## 2005-06 SCSU MEN'S HOCKEY NEWS

Release Date: Nov. 21, 2005

**BACK HOME AGAIN:** The St. Cloud State men's hockey team (4-7-1, 3-6-1 WCHA) will be home for the holiday this week, as the Huskies play a post-Thanksgiving series at the National Hockey Center (5,763 cap./200x100) on Nov. 25-26, against Brown University (2-4-0, 2-4-0 ECAC/Ivy)...the games will be televised live on Charter Communications Channel 14 in the St. Cloud area. The games will also be broadcast live on KNSI AM 1450/KCML FM 99.90 out of St. Cloud. This marks the renewal of the series, which started in 1988. SCSU is 4-1-0 in matches played against Brown, and in the two teams most recent meeting, the Huskies dropped a 4-1 decision in Providence. The last time Brown visited the NHC, the Huskies swept by scores of 4-2 and 5-4...**SPECIAL PRICE:** As a special holiday promotion this weekend, fans can purchase a general admission ticket for the Brown University games on Nov. 18 or Nov. 19 for the low price of \$5. The \$5 general admission ticket can only be purchased at the SCSU Athletic Ticket Office - and they will be available at the door on the day of each game this weekend. **2005-06 RESULTS:** SCSU is 4-7-1, 3-6-1 WCHA in 2005-06. The St. Cloud State University men's hockey team ended its 2004-05 season with a 14-23-3 overall record and an 8-19-1 WCHA record. In the always rugged WCHA, the Huskies placed ninth in 2004-05.



**SCSU COACH BOB MOTZKO:** Motzko (4-7-1, 3-6-1 WCHA career record) is only the second coach at SCSU since the Huskies moved to the NCAA Division I level in 1987-88. Motzko played served as a men's hockey assistant coach at the University of Minnesota from 2001-2005. A 1987 graduate of St. Cloud State University, Motzko was a two-year varsity letterwinner for the SCSU hockey team from 1984-86. Motzko began his coaching career in 1986-87 as an assistant coach for the legendary Herb Brooks at SCSU - and also worked with former SCSU head coach Craig Dahl.

Motzko went on to serve as general manager and head coach of the USHL's North Iowa Huskies from 1987 through 1991. In 1991, Motzko was named assistant coach at Miami University (Ohio). He served for one season as an associate head coach at the University of Denver from 1993-94, before returning to Miami University in 1994. Motzko was named general manager and head coach of the USHL's Sioux Falls Stampede in 1998, and in 2000, Motzko was named the USHL General Manager of the Year. He then joined the staff at Minnesota in 2001. A native of Austin, Minn., Motzko and his wife Shelley are the parents of three children. They currently reside in St. Cloud, Minn.

**ASSISTANT COACHING STAFF:** Coach Motzko will be assisted in 2005-06 by Fred Harbinson and Eric Rud. Harbinson begins his fourth season as a member of the SCSU coaching corps in 2005-06. Harbinson is a 1995 graduate of Wisconsin-Superior. Rud will begin his first season as an assistant at SCSU in 2005-06. A 1997 graduate of Colorado College, Rud served as an assistant at CC in 2004-05. Eric Bakke will serve as the team's video coordinator in 2005-06, and Jeff Kruger will work as the team's strength and conditioning coach. Dave Wenniger is the team's goalie coach in 2005-06. The staff is completed by director of equipment operations and 12-year veteran Jeremiah Mlnkel.

**POLL POSITION:** The Huskies recently received votes in one of the national Division I college hockey polls. On Nov. 21, the USCHO.com poll listed the Huskies with one vote in the national poll. The Huskies have played five ranked teams this season (out of six), and this weekend they will host Brown - which received votes in the latest USCHO poll on Nov. 14 - but did not receive a vote on Nov. 21.



## MORE NEWS AND NOTES...

**TEAM CAPTAINS:** Junior defender Casey Borer, a resident of Brooklyn Park, Minn., will serve as a team captain for the Huskies in 2005-06. The alternate captains for this winter are senior forward Konrad Reeder (Vanderhoof, B.C.) and senior forward Brock Hooton (Nanaimo, B.C.). Of note, the last time a junior served as a team captain for the Huskies was Jon Cullen in 2001-02.

**SPLIT AT THE NHC:** SCSU lost a tough 3-2 decision to #7/8 North Dakota (8-5-1, 4-4-0 WCHA) on Nov. 19 at the NHC. The Huskies gave up three first period goals, which spelled the difference in the game. Take away the game's tough start, and the Huskies dominated play in the second two periods outshooting UND by a 31-13 total. In the third period, SCSU applied considerable pressure as it outshot UND 16-3 down the stretch. UND scored early in the first with an unassisted goal by Erik Fabian at 4:49. Drew Stafford gave UND a 2-0 lead with another unassisted goal on the power play at 7:52. Senior forward Brock Hooton got SCSU back into the thick of things with a power play goal at 15:31, with assists from Andrew Gordon and Billy Hengen. In the second period, SCSU's Grant Clifton made it 3-2 with his first goal of the season at 10:00. Assists were notched by Nate Dey and Hooton. In the nets, SCSU's Bobby Goepfert had 23 saves and UND's Jordan Parise had 41 saves and the win. On the power play, UND was 1-of-2 and SCSU was 1-of-4... SCSU collected another victory over a nationally ranked opponent on Nov. 18, with a 3-2 win over #7/8 UND. SCSU battled back from a 1-0 deficit to gain the win. Nate Raduns charted the game winner on an unassisted goal at 10:37 of the third period. Raduns' heroics came on the heels of the game tying goal by SCSU freshman John Swanson. Swanson brought the hometown crowd to its feet with a goal at 9:47. Matt Hartman, and Michael Olson added the assists on Swanson's goal - which was his first as a Husky. UND started the game's offense at 5:29 of the first period with a goal by Mike Prpich, as Erik Fabian had the assist. In the second period, SCSU tied the game with a goal by Konrad Reeder at 3:05. Aaron Brocklehurst provided the assist on the play. UND jumped back into the lead with a goal by Jonathan Toews at 6:03, as Chris Porter had the assist. In the closing minute of play, UND pulled its goalie but it failed to produce a score. SCSU goalie Bobby Goepfert was impressive throughout the evening with 28 saves. Philippe Lamoureux had 23 saves for UND in the game, as the UND skaters outshot the Huskies 30-26. On the power play, SCSU was 0-of-7 and UND was 0-of-3.

**AS SEEN ON TV:** A total of 17 SCSU home games will be seen live on Charter Communications Cable Television (Channel 14) in the St. Cloud area during the 2005-06 season. The lone games that are not slated to be shown live on Charter Communication Cable Television in 2005-06 are the Alberta game on Oct. 8 and the Robert Morris game on Dec. 18. The remaining 17 home games are scheduled to be televised live. SCSU graduate and Twin Cities sports media personality Clay Matvick will provide the play-by-play this season, with fellow Husky graduate Ryan Dale providing the color commentary. The telecasts are completely produced live by SCSU's mass communications students under the guidance of Husky Productions faculty advisor Gregory Martin.

MORE NEWS AND NOTES...

THE BOB MOTZKO SHOW: The Bob Motzko Show will air live on Mondays from 6 p.m. to 7 p.m. on KNSI 1450 AM from JPs Grill and Bar in Sauk Rapids. Don Lyons will serve as the program's host along with Coach Motzko. St. Cloud Times sports writer Kevin Allenspach will also provide his insight each week. The public is invited to attend the weekly show at JPs Grill and Bar (located at Hwy 10 and Golden Spike Road in Sauk Rapids).

LOCAL KIDS DO GOOD: The SCSU win on Nov. 18 had a definite local flavor as the Huskies, fourth line was comprised of three St. Cloud-area players junior Nate Raduns (Sauk Rapids, Minn.), sophomore Matt Hartman (St. Cloud/Apollo H.S.) and freshman John Swanson (St. Cloud/Tech H.S.). Swanson gained his first career goal at SCSU on Nov. 18. Not only did Swanson score his first career goal, Raduns notched his first point and goal of the 2005-06 season. To complete the area scoring list, Hartman posted an assist on Swanson's goal. According to Kevin Allenspach and the St. Cloud Times, this marked the first time two St. Cloud area players have scored a goal in the same game for the Huskies.

THE BC CONNECTION AT SCSU: The province of British Columbia has provided SCSU with several top players over the years, and that connection clicked this weekend for the Huskies. Senior Konrad Reeder, a native of Vanderhoof, B.C., posted his second goal of the season during SCSU's win on Nov. 18. To complete the play, Reeder was assisted by sophomore defender Aaron Brocklehurst (a resident of Nanaimo, B.C.). Of note, freshman forward Michael Olson (who played with Nanaimo of the BCHL) had an assist on Swanson's goal that night. On Nov. 19, senior forward Brock Hooton lit the lamp with his first goal of the season on the power play. He also had an assist on Grant Clifton's goal in the second period. Hooton now has 16 goals and 35 assists in his career (51 points). Both Reeder and Hooton are assistant captains this season for the Huskies.

LOTS OF SHOTS: The Huskies hit a season-high with 43 shots on goal in the 3-2 loss to UND. The previous team-high was 42 shots on goal in a 7-0 win at Michigan Tech. In the third period on Nov. 19, the Huskies outshot UND 16-3...the Huskies snapped a seven-game winless streak against UND on Nov. 18. This was SCSU's first win over UND since a 2-1 victory in Grand Forks on 11/14/03. The last time the Huskies gained a win over the UND skaters at the NHC was a 7-3 win on 11/8/02.

CLAFTON SCORES: Grant Clifton posted his 10th career goal during SCSU's game on Nov. 19. The goal was his first of the season, as he now has 1g/1a this season.

TOUGH DEFENSE: The Huskies have been strong on defense this season. In fact, they have allowed more than three goals only once this season (a 4-2 loss at Colorado College). In the nation, SCSU ranks 13th on defense allowing just 2.50 goals per game. On the penalty kill, SCSU has charted solid numbers and currently ranks ninth in the nation with a rate of 87.9% (58-of-66).

GORDON TAKES THE LEAD: Sophomore Andrew Gordon is the team leader in scoring with 13 points (4g/9a). Senior Joe Jensen ranks second with 11 points and he leads the club with seven goals. Senior Billy Hengen is third on the team with 10 points (3g/7a). In the WCHA (league games only), Gordon ranks sixth with .70 assists per game. He ranks 10th among WCHA players with 1.00 points per game. Of note, Jensen ranks 8th in the WCHA with .50 goals per game...sophomore Matt Stephenson has .50 points per game and he ranks seventh among league defenders...in league games, goalie Bobby Goepfert ranks fifth among WCHA goalies with a 2.42 GAA and a .921 save rate.

THIRD TIME IS A CHARM: St. Cloud State is a perfect 4-0-0 this season when the Huskies score three or more goals in a game. If the Husky defense allows less than three goals in a game this season, SCSU is 4-0-1 this year. To complete the numbers game, SCSU is 0-7-0 when it allows more than three goals in a game this season.
