### SCSU vs. MINNESOTA - CLASIC COLLEGE HOCKEY

The #14/15 St. Cloud State University men's hockey team (10-10-2, 5-8-1 WCHA) will travel to Minnesota on Jan. 11 for a 7:07 p.m. game at Mariucci Arena (10,000/200x100). The Huskies and Gophers will play at the National Hockey Center (5,763 cap/200x100) in St. Cloud, on Jan. 12, at 7:07 p.m. In addition to the usual media coverage on radio, the Friday game is slated to be televised live on the national cable network Big Ten Network. The game at SCSU on Jan. 12, will be televised live on Charter Channel 14 in St. Cloud and on Fox Sports North out of Minneapolis. Fans can also watch the Saturday game this weekend on the B2 Networks live video stream at [www.stcloudstate.edu/athletics](http://www.stcloudstate.edu/athletics).

### HUSKY HEADLINERS:

- ▲ *These games against Minnesota will be part of the DQ Cup series, which SCSU won in 2006-07. The DQ Cup is awarded annually to the best WCHA team from the state of Minnesota.*
- ▲ *The Huskies are currently ranked #14/15 in the latest DI polls, while Minnesota is ranked 14/15. This marks the ninth consecutive nationally ranked opponent for SCSU.*
- ▲ *SCSU is 4-1-2 against the Gophers over the past two seasons during the Bob Motzko era, and SCSU is 3-0-2 in the last five outings against UM.*
- ▲ *The Huskies' Ryan Lasch leads all NCAA Division I players this season with 32 points this winter. He ranks third in the nation with a 1.45 ppg scoring rate.*

## MORE NEWS AND NOTES...

### LAST YEAR

The Huskies (22-11-7) placed second in the always rugged Western Collegiate Hockey Association (14-7-7 WCHA), which equals the team's best-ever finish in the regular season standings of the WCHA since SCSU joined the league in 1990-91. SCSU advanced to the 2007 WCHA Final Five for the second consecutive season (10th time in team history), thanks to first round playoff wins over Minnesota Duluth (SCSU won the series 2-1). To complete the season, the Huskies gained their first NCAA Division I tournament bid since 2003. This marked the sixth NCAA bid for the Huskies since 1989. SCSU lost in first round play at the 2007 NCAA East Regional by a score of 4-1 against Maine in Rochester, N.Y. The Huskies were the #2 seed at the Regional tournament.

### TEAM CAPTAINS

Senior defender Matt Stephenson, a resident of Midland, Ontario, has been named as the Huskies' captain for 2007-08. Senior forward Nate Dey (Maplewood, Minn.), junior forward Michael Olson (Tisdale, Sask.) and sophomore defender Garrett Raboin (Detroit Lakes) have all been selected as team alternate captains for the 2007-08 season.

### POLL POSITION

SCSU was ranked 14th in the latest USCHO.com poll, and 15th in the latest USA Today/USA Hockey Magazine poll. The Huskies have been ranked in the top 20 for 10 consecutive weeks...prior to Oct. 22, 2007, SCSU had gained a spot in the college hockey top 20 polls for 36 consecutive weeks...the Huskies ended the 2006-07 season ranked 7th in the final USCHO.com poll and 8th in the final USA Today/USA Hockey Magazine poll. ...of note, the #2 ranking (on 2/28/07) equals the best ranking the Huskies hit last season...in the WCHA pre-season poll, the Huskies received a sixth place ranking for 2007-08.

### FIRST GWG AT SCSU

Freshman Nick Oslund scored his first game winning goal as a Husky during SCSU's 3-2 win over North Dakota on Jan. 4. This was Oslund's third goal of the season...freshman Aaron Marvin posted his first power play goal of his collegiate career on Jan. 5 against UND. Marvin scored two goals last weekend against UND, and now has three goals this season.

### NATIONAL LEADER

Sophomore Ryan Lasch leads all NCAA Division I players with 32 points this season. He now has 17 goals and 15 assists for the Huskies in 2007-08. He ranks third in nation with a 1.45 ppg scoring average. Lasch owns a current three-game goal scoring streak (with five goals in the last three games) and a six-game point scoring streak. He leads the WCHA in points and goals, and he also ranks third in the nation with a goal scoring rate of .77 goals per game. In just two seasons of play, Lasch has scored 33g/38a for 71 points as a Husky. In comparison, current SCSU scoring record holder Jeff Saterdalen notched 93 points in his first two years at SCSU (41g/52a) in 1988-89 and 1989-90. In his career at SCSU, Saterdalen had 78g/101a for 179 career points from 1988-92.

### FIRST POINT IN 2007-08

Sophomore defender Jon Ammerman gained his first point of the season with an assist on Oslund's goal...junior Brent Borgen, a transfer from Minnesota, posted two assists in the win over UND. This was his first multi-point performance of the season at SCSU...freshman netminder Dan Dunn scored his third win of the season with his 33 save effort against UND on Jan. 4. He is now 3-1-1 on the season

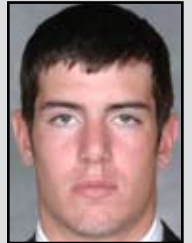

## The Last Time Out...

### Jan. 4: at #15 SCSU 3, #8 North Dakota 2

SCSU rallied with three third period goals to gain a 3-2 victory over #8 North Dakota on Friday, Jan. 4, at the NHC. Nick Oslund capped SCSU's third period rally with the game winner at 13:00 of the final period, as assists were provided by Jon Ammerman and Brent Borgen. Both teams went scoreless in the first period, as UND outshot the Huskies 10-8 in that period. In the second period, UND applied the pressure with 11 shots on goal and held the Huskies to no shots in the second period. UND broke the scoring deadlock at 1:43 of the second with a goal by Andrew Kozek. Early in the third period, UND looked to ice the game at :58 with a goal by Jake Marto. The Huskies added stage one of their comeback at 3:41 of the third period, with a goal by Ryan Lasch. Stage two of the comeback was completed by Aaron Marvin, who scored at 5:06 of the third period with an assist by Borgen. Dan Dunn (Oshawa, Ont.) was stellar between the pipes with 33 saves in the contest.

### Dec. 30: #16 St. Cloud State 4, #15 Harvard 1

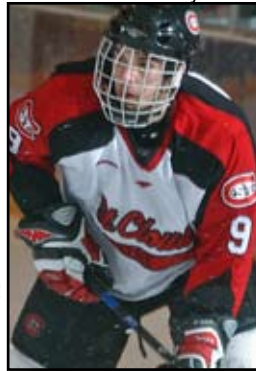
SCSU lost a tough WCHA match against #8 North Dakota on Jan. 5. UND relied upon a three-goal first period to wrap up the contest. The Huskies fell behind quickly as North Dakota's Rylan Kaip scored at the :13 mark of the first period. The Huskies managed to get back into the fray with Lasch's 17th goal of the season at 12:07 of the first period. UND charged to a 2-1 lead with a goal by Ryan Duncan at 16:48. Matt Watkins netted the game winner for UND at 18:24 of the first period. In the second period, SCSU started a comeback when Marvin posted his third goal of the season and second goal of the series at 5:20 on the power play. UND iced the game later in the second period, as T.J. Oshie scored at 8:57 of the second period. Duncan added his second goal of the night at 15:02 of the second. To conclude the scoring, Chris VandeVelde scored at 16:11. In the game, SCSU outshot UND by a 31-30 margin. Dunn was the goalie of record for SCSU with seven saves in the first period. Jase Weslosky completed the game with 17 saves in the final two periods of play. On the power play, SCSU was 1-of-7 and UND was 1-of-3. power play.



## MORE NEWS AND NOTES...

### FROSH LEADER AT SCSU

Freshman Garrett Roe continues to lead the nation's rookies in scoring this season with 28 points and a 1.33 ppg scoring rate. in 2007-08. Roe now has 11g/17a for a total of 28 points...sophomore Andreas Nodl saw his eight-game point streak snapped on Jan. 4, but he rebounded with an assist on Jan. 5. Nodl has been held off the score sheet only four times this season. He ranks third on the team with 10g/14a and 24 points. Lasch, Roe and Nodl rank first, second and fourth respectively in the WCHA scoring leader race this season.

### STREAKS SNAPPED

The win over UND on Jan. 4, was the first win by the Huskies over UND at the National Hockey Center since a 3-2 victory by SCSU on Nov. 18, 2005. The victory also snapped a six-game winless streak by the Huskies against UND, which dated back to a 2-1 OT win over UND on Jan. 28, 2006... senior Aaron Brocklehurst snapped a nine-game scoring drought with his 11th assist of the season on Jan. 5

### BORER SCORES AT CAROLINA

Casey Borer, who was a four-year standout for the Huskies on defense from 2003-07, was called up to the Carolina Hurricanes and made his NHL debut on Jan. 2 against Atlanta. He replaced former SCSU standout Bret Hedican (1988-91), who is on Carolina's injured reserve list. Borer went on to score his first NHL goal and assist on Jan. 4 vs. Atlanta... Borer joins a long list of Huskies in the NHL. Other former Huskies in the NHL this season include Tyler Arnason and Jeff Finger (Colorado), Matt Cullen and Hedican (Carolina), Mark Hartigan (Detroit), Ryan Malone (Pittsburgh), Mark Parrish (Minnesota), Duvie Westcott (Columbus) and Joe Motzko (Washington).

### DID YOU KNOW?

The six goals allowed by the Huskies on Jan. 5, was the most allowed by SCSU since a 6-2 loss to North Dakota on March 16, 2007 in the opening round of the WCHA Final Five. This marked only the fourth time this season that the Huskies have allowed more than four goals in a game. The four-goal deficit was also the largest for the Huskies since its loss to UND on March 16, 2007... SCSU's win on Jan. 4, marked the first time since Feb. 24, 2007 (vs. Minnesota) that the Huskies have roared back from a two-goal deficit to win a game... the games against UND marked the Huskies' 13th and 14th consecutive nationally ranked opponent... SCSU coach Bob Motzko, an assistant coach for UM's Don Lucia from 2001-05, owns a 4-1-2 record against the Gophers since moving to SCSU in 2005-06...SCSU is 3-0-2 in the last five meetings against UM and it is 4-4-2 in the last 10 meetings vs. the Gophers...last year, the Huskies posted a 5-5 tie and a 5-3 win at Mariucci, and the Huskies gained a 3-3 tie and a 5-1 win at the NHC in 2006-07...Ryan Lasch had three goals and five assists in four games vs. Minnesota last year.

### The Motzko Story

Bob Motzko will begin his third season as head coach with the Huskies in 2007-08. The 2006 and 2007 WCHA Coach of the Year, Motzko has guided the Huskies to two consecutive WCHA Final Five appearances, a second place regular season finish in the WCHA in 2007 and a berth in the 2007 NCAA Division I tournament. In three seasons with the Huskies, Motzko has charted an impressive 54-37-13 overall record and has seen the Huskies ranked among the nation's top 20 teams for more than 34 weeks (including a #7/8 national ranking in the final 2006-07 college polls) during his tenure at SCSU.

In 2006-07, Motzko led the Huskies to a 22-11-7 overall record and a second place record of 14-7-7 in the always rugged WCHA. SCSU advanced to the WCHA Final Five in 2007, and also gained the team's first NCAA bid since 2003. In 2007, Motzko saw SCSU standout Bobby Gopfert named a Hobey Baker Award top 10 finalist. SCSU freshman forward Andreas Nodl was named the 2007 HCA Division I Rookie of the Year and the 2007 WCHA Rookie of the Year. SCSU players have already gained All-America honors twice during Motzko's tenure.

In 2005-06, the Huskies earned a 22-16-4 overall record and a 13-13-2 WCHA record in 2005-06. SCSU ranked 14th in the final national college polls in 2005-06, and the Huskies also advanced to the title game of the 2006 WCHA Final Five - marking SCSU's first trip to the Final Five since 2001-02.

A former SCSU hockey player and graduate of St. Cloud State, Motzko served as a men's hockey assistant coach at the University of Minnesota since 2001. He was part of two NCAA Division I national championship teams in 2002 and 2003, and helped the Gophers win WCHA playoff crowns in 2003 and 2004. His four recruiting classes at Minnesota were considered among the best in the nation, and Motzko helped produce one Hobey Baker Award winner, three first team All-Americans, two second team All-Americans and many All-WCHA honorees at Minnesota.

A 1987 graduate of St. Cloud State University, Motzko was a two-year varsity letterwinner for the SCSU hockey team from 1984-86. Motzko began his coaching career in 1986-87 as an assistant coach for the legendary Herb Brooks at SCSU - and also worked with former SCSU head coach Craig Dahl.

Motzko went on to serve as general manager and head coach of the USHL's North Iowa Huskies from 1987 through 1991. In 1989, Motzko led the North Iowa squad to a United States Junior A national championship and was named that year's USHL Coach of the Year.

In 1991, Motzko was named associate head coach at Miami University (Ohio), where he helped lead the RedHawks to a Central Collegiate Hockey Association title and an NCAA tournament berth in 1992-93. He served for one season as an associate head coach at the University of Denver from 1993-94, before returning to Miami University in 1994.

Motzko was named general manager and head coach of the USHL's Sioux Falls Stampede in 1998. He led the Stampede to a 77-31-6 record in the team's first two seasons in the USHL, and in 2000, Motzko was named the USHL General Manager of the Year. At Sioux Falls, 26 players moved on to college programs around the United States including SCSU standouts Mike Doyle, Joe Jensen and Dave Iannazzo.

A native of Austin, Minn., Motzko and his wife Shelley are the parents of three children. They currently reside in St. Cloud, Minn.

**MOTZKO'S STAFF:** Motzko will be assisted this winter by third-year coach Eric Rud and first-year coach Mike Gibbons. and first-year volunteer goalie coach Justin Johnson. SCSU's support staff features 13-year veteran equipment manager Jeremiah Minkel, three-year veteran athletic trainer Bryan DeMaine, strength and fitness coordinator Travis Zins and director of hockey operations Mr. Matt Chapman.
