2005-06 SCSU MEN'S HOCKEY NEWS

Release Date: Nov. 28, 2005

NORTH TO ALASKA: The St. Cloud State men's hockey team (5-7-2, 3-6-1 WCHA) will be headed north to Alaska this weekend, as the Huskies journey to the University of Alaska-Anchorage for a pair of games on Dec. 2-3. Both games will start at 10:07 p.m. (Central Time) at UAA's Sullivan Arena (6,406 cap./200x100). The games will also be broadcast live on KNSI AM 1450/KCML FM 99.90 out of St. Cloud. SCSU leads the all-time series 35-11-4, and the Huskies are 34-9-4 in the series since moving to the NCAA Division I level in 1987-88. Last year, SCSU split a series at UAA (L, 4-3 and W, 6-3).

2005-06 RESULTS: SCSU is 5-7-2, 3-6-1 WCHA in 2005-06. The St. Cloud State University men's hockey team ended its 2004-05 season with a 14-23-3 overall record and an 8-19-1 WCHA record. In the always rugged WCHA, the Huskies placed ninth in 2004-05.



SCSU COACH BOB MOTZKO: Motzko (5-7-2, 3-6-1 WCHA career record) is only the second coach at SCSU since the Huskies moved to the NCAA Division I level in 1987-88. Motzko played served as a men's hockey assistant coach at the University of Minnesota from 2001-2005. A 1987 graduate of St. Cloud State University, Motzko was a two-year varsity letterwinner for the SCSU hockey team from 1984-86. Motzko began his coaching career in 1986-87 as an assistant coach for the legendary Herb Brooks at SCSU - and also worked with former SCSU head coach Craig Dahl.

Motzko went on to serve as general manager and head coach of the USHL's North Iowa Huskies from 1987 through 1991. In 1991, Motzko was named assistant coach at Miami University (Ohio). He served for one season as an associate head coach at the University of Denver from 1993-94, before returning to Miami University in 1994. Motzko was named general manager and head coach of the USHL's Sioux Falls Stampede in 1998, and in 2000, Motzko was named the USHL General Manager of the Year. He then joined the staff at Minnesota in 2001. A native of Austin, Minn., Motzko and his wife Shelley are the parents of three children. They currently reside in St. Cloud, Minn.

ASSISTANT COACHING STAFF: Coach Motzko will be assisted in 2005-06 by Fred Harbinson and Eric Rud. Harbinson begins his fourth season as a member of the SCSU coaching corps in 2005-06. Harbinson is a 1995 graduate of Wisconsin-Superior. Rud will begin his first season as an assistant at SCSU in 2005-06. A 1997 graduate of Colorado College, Rud served as an assistant at CC in 2004-05. Eric Bakke will serve as the team's video coordinator in 2005-06, and Jeff Kruger will work as the team's strength and conditioning coach. Dave Wenniger is the team's goalie coach in 2005-06. The staff is completed by director of equipment operations and 12-year veteran Jeremiah Mlnkel.

MORE NEWS AND NOTES...

TEAM CAPTAINS: Junior defender Casey Borer, a resident of Brooklyn Park, Minn., will serve as a team captain for the Huskies in 2005-06. The alternate captains for this winter are senior forward Konrad Reeder (Vanderhoof, B.C.) and senior forward Brock Hooton (Nanaimo, B.C.). Of note, the last time a junior served as a team captain for the Huskies was Jon Cullen in 2001-02.

HUSKIES BEAR DOWN: In a non-conference battle on Nov. 25, SCSU charted a 4-1 win over Brown at the NHC. In the game, SCSU dominated play in the first period as it outshot Brown 16-3. The scoreboard said otherwise as the two teams were tied 1-1 at the end of the first period. SCSU's Marty Mjelleli carded his first career goal at SCSU with a tally at 2:52 of the first. Assists on the play were credited to Billy Hengen and Justin Fletcher. Brown roared back with a power play goal at 8:15 of the first period by Matt Vokes. In the second period, SCSU iced the game with a pair of goals to make it 3-1. Senior Joe Jensen scored his eighth goal of the season at 12:06 with assists from Brock Hooton and Hengen.

Senior defender T.J. McElroy notched his second goal of the season at 14:58 of the second with assists from Jensen and Andrew Gordon. To complete the scoring, Gordon tallied at 17:13 of the third on the power play. Hengen added an assist along with Jensen. In the nets, Bobby Goepfert gained the victory and improved his season total to 5-5-1. He made 20 saves in the contest and allowed only one goal on the power play. Adam D'Alba had 28 saves for the Bears. On the power play, SCSU was 1-of-5 and Brown was 1-of-6. SCSU outshot the Bears 32-21 in the contest... SCSU posted its second tie of the season with a 4-4 deadlock against Brown on Nov. 26. In a goal-for-goal slugging match, the Huskies gained the early upper hand in the first period with a shorthanded goal by sophomore forward Andrew Gordon at 11:05. He was assisted on the play by Joe Jensen and T.J. McElroy. Brown fired back with a first period goal at 12:55 by Brian McNary on the power play. On the penalty kill again, SCSU added its second SHG when senior Konrad Reeder scored with an unassisted effort at 15:44 of the first. The SCSU lead was short-lived as Brown posted a goal at 17:13 of the first by Rugo Santini. In the second period, Brown gained a 3-2 edge in the game when Ryan Garbutt scored at 5:27. SCSU opted to change goalies at this point, as Bobby Goepfert was brought in for starter Tim Boron. SCSU tied the game at 3-3 at 6:36 of the second with a power play goal from Jensen. Justin Fletcher and Brock Hooton added assists on the goal. Gordon carded his second goal of the game at :42 of the third period. Jensen and Billy Hengen each had assists on the play. Brown brought the scoring to an end at 3:51 of the third period, when Prough scored with an assist from McNary. Overall, Brown outshot the Huskies 36-33 in the match and both teams were 1-of-4 on the power play. D'Alba had 29 saves in the game, and Goepfert made 25 saves and gained the decision for SCSU.

AS SEEN ON TV: A total of 17 SCSU home games will be seen live on Charter Communications Cable Television (Channel 14) in the St. Cloud area during the 2005-06 season. The lone games that are not slated to be shown live on Charter Communication Cable Television in 2005-06 are the Alberta game on Oct. 8 and the Robert Morris game on Dec. 18. The remaining 17 home games are scheduled to be televised live. SCSU graduate and Twin Cities sports media personality Clay Matvick will provide the play-by-play this season, with fellow Husky graduate Ryan Dale providing the color commentary.

Team Notes: The Huskies will venture north to Anchorage this weekend as they renew the WCHA series against the Seawolves...this will mark SCSU,s first meeting with new UAA head coach Dave Shiyak. Last year, the Huskies posted a 4-3 loss and a 6-3 win at UAA on Feb. 4-5, 2005. SCSU leads the all-time series 34-9-4 at the DI level (35-11-4 all levels). The series started in 1983, and SCSU is 7-2-1 against UAA in the last 10 meetings. As members of the WCHA, SCSU has never lost to UAA in St. Cloud, and the last time SCSU lost to UAA in St. Cloud was a pair of losses in 1987-88 ^ when SCSU was a Division I independent. Last winter, SCSU and UAA only played twice. This season, SCSU will host UAA at the National Hockey Center on Feb. 3-4...junior defender Mark Smith leads UAA in scoring this season with four goals and four assists...senior forward Ales Perez has two goals and four assists for UAA this season, and he is the team captain...in the nets Nathan Lawson (4.02 GAA) and John DeCaro (2.89 GAA) share the duties.
