## 2005-06 SCSU MEN'S HOCKEY NEWS

Release Date: Dec. 12, 2005

**NON-CONFERENCE BATTLE:** The St. Cloud State men's hockey team (6-8-2, 4-7-1 WCHA) will host Robert Morris University (4-9-1, 1-3-0 CHA) in a pair of non-conference games on Saturday, Dec. 17 and Sunday, Dec. 18. Both games at the National Hockey Center (5,763 cap./200x100) will start at 7:07 p.m. The games will also be broadcast live on KNSI AM 1450/KCML FM 99.90 out of St. Cloud. The Dec. 17 game will be televised live on Charter Communications Cable Channel 14 in the St. Cloud area. The Dec. 18 game will also be broadcast live on KVSC FM 88.1. This marks the first time these two schools have played each other.

**SPECIAL HOLIDAY PRICE:** As a special holiday promotion, fans can purchase a general admission ticket for the Robert Morris University games on Dec. 17-18 for the low price of \$5. The \$5 general admission ticket can only be purchased at the SCSU Athletic Ticket Office - and they will be available at the door on the day of each game against Robert Morris. **2005-06 RESULTS:** SCSU is 6-8-2, 4-7-1 WCHA in 2005-06. The St. Cloud State University men's hockey team ended its 2004-05 season with a 14-23-3 overall record and an 8-19-1 WCHA record. In the always rugged WCHA, the Huskies placed ninth in 2004-05.



**SCSU COACH BOB MOTZKO:** Motzko (6-8-2, 4-7-1 WCHA career record) is only the second coach at SCSU since the Huskies moved to the NCAA Division I level in 1987-88. Motzko played served as a men's hockey assistant coach at the University of Minnesota from 2001-2005. A 1987 graduate of St. Cloud State University, Motzko was a two-year varsity letterwinner for the SCSU hockey team from 1984-86. Motzko began his coaching career in 1986-87 as an assistant coach for the legendary Herb Brooks at SCSU - and also worked with former SCSU head coach Craig Dahl. Motzko went on to serve as general manager and head coach of the USHL's North Iowa Huskies from 1987 through 1991. In 1991, Motzko was named assistant coach at Miami University (Ohio). He served for one season as an associate head coach at the University of Denver from 1993-94, before returning to Miami University in 1994. Motzko was named general manager and head coach of the USHL's Sioux Falls Stampede in 1998, and in 2000, Motzko was named the USHL General Manager of the Year. He then joined the staff at Minnesota in 2001. A native of Austin, Minn., Motzko and his wife Shelley are the parents of three children. They currently reside in St. Cloud, Minn.

**ASSISTANT COACHING STAFF:** Coach Motzko will be assisted in 2005-06 by Fred Harbinson and Eric Rud. Harbinson begins his fourth season as a member of the SCSU coaching corps in 2005-06. Harbinson is a 1995 graduate of Wisconsin-Superior. Rud will begin his first season as an assistant at SCSU in 2005-06. A 1997 graduate of Colorado College, Rud served as an assistant at CC in 2004-05. Eric Bakke will serve as the team's video coordinator in 2005-06, and Jeff Kruger will work as the team's strength and conditioning coach. Dave Wenniger is the team's goalie coach in 2005-06. The staff is completed by director of equipment operations and 12-year veteran Jeremiah MInkel.

## MORE NEWS AND NOTES...

**TEAM CAPTAINS:** Junior defender Casey Borer, a resident of Brooklyn Park, Minn., will serve as a team captain for the Huskies in 2005-06. The alternate captains for this winter are senior forward Konrad Reeder (Vanderhoof, B.C.) and senior forward Brock Hooton (Nanaimo, B.C.). Of note, the last time a junior served as a team captain for the Huskies was Jon Cullen in 2001-02.

**HUSKIES BEAR DOWN:** A hat trick by senior Konrad Reeder provided SCSU with the boost it needed to gain a 5-0 win at Alaska Anchorage on Dec. 2. Reeder got the Huskies started at UAA with his fourth goal of the season at 6:58 of the first period. Justiin Fletcher and Billy Hengen had assists. Reeder continued the hot hand at 14:30 of the first with his second goal of the night as Marty Mjelleli and Nate Raduns had assists on the play. Reeder brought home his first career hat trick when he scored at 17:35 of the first period, with assists provided by Mjelleli and Raduns. The third goal by Reeder was also the last allowed by starter John DeCaro, who was replaced after the play by Nathan Lawson. SCSU outshot the Seawolves 14-9 in the first period. SCSU iced the game late in the third period when John Swanson scored on the power play at 15:54, with assists from Grant Clifton and Reeder. Nate Raduns finished the scoring for SCSU at 16:44 with an assist from Casey Borer. For Goepfert, this was his second shutout of the season and his fifth career shutout as a collegiate goalie. Goepfert had three shutouts during his time at Providence College. In the game, Goepfert made 16 saves for the Huskies... SCSU was not able to make it a sweep, as host UAA charted a 2-1 win on Dec. 3. Sophomore Nate Dey gave the Huskies a 1-0 lead in the game with a goal at 4:28 of the second period. Dey, who was just out of the penalty box, was assisted on the play by sophomore Andrew Gordon and senior Konrad Reeder. For Dey, the goal was his first of the season and his sixth goal as a Husky. For Reeder, the assist provided him with his fifth point of the weekend in Alaska. The Seawolves ended Goepfert's shutout streak on the weekend with a power play goal by Charlie Kronschnabel at 7:21 of the second. He was assisted on the play by Spence Gilchrist and Billy Smith. SCSU's hopes of a weekend sweep in Anchorage were dashed when UAA's Billy Smith scored at 10:11 of the third period with an assist by Brent McMann. In the game, SCSU's goalie Bobby Goepfert made 24 saves while UAA goalie Nate Lawson had 34 saves in the game. On the power play, SCSU was 0-of-3 and UAA was 1-4.

## MORE NEWS AND NOTES...

**THE BOB MOTZKO SHOW:** The Bob Motzko Show will air live on Mondays from 6 p.m. to 7 p.m. on KNSI 1450 AM from JPs Grill and Bar in Sauk Rapids. Don Lyons will serve as the program's host along with Coach Motzko. St. Cloud Times sports writer Kevin Allenspach will also provide his insight each week. The public is invited to attend the weekly show at JPs Grill and Bar (located at Hwy 10 and Golden Spike Road in Sauk Rapids).

**IF THE HAT FITS:** Konrad Reeder gained his first career hat trick on Dec. 2 at UAA, and he now has six goals this winter. He posted the natural hat trick with three consecutive goals in the first period that night. Of note, the last person to gain a Husky hat trick was Joe Motzko on March 7, 2003 against Minnesota. The last person to gain a hat trick in one period was Mark Hartigan, who set a school record with four goals in a period against UAA on Feb. 15, 2002. Reeder now has 14 goals in his career at SCSU, and his six goals this season is a career-best for the forward from Vanderhoof, B.C. Reeder's previous season-high was five goals posted in 2003-04. He completed the big weekend with an assist later that night, and also had an assist on Nate Dey's goal on Dec. 3. In total, Reeder had a career-weekend with three goals and two assists for five points. The assist on Dec. 2, was Reeder's first of the season and he now has 14 goals and nine assists in his storied career with the Huskies.

**THREE POINT NIGHT:** Nate Raduns and Marty Mjelleli both enjoyed career bests with their three-point efforts against UAA on Dec. 2. Raduns had one goal and two assists in the 5-0 win over the Seawolves. He had previously posted two points several times during his career, but this was his first three point night. Mjelleli also had three assists in the win at UAA. A rugged performer from Shattuck-St. Mary's, Mjelleli grabbed his first three assists of his career in the game. He now has 1g/3a in his career with the Huskies.

**ANOTHER ZERO:** SCSU junior Bobby Goepfert chalked up his second shutout of the season on Dec. 2 with a 5-0 win over UAA. He had 16 saves in the game and now has five shutouts during his career as a collegiate player. Goepfert also had three shutouts during his two-year stint at Providence College. Of note, both of Goepfert's SCSU shutouts have taken place on the road. The last SCSU goalie to hit two shutouts in the same season was Jake Moreland with two shutouts during the 2002-03 campaign. Goepfert's goals against average is an impressive 2.03 and his save rate is .929 – both would be team records if the season ended today. The current SCSU season record for save percentage is .926 by Scott Meyer in 2000-01 and the GAA record is 2.22 set by Dean Weasler in 2001-02.

**FIRST ONE IN 2005-06:** Sophomore forward Nate Dey, who had 5g/7a in 2004-05, posted his first goal of the 2005-06 season on Dec. 3 at UAA. Dey scored at the 4:28 mark of the second period for the Huskies. Andrew Gordon and Konrad Reeder had assists on the play. Of note, Gordon now leads the team with 18 points (7g/11a). Gordon has already bypassed his season total for 2004-05, which was 17 (9g/8a). Gordon hails from Nova Scotia, but he played junior hockey with Notre Dame out of Wilcox, Sask.

**TOUGH SLATE:** As mentioned before, SCSU has played five nationally ranked teams in its first eight weekends of play. As the Huskies look ahead, SCSU's schedule includes dates at nationally ranked Colgate, Denver and North Dakota. SCSU will also host Colorado College and then finish the regular season with a date at #1 Wisconsin.

**SUNDAY TREAT:** SCSU will play in a rare Sunday night date on Dec. 18 against Robert Morris. This will mark the first time since Oct. 10, 2005 that the Huskies have played on a Sunday. The last time was a Sunday game against Ohio State in the third place game of the New Hampshire Icebreaker. SCSU won that game 3-1.

**SCSU VS. CHA:** As a Division I team, SCSU is 24-0 in games played against current members of the CHA (Air Force: 9-0, Huntsville: 7-0, Bemidji: 8-0). These records do not include SCSU games played before 1987-88. SCSU has never played Robert Morris,
