a score of 73-68-77=218. As a team, SCSU was third with a score of 288-274-305=867. USD won the meet with a tally of 286-278-285=849 and Augustana was second at 291-275-290=853. North Dakota State (300-279-297=876), North Dakota (297-289-298=884), Minnesota State (312-280-297=889) and South Dakota State (310-286-299=895) completed the field. SCSU's other placers were as follows: T16. Jim Anderson (76-68-77=221), T23. Bob Gartland (74-74-78=226) and T31. Tanner Bown (77-71-83=231). On the women's side of the tournament, SCSU placed fourth with a score of 320-300-232=943. UN-Omaha won the event with a tally of 308-305-306=919, while MSU, Mankato was second (314-305-312=931) and UND was third at (309-313-318=940). SDSU (324-315-316=955), USD (317-320-327=964), Augustana (347-329-348=1024) and NDSU (359-340-373=1072) completed the field. Kristin Osheim led the Huskies with a third place finish of 78-69-78=225 and Sarah LeClair (11th) had a 81-74-80=235. The other SCSU placers were Angela Kippley (77-77-82=236), Kristina Carlin (84-80-84=248) and Becca Rotert (87-85-83=255). First team All-NCC honors were bestowed upon Little and Osheim, while Gartland and LeClair gained second team All-NCC honors in 2003.

**LAST YEAR:** The SCSU women's team qualified for the NCAA Division II North Region tournament in 2003, and placed fourth as a team. Sarah LeClair placed sixth at the regional, and qualified for the NCAA nationals in 2003. At the national tournament at Howey-in-the-Hills, Fla, LeClair placed 42nd overall. In NCC action last year, the Huskies placed 4th on the women's side and third in men's play. Chris Little and Pete Jameson were both named to the All-NCC golf team last year.
