## 2005-06 SCSU MEN'S HOCKEY NEWS

Release Date: Oct. 24, 2005

**BACK AT THE NHC:** The St. Cloud State men's hockey team (1-2-1, 0-1-1 WCHA) will continue its 2005-06 season with a pair of 7:07 p.m. home games against #7 Minnesota (2-1-1, 2-0-0 WCHA) on Friday and Saturday, Oct. 28-29 at the National Hockey Center (cap. 5,763/200x100) in St. Cloud. The games will be broadcast live on KNSI AM 1450 and KCML FM 99.9 out of St. Cloud. KVSC FM 88.1 will also carry the games live this weekend. The games will also be televised on Charter Communications Cable Television channel 14 in St. Cloud and Fox Sports North. Of note, the Oct. 28 game will be televised live throughout the nation on ESPNU. Tickets are available for both games (as of Oct. 25), so please call 1-877-SCSUTIX or 320-308-2137 for more information.

**2004-05 RESULTS:** The St. Cloud State University men's hockey team ended its 2004-05 season with a 14-23-3 overall record and an 8-19-1 WCHA record. In the always rugged WCHA, the Huskies placed ninth in 2004-05.



**SCSU COACH BOB MOTZKO:** Motzko (1-2-1, 0-1-1 WCHA career record) is only the second coach at SCSU since the Huskies moved to the NCAA Division I level in 1987-88. Motzko played served as a men's hockey assistant coach at the University of Minnesota from 2001-2005. A 1987 graduate of St. Cloud State University, Motzko was a two-year varsity letterwinner for the SCSU hockey team from 1984-86. Motzko began his coaching career in 1986-87 as an assistant coach for the legendary Herb Brooks at SCSU - and also worked with former SCSU head coach Craig Dahl.

Motzko went on to serve as general manager and head coach of the USHL's North Iowa Huskies from 1987 through 1991. In 1991, Motzko was named assistant coach at Miami University (Ohio). He served for one season as an associate head coach at the University of Denver from 1993-94, before returning to Miami University in 1994. Motzko was named general manager and head coach of the USHL's Sioux Falls Stampede in 1998, and in 2000, Motzko was named the USHL General Manager of the Year. He then joined the staff at Minnesota in 2001. A native of Austin, Minn., Motzko and his wife Shelley are the parents of three children. They currently reside in St. Cloud, Minn.

**ASSISTANT COACHING STAFF:** Coach Motzko will be assisted in 2005-06 by Fred Harbinson and Eric Rud. Harbinson begins his fourth season as a member of the SCSU coaching corps in 2005-06. Harbinson is a 1995 graduate of Wisconsin-Superior. Rud will begin his first season as an assistant at SCSU in 2005-06. A 1997 graduate of Colorado College, Rud served as an assistant at CC in 2004-05. Eric Bakke will serve as the team's video coordinator in 2005-06, and Jeff Kruger will work as the team's strength and conditioning coach. Dave Wenniger is the team's goalie coach in 2005-06.

**HUSKIES MAKE ESPN DEBUT:** St. Cloud State and the National Hockey Center will have its debut on an ESPN affiliate this weekend. On Oct. 28, the Huskies- Minnesota game will be carried live on ESPNU, which marks the first time a regular season home game from SCSU has been carried on an ESPN affiliate. ESPNU will carry the feed nationally provided by Charter Communications Cable, which features the play-by-play voices of SCSU grads Clay Matvick and Ryan Dale. The game will be produced by SCSU's Husky Productions crew under the leadership of advisor Gregory Martin. Husky Productions is a student-run operation that provides invaluable hands-on television production experience for many students in SCSU's nationally accredited mass communications program. ESPNU is available on Direct TV channel 609. The game, as with all SCSU home games this season (with the exception of the Dec. 18 game) will also be televised on Charter Communications Cable Channel 14 in the St. Cloud area.

**HUSKY HOCKEY ON THE AIR:** Once again in 2005-06, KNSI AM 1450 and KCML FM 99.59 will carry SCSU hockey live over the radio (and on the web at www.1450knsi.com). Don Lyons will call the play-by-play with color commentary provided by SCSU All-American Dave Reichel..home and away games will also be broadcast live on KVSC 88.1. ## MORE NEWS AND NOTES...

**TEAM CAPTAINS:** Junior defender Casey Borer, a resident of Brooklyn Park, Minn., will serve as a team captain for the Huskies in 2005-06. The alternate captains for this winter are senior forward Konrad Reeder (Vanderhoof, B.C.) and senior forward Brock Hooton (Nanaimo, B.C.). Of note, the last time a junior served as a team captain for the Huskies was Jon Cullen in 2001-02.

**HUSKIES TIE UW:** SCSU opened its 2005-06 WCHA season with a solid 2-2 tie against #13 ranked Wisconsin at the NHC on Oct. 21. Down 2-1 in the final period, sophomore Matt Hartman a native of St. Cloud was the game's hometown hero as he netted his first goal of the season at 8:44 of the third with assists going to junior forward Dan Kronick and sophomore defender Matt Stephenson. The tally knotted the score at 2-2, which stood through the overtime session as the Huskies outshot Wisconsin 3-0 in the extra period. SCSU broke a 0-0 stalemate in the second period, when freshman forward Michael Olson posted a shorthanded goal at 10:16. Stephenson added the assist on the play.

Wisconsin charged back in the third period with a goal by Jack Skille at 7:01. The Badgers gained a brief lead at 2-1, when Tom Gilbert scored at 7:52, with assists going to Jake Dowell and Matt Ford. Overall, SCSU outshot UW 37-26 in the contest. In the nets, SCSU's Bobby Goepfert was impressive with 24 saves to his credit in his second consecutive OT game. On the power play, SCSU was 0-of-7 and UW was 0-of-6... SCSU dropped a tough 3-1 decision at home against #13 Wisconsin on Oct. 22. The Badgers never trailed in the game, as they gained a 1-0 lead in the first period with a goal by Ryan MacMurchy at 7:43 on the power play. At 4:11 of the second period, Pavelski notched the game winner. The Huskies got back into the game at 9:19 of the second period, when Andrew Gordon posted his second goal of the young season. The power play marker was assisted by Joe Jensen and Billy Hengen. UW iced the contest at 9:12 of the third period, as Pavelski posted his second goal of the night. Wisconsin outshot the Huskies 28-15 in the match, as Goepfert made 25 saves and gained the game's third star award. Elliott had 14 saves for the Badgers. On the power play, SCSU was 1-of-6 and UW was 1-of-9. A total of 5,988 fans packed the NHC on "Craig Dahl Appreciation Night" at SCSU. The Huskies saluted Dahl during an emotional ceremony between the first and second period of the game against Wisconsin. Dahl led the Huskies from 1987 until he stepped down as head coach prior to the start of the 2005-06 season.

**AS SEEN ON TV:** A total of 17 SCSU home games will be seen live on Charter Communications Cable Television in the St. Cloud area during the 2005-06 season. The lone games that are not slated to be shown live on Charter Communication Cable Television in 2005-06 are the Alberta game on Oct. 8 and the Robert Morris game on Dec. 18. The remaining 17 home games are scheduled to be televised live. SCSU graduate and Twin Cities sports media personality Clay Matvick will provide the play-by-play this season, with fellow Husky graduate Ryan Dale providing the color commentary. The telecasts are completely produced live by SCSU's mass communications students under the guidance of Husky Productions faculty advisor Gregory Martin.
