## 2005-06 SCSU MEN'S HOCKEY NEWS

Release Date: Jan. 9, 2006

**BACK ON THE ROAD:** The St. Cloud State men's hockey team (9-8-3, 4-7-1 WCHA) will travel to Denver, Colo. for a pair of conference games at the University of Denver (11-9-2, 8-4-2 WCHA) on Friday and Saturday, Jan. 13-14. The game on Jan. 13 will start at 8:37 p.m. (CT) and the game on Jan. 14 will kick off at 8:07 p.m. The games will also be broadcast live on KNSI AM 1450/KCML FM 99.90 out of St. Cloud. The games will be televised live on Fox Sports Net Rocky Mountain, which is available on DirecTV (channel 645) in the St. Cloud area. This will mark the first and only regular season appearance for the Huskies against the defending national champions Denver this season.

**2005-06 RESULTS:** SCSU is 9-8-3, 4-7-1 WCHA in 2005-06. The St. Cloud State University men's hockey team ended its 2004-05 season with a 14-23-3 overall record and an 8-19-1 WCHA record. In the always rugged WCHA, the Huskies placed ninth in 2004-05.



**SCSU COACH BOB MOTZKO:** Motzko (9-8-3, 4-7-1 WCHA career record) is only the second coach at SCSU since the Huskies moved to the NCAA Division I level in 1987-88. Motzko served as a men's hockey assistant coach at the University of Minnesota from 2001-2005. A 1987 graduate of St. Cloud State University, Motzko was a two-year varsity letterwinner for the SCSU hockey team from 1984-86. Motzko began his coaching career in 1986-87 as an assistant coach for the legendary Herb Brooks at SCSU - and also worked with former SCSU head coach Craig Dahl. Motzko

went on to serve as general manager and head coach of the USHL's North Iowa Huskies from 1987 through 1991. In 1991, Motzko was named assistant coach at Miami University (Ohio). He served for one season as an associate head coach at the University of Denver from 1993-94, before returning to Miami University in 1994. Motzko was named general manager and head coach of the USHL's Sioux Falls Stampede in 1998, and in 2000, Motzko was named the USHL General Manager of the Year. He then joined the staff at Minnesota in 2001. A native of Austin, Minn., Motzko and his wife Shelley are the parents of three children. They currently reside in St. Cloud, Minn.

**ASSISTANT COACHING STAFF:** Coach Motzko will be assisted in 2005-06 by Fred Harbinson and Eric Rud. Harbinson begins his fourth season as a member of the SCSU coaching corps in 2005-06. Harbinson is a 1995 graduate of Wisconsin-Superior. Rud will begin his first season as an assistant at SCSU in 2005-06. A 1997 graduate of Colorado College, Rud served as an assistant at CC in 2004-05. Eric Bakke will serve as the team's video coordinator in 2005-06, and Jeff Kruger will work as the team's strength and conditioning coach. Dave Wenniger is the team's goalie coach in 2005-06. The staff is completed by director of equipment operations and 11-year veteran Jeremiah MInkel.

**POLL POSITION:** The Huskies recently received votes in one of the national Division I college hockey polls. The current USCHO.com poll listed the Huskies with 1 vote in the national poll. Of note, this week's opponent Colgate is ranked #12 in the USCHO.com poll and #14 in the USA Today/USA Hockey Magazine poll this week.



## MORE NEWS AND NOTES...

**TEAM CAPTAINS:** Junior defender Casey Borer, a resident of Brooklyn Park, Minn., will serve as a team captain for the Huskies in 2005-06. The alternate captains for this winter are senior forward Konrad Reeder (Vanderhoof, B.C.) and senior forward Brock Hooton (Nanaimo, B.C.). Of note, the last time a junior served as a team captain for the Huskies was Jon Cullen in 2001-02.

**HUSKIES WIN, TIE AT COLGATE:** A third period goal by Michael Olson helped St. Cloud State to a 3-2 win at #12/14 Colgate on Jan. 6, in Hamilton, N.Y. Olson notched his game winner at 5:49 with assists from Aaron Brocklehurst and John Swanson. This was Olson's second goal of the season. The Huskies' first goal was posted by Nate Raduns, who scored at 13:31 on a wrap around goal with assists from Justin Fletcher and Konrad Reeder. In the second period, Colgate tied the contest at 6:26 with a power play goal by Nick St. Pierre. The Huskies regained the lead at 2-1 with a power play tally from Andrew Gordon (his eighth goal of the season) with assists from Fletcher and Brock Hooton. The Raiders charged back at 16:33 with an even-strength goal by Marc Fulton. In the game, SCSU outshot Colgate 41-32 and it outshot the Raiders 18-8 in the third period. Bobby Goepfert had 30 saves while Kowalkoski had 38 saves in the game. On the power play, SCSU was 1-of-8 and Colgate was 1-of-6... in an upstate New York shootout, SCSU skated to a 5-5 tie at #12/14 Colgate University (10-5-5) in Hamilton, N.Y. on Jan. 7. A goal by Matt Hartman at 18:11 of the third period pushed the score to 5-5 and forced SCSU's fifth overtime adventure of the season. The Huskies opened the evening's scoring with a tally by Swanson. He posted the goal at 6:04 with a shot from the slot past Colgate netminder Mark Dekanich. He was assisted on the play by Hartman and Olson. The Raiders tied the score at 13:19 of the first period with a goal by Tom Riley. Colgate gained a 2-1 lead in the match with a goal by Jon Smyth at 16:49 of the first period. In the second period, Colgate extended its lead to 3-1, as Marc Fulton scored at 4:14 on the power play. The Huskies got back into the mix at 15:53 of the second period with a power play goal by Dan Kronick. Assists were carded on the play by Gary Houseman and Brocklehurst. SCSU had gained the advantage when Colgate's Jesse Winchester was sent to the box after checking Billy Hengen from behind - resulting in a five minute penalty and a game misconduct. Still on the power play in the second period, the Huskies took advantage with a power play goal by Gordon at 18:10. Assists were credited to Hengen and Reeder. The goal provided a 3-3 score going into the final period. Colgate regained the game's lead at 1:30 of the third period with a goal by Kyle Wilson. The battling Huskies knotted the score at 4-4 with their third power play goal of the evening. This time, Fletcher scored at 9:09 of the third with assists from Reeder and Hengen. Colgate went up 5-4 at 12:58 with a power play goal by Wilson. SCSU was not ready to call it a night, as the Huskies tied the game up once again with a goal by Hartman at 18:11. In the slot, Hartman was assisted on the play by Casey Borer and Swanson. The Huskies will outshot Colgate 44-33 in the game, as they were 3-of-8 on the power play. Bobby Goepfert made 28 saves in the game, as Dekanich had 39 saves for Colgate.

## MORE NEWS AND NOTES...

**THE BOB MOTZKO SHOW:** The Bob Motzko Show will air live on Mondays from 6 p.m. to 7 p.m. on KNSI 1450 AM from JPs Grill and Bar in Sauk Rapids. Don Lyons will serve as the program's host along with Coach Motzko. St. Cloud Times sports writer Kevin Alenspach will also provide his insight each week. The public is invited to attend the weekly show at JPs Grill and Bar (located at Hwy 10 and Golden Spike Road in Sauk Rapids).

**NOTES FROM NEW YORK:** St. Cloud State completed its final non-conference series of the regular season with a trip to Hamilton, N.Y. for a two-game set against #12/14 Colgate. This marked the first time these two teams had played and it was SCSU's first games played in the state of New York since at RPI on Nov. 21-22, 2003. SCSU is only the second team from the WCHA to play in the Starr Arena at Colgate. The last time a WCHA squad played at Colgate's Starr Arena (which was used in the filming of the famed hockey movie "Slapshot") was Colorado College on Jan. 6, 1964 – 42 years to the day that SCSU played game one at Colgate...the Huskies have enjoyed success over the year against teams from the ECAC, as their record is 18-11-3 against ECAC teams since going DI in 1987-88...the Huskies have now played 12 games this season against teams ranked in the national polls. Colgate was ranked #12/14 going into the weekend, and the Huskies are now 4-6-2 in play against those nationally ranked teams.

**REEDER ROLLS:** Senior forward Konrad Reeder now has scored a point in his last seven consecutive games. This year, Reeder has netted six goals and seven assists for a total of 13 points...on the topic of point scoring streaks, sophomore defender Aaron Brocklehurst has a four-game scoring streak, which includes four assists in the the last four games for the Huskies.

**A NICE RUN:** The Huskies now own a 6-2-2 in its last 10 games and they are 3-1-1 in the team's last five outings...SCSU has a four-game unbeaten string which equals a four-game unbeaten streak set from Oct. 29, 2004 through Nov. 12, 2004 (wins over Princeton, Yale and MTU).

**OLSON GAINS GWG AND OTHER NOTES:** Rookie Michael Olson scored his first game winning goal for the Huskies on Jan. 6 against Colgate...Andrew Gordon now leads the team with 22 points this season (9g/13a). He moved ahead of senior Joe Jensen, who has 12 goals and 9 assists for 21 points...senior Billy Hengen ranks third on the team with 3 goals and 15 assists for 18 points. The 15 assists equals a career season-best for Hengen. He has posted 15 assists in both 2003-04 and 2004-05.... with 43 goals and 46 assists in his career, Joe Jensen leads the team in career scoring among active players. He ranks 18th in the SCSU career goal charts...Andrew Gordon leads the Huskies at +13 on the plus/minus.

**TOUGH SLATE:** The Huskies have played six nationally ranked team this season - including #1 Wisconsin (which they tied 2-2 and lost 3-1 on Oct. 21-22 in St. Cloud). Others on that list include Northern Michigan, Minnesota, Colgate, Colorado College and North Dakota. SCSU has posted a win or a tie over all the nationally ranked teams - with the exception of Colorado College. Denver will be SCSU's seventh nationally ranked team played this season.

**PLAYER OF THE WEEK:** John Swanson became the second SCSU player to gain WCHA Player of the Week honors on Jan. 9. He netted one goal and two assists at Colgate and was named the WCHA Rookie of the Week. He is the first SCSU player since Matt Hartman to gain Rookie of the Week honors. Last year, Hartman was named Rookie of the Week on Feb. 7, 2005.

**REUNION TIME:** SCSU coach Bob Motzko will face-off against his old boss this weekend in Denver. Motzko served as an assistant coach from 1991-93 when current DU coach George Gwozdecky was the head coach at Miami University. This marks the first time as a college coach that Motzko has faced Gwozdecky. Earlier this year, Motzko and his Huskies faced off against Don Lucia at Minesota - where Motzko was an assistant from 2001-05.
