2007-08 SCSU Men's Hockey News

Release Date: Oct. 9, 2007

SEASON OPENER: The #17 St. Cloud State University men's hockey team 22-11-7, 14-7-7 WCHA record in 2006-07) will open its 2007-08 season on Friday and Saturday, Oct. 12-13, with a pair of 7:07 p.m. games against Canisius College at the National Hockey Center (5,763 cap./200x100). Tickets are available for these games, and information about tickets can be obtained by calling 1-877-SCSUTIX or 320-308-2137.

LAST YEAR: The Huskies (22-11-7) placed second in the always rugged Western Collegiate Hockey Association (14-7-7 WCHA), which equals the team's best-ever finish in the regular season standings of the WCHA since SCSU joined the league in 1990-91. SCSU advanced to the 2007 WCHA Final Five for the second consecutive season (10th time in team history), thanks to first round playoff wins over Minnesota Duluth (SCSU won the series 2-1). To complete the season, the Huskies gained thier first NCAA Division I tournament bid since 2003. This marked the sixth NCAA bid for the Huskies since 1989. SCSU lost in first round play at the 2007 NCAA East Regional by a score of 4-1 against Maine in Rochester, N.Y. The Huskies were the #2 seed at the Regional tournament.

PRESS PASS: All SCSU games will be broadcast live on KCML FM 99.9 in the St. Cloud area with Don Lyons and Dave Reichel calling the shots this season. Fans will be able to listen to the games on the web by going to the Leighton Broadcasting website at www.lite999.com. Selected Husky games will also be broadcast live on KVSC FM 88.1 (www.kvsc.org).

THE BOB MOTZKO SHOW: The Bob Motzko Show will air every Monday during the season from 6 p.m. to 7 p.m. on KNSI 1450 AM. The show will broadcast live from Roster's Sports Bar and Grill in St. Cloud. You can listen on the web at www.1450knsi.com

TV TIME: All SCSU home games this season will be televised live on Charter Cable's Mainstreet network (Charter Cable Channel 14 in the St. Cloud area), with Rob Hudson and Brian Piatt calling the shots. The games at UMD and Minnesota State are also slated to air on Charter Mainstreet.

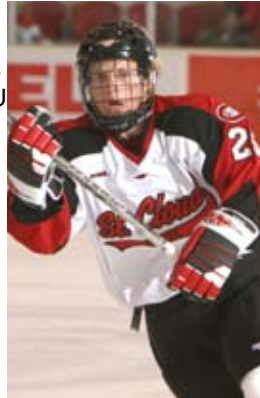
Husky Headliners:

- The Huskies will open their 2007-08 season on Oct. 12-13, with a pair of home games against non-conference rival Canisius. This marks the first times these two teams have played each other.
- In 2006-07, SCSU's Andreas Nodl was named the inaugural HCA Rookie of the Year for Division I. He also received Rookie of the Year honors from the WCHA, CHN and USCHO.com. He has been selected as a Player to Watch in the CHN preseason All-American poll.
- The Huskies were picked sixth in the 2007-08 preseason WCHA poll. Last year, the Huskies were picked fifth in the poll, but finished second in the final 2006-07 WCHA standings. In the preseason national polls, SCSU was ranked 17th by USCHO.com and 16th by the Let's Play Hockey preseason poll.
- The Huskies will bring back 18 letterwinners from last year's squad, which finished with a 22-11-7, 14-7-7 WCHA record. This includes six of the team's top 10 point producers from last year.
- Bob Motzko will begin his third season at SCSU in 2007-08. He will be joined on the bench by assistants Eric Rud and newcomer Mike Gibbons.



MORE NEWS AND NOTES...

POLL POSITION: SCSU received a #17 ranking in the USCHO.com preseason poll, and it received votes in the USA Today/USA Hockey Magazine preseason poll. The Huskies were also ranked #16 in the Let's Play Hockey preseason poll. The Huskies ended the 2006-07 season ranked 7th in the final USCHO.com poll and 8th in the final USA Today/USA Hockey Magazine poll. In the Inside College Hockey poll, the Huskies were ranked 10th in that final poll. SCSU has gained a spot in the college hockey top 20 polls for 35 consecutive weeks - dating back to Jan. 30, 2006...of note, the #2 ranking (on 2/28) equals the best ranking the Huskies hit last season. The last time SCSU was higher in the polls, was a second place ranking on Feb. 25, 2002...in the WCHA pre-season poll, the Huskies received a sixth place ranking for 2007-08.

NCAA FACTS: The Huskies made their sixth trip to the NCAA championships in 2007, and their first trip since 2003. SCSU's first NCAA bid was received in 1989, and the Huskies have also made NCAA appearances in 2000, 2001, 2002 and 2003. The Huskies are 0-7 in NCAA tournament play since 1989.

FINAL FIVE FACTS: The Huskies returned to the WCHA Final Five for the second consecutive season in 2007. The second seed in the WCHA post-season, SCSU earned their trip to the WCHA Final Five in St. Paul with a big 2-1 series win against Minnesota Duluth on March 9-11 in St. Cloud. This marked the first time since 2001-02 that the Huskies had home ice in the WCHA tournament. In game one against UMD, the Huskies lost 3-1. In game two, the Huskies posted a 3-2 overtime win over the Bulldogs. In the third game, SCSU won an epic 3-2 triple OT decision against UMD. At 11:33, this was the longest game in team history and the fifth longest game in NCAA Division I ice hockey history.

TEAM CAPTAIN: Senior defender Matt Stephenson, a resident of Midland, Ontario, has been named as the Huskies' captain for 2007-08. Senior forward Nate Dey (Maplewood, Minn.) was named an alternate captain for 2007-08.

FIT TO BE TIED: The Huskies set a team record by chalking up seven ties last season, which bypassed the old record of five ties in 1999. The seven ties also tied a league record for most ties in WCHA play. SCSU also set a new team record by participating in 12 OT games this season. SCSU was 3-2-7 in OT games this season.

COACH OF THE YEAR PART II: SCSU coach Bob Motzko was named the WCHA coach of the Year for the second consecutive season in 2006-07. This marks the third time in team history that a SCSU coach has gained WCHA Coach of the Year honors. Motzko was also selected for the second consecutive season as a finalist for the Spencer Penrose Award, which is awarded to the nation's Division I Coach of the Year by the AHCA.

The Motzko Story

Bob Motzko (44-27-11, 27-20-9 WCHA career record) was named as the 2007 and 2006 WCHA Co-Coach of the Year. Motzko is only the second coach at SCSU since the Huskies moved to the NCAA Division I level in 1987-88. Motzko was also named as the INCH National Division I Coach of the Year. Motzko served as a men's hockey assistant coach at the University of Minnesota from 2001-2005. A 1987 graduate of St. Cloud State University, Motzko was a two-year varsity letterwinner for the SCSU hockey team from 1984-86. Motzko began his coaching career in 1986-87 as an assistant coach for the legendary Herb Brooks at SCSU - and also worked with former SCSU head coach Craig Dahl. Motzko went on to serve as general manager and head coach of the USHL's North Iowa Huskies from 1987 through 1991. In 1991, Motzko was named assistant coach at Miami University (Ohio). He served for one season as an associate head coach at the University of Denver from 1993-94, before returning to Miami University in 1994. Motzko was named general manager and head coach of the USHL's Sioux Falls Stampede in 1998, and in 2000, Motzko was named the USHL General Manager of the Year. He then joined the staff at Minnesota in 2001. A native of Austin, Minn., Motzko and his wife Shelley are the parents of three children. They currently reside in St. Cloud, Minn.

MOTZKO's STAFF: Motzko will be assisted this winter by third-year coach **Eric Rud** and first-year coach Mike Gibbons. and first-year volunteer goalie coach **Justin Johnson**. SCSU's support staff features 13-year veteran equipment manager **Jeremiah Minkel**, three-year veteran athletic trainer **Bryan DeMaine**, strength and fitness coordinator **Travis Zins** and director of hockey operations **Mr. Matt Chapman**.



MORE NEWS AND NOTES...

PLAYER TO WATCH: SCSU sophomore Andreas Nodl (Vienna, Austria) has been named as a player to watch in 2007-08 by the College Hockey News pre-season All-America list. Nodl was selected as the 2007 HCA Division I Rookie of the Year. The team's leading scorer with 46 points (18g/28a), Nodl was recognized as the 2007 WCHA Rookie of the Year and he also earned All-WCHA Third Team honors and WCHA All-Rookie Team accolades. Nodl led the team with 46 points, 28 assists and five game winning goals. The five GWGs this season tied a team record for most game winners in a season. He also set a team record for points by a freshman in one season. Nodl was the first player in team history to earn WCHA Rookie of the Year honors, and he was the first freshman player at SCSU to be selected for All-WCHA honors. Of note, Nodl was also named to the Inside College Hockey and College Hockey News All-Rookie teams. He was named the HCA Division I Rookie of the Month in January.

ALL-ROOKIES NOW SOPHOMORES: Ryan Lasch (Lake Forest, Calif.) gained a spot on the 2007 WCHA All-Rookie Team along with Nodl. Lasch notched 16 goals and 23 assists for 39 points this winter. He was named the HCA Division I Rookie of the Month in November. In WCHA games only, Lasch ranked second in the league in scoring at 1.14 ppg.

BEST IN THE STATE OF HOCKEY: SCSU won the coveted DQ Cup in 2006-07. This award is sponsored by Dairy Queen, and it is presented to the WCHA team from the state of Minnesota that has the best win-loss record in action against other WCHA teams from the state of Minnesota. SCSU was 7-2-3 this season in WCHA games against Minnesota, Minnesota Duluth and Minnesota State Mankato. The Huskies' win rate of .708 those games aced out second place Minnesota (5-2-3, .650).

HOBEBY FINALIST: SCSU's Bobby Goepfert became the second player in SCSU history last season to be named a Hobey Baker Award top 10 finalist. Goepfert also became the first Husky at the Division I level to gain All-America honors twice during his collegiate career. The last SCSU player to gain All-America honors twice was Mike Brodzinski in 1986 and 1987 (DIII level). Goepfert set a team record by posting a 2.24 goals against average during his career with the Huskies.

Goepfert also broke Scott Meyer's career record for save percentage at .924 for his two years at SCSU. In just two seasons at SCSU, Goepfert had 2,014 saves – which ranks fifth in team history. He had 1,010 saves in 2005-06 and 1,004 saves in 2006-07 – which mark the second and third times in team history that a Husky goalie had 1,000-plus saves in a season. Goepfert's career 27.59 saves per game ranks first in team history. He ranks fifth in team history with 37 wins (37-24-11). A transfer from Providence College, Goepfert set team records this season with seven ties in 2006-07 and he also hit a team career record with 11 from 2005-07.

GREAT DEFENSE: 2006-07 marked the fourth time in team history that the Huskies have allowed less than 100 goals in a season. SCSU gave up only 99 goals in 40 games this season. The team's record for least goals allowed in a season was 92 in 2000-01 (41 games). SCSU also allowed 97 goals in a season in 2001-02 and 2005-06.

THE STREAK: SCSU set a team record by winning 12 games in a row. The streak started on Nov. 17, 2006 with a 4-0 win over Clarkson. The streak ended on Jan. 12, 2007 with a tough 6-4 loss at home against Minnesota State Mankato. SCSU also set a team record with its 15-game unbeaten streak from Nov. 4, 2006 to Jan. 12, 2007. Of note, SCSU was 9-7-5 against nationally ranked teams this season and that included wins over Minnesota, Clarkson, Denver, Vermont and CC.

THE HOUSE WAS A ROCKING: The Huskies averaged 5,971 fans (8th in the nation) at their home games in 2006-07, which equals a total of 125,396 fans at 21 games this season. This marks the 11th consecutive season that SCSU has drawn over 100,000 fans to its home games and it is the second largest number of fans for a single-season of SCSU hockey. The team's single-season attendance record of 128,641 fans was set in 1997-98 (23 games).

NO SHG ALLOWED: SCSU allowed no shorthanded goals last season, which marked the first time in team history (DI level) that the Huskies have accomplished this feat. season.
