2005-06 SCSU MEN'S HOCKEY NEWS

Release Date: Nov. 7, 2005

HUSKIES VS. HUSKIES: The St. Cloud State men's hockey team (2-5-1 1-4-1 WCHA) will continue its 2005-06 season with a pair of WCHA road games at Michigan Tech University (1-8-1, 0-3-1 WCHA) on Nov. 11-12. The games in Houghton, Mich. are both slated to begin at 6:07 p.m. (CT) at the MacInnes Student Ice Arena (cap. 4,200/200x85) on the campus of MTU. The game will be broadcast live in the St. Cloud area on KNSI AM 1450 and KCML 99.9 FM, with Don Lyons calling the play-by-play...SCSU owns a 38-24-4 all-time series lead over the Huskies from MTU. SCSU owns a seven-game unbeaten streak against MTU, dating back to a 4-3 OT loss at MTU on Jan. 31, 2003. The series started on Jan. 23, 1948, with MTU posting a 9-1 win.

2005-06 RESULTS: SCSU is 2-5-1, 1-4-1 WCHA in 2005-06. The St. Cloud State University men's hockey team ended its 2004-05 season with a 14-23-3 overall record and an 8-19-1 WCHA record. In the always rugged WCHA, the Huskies placed ninth in 2004-05.



SCSU COACH BOB MOTZKO: Motzko (2-5-1, 1-4-1 WCHA career record) is only the second coach at SCSU since the Huskies moved to the NCAA Division I level in 1987-88. Motzko played served as a men's hockey assistant coach at the University of Minnesota from 2001-2005. A 1987 graduate of St. Cloud State University, Motzko was a two-year varsity letterwinner for the SCSU hockey team from 1984-86. Motzko began his coaching career in 1986-87 as an assistant coach for the legendary Herb Brooks at SCSU - and also worked with former SCSU head coach Craig Dahl.

Motzko went on to serve as general manager and head coach of the USHL's North Iowa Huskies from 1987 through 1991. In 1991, Motzko was named assistant coach at Miami University (Ohio). He served for one season as an associate head coach at the University of Denver from 1993-94, before returning to Miami University in 1994. Motzko was named general manager and head coach of the USHL's Sioux Falls Stampede in 1998, and in 2000, Motzko was named the USHL General Manager of the Year. He then joined the staff at Minnesota in 2001. A native of Austin, Minn., Motzko and his wife Shelley are the parents of three children. They currently reside in St. Cloud, Minn.

ASSISTANT COACHING STAFF: Coach Motzko will be assisted in 2005-06 by Fred Harbinson and Eric Rud. Harbinson begins his fourth season as a member of the SCSU coaching corps in 2005-06. Harbinson is a 1995 graduate of Wisconsin-Superior. Rud will begin his first season as an assistant at SCSU in 2005-06. A 1997 graduate of Colorado College, Rud served as an assistant at CC in 2004-05. Eric Bakke will serve as the team's video coordinator in 2005-06, and Jeff Kruger will work as the team's strength and conditioning coach. Dave Wenniger is the team's goalie coach in 2005-06.

POLL POSITION: The Huskies recently received votes in one of the national Division I college hockey polls. On Oct. 31, the USCHO.com poll listed the Huskies with five votes in the national poll. For the first time in 2005-06, the Huskies will play an opponent that is not ranked among the nation's top 15 teams when they travel to Michigan Tech on Nov. 11-12.



MORE NEWS AND NOTES...

TEAM CAPTAINS: Junior defender Casey Borer, a resident of Brooklyn Park, Minn., will serve as a team captain for the Huskies in 2005-06. The alternate captains for this winter are senior forward Konrad Reeder (Vanderhoof, B.C.) and senior forward Brock Hooton (Nanaimo, B.C.). Of note, the last time a junior served as a team captain for the Huskies was Jon Cullen in 2001-02.

HUSKIES BATTLE #1 CC: In a close battle with the nation's number one team, SCSU lost a tough 3-2 decision at Colorado College (on Nov. 5. SCSU's offense came to life in the third period after CC charted a 2-0 lead after two periods. In the first period, Colorado College gained a 1-0 lead when Aaron Slatengren scored at 13:39. The Tigers stretched their lead to 2-0 in the second period, when Scott Thauwald scored at 13:17. The Huskies came through in the third period again to break the shutout with a quick goal by sophomore forward Andrew Gordon, who scored at the :20 mark with assists from Billy Hengen and Joe Jensen. CC charged back with the eventual game winning goal at 6:57 of the third period by Trevor Frischmon. The Huskies got back into the action with a goal by Jensen at the 7:27 mark of the third period with assists from Gordon and junior defender Justin Fletcher. Overall, SCSU was outshot 31-30 in the game as Tim Boron made 28 saves in the game. Matt Zaba posted 28 saves for the Tigers. Both teams were held scoreless on the power play, as both teams were 0-of-3 on the advantage...SCSU posted a tough 4-2 loss to host Colorado College on Friday, Nov. 4. The two squads battled to a 0-0 draw in the first period as the Tigers outshot the Huskies 14-5. Once again, junior goalie Bobby Goepfert was impressive between the pipes with 14 first period saves. In the second period, the offense got started when CC's Chad Rau scored on the power play at 5:02. SCSU tied the game at 7:20 of the second when Dan Kronick scored his first goal of the season (and his first as a Husky). He received power play assists from Aaron Brocklehurst and Grant Clifton. Sterling lifted CC to a 2-1 lead when he scored at 12:47 of the second. Again, the Huskies charged back into the action when senior Joe Jensen scored his fourth goal of the season at 15:41. Assists on the play were added by Andrew Gordon and Billy Hengen. In the third period, Sterling gave the Tigers a 3-2 lead at the :56 mark on a shot from the top of the right circle. CC iced the contest at 18:15 of the third with Patrosso's goal. In the game, SCSU was outshot 38-30 and the Huskies were 1-of-2 on the power play. CC was 1-of-5 on the power play. Goepfert made 34 saves in the game and Matt Zaba had 28 saves for the Tigers.

KRONICK SCORES AT CC: Junior forward Dan Kronick, a transfer from UMD, posted his first goal at SCSU on Nov. 4 at CC. He charted the tally at 7:20 of the second play on the power play.

DEFENDERS SCORE POINTS: Junior defenders Grant Clifton and Justin Fletchers posted their first points of the 2005-06 campaign at Colorado College. Clifton gained an assist on Nov. 4 and Fletcher had an assist on Joe Jensen's goal on Nov. 5.

MOVING UP: Did you know that senior Joe Jensen continues to move up the career charts. He now has 35g/40a for 75 points in his career. He ranks 32nd in the SCSU career scoring charts, and is two points away from current NHLer Bret Hedican, who had 77 points from 1988-91 at SCSU.

Team Notes: The Huskies from MTU own a 1-8-1, 0-3-1 WCHA record this year and are fresh from a 5-2 and 4-3 series loss at Denver, and ironically both teams met back at the Minneapolis-St. Paul airport on the teams' return from Colorado last Sunday...Team captain Brandon Schwartz is a resident of St. Cloud. He has 3g/5a this year...the Huskies own a seven-game unbeaten streak against the MTU Huskies dating back to a 4-3 OT loss on Jan. 31, 2003...SCSU senior Joe Jensen has had success against MTU wiith 5g/5a during his career vs. MTU...last year, SCSU did not play in Houghton. The last time SCSU made the trip to Copper Country was a 4-1, 3-1 sweep on Feb. 6-7, 2004...the MTU-SCSU series dates back to Jan. 23, 1948, when the MTU Huskies beat SCSU 9-1...MTU has not won a a game since its season opener on Oct. 7 vs. Mercyhurst (4-3). MTU has a two-game losing skid, which dates back to a 2-2 tie against UMD on Oct. 29...of note, MTU lost two games to Northern Michigan this season 5-1, 2-1 on Oct. 21-22.
