2005-06 SCSU MEN'S HOCKEY NEWS

Release Date: Jan. 16, 2006

BACK ON THE ROAD: The St. Cloud State men's hockey team (10-9-3, 5-8-1 WCHA) will host Minnesota Duluth (8-12-4, 5-8-3 WCHA) for a pair of WCHA games at the National Hockey Center in St. Cloud, Minn. on Friday, Jan. 20 and Saturday, Jan. 21. Game time both nights is slated for 7:07 p.m. The games will also be broadcast live on KNSI AM 1450/KCML FM 99.90 out of St. Cloud and KVSC FM 88.1 - the campus station of SCSU. The games will be televised live on Charter Communications Channel 14 in the St. Cloud area. Of note, the game on Jan. 21 will be broadcast live in the Duluth area on WDIO TV. This will mark the first and only regular season appearance for the Huskies against the Bulldogs in 2005-06.

2005-06 RESULTS: SCSU is 10-9-3, 5-8-1 WCHA in 2005-06. The St. Cloud State University men's hockey team ended its 2004-05 season with a 14-23-3 overall record and an 8-19-1 WCHA record. In the always rugged WCHA, the Huskies placed ninth in 2004-05.



SCSU COACH BOB MOTZKO: Motzko (10-9-3, 5-8-1 WCHA career record) is only the second coach at SCSU since the Huskies moved to the NCAA Division I level in 1987-88. Motzko served as a men's hockey assistant coach at the University of Minnesota from 2001-2005. A 1987 graduate of St. Cloud State University, Motzko was a two-year varsity letterwinner for the SCSU hockey team from 1984-86. Motzko began his coaching career in 1986-87 as an assistant coach for the legendary Herb Brooks at SCSU - and also worked with former SCSU head coach Craig Dahl. Motzko went on to serve as general manager and head coach of the USHL's North Iowa Huskies from 1987 through 1991. In 1991, Motzko was named assistant coach at Miami University (Ohio). He served for one season as an associate head coach at the University of Denver from 1993-94, before returning to Miami University in 1994. Motzko was named general manager and head coach of the USHL's Sioux Falls Stampede in 1998, and in 2000, Motzko was named the USHL General Manager of the Year. He then joined the staff at Minnesota in 2001. A native of Austin, Minn., Motzko and his wife Shelley are the parents of three children. They currently reside in St. Cloud, Minn.

ASSISTANT COACHING STAFF: Coach Motzko will be assisted in 2005-06 by Fred Harbinson and Eric Rud. Harbinson begins his fourth season as a member of the SCSU coaching corps in 2005-06. Harbinson is a 1995 graduate of Wisconsin-Superior. Rud will begin his first season as an assistant at SCSU in 2005-06. A 1997 graduate of Colorado College, Rud served as an assistant at CC in 2004-05. Eric Bakke will serve as the team's video coordinator in 2005-06, and Jeff Kruger will work as the team's strength and conditioning coach. Dave Wenniger is the team's goalie coach in 2005-06. The staff is completed by director of equipment operations and 11-year veteran Jeremiah MInkel.

MORE NEWS AND NOTES...

TEAM CAPTAINS: Junior defender Casey Borer, a resident of Brooklyn Park, Minn., will serve as a team captain for the Huskies in 2005-06. The alternate captains for this winter are senior forward Konrad Reeder (Vanderhoof, B.C.) and senior forward Brock Hooton (Nanaimo, B.C.). Of note, the last time a junior served as a team captain for the Huskies was Jon Cullen in 2001-02.

HUSKIES TOPPLE DEFENDING CHAMPS:

SCSU snapped a six-game losing streak against Denver with a 5-1 victory over the defending NCAA champs on Jan. 13 in Denver Colo. The Huskies opened the game's scoring at 5:44 of the first with a tally by Joe Jensen who dug the puck past DU goalie Glenn Fisher. Assists on the play were carded by Billy Hengen and Matt Stephenson. The goal was Jensen's team-leading 13th of the season and it was Hengen's team-leading 16th assist of the season. Hengen padded SCSU's lead to 2-0 with a power play goal at 9:04 of the first period. Jensen notched his 10th assist of the season on the play along with Brock Hooton. The Pioneers posted their lone first period goal at 14:08 with a score by Matt Carle. The Huskies got back on track offensively with a goal by Gary Houseman. He scored his fourth goal of the season at 16:11 of the first period with assists from Justin Fletcher and Nate Dey. In the second period, Aaron Brocklehurst posted his second goal of the season at 5:45. The lone assist on the slap shot from the point by Brocklehurst was marked by Grant Clifton. The goal prompted DU to pull its starting netminder Fisher and replace him with Peter Mannino. To end the second period offense, Dan Kronick pushed the margin to 5-1 with a goal at 19:43 of the second period. Nate Raduns tallied the solo assist on the play. DU outshot the Huskies 19-15 in the first period, but a tough SCSU defense limited Denver to just six shots in the second period. In the game, SCSU was outshot by the Pioneers 31-28 but the Huskies were 1-of-5 on the power play and DU was 0-of-6. In the nets, Bobby Goepfert was impressive with 30 saves... SCSU saw its five-game unbeaten streak come to a halt on Jan. 14, due to a 5-2 loss at Denver. In the first period, the Pioneers broke a 0-0 deadlock with a goal at 15:33 by Matt Carle. DU pushed the lead to 2-0 with an unassisted goal by T.J. Fast at 16:56. The Pioneers padded their lead in the second period with a shorthanded goal by J.D. Corbin at 5:08. The Huskies broke the shutout for Mannino with a power play marker posted by Fletcher at :57 of the third period. He was assisted on the play by Hooton. The goal was Fletcher's fourth of the season and 18th in his career. Once again on the power play, DU pushed the score to 4-1 with a tally by Stasny at 2:46 of the third. SCSU refused to quit as sophomore forward Andrew Gordon (Porters Lake, N.S.) posted his 10th goal of the season at 3:26 of the third. The game was iced late by DU as Carle charted an empty net power play goal at 18:42. In the game, SCSU outshot DU 33-28 and the Huskies were 1-of-8 on the power play. Denver was 2-of-8 on the power play.

The lone games that are not slated to be shown live on Charter Communication Cable Television in 2005-06 are the Alberta game on Oct. 8 and the Robert Morris game on Dec. 18. The remaining 17 home games are scheduled to be televised live. SCSU graduate and Twin Cities sports media personality Clay Matvick will provide the play-by-play this season, with fellow Husky graduate Ryan Dale providing the color commentary.

MORE NEWS AND NOTES...

THE BOB MOTZKO SHOW: The Bob Motzko Show will air live on Mondays from 6 p.m. to 7 p.m. on KNSI 1450 AM from JPs Grill and Bar in Sauk Rapids. Don Lyons will serve as the program's host along with Coach Motzko. St. Cloud Times sports writer Kevin Alenspach will also provide his insight each week. The public is invited to attend the weekly show at JPs Grill and Bar (located at Hwy 10 and Golden Spike Road in Sauk Rapids).

CLOSING IN ON 100: Joe Jensen now has 91 career points, and is on track to become the 19th player (all at the DI level) to score 100 points at SCSU. He has 44 goals and 47 assists in his career and ranks 17th in the career charts for goals along with Jon Cullen (1999-03 at 44. Jensen's 13 goals is a career season-best – his previous season-high was 12 goals in 2004-05. Of note, Andrew Gordon now leads the team with 24 points (10g/14a). The 10 goals is a career season-high for Gordon, a native of Porters Lake, Nova Scotia.

A KRONICK REUNION: SCSU junior Dan Kronick will reunite with his former teammates at UMD this weekend. A transfer from Duluth, Kronick played there for two seasons before transferring to SCSU in 2004-05. He redshirted last year and is now in his junior season at SCSU. Of note, Kronick played in one game against SCSU during his UMD career. He skated vs. the Huskies on Nov. 8, 2003 in a 5-3 loss at the DECC. He posted no points in that game. At UMD, Kronick played in 14 games and had three assists from 2002-2004.

RUN ENDED AT DU: The Huskies snapped a six-game losing skid against Denver on Jan. 13 with a 5-1 win at Magness Arena. SCSU's last win over DU was a 5-4 win at Magness Arena on Jan. 11, 2003. The win also kept alive a five-game unbeaten string for the Huskies, which dated back to a 2-1 loss at UAA on Dec. 3. Unfortunately, SCSU ended its unbeaten string on Jan. 14 with a 5-2 loss to Denver. Of note, SCSU is 3-1-1 in the last five games and 8-3-2 since Nov. 12... the five games is SCSU's longest unbeaten string since a five-game unbeaten from Feb. 6-Feb. 20, 2004

FLETCHER HAS HOT HAND: Junior defender Justin Fletcher leads the Huskies with a four-game scoring streak. In those four games, Fletcher has two goals and three assists to his credit...senior forward Konrad Reeder saw his seven-game scoring streak end this weekend at Denver... senior Brock Hooton posted his 10th assist of the season on Jan. 13 and his 11th assist on Jan. 14. His previous career season-high for assists was 10 in 2003-04

TOUGH SLATE: The Huskies have played seven nationally ranked team this season - including #1 Wisconsin (which they tied 2-2 and lost 3-1 on Oct. 21-22 in St. Cloud). Others on that list include Northern Michigan, Minnesota, Colgate, Colorado College and North Dakota. SCSU has posted a win or a tie over all the nationally ranked teams - with the exception of Colorado College.

QUICK FACTS: SCSU is 6-3-1 in action on Friday nights this year and 3-6-2 in play on Saturday nights this season...SCSU is ranked 12th in the nation on the penalty kill this season at 86.3% (101-117). Of note, SCSU is 7-1-1 when it holds an opposing team scoreless on the power play...SCSU is the third least penalized team in the nation this season with only 14.3 PIM per game this season...SCSU's 2.36 goals allowed per game ranks 10th in the nation...Bobby Goepfert's save rate of .924 ranks 12th among DI goalies and his GAA is 2.12 (also 12th in the nation among DI netminders)...SCSU's power play rate of 18.9% is 15th in the nation. In comparison, SCSU's PP rate in 2004-05 ranked 53rd at 12.2%.

FLETCHER TOPS ON PP: Justin Fletcher posted his fourth power play goal of the season and his 14th career ppg, which places him on top of the SCSU career power play goal list for defensemen. The previous lead was Steve Ross, who had 13 power play goals from 1989-93. A junior, Fletcher hit a career-high six PPGs last season. In his career, Fletch has 18 goals and 31 assists to his credit.
