2005-06 SCSU MEN'S HOCKEY NEWS

BACK ON THE ROAD: The St. Cloud State men's hockey team (12-9-3, 7-8-1 WCHA) will travel to Grand Forks, N.D. this weekend for a two-game WCHA series against #6/7 University of North Dakota (17-10-1, 10-8-0 WCHA). The games will be played at the Ralph Engelstad Arena (11,406 cap./200x85) in Grand Forks. The games will also be broadcast live on KNSI AM 1450/KCML FM 99.90 out of St. Cloud. This marks the second series that these two teams have played this season.

2005-06 RESULTS: SCSU is 12-9-3, 7-8-1 WCHA in 2005-06. The St. Cloud State University men's hockey team ended its 2004-05 season with a 14-23-3 overall record and an 8-19-1 WCHA record. In the always rugged WCHA, the Huskies placed ninth in 2004-05.



SCSU COACH BOB MOTZKO: Motzko (12-9-3, 7-8-1 WCHA career record) is only the second coach at SCSU since the Huskies moved to the NCAA Division I level in 1987-88. Motzko served as a men's hockey assistant coach at the University of Minnesota from 2001-2005. A 1987 graduate of St. Cloud State University, Motzko was a two-year varsity letterwinner for the SCSU hockey team from 1984-86. Motzko began his coaching career in 1986-87 as an assistant coach for the legendary Herb Brooks at SCSU - and also worked with former SCSU head coach Craig Dahl. Motzko went on to serve as general manager and head coach of the USHL's North Iowa Huskies from 1987 through 1991. In 1991, Motzko was named assistant coach at Miami University (Ohio). He served for one season as an associate head coach at the University of Denver from 1993-94, before returning to Miami University in 1994. Motzko was named general manager and head coach of the USHL's Sioux Falls Stampede in 1998, and in 2000, Motzko was named the USHL General Manager of the Year. He then joined the staff at Minnesota in 2001. A native of Austin, Minn., Motzko and his wife Shelley are the parents of three children. They currently reside in St. Cloud, Minn.

Brooks at SCSU - and also worked with former SCSU head coach Craig Dahl. Motzko went on to serve as general manager and head coach of the USHL's North Iowa Huskies from 1987 through 1991. ASSISTANT COACHING STAFF: Coach Motzko will be assisted in 2005-06 by Fred Harbinson and Eric Rud. Harbinson begins his fourth season as a member of the SCSU coaching corps in 2005-06. Harbinson is a 1995 graduate of Wisconsin-Superior. Rud will begin his first season as an assistant at SCSU in 2005-06. A 1997 graduate of Colorado College, Rud served as an assistant at CC in 2004-05. Eric Bakke will serve as the team's video coordinator and travel coordinator in 2005-06, and Jeff Kruger will work as the team's strength and conditioning coach. Dave Wenniger is the team's goalie coach in 2005-06. The staff is completed by director of equipment operations and 11-year veteran Jeremiah Minkel.

POLL POSITION: The Huskies recently received votes in one of the national Division I college hockey polls. The current USCHO.com poll listed the Huskies with 29 votes in the national poll. The Huskies have played seven nationally ranked team this season - including Wisconsin (which they tied 2-2 and lost 3-1 on Oct. 21-22 in St. Cloud). Others on that list include Northern Michigan, Minnesota, Colgate, Colorado College, Denver and North Dakota. SCSU has posted a win or a tie over all the nationally ranked teams - with the exception of Colorado College.



MORE NEWS AND NOTES...

TEAM CAPTAINS: Junior defender Casey Borer, a resident of Brooklyn Park, Minn., will serve as a team captain for the Huskies in 2005-06. The alternate captains for this winter are senior forward Konrad Reeder (Vanderhoof, B.C.) and senior forward Brock Hooton (Nanaimo, B.C.). Of note, the last time a junior served as a team captain for the Huskies was Jon Cullen in 2001-02.

KRONICK GETS P.O.W. HONORS: The Dan Kronick Show pulled into town on Jan. 20-21, as the junior forward had four goals and two assists in a sweep over UMD. For his hard work, Kronick was named the WCHA's Offensive Player of the Week on Jan. 23. In SCSU's 6-3 sweep win over UMD on Jan. 21, Kronick netted three power play goals and added an assist on Konrad Reeder's first period goal to lift SCSU past Kronick's old teammates at UMD. SCSU led 4-0 at the end of the first, thanks to two goals by Kronick and the game winner from Michael Olson. The Huskies added a goal by Kronick in the second, and then iced the game with an empty netter by Aaron Brocklehurst in the third. UMD's posted two goals in the second and closed the gap to 5-3 with a third period tally, before senior netminder Jason Montgomery shut the door with 35 saves. Of note, Reeder had three assists in the game to match Kronick's four points...on Jan. 20, the Huskies trailed 1-0 in the first, before Reeder tied the game with a power play goal at 11:29. He was assisted by Kronick and Brocklehurst. In the second, Kronick gave the Huskies a 2-1 lead with an assist from Reeder and Marty Mjelleli. UMD tied the game with a goal by MacGregor Sharp, but Andrew Gordon came through with the game winner at 12:33 of the third period. Billy Hengen and Nate Raduns had assists on the play. To complete the day, Nate Dey scored an empty net goal - his first ENG as a Husky - at 19:51 of the third. Bobby Goepfert made the start with 30 saves.



Kronick named WCHA POW

AS SEEN ON TV: Charter Communications Cable Channel 14 and Astound Channel 27 will televise SCSU games in the St. Cloud area during the 2005-06 season. The lone games that are not slated to be shown live on Charter Communication Cable Television in 2005-06 are the Alberta game on Oct. 8 and the Robert Morris game on Dec. 18. The remaining 17 home games are scheduled to be televised live. SCSU graduate and Twin Cities sports media personality Clay Matvick will provide the play-by-play this season, with fellow Husky graduate Ryan Dale providing the color commentary. Select games can be seen on Charter's Main Street channel throughout the state of Minnesota (wherever Charter cable service is available). The SCSU games at Mankato on Feb. 17-18, will also be available on Comcast Cable in the Twin Cities.

AMONG THE BEST: SCSU ranks eighth in the nation with a penalty kill rate of 86.1% (105-of-122). SCSU has also made moves on the power play, and the Huskies currently rank ninth in the nation on the advantage with a 20.6% rate (27-of-131)...SCSU is the second least penalized team in the nation with a low average of 14.1 PIM per game...SCSU ranks 10th in the nation on defense at 2.38 goals allowed per game and it has moved up to 15th in the nation on offense with a 3.33 goals per game rate. In fact, SCSU has scored 44 goals in its past 10 games. In comparison, SCSU only scored 23 goals in the first 10 games of 2005-06 - which included a 7-0 win at MTU in the 10th game of the season.

MORE NEWS AND NOTES...

THE BOB MOTZKO SHOW: The Bob Motzkko Show will air live on Mondays from 6 p.m. to 7 p.m. on KNSI 1450 AM from JPs Grill and Bar in Sauk Rapids. Don Lyons will serve as the program's host along with Coach Motzko. St. Cloud Times sports writer Kevin Alenspach will also provide his insight each week. The public is invited to attend the weekly show at JPs Grill and Bar (located at Hwy 10 and Golden Spike Road in Sauk Rapids).

CLOSING IN ON 100: Joe Jensen now has 91 career points, and is on track to become the 19th player (all at the DI level) to score 100 points at SCSU. He has 44 goals and 47 assists in his career and ranks 17th in the career charts for goals along with Jon Cullen (1999-03 at 44. Jensen's 13 goals is a career season-best - his previous season-high was 12 goals in 2004-05. Of note, Andrew Gordon now leads the team with 25 points (11g/14a). The 11 goals is a career season-high for Gordon, a native of Porters Lake, Nova Scotia. Gordon currently ranks 16th in the WCHA (overall games) with 1.04 ppg. Jensen ranks ninth in the WCHA with 13 goals and Gordon is 13th with 11.

REEDER COLLECTS FIRST PPG: Senior assistant captain Konrad Reeder has been enjoying a record season with a career-best eight goals and 11 assists this season for 19 points. Reeder hit his first career power play goal as a Husky on Jan. 20 at 11:29 of the first period against Duluth. Reeder was named to the Academic All-WCHA team in 2004-05. SCSU is 5-0-1 this year when Reeder scores a goal. In his storied career, Reeder has 15 goals and 18 assists for 33 points - the most by any Vanderhoof resident in the history of SCSU hockey.

FIRST WCHA SWEEP SINCE 2004-05: The two game sweep against UMD was the Huskies first WCHA sweep since winning two at the NHC against Michigan Tech on Nov. 12-13, 2004...the four goals scored in the first period against UMD on Jan. 21, was the most by the Huskies in a period since they charted four goals in the third period during a 5-4 loss at Minnesota on Feb. 25, 2005...finally, SCSU notched its first empty net goals this past weekend against UMD, since the Huskies scored an empty net goal on Jan. 29, 2005 against Sacred Heart and their first WCHA ENG since an empty netter against UMD on Jan. 14, 2005 at UMD.

FLETCHER KEEPS STREAK ALIVE: Junior defender Justin Fletcher leads the Huskies with a six-game scoring streak. In those six games, Fletcher has two goals and six assists to his credit. He now ranks 7th in the WCHA for defenders scoring with .77 ppg.

MONTY ON THE ICE: Senior goalie Jason Montgomery made his second start of the season in the nets for the Huskies on Jan. 21, and he came away with his second win of the season. In the game, Montgomery made 35 saves and allowed just three goals against UMD. Montgomery was in the nets earlier in the season during a win against Robert Morris, and the last time he posted a win in the WCHA was a 4-2 win over UMD at the NHC on Nov. 26, 2004.

HUSKIES SHOW WELL IN RECENT GAMES AND IRON JOE: SCSU is 10-3-2 in its last 15 games and 6-1-1 in its last eight starts. The Huskies have outscored their opponents 80-57 this season - in comparison, SCSU was outscored 126-109 last year...opponents are finding the NHC a tough place to play this season. The Huskies are 7-3-2 at the NHC this year and last year SCSU was 6-11-1 at the NHC...one of the nation's top penalty kill teams, SCSU is 9-1-1 this year when it holds the opposition scoreless on the power play...SCSU is a perfect 7-0-0 when the Huskies have a lead going into the second period...Joe Jensen missed his first games since the first game of the 2002-03 season this past weekend. He did not play in the Huskies' first game of the 2002-03 season, and he then played in 137 consecutive games before missing the two starts against Minnesota Duluth...Billy Hengen's 19 assists is ninth best in the WCHA (overall games)...Bobby Goepfert's 2.11 goals against average is second best in the WCHA, while his .925 save rate is third best behind Wisconsin's Brian Elliot (.944) and North Dakota's Jordan Parise (.929).
