2005-06 SCSU MEN'S HOCKEY NEWS

HUSKIES TRAVEL TO MANKATO: St. Cloud State men's hockey team (17-10-3, 12-9-1 WCHA) will travel to downstate rival Minnesota State Mankato (12-16-4, 8-13-3 WCHA) for a pair of league games on Feb. 17 (7:37 p.m.) and Feb. 18 (7:07 p.m.). The games will also be broadcast live on KNSI AM 1450/KCML FM 99.9 out of St. Cloud. The games will be televised live on Charter Communications Cable channel 14 and Astound Cable channel 27 in the St. Cloud region via Charter's Main Street Channel. The games are also slated to be televised in the Twin Cities area on Comcast Cable...both of these games will count toward the DQ Cup standings, and a SCSU sweep over the Mavericks would clinch the inaugural DQ Cup title for the Huskies. This marks the only time during the regular season that SCSU will play the Mavericks. In the all-time series at the DI level, SCSU leads the Mavericks 17-4-3.

2005-06 RESULTS: SCSU is 17-10-3, 12-9-1 WCHA in 2005-06. The St. Cloud State University men's hockey team ended its 2004-05 season with a 14-23-3 overall record and an 8-19-1 WCHA record. In the always rugged WCHA, the Huskies placed ninth in 2004-05.



SCSU COACH BOB MOTZKO: Motzko (17-10-3, 12-9-1 WCHA career record) is only the second coach at SCSU since the Huskies moved to the NCAA Division I level in 1987-88. Motzko served as a men's hockey assistant coach at the University of Minnesota from 2001-2005. A 1987 graduate of St. Cloud State University, Motzko was a two-year varsity letterwinner for the SCSU hockey team from 1984-86. Motzko began his coaching career in 1986-87 as an assistant coach for the legendary Herb Brooks at SCSU - and also worked with former SCSU head coach

Craig Dahl. Motzko went on to serve as general manager and head coach of the USHL's North Iowa Huskies from 1987 through 1991. In 1991, Motzko was named assistant coach at Miami University (Ohio). He served for one season as an associate head coach at the University of Denver from 1993-94, before returning to Miami University in 1994. Motzko was named general manager and head coach of the USHL's Sioux Falls Stampede in 1998, and in 2000, Motzko was named the USHL General Manager of the Year. He then joined the staff at Minnesota in 2001. A native of Austin, Minn., Motzko and his wife Shelley are the parents of three children. They currently reside in St. Cloud, Minn.

ASSISTANT COACHING STAFF: Coach Motzko will be assisted in 2005-06 by Fred Harbinson and Eric Rud. Harbinson begins his fourth season as a member of the SCSU coaching corps in 2005-06. Harbinson is a 1995 graduate of Wisconsin-Superior. Rud will begin his first season as an assistant at SCSU in 2005-06. A 1997 graduate of Colorado College, Rud served as an assistant at CC in 2004-05. Eric Bakke will serve as the team's video coordinator and travel coordinator in 2005-06, and Jeff Kruger will work as the team's strength and conditioning coach. Dave Wenniger is the team's goalie coach in 2005-06. The staff is completed by director of equipment operations and 11-year veteran Jeremiah Mlnkel.

OLYMPIC GLORY: Mark Parrish, who played for the Huskies from 1995-97, will play for Team USA at the upcoming Winter Olympics in Italy. On Feb. 6, Bret Hedican (1988-91) was announced as a squad member of the 2006 USA Olympic Team. He replaces the injured Aaron Miller on the Team USA roster. This mark's Hedican second trip to the Olympics. He also played in the 1992 games in Albertville. Former Husky Matt Cullen (1995-97) was also named as a member of the Team USA "taxi squad," which will travel to Italy and he will serve as a reserve at the Games in case of injury.

HUSKY HOCKEY ON THE AIR: Once again in 2005-06, KNSI AM 1450 and KCML FM 99.59 will carry SCSU hockey live over the radio (and on the web at www.1450knsi.com). Don Lyons will call the play-by-play with color commentary provided by SCSU All-American Dave Reichel..home and away games will also be broadcast live on KVSC 88.1. You can also pick up KVSC on the web at www.kvsc.org

HUSKIES UP TO #14: SCSU moved up to #14 in the USCHO.com poll this week. The Huskies received 25 votes in the USA Today/American Hockey Magazine poll on Feb. 13. The Huskies have played seven nationally ranked teams this season including Wisconsin, Northern Michigan, Minnesota, Colgate, Colorado College, Denver and North Dakota.



MORE NEWS AND NOTES...

TEAM CAPTAINS: Junior defender Casey Borer, a resident of Brooklyn Park, Minn., will serve as a team captain for the Huskies in 2005-06. The alternate captains for this winter are senior forward Konrad Reeder (Vanderhoof, B.C.) and senior forward Brock Hooton (Nanaimo, B.C.). Of note, the last time a junior served as a team captain for the Huskies was Jon Cullen in 2001-02.

HUSKIES SPLIT WITH #8 CC: SCSU ended a six-game losing streak against #8 Colorado College on Feb. 11, with a big 2-1 win over the Tigers at the NHC. The victory was the first for the Huskies against CC since a 4-3 victory at Colorado Springs on Feb. 11, 2005. This also marked the first win for the Huskies over CC at the National Hockey Center since a 4-2 decision on Feb. 14, 2003. Senior Joe Jensen posted the game winner at 17:51 of the second on the power play. He was assisted on the play by team scoring leader Andrew Gordon and Justin Fletcher. Jensen's goal broke a 1-1 stalemate that was set up by Colorado College's Lee Sweat, who scored his team's lone goal at 12:27 of the second. SCSU broke the ice in the game at 9:43 of the first period with a goal by Gary Houseman, his fifth of the season. He was assisted on the play by Fletcher and Matt Stephenson. In the game, SCSU was outshot 41-31 but they were 1-of-3 on the power play. CC was 0-of-5 on the power play in the game. In the nets, the game's number star was SCSU's Bobby Goepfert. He made 40 saves against the #8 ranked Tigers. Chris Kawano had 29 saves for CC in the match... CC snapped a six-game winning streak for SCSU with a 6-3 victory over the Huskies on Feb. 10 in St. Cloud. CC gained an early lead in the game as Brandon Polich scored at 2:26 of the first period. The Huskies roared back at 6:30 as Andrew Gordon scored his 14th goal of the season on the power play with assists from Brock Hooton and Grant Clifton. CC gained a 2-1 lead at 13:58 with an unassisted goal by Chad Rau. In the second period, CC pushed the score to 3-1 with a goal by Lee Sweat at 3:44. The Huskies moved back into the hunt with a power play goal by Dan Kronick at 5:07 of the second. Aaron Brocklehurst and Grant Clifton were both credited with assists on the play. The game winner was notched at 5:28 of the second by Jimmy Kilpatrick. Rau posted his second goal of the night at 18:01 of the second. In the third period, SCSU moved it to 5-3 with a goal by Billy Hengen at 10:12. Justin Fletcher had the assist on Hengen's sixth goal of the season. To ice the contest, CC's Marty Sertich scored at 16:06 of the third.

AMONG THE BEST: SCSU's offense ranks 17th in the nation with 3.30 goals per game. Among WCHA teams, SCSU ranks fourth in the loop... at 86.4%, the Huskies rank eighth in the nation on the penalty kill and second in the WCHA (overall games played)...the Huskies rank ninth in the nation on the power play at 20.8% this season and fourth in the WCHA. Colorado College is ranked 5th in the WCHA, and SCSU held the Tigers scoreless on the advantage this past weekend...the Huskies have finally hit the bottom - the bottom of the penalty minute list this season. SCSU is currently the least penalized team in the nation with just 13.6 PIM per game this season...SCSU ranks sixth in the nation with a 1.00 scoring margin this season...at 2.30 goals allowed this season, the Huskies rank 10th in the nation on defense...Joe Jensen is tied for 6th in the nation with four game winning goals this season... with 22 points to his credit, Fletcher ranks 14th in the nation for defenseman scoring.

MORE NEWS AND NOTES...

THE BOB MOTZKO SHOW: The Bob Motzko Show will air live on Mondays from 6 p.m. to 7 p.m. on KNSI 1450 AM from JPs Grill and Bar in Sauk Rapids. Don Lyons will serve as the program's host along with Coach Motzko. St. Cloud Times sports writer Kevin Alenspach will also provide his insight each week. The public is invited to attend the weekly show at JPs Grill and Bar (located at Hwy 10 and Golden Spike Road in Sauk Rapids).

ALL ALONE: Senior forward Joe Jensen notched his 13th career game winning goal on Feb. 11. Jensen is now the lone all-time career game winning goal leader at SCSU. He was previously tied for the GWG honor along with former SCSU standout Joe Motzko, who had 12 game winners from 1999-03. Motzko is currently playing professional hockey in the Columbus Bluejackets system. Jensen now has 92 career points at SCSU, with 45 goals and 47 assists. He also has 14 power play goals in his career.

NICE COMEBACK: After being pulled during the game in SCSU,s 6-3 loss to #8 ranked CC on Feb. 10, junior goalie Bobby Goepfert came back strong in game two of the CC series. In the complete game win, Goepfert posted 40 saves - including 19 third period saves. The 40 saves is the most posted by Goepfert in a game this season. His top effort pushed his GAA back down to 2.07 and his save rate this season to .927. Goepfert ranks 10th in the nation for GAA and ninth for Save Percentage.

FLETCHER ON FIRE: Junior defender Justin Fletcher and sophomore forward Andrew Gordon both have team leading three-game point scoring streaks. Fletcher had assists on both goals in the Huskies, 2-1 win over CC, and he had one assist on Feb. 10. Gordon assisted Jensen on his game winning goal on Feb. 11, and he also had a goal on Feb. 10...of note, Gordon currently leads the Huskies in scoring with 14 goals and 17 assists for 31 points. He is tied with Jensen for the team,s goal scoring lead, while Billy Hengen leads the team in assists with 20...Fletcher leads the Huskies at +17 on the plus/minus.

IT HAS BEEN A LONG TIME: The Huskies, 6-3 setback against the Tigers on Feb. 10, snapped a six-game win streak this season for SCSU. The last time that SCSU lost a game was on Jan. 14 at Denver. The last time SCSU lost a game at home prior to Feb. 10, was a setback against UND on Nov. 19. The six goals allowed in the CC loss were the most given up by the Huskies in a game since an 8-2 loss to the Tigers on March 11, 2005 in the WCHA playoffs. The last time SCSU allowed six goals at the NHC was a 6-1 loss to Denver on Jan. 22, 2005.

SINGER SEWS UP ANOTHER WIN: Senior forward Josh Singer saw ice time on Feb. 11 for just the third time this season. In each of Singer's three games played this season, the Huskies have charted a victory.

HUSKY FACTS: Joe Jensen ranks 18th in the SCSU records with 14 career power play goals...with 21g/52a for 73 career points, Billy Hengen is the second leading active player for career points at SCSU - behind Jensen's 92 points...the CC game on Feb. 10, was the first time this season that the Huskies have suffered a loss when they have scored three-or-more goals in a game. The game also marked the first time that the Huskies have allowed more than five goals in a game this season...the Huskies are a perfect 4-0-0 when Gary Houseman scores a goal this season...SCSU is 8-8-2 against nationally ranked teams this season...SCSU is 11-2-1 when its opponent fails to score on the power play...the Huskies have only lost one game in Mankato during the SCSU Division I era (since 1987-88). That loss in the city of Mankato occurred on Nov. 15, 2002 with a 7-6 setback against the Mavericks at the Midwest Wireless Civic Center...both SCSU and MSU are members of the always rugged North Central Conference for the two schools' Division II athletic teams.
