## 2005-06 SCSU MEN'S HOCKEY NEWS

Release Date: Jan. 3, 2006

**NEW YORK BOUND:** The St. Cloud State men's hockey team (8-8-2, 4-7-1 WCHA) will travel to Hamilton, N.Y. for a pair of non-conference games at #12/14 Colgate University (10-3-4, 6-1-1 ECAC) on Friday and Saturday, Jan. 6-7. The game time both nights is slated for 6 p.m. (CT) both nights at Colgate's Starr Rink (2,246/200x85). The games will also be broadcast live on KNSI AM 1450/KCML FM 99.90 out of St. Cloud. This marks the first time these two schools have played each other and it is the first time that SCSU has played games at Colgate. This will also be the final regular season non-conference series of the year for the Huskies.

**2005-06 RESULTS:** SCSU is 8-8-2, 4-7-1 WCHA in 2005-06. The St. Cloud State University men's hockey team ended its 2004-05 season with a 14-23-3 overall record and an 8-19-1 WCHA record. In the always rugged WCHA, the Huskies placed ninth in 2004-05.



**SCSU COACH BOB MOTZKO:** Motzko (8-8-2, 4-7-1 WCHA career record) is only the second coach at SCSU since the Huskies moved to the NCAA Division I level in 1987-88. Motzko played served as a men's hockey assistant coach at the University of Minnesota from 2001-2005. A 1987 graduate of St. Cloud State University, Motzko was a two-year varsity letterwinner for the SCSU hockey team from 1984-86. Motzko began his coaching career in 1986-87 as an assistant coach for the legendary Herb Brooks at SCSU - and also worked with former SCSU head coach Craig Dahl.

Motzko went on to serve as general manager and head coach of the USHL's North Iowa Huskies from 1987 through 1991. In 1991, Motzko was named assistant coach at Miami University (Ohio). He served for one season as an associate head coach at the University of Denver from 1993-94, before returning to Miami University in 1994. Motzko was named general manager and head coach of the USHL's Sioux Falls Stampede in 1998, and in 2000, Motzko was named the USHL General Manager of the Year. He then joined the staff at Minnesota in 2001. A native of Austin, Minn., Motzko and his wife Shelley are the parents of three children. They currently reside in St. Cloud, Minn.

**ASSISTANT COACHING STAFF:** Coach Motzko will be assisted in 2005-06 by Fred Harbinson and Eric Rud. Harbinson begins his fourth season as a member of the SCSU coaching corps in 2005-06. Harbinson is a 1995 graduate of Wisconsin-Superior. Rud will begin his first season as an assistant at SCSU in 2005-06. A 1997 graduate of Colorado College, Rud served as an assistant at CC in 2004-05. Eric Bakke will serve as the team's video coordinator in 2005-06, and Jeff Kruger will work as the team's strength and conditioning coach. Dave Wenniger is the team's goalie coach in 2005-06. The staff is completed by director of equipment operations and 11-year veteran Jeremiah Mlnkel.

Of note, this week's opponent Colgate is ranked #12 in the USCHO.com poll and #14 in the USA Today/USA Hockey Magazine poll this week.



## MORE NEWS AND NOTES...

**TEAM CAPTAINS:** Junior defender Casey Borer, a resident of Brooklyn Park, Minn., will serve as a team captain for the Huskies in 2005-06. The alternate captains for this winter are senior forward Konrad Reeder (Vanderhoof, B.C.) and senior forward Brock Hooton (Nanaimo, B.C.). Of note, the last time a junior served as a team captain for the Huskies was Jon Cullen in 2001-02.

**SWEEP VS. ROBERT MORRIS:** SCSU completed its first series sweep since a pair of wins over Sacred Heart last season on Jan. 28-29, by posting a big 6-2 win over Robert Morris on Dec. 18. Gary Houseman, who scored three goals on the weekend, started the ball rolling for the Huskies with a power play goal at 9:22 of the first period. He was assisted on the play by Dan Kronick and Aaron Brocklehurst. Marty Mjelleli continued with the hot hand as he scored SCSU's second goal of the night at 10:00 of the first. Kronick and David Carlisle had assists on the play. Robert Morris broke the weekend shutout at 18:39 of the first period, as Jace Buzek scored. To end the period, SCSU defender Casey Borer charted his first career goal at 19:11. He was assisted on the historic goal by Brock Hooton and Nate Dey. In the second period, Joe Jensen added his 12th goal of the season with a shorthanded effort at 3:53. The play was unassisted and it was Jensen's fourth career SHG. In the final period, Mjelleli notched his second goal of the evening with a tally at 14:00. Assists were provided by Konrad Reeder and Kronick. Reeder now owns a team-high, five game point scoring streak at SCSU. To complete the SCSU attack senior Josh Singer scored his first goal of the season at 18:37 on the power play. He was assisted on the play by Sean Garrity and Matt Francis. These were the first assists of the season for both Garrity and Francis, while Singer was also making his 2005-06 on-ice debut for the Huskies. RMU ended the game with a goal by Aaron Clarke at 20:00. On the night, SCSU was 4-of-8 on the power play, and RMU was 0-of-3. Jason Montgomery, who was making his first start and seeing his first playing time since a Feb. 26, 2005 game against Minnesota last season, made 29 saves in the game on route to his 10th career win at SCSU... on Dec. 17, the Huskies notched a 7-0 win over Robert Morris at the NHC. The Huskies' grabbed a quick lead in the first period and never let the Colonials answer the bell. Jensen scored his 12th career game winning goal, which ties a team record set by Joe Motzko from 1999-03. Jensen got the GWG at 2:43 of the first period with power play assists from Billy Hengen and Justin Fletcher. Jensen pushed the lead to 2-0 with a goal at 7:21 of the first period with assists from Fletcher and Andrew Gordon. In the second period, Dey scored a goal at 11:53. Hooton and Matt Hartman each had assists on the play. Hooton added his second goal of the season at 13:57 of the second with assists from Jensen and Gordon on the Husky power play. Into the third period, the Huskies kept up the pressure with a pair of goals by Houseman. To ice the night, Hartman scored his third goal of the season at 18:53 with assists from Aaron Brocklehurst and Reeder. SCSU outshot the Colonials 53-13 - including 19 shots apiece in the first and third periods. The shot total for SCSU was just three shy of the team record set twice against Michigan Tech - the latest coming on Feb. 1, 2003. SCSU's defensive effort was also stellar, as it marked the lowest shot total allowed since a 12 shot effort allowed against Alaska Anchorage at the NHC on Nov. 28, 2003. Junior goalie Bobby Goepfert (Kings Park, NY) gained his third shutout of the season in the game with 13 saves. Goepfert is the first SCSU goalie to post three shutouts in a season since Dean Weasler had three in 2001-02.

## MORE NEWS AND NOTES...

**THE BOB MOTZKO SHOW:** The Bob Motzko Show will air live on Mondays from 6 p.m. to 7 p.m. on KNSI 1450 AM from JPs Grill and Bar in Sauk Rapids. Don Lyons will serve as the program's host along with Coach Motzko. St. Cloud Times sports writer Kevin Alenspach will also provide his insight each week. The public is invited to attend the weekly show at JPs Grill and Bar (located at Hwy 10 and Golden Spike Road in Sauk Rapids).

**A NEW YEAR:** The St. Cloud State men's hockey team will kick off the 2006 portion of its schedule with a trip to New York on Jan. 6-7. The Huskies will play a pair of games in Hamilton, N.Y. against non-conference rival Colgate - a nationally ranked squad from the ECAC. Last year, Colgate advanced to the NCAA Division I playoffs where it lost a 6-5 decision to Colorado College in the Midwest Regional at Grand Rapids, Mich. This will mark the first time that SCSU and Colgate have played and it will also mark SCSU's final regular season non-conference series of the 2005-06 schedule. This will also mark the second time this season that SCSU has played an ECAC squad. On Nov. 25-26, the Huskies played a pair of games against ECAC rival Brown University at the National Hockey Center. SCSU won the first game of that series by a 4-1 margin, and skated to a 4-4 tie in game two. This will be the lone WCHA rival that Colgate plays during the regular season in 2005-06.

**ON TRACK FOR 100:** Senior Joe Jensen, a draftee of the Pittsburgh Penguins, is the team's current scoring leader with 12 goals and nine assists for 21 points. Last year, Jensen had 12 goals and 14 assists for a season career-high of 26 points. Jensen is rapidly closing in on membership in SCSU's elite 100-point club. At present, Jensen has 89 points (43g/46a) in his career. He is tied for the team's all-time game winning goal record with 12 during his career - he shares the record with Joe Motzko, who also had 12 from 1999-03. Jensen ranks among the team's top 25 players for career goals and career assists. Jeff Saterdalen is SCSU's all-time scoring leader with 179 points from 1988-92. Mark Hartigan is the team's all-time goal leader with 86 from 1999-02.

**PLUS/MINUS NOTE:** At +13, Andrew Gordon is leading the Huskies on the all-important plus-minus this season. He also ranks second on the team with 7 goals and 13 assists for 20 points. SCSU's freshman scoring leader in 2004-05, Gordon has already surpassed his 17 point (9g/8a) scoring total from last year.

**IMPRESSIVE NUMBERS:** at the midway point of the season, junior goalie Bobby Goepfert, a Pittsburgh Penguin draftee, has been impressive in the nets. He owns a 1.89 goals against average and a .931 save rate this season for the Huskies. Of note, the current team record for goals against average in a season is 2.22 set by Dean Weasler in 2001-02. Weasler also hit the save percentage record in 2001-02 with a .923 rate.

**TOUGH SLATE:** The Huskies have played five nationally ranked team this season - including #1 Wisconsin (which they tied 2-2 and lost 3-1 on Oct. 21-22 in St. Cloud). Others on that list include Northern Michigan, Minnesota, Colorado College and North Dakota. SCSU has posted a win or a tie over all the nationally ranked teams - with the exception of Colorado College. Colgate will be SCSU's sixth nationally ranked team played this season.

**EVERYONE GETS A POINT:** Did you know that every skater who has suited up for a game this season at SCSU has scored at least one point this season - this doesn't include all the SCSU goalies but Bobby Goepfert does have one assist this year.

**SCSU VS. ECAC:** Colgate is a member of the ECAC and it is currently in second place this season with a 6-1-1 record (10-3-4 overall). Since going DI in 1987-88, the Huskies have fared well against ECAC opponents as they own a 17-11-2 record against ECAC clubs. SCSU is 5-1-1 against Brown, 2-4-0 against RPI and 2-3-1 vs. St. Lawrence. Others on the list include Clarkson (2-2-0), Princeton (3-1-0), Dartmouth (2-0-0) and Yale (1-0-0).
